Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic Tropical cyclone activity not expected next 48 hours
- Eastern Pacific Tropical cyclone activity not expected next 48 hours
- Central Pacific No tropical cyclones expected through Sat night
- Western Pacific No activity threatening U.S. territories

Significant Weather:

- Heavy snow Higher elevations of Great Basin and Central Rockies
- Heavy rain w/possible flash flooding Desert Southwest
- Rain/snow mix Great Lakes
- Rain and thunderstorms Southern Plains to Mid-Atlantic
- Critical Fire Weather Areas/Red Flag Warnings: None
- Space Weather: No space weather storms observed/predicted

Severe Weather Outbreak Nov 17-18 (Final) FEMA



FEMA Region V

- RRCC activated to Level III; RWC remains at Watch/Steady State
- IMAT and LNO deployed to IL
- ▲ Joint PDAs for 15 (+2) counties in IL (IA began Nov 21 and PA to begin Dec 2)
- Region-wide data:
 - Fatalities: 8 (confirmed); Injured: 150-200 unconfirmed (media sources)
 - Power outages: 23,581 (peak 753,352)

Illinois

- SEOC at Level III (Limited Staffing)
- ▲ Governor declared state of disaster for 15 (+2) counties
- 6 confirmed fatalities
- ▲ Sporadic power outages remain
- ▲ Total number of homes damaged/destroyed could exceed 1,500
- 3 shelters open with 14 occupants

Michigan

- SEOC at Normal Operations
- 2 confirmed fatalities
- ▲ 21,051 customers remain without power; full restoration by Sat
- 2 shelters open with 7 occupants




Severe Weather Outbreak – Nov 17-18
















Total Snow Forecast






Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day





Precipitation Forecast – 4 and 5 Day






River Forecast – 7 Day






Convective Outlooks Days 1-3






Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8







