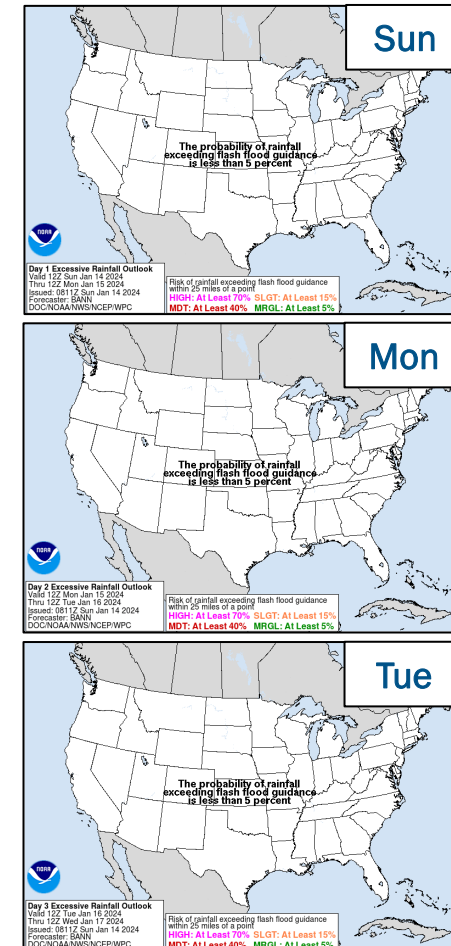

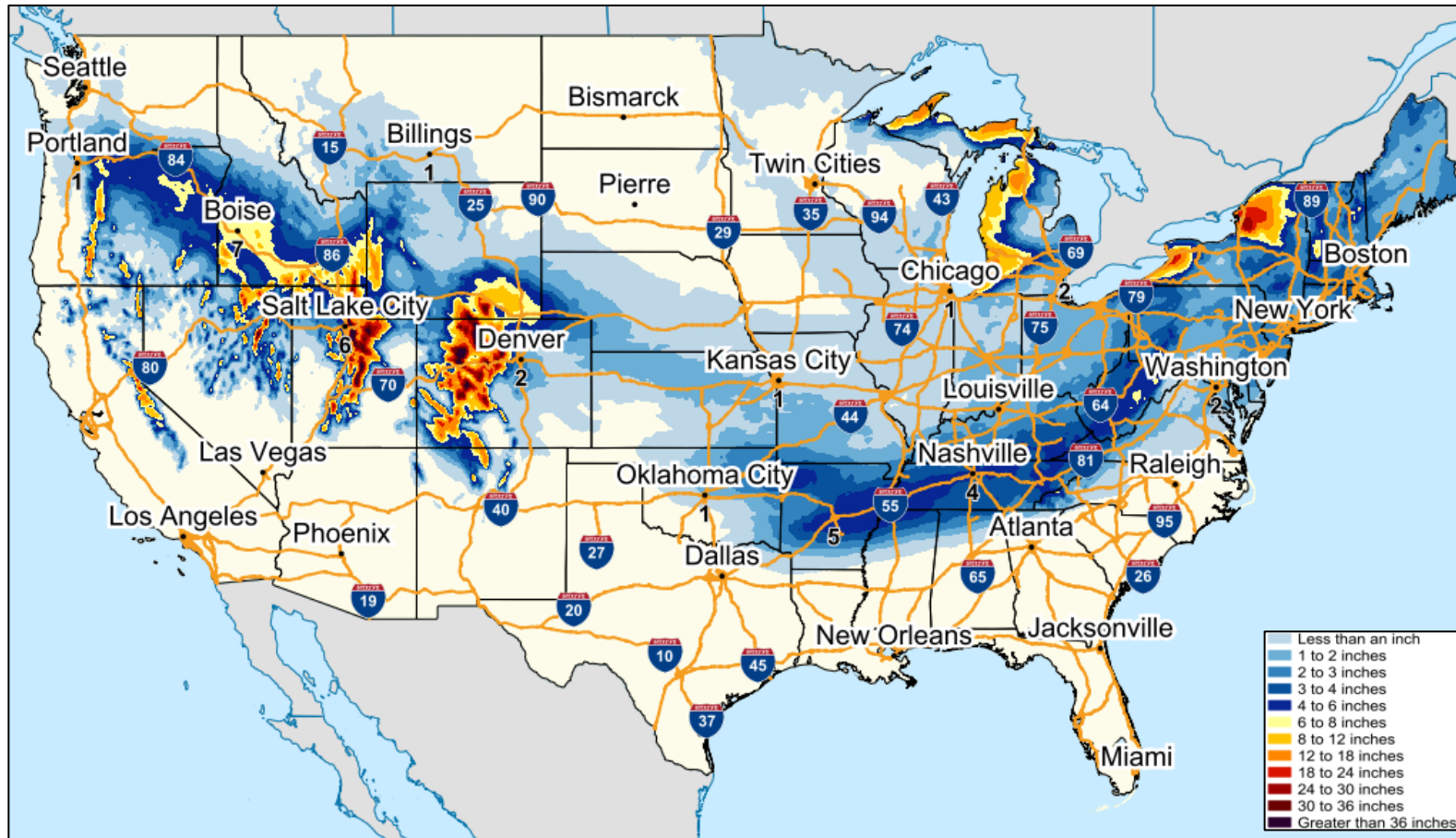

