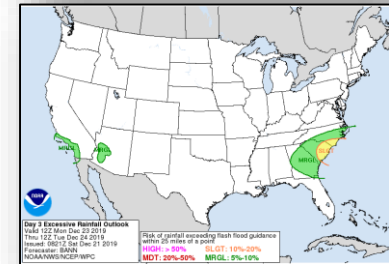
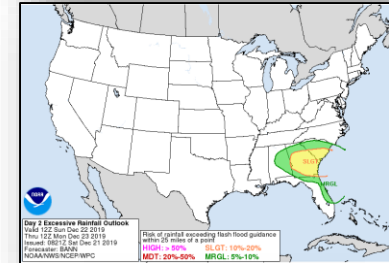
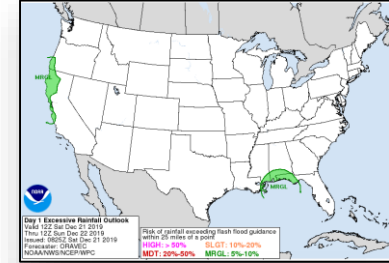
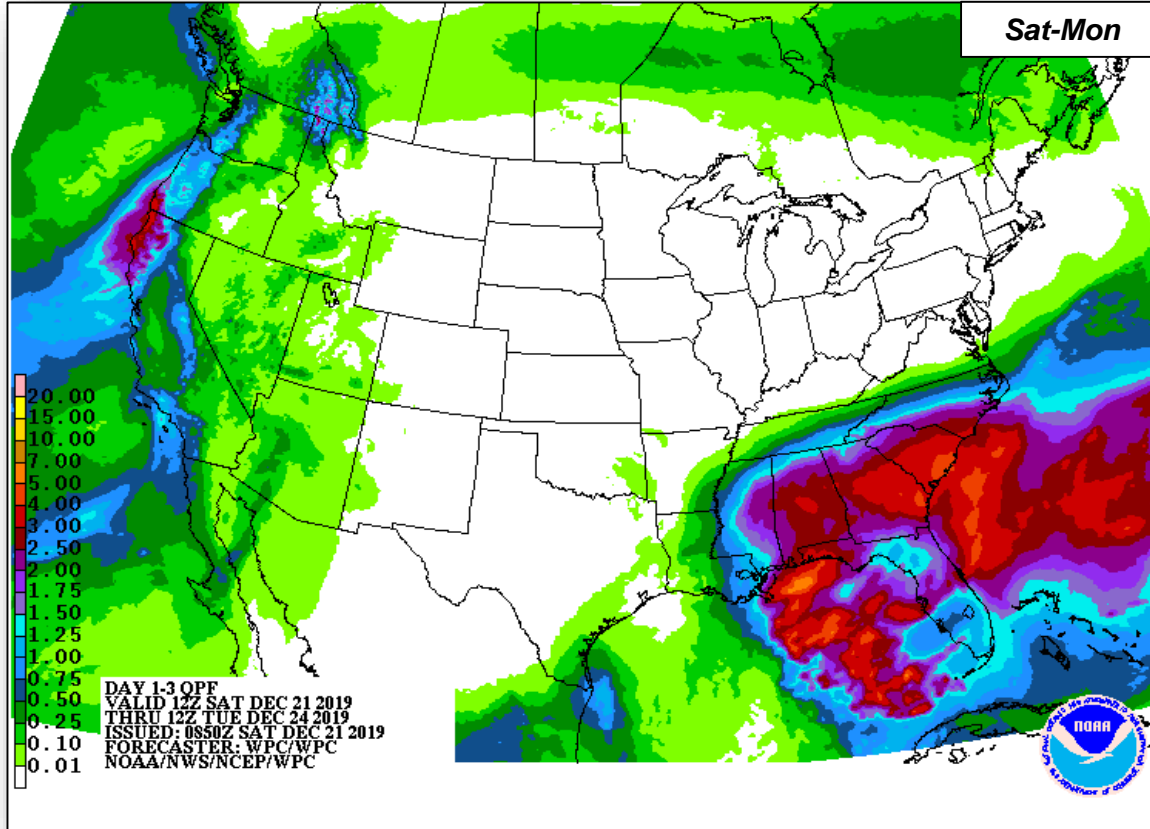
National Weather Forecast

