

**Central Pacific** 

#### **Eastern Pacific**



- Disturbance 1 remains in the Eastern Pacific Hurricane
   Center area of responsibility
- Tropical Storm Dora is expected to be near the Central Pacific Hurricane Center's area of responsibility early next week



#### **Tropical Storm Dora** (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 275 miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 16 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 40 mph
- Strengthening is forecast; could become a hurricane by Tuesday


#### Disturbance 1 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,100 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California Peninsula, Mexico
- Significant development of this system is unlikely
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (near 0%)

#### Disturbance 2 (As of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Could form late this week a few hundred miles S of the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Some gradual development is possible by the weekend
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Medium (40%)

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 750 miles NE of the northern Leeward Islands
- Conditions could still support tropical cyclone formation during the next 2-3 days, while moving 10 to 15 mph
- Formation chance 48 hour: Medium (40%); 7-day: Medium (50%)


#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles south of Nova Scotia
- Tropical cyclone formation is not anticipated
- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (near 0%)





## **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