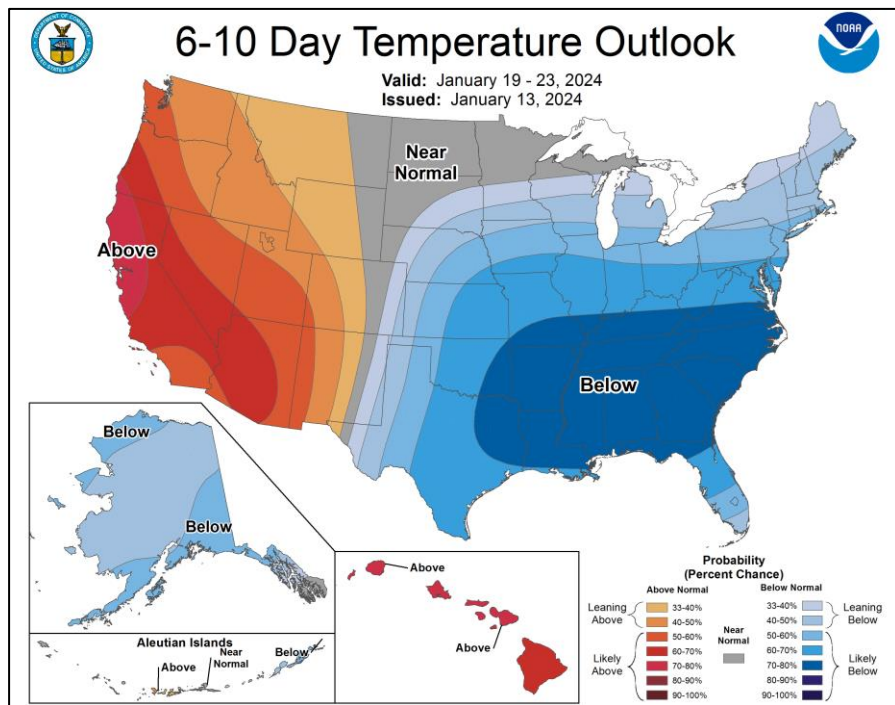

# Ice Accumulation Forecast

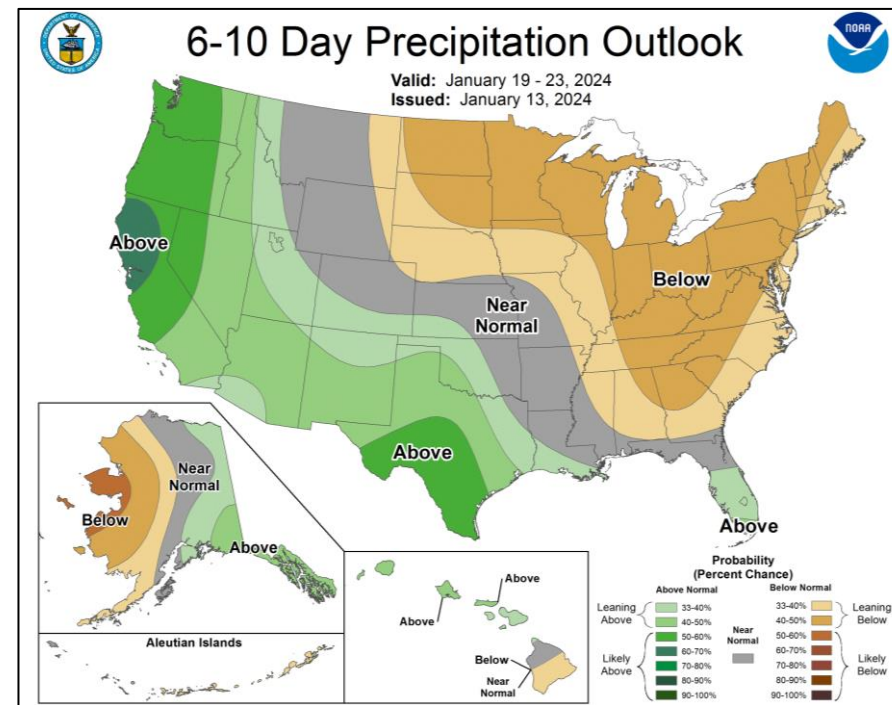