Forecast Snowfall

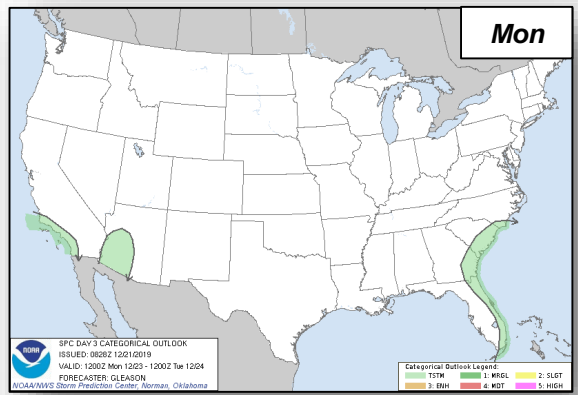
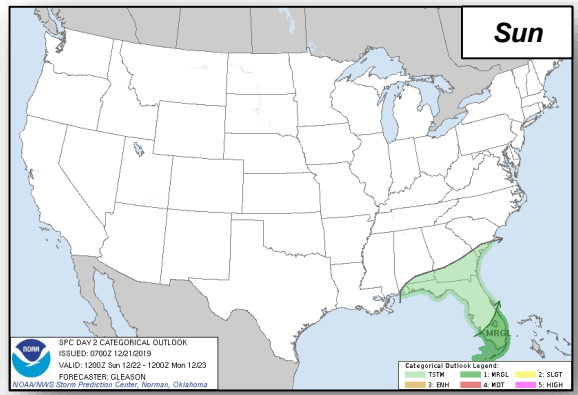
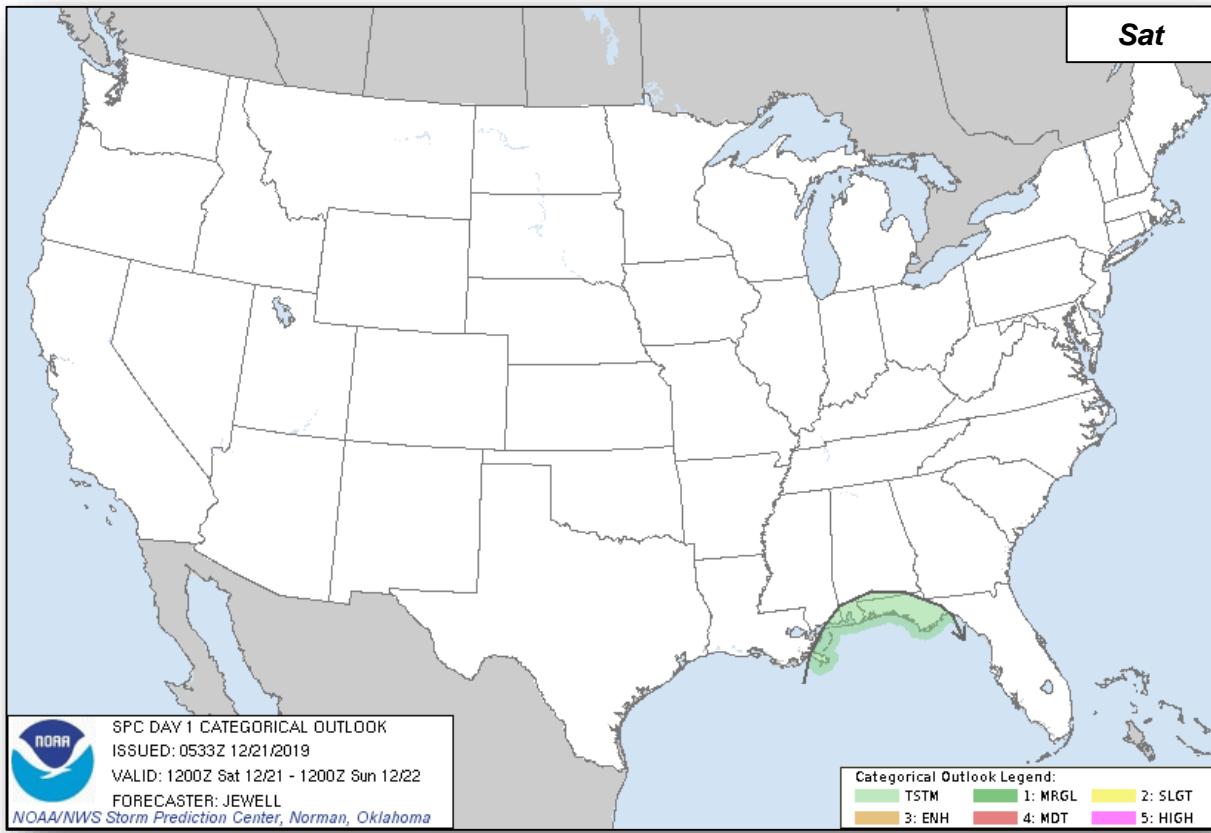


