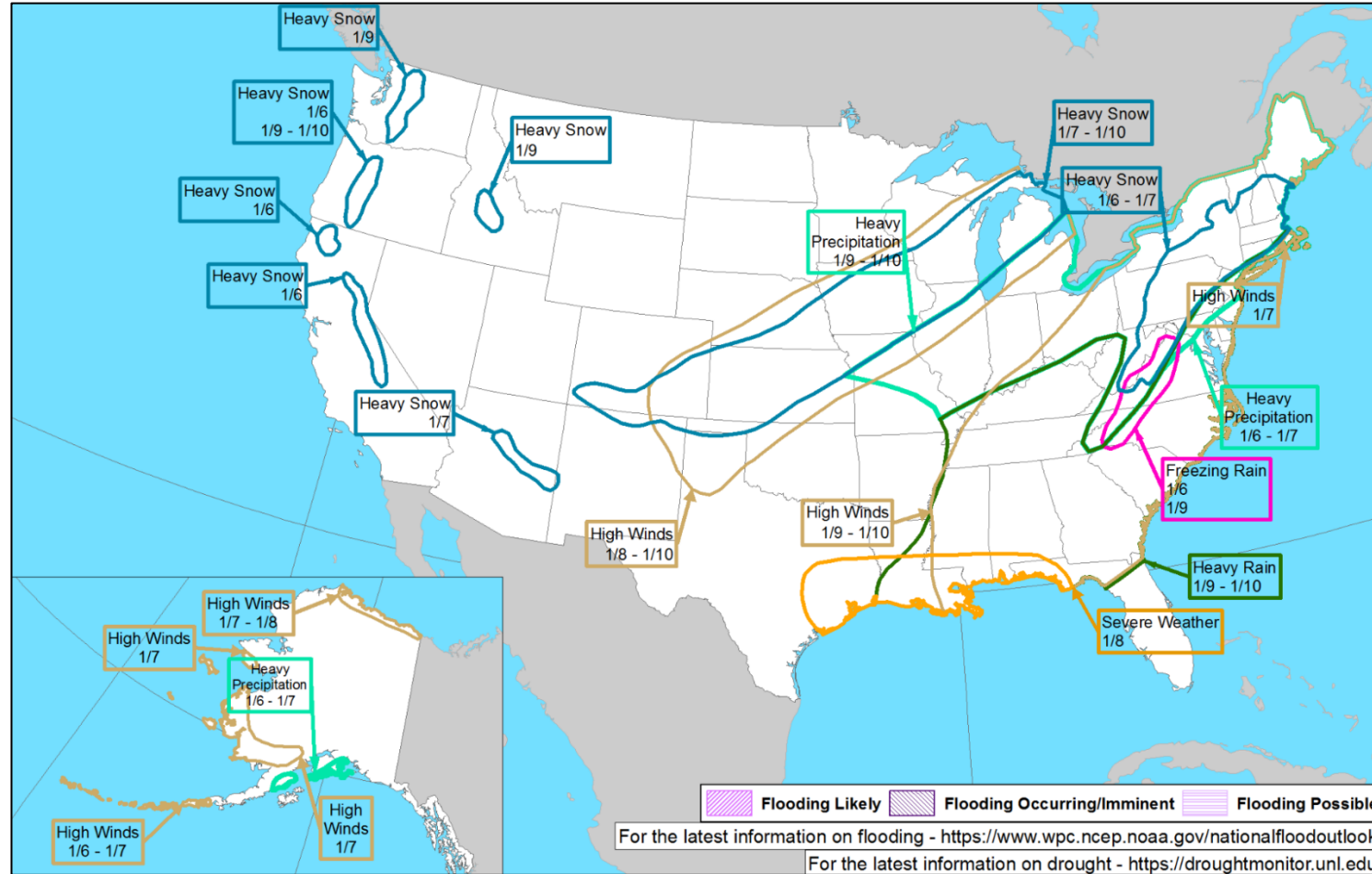


# Ice Accumulation