



## Disturbance 1 (EP91): (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over 1,500 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California Peninsula
- A tropical depression is likely to form within the next few days
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (20%);7-day Medium (40%)

## Disturbance 2: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located approximately 1,000 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California Peninsula
- Some slow development is possible later this week
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (10%);7-day Low (20%)




### Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (near 0%); 7-day – Medium (40%)