Forecast Ice Accumulation

Severe Weather Outlook



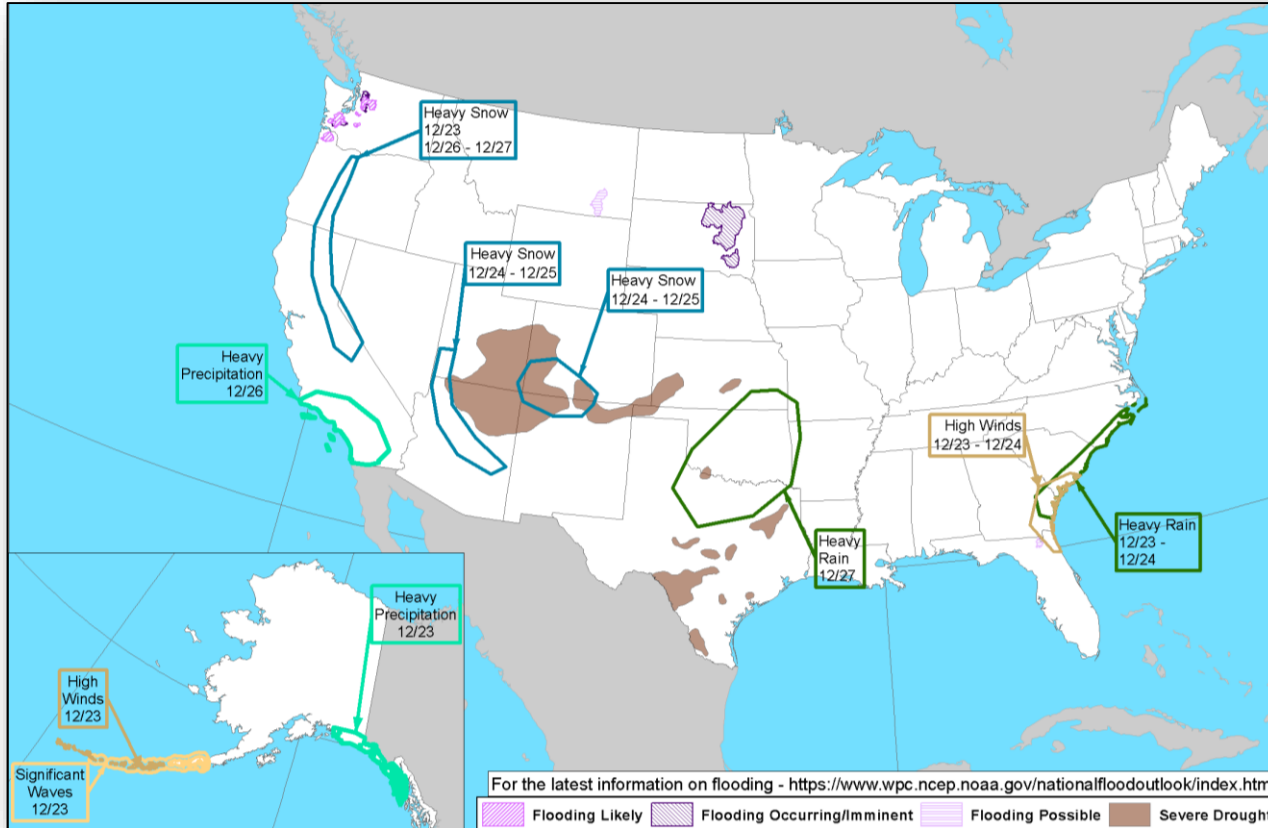
