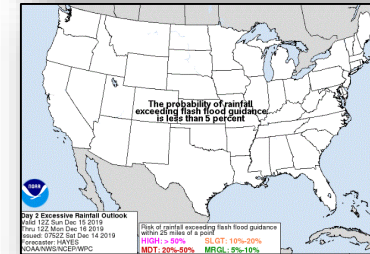
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



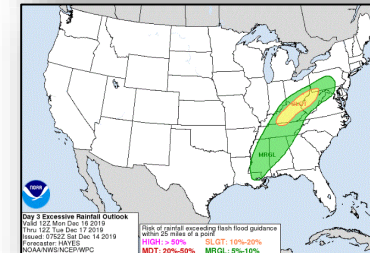

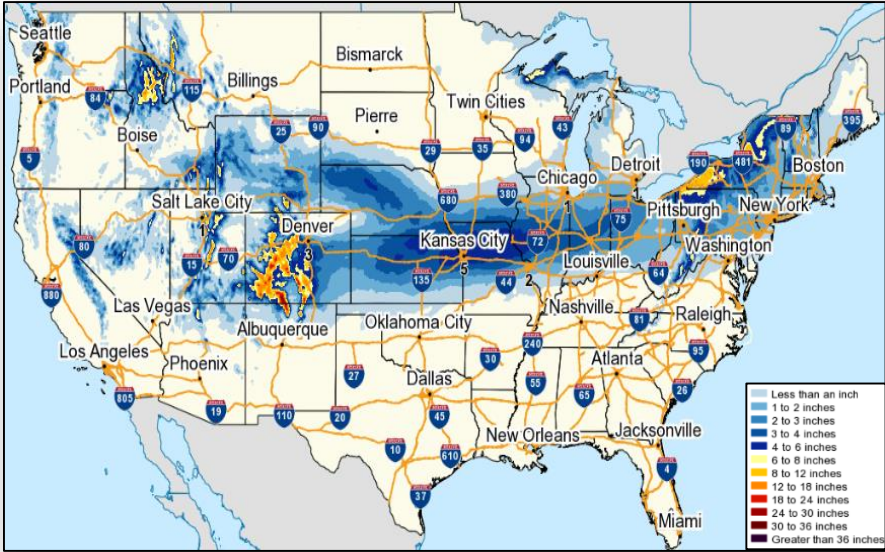

