

FEMA Daily Operations Briefing Wednesday, December 11, 2013 8:30 a.m. EST

Winter Storm – Mid-Atlantic/Northeast (Final)



- Wintery precipitation moved through the Mid-Atlantic Tuesday and has moved off the Northeast Coast
 - Snowfall amounts of 1 to 6 inches, with isolated higher amounts reported
 - All Winter Storm Warnings in the affected area have expired

Impacts:


- · Power outages due to downed trees and power lines have been the primary impacts
- 4,724 customers without power (down from 202,477) in FEMA Region III; sporadic outages elsewhere (EAGLE-I; as of 7:30 a.m. EST)
 - VA: 650 customers without power (down from 142,320)
 - WV: 3,725 customers without power (down from 22,347)

Response:

- VA SEOC remains partially activated; all others are at Normal Operations
- All affected Regions are at Watch/Steady State
- NRCC is not activated; NWC is at Watch/Steady State
- · No shortfalls, unmet needs or requests for FEMA assistance




Open Field Offices as of December 11, 2013






National Weather Forecast






Active Watches/Warnings






Precipitation Forecast – 3 Day








River Forecast – 7 Day






Convective Outlooks Days 1-3





Hazard Outlook: Dec 13 - 17


