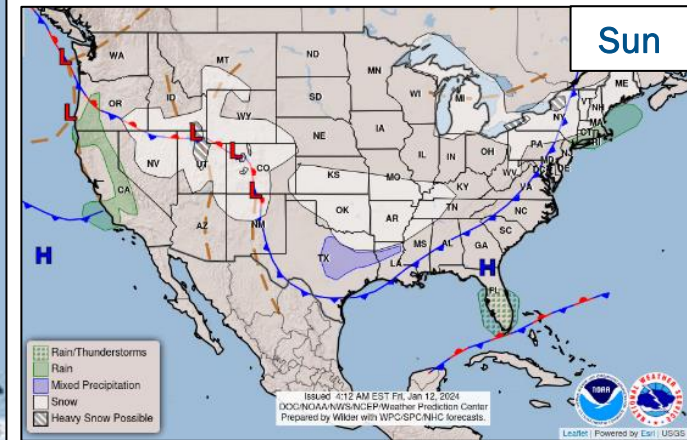

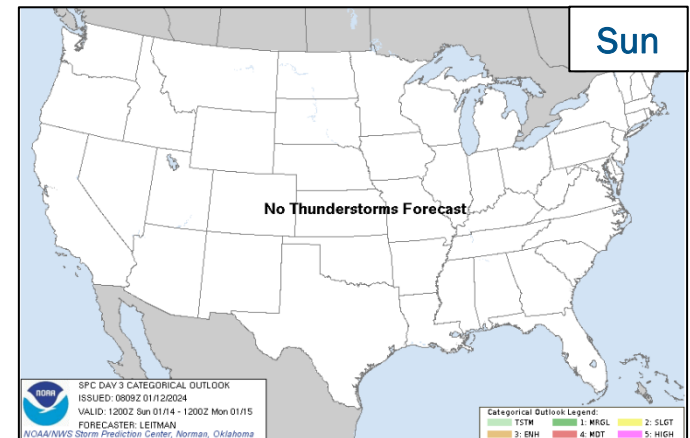