Forecast Snowfall

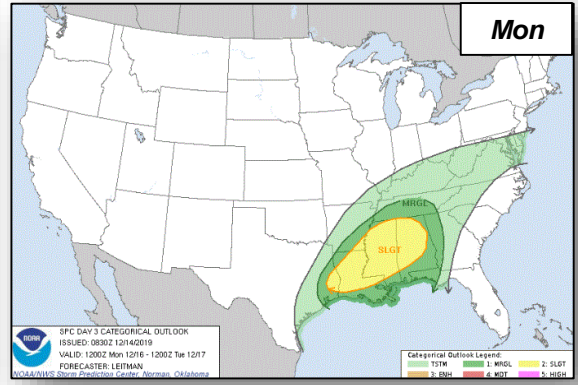
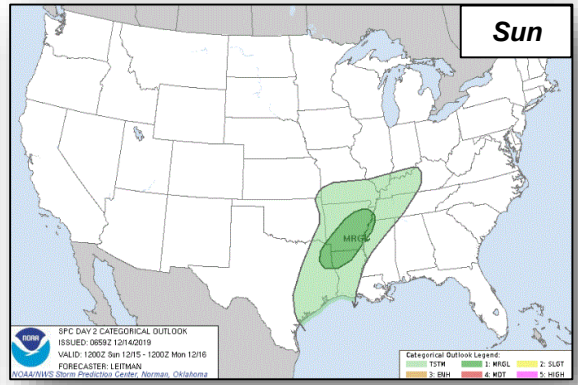
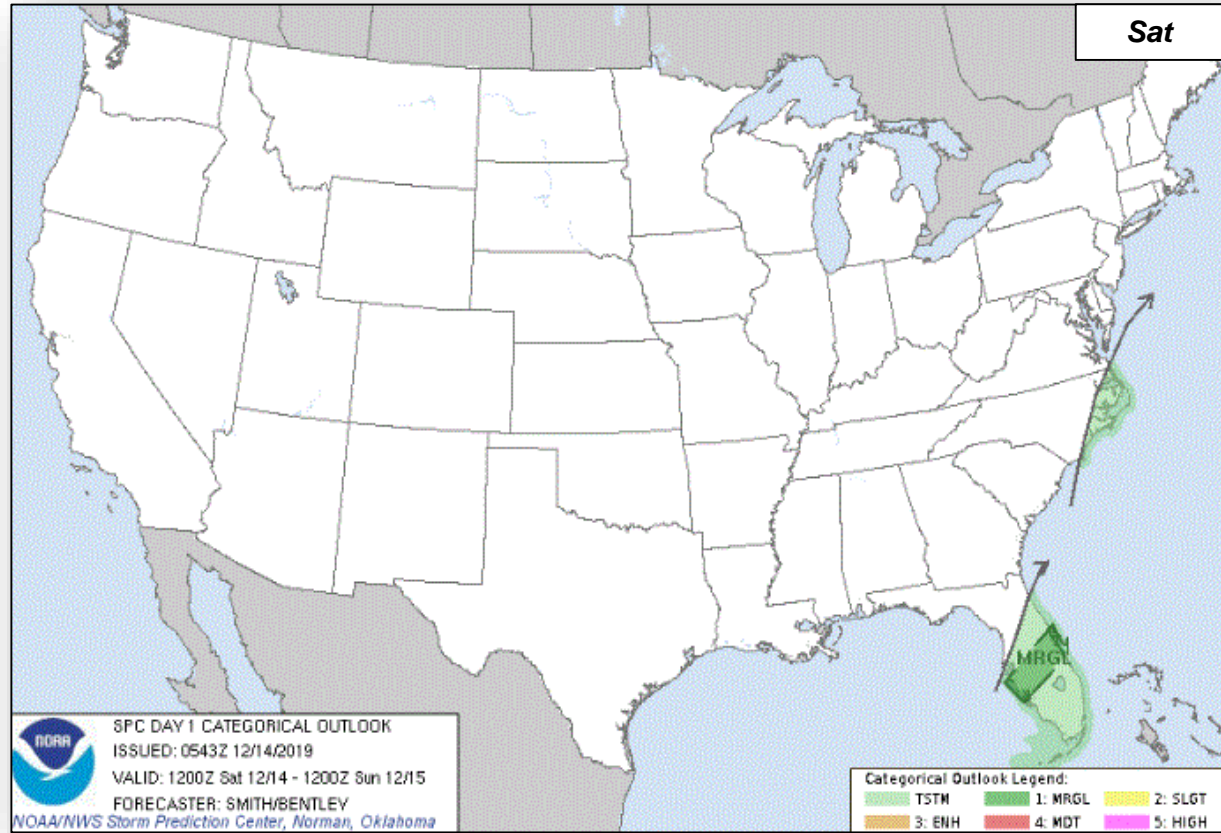


