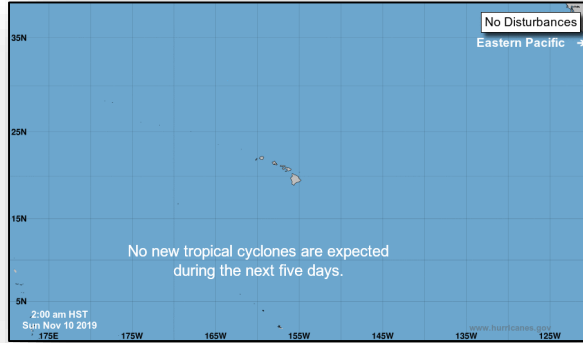

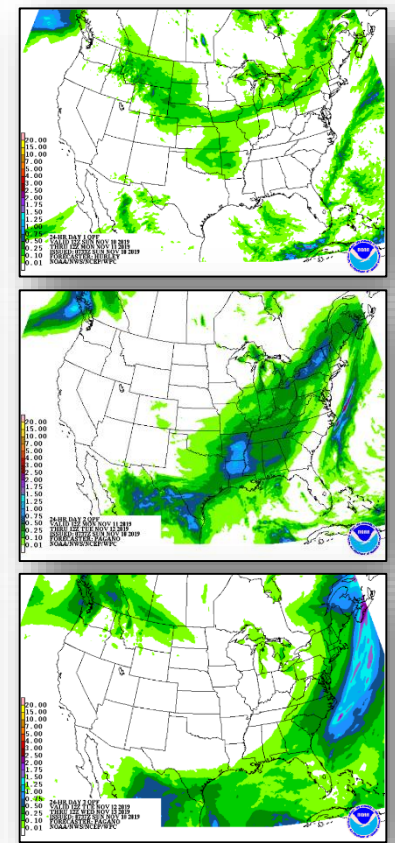
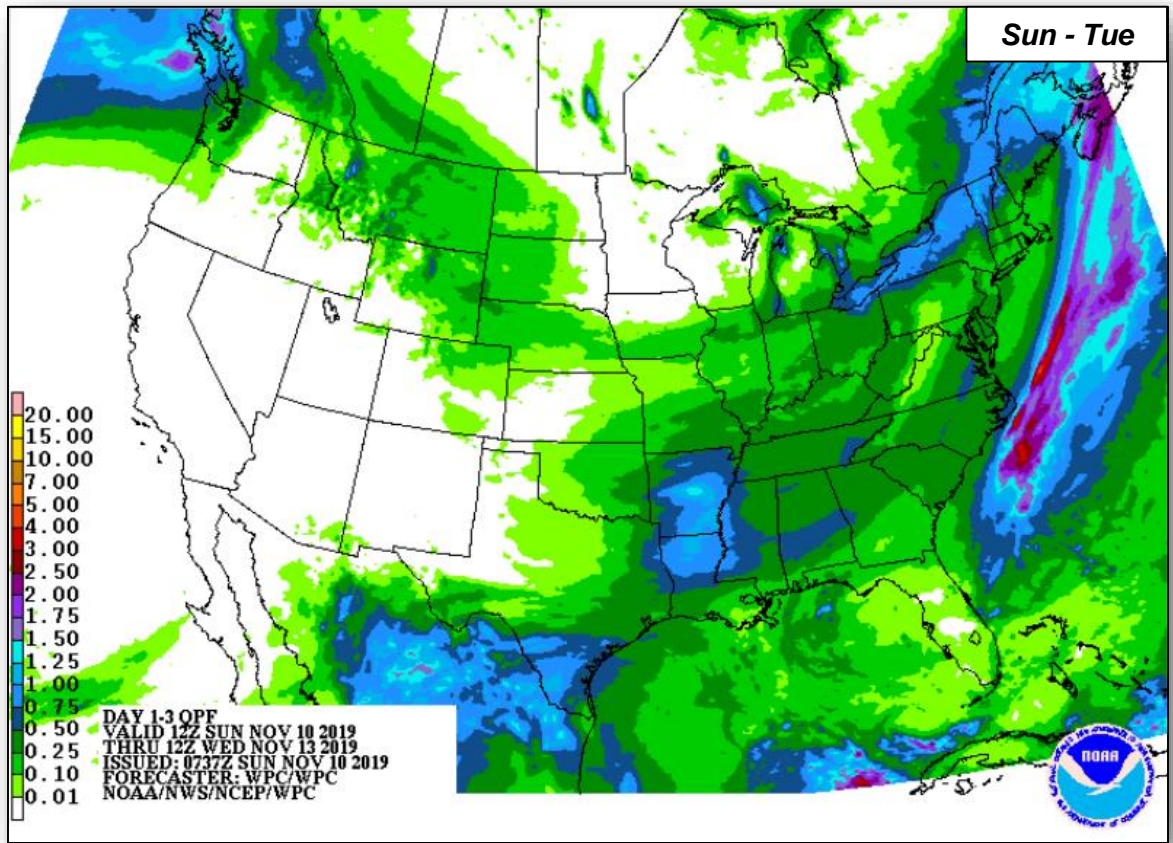
National Weather Forecast