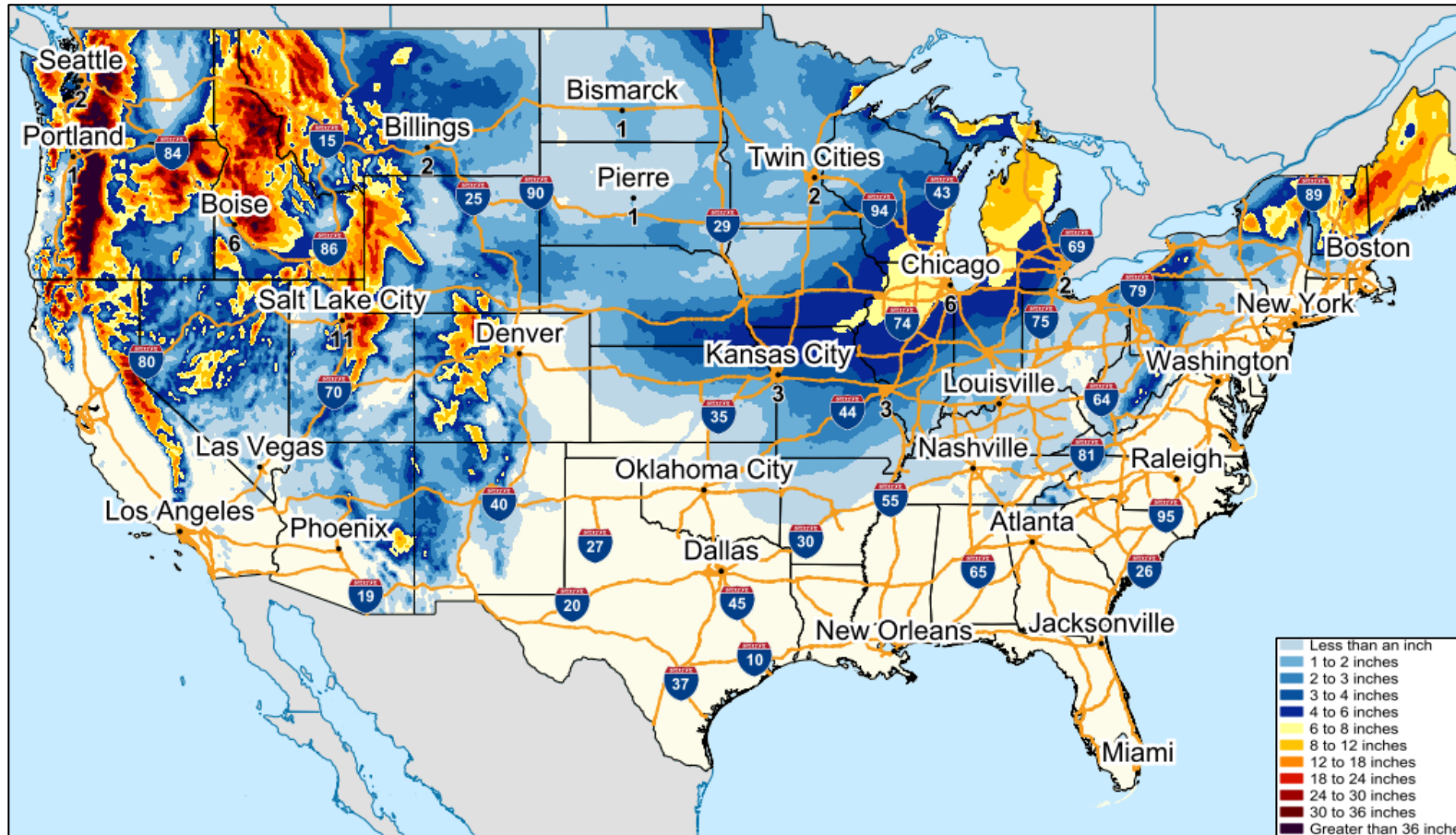
Severe Weather Outlook