Forecast Ice Accumulation

Severe Weather Outlook



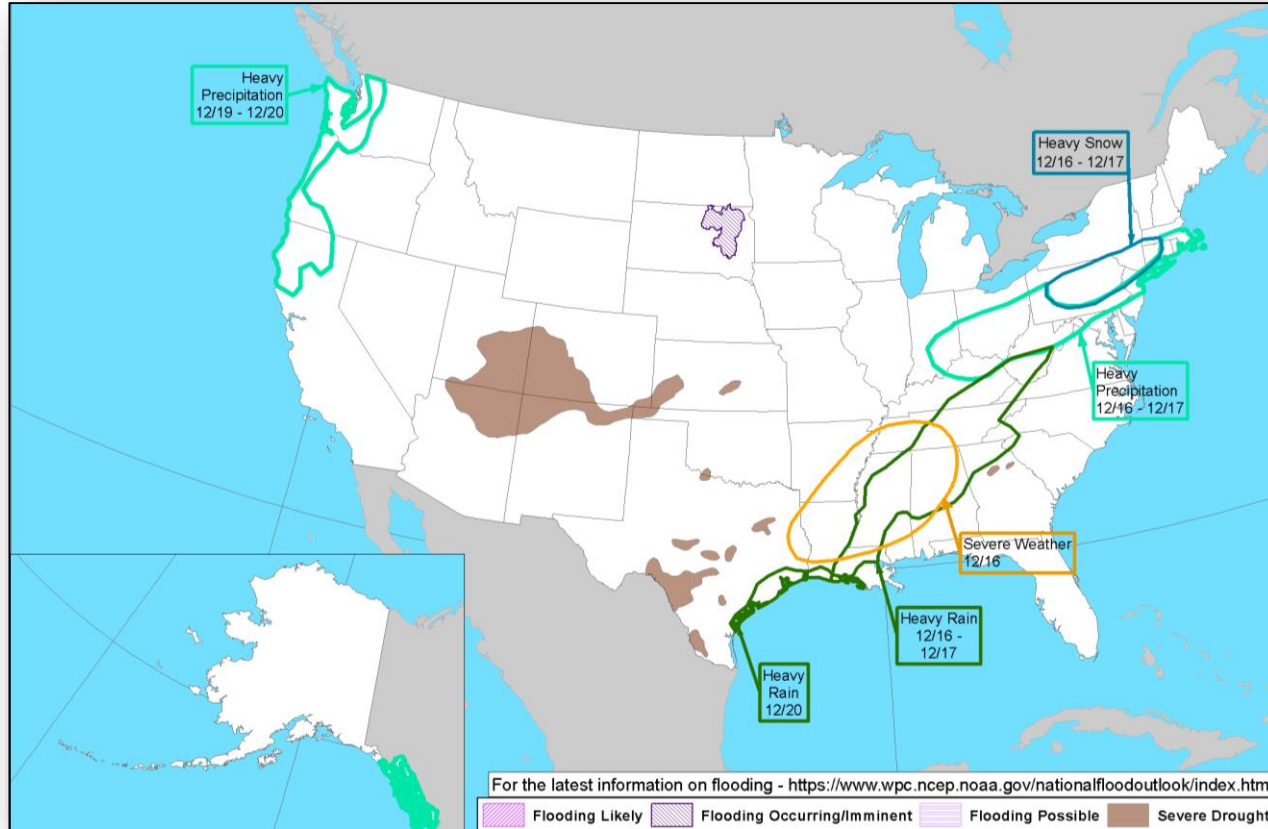

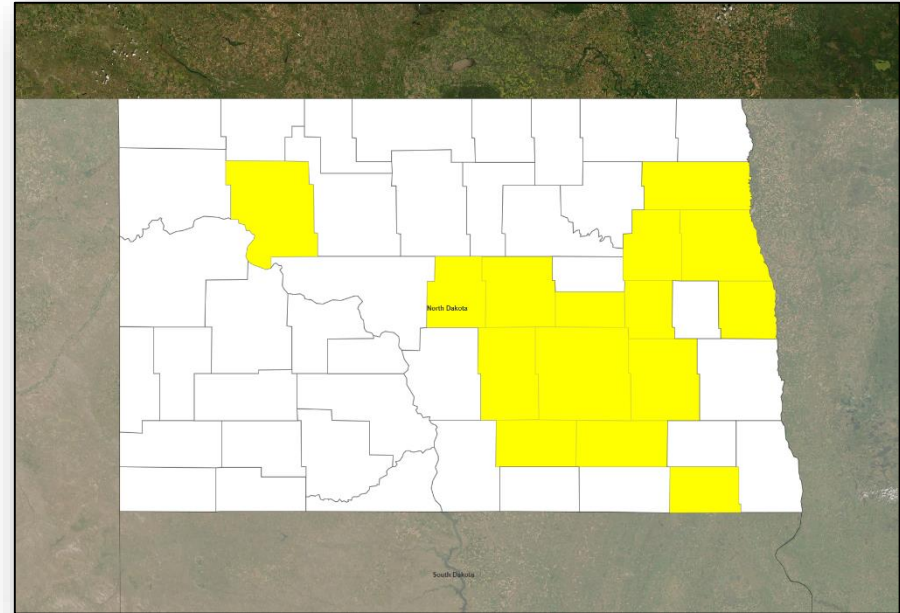