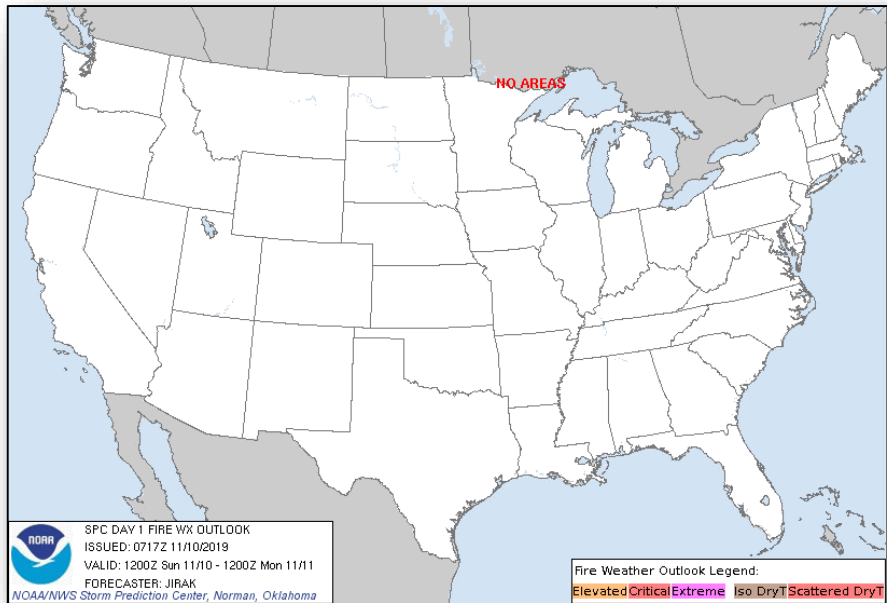
Severe Weather Outlook



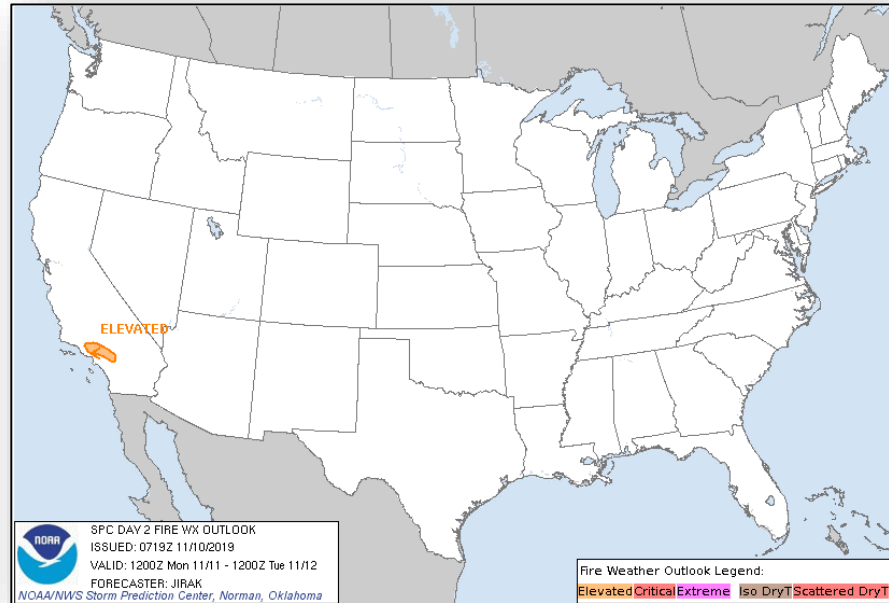
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