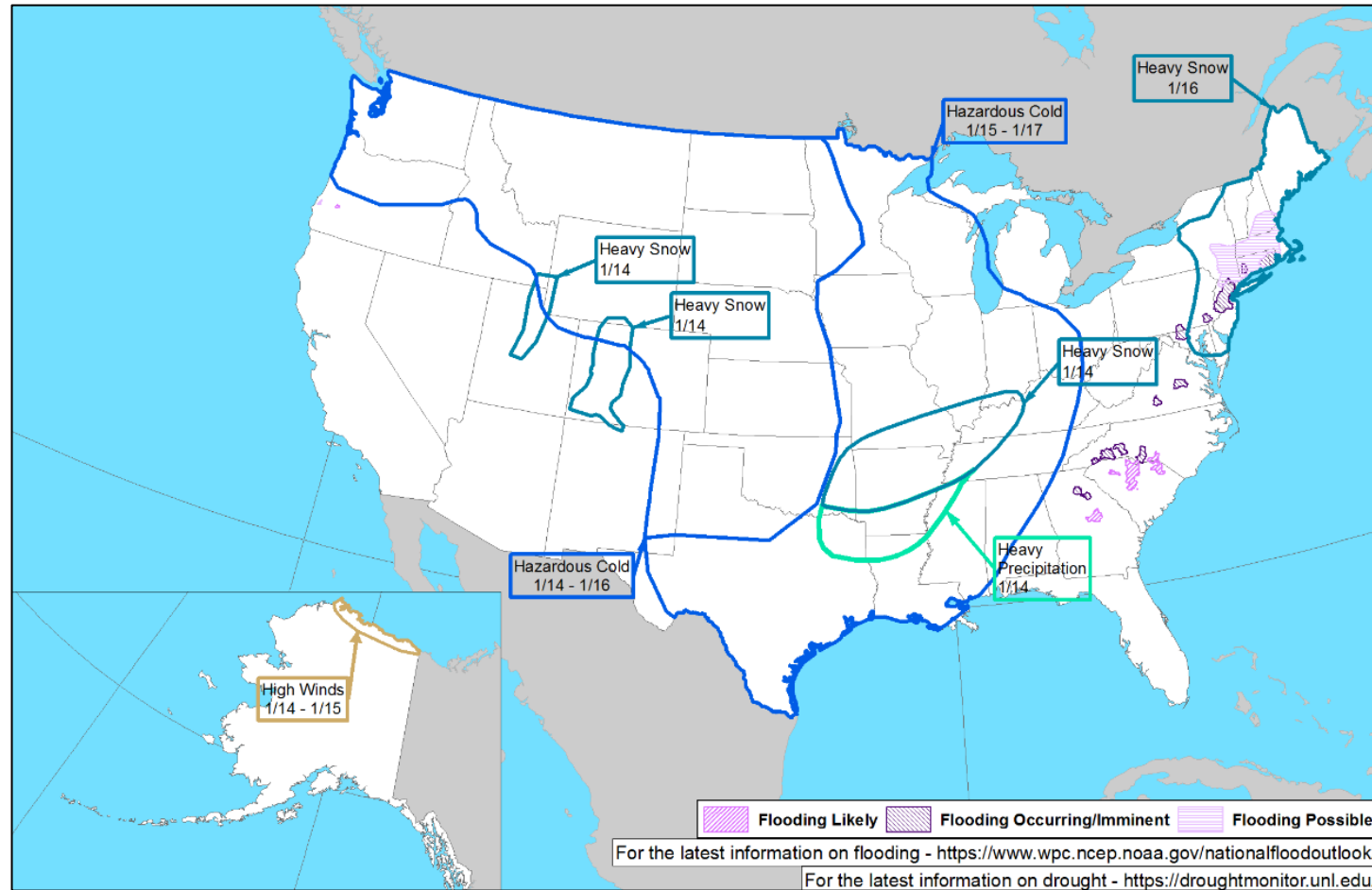

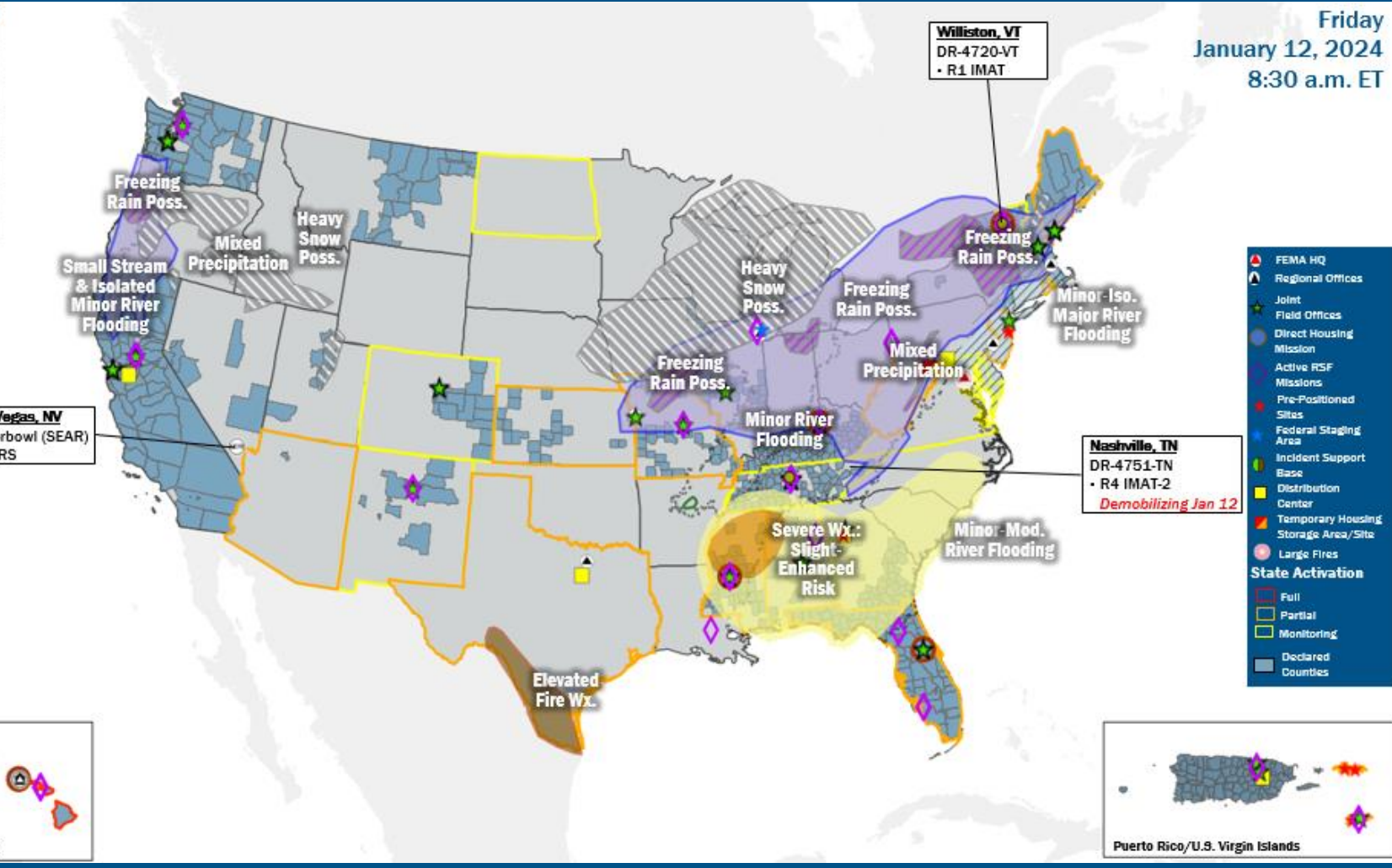
