- Moderate to heavy rainfall and flash flooding threat over the Desert Southwest

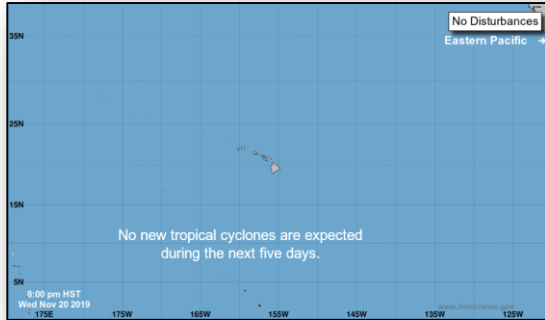
## **Tropical Activity:**

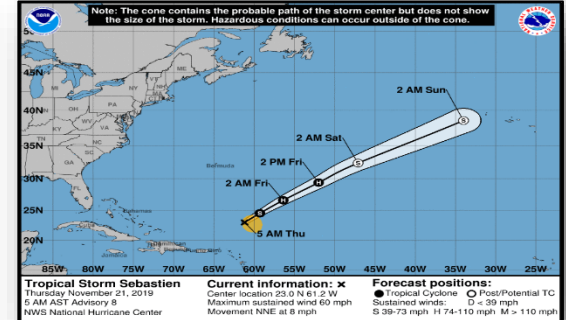

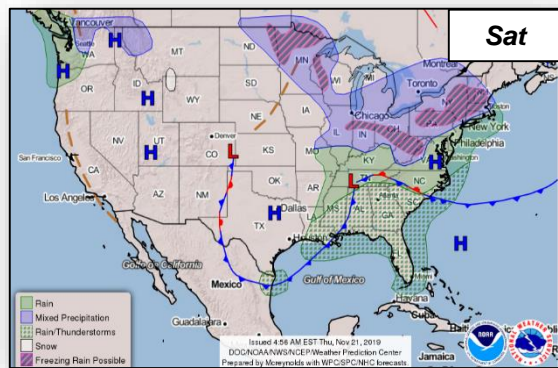
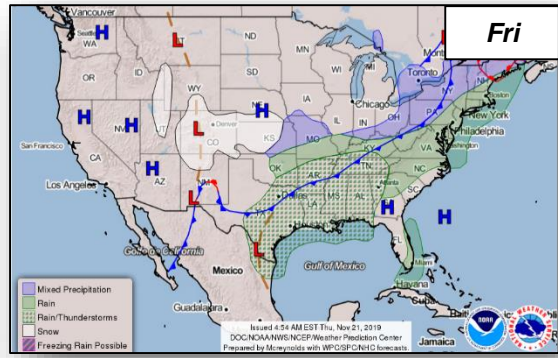
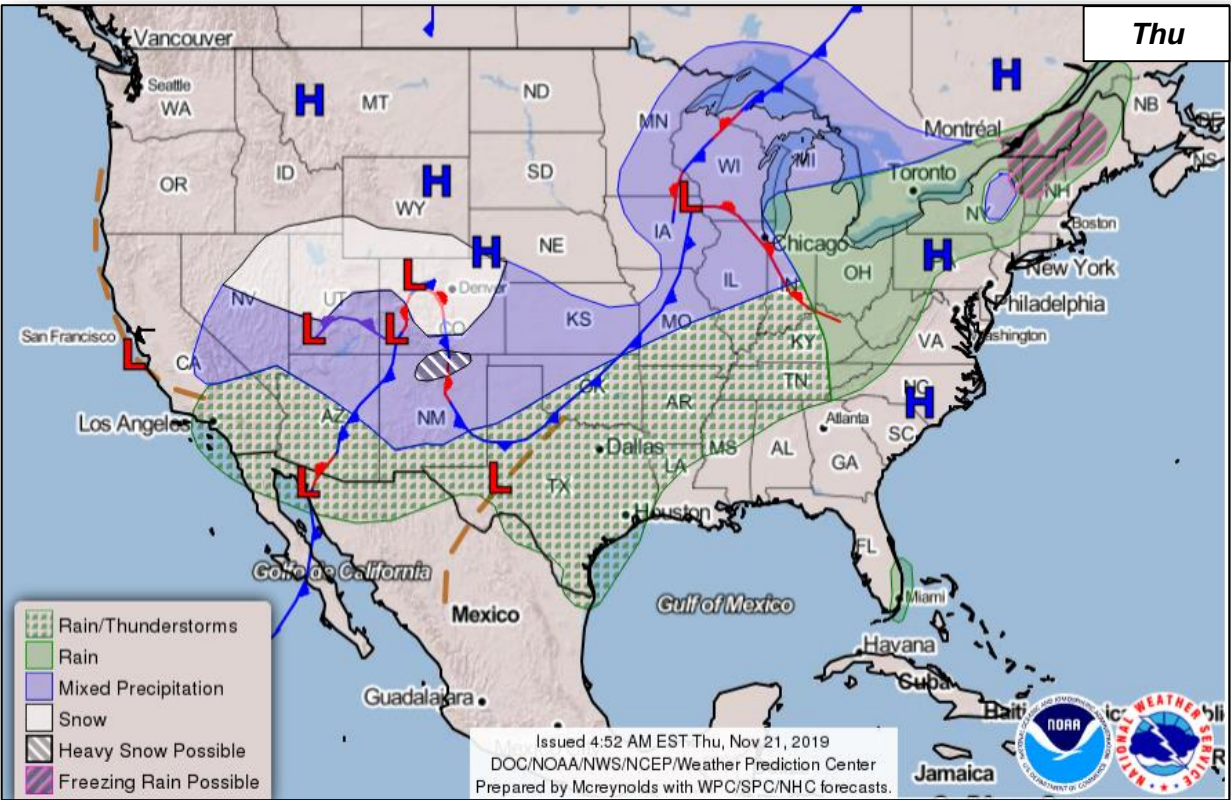
**Tropical Storm Sebastien** (Advisory #8 as of 4:00 a.m. EST)