Fire Weather Outlook

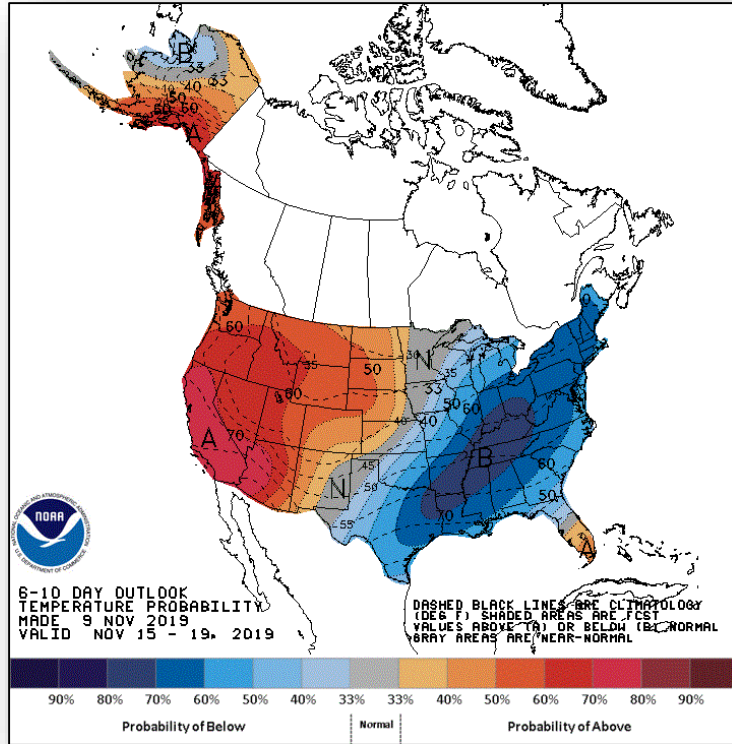

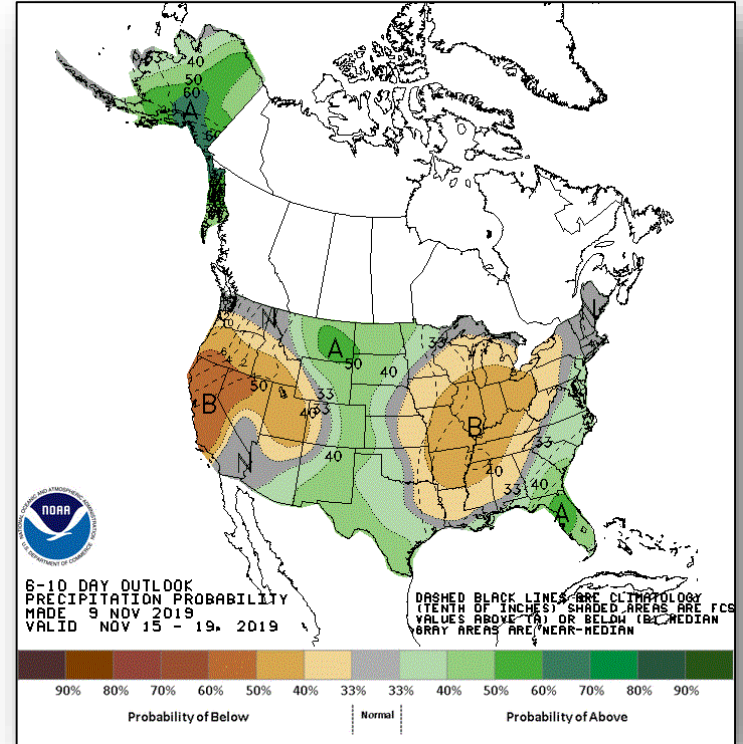

6-10 Day Temperature Probability



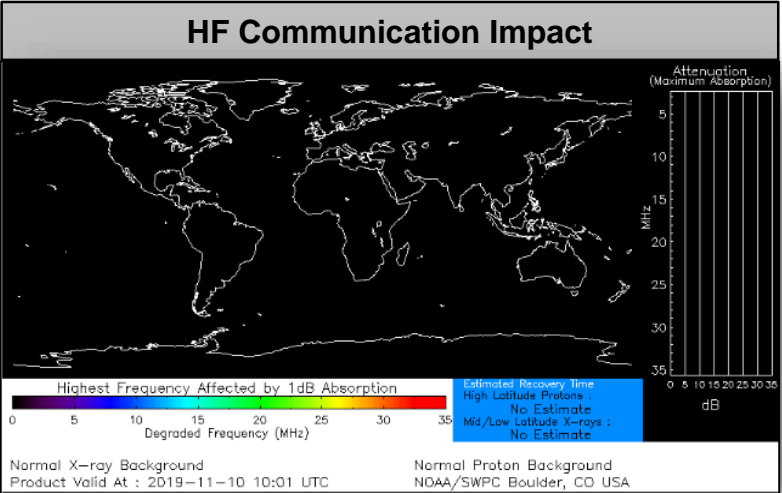
6-10 Day Precipitation Probability
