- Space Weather: No space weather storms observed or predicted

- Western Pacific: No activity threatening U.S. territories











#### 72-hour ice accumulation









#### 72-hour ice accumulation > 1.00 inch






### High / Low Temperatures

#### **State Response**

- · All State EOC remain at Normal Operations with the exception of KY
  - KY Level 1 (EOC standard with hot standby mode)
- · There are no unmet needs or requests for FEMA assistance

- RRCC not activated; RWC at Watch/Steady State (24/7)

- IMAT-1 deployed to KY EOC; SLNO deployed to TN EOC
- · IMAT-2 deployed to NC JFO and can re-deploy to TN if required
- USACE light PRT deploying to Ft Campbell

#### FEMA Region VI


- RRCC activated to Level II (with ESF 1, 3, 6, and DCE); MOC Denton at Watch/Steady State (24/7)

### Atlantic Tropical Outlook






#### As of 12:50 p.m. EDT, Dec 4

- Low chance (20%) of developing into a tropical cyclone next five days








# River Forecast – 7 Day






# Convective Outlooks Days 1-3






### Critical Fire Weather Areas Days 1 - 8