- 355 miles NNE of the Leeward Islands
- Moving NNE at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 160 miles
- Could become a hurricane tonight or Friday
- No threat to U.S. interests

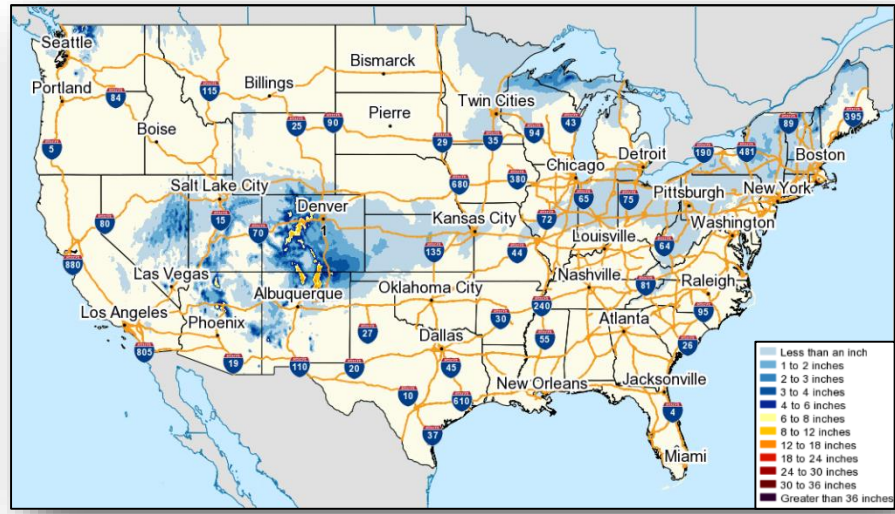
Current Disturbances & 5 Day Cyclone Formation: < 40% | 40-60% | > 60%