Forecast

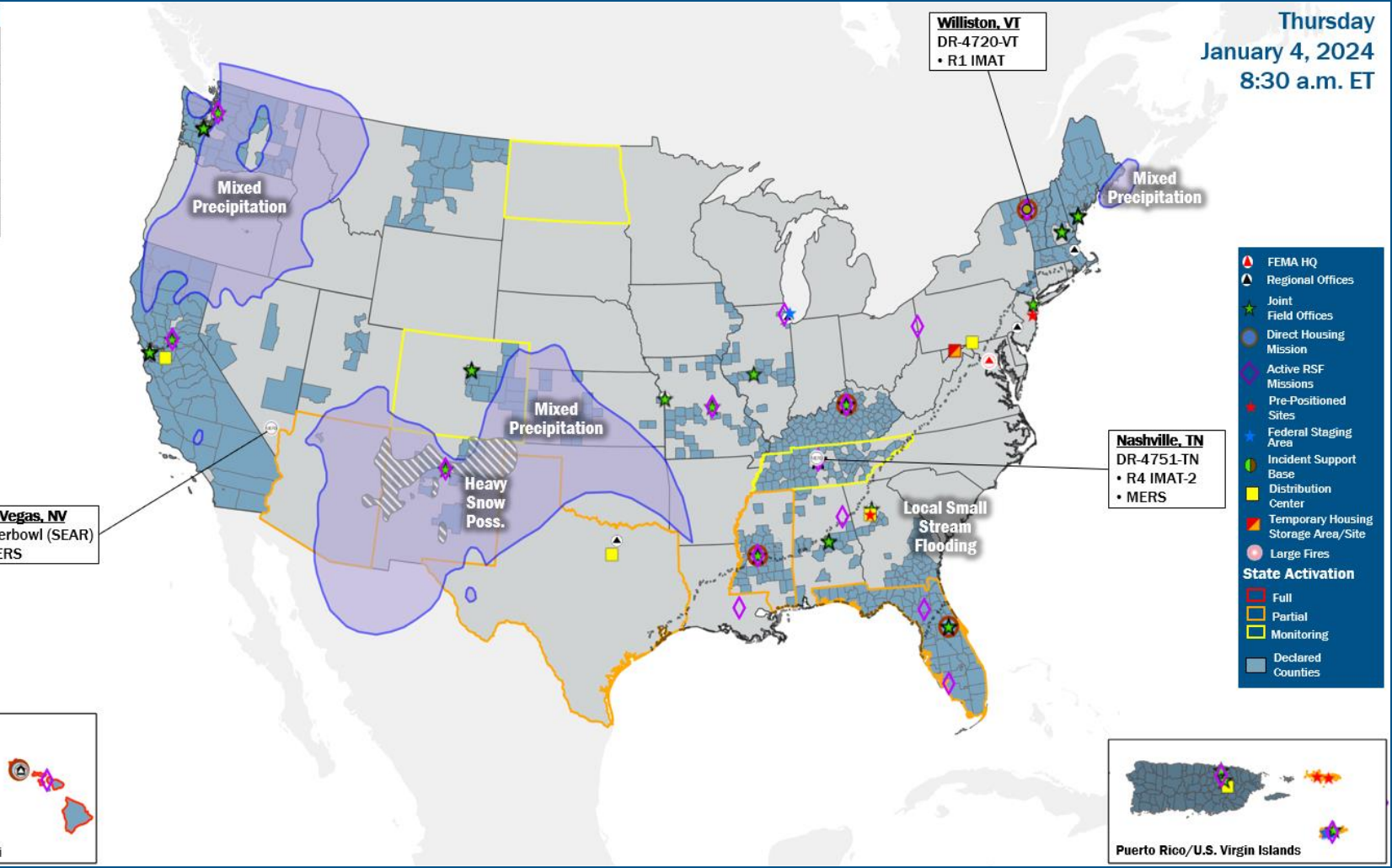
