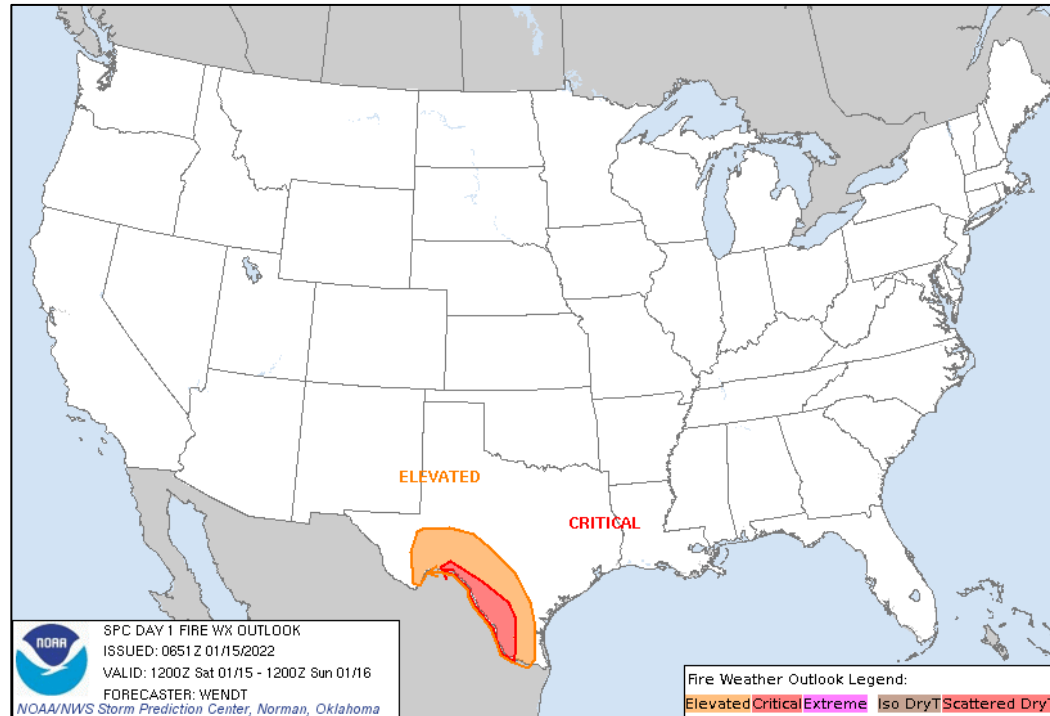
National Weather Forecast



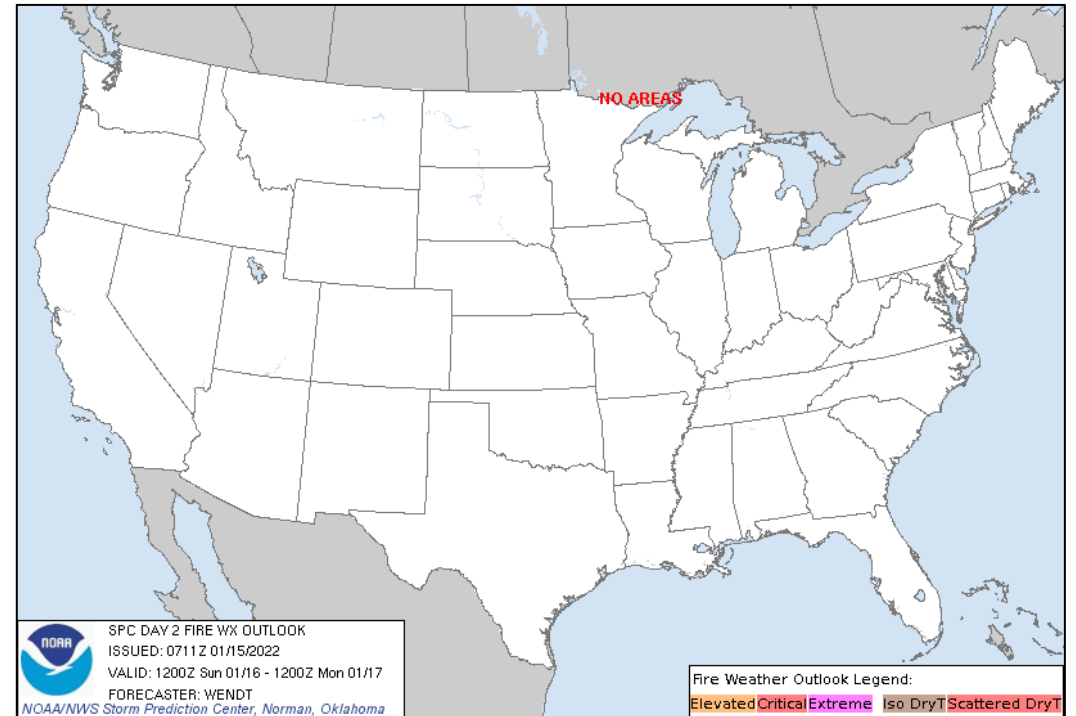

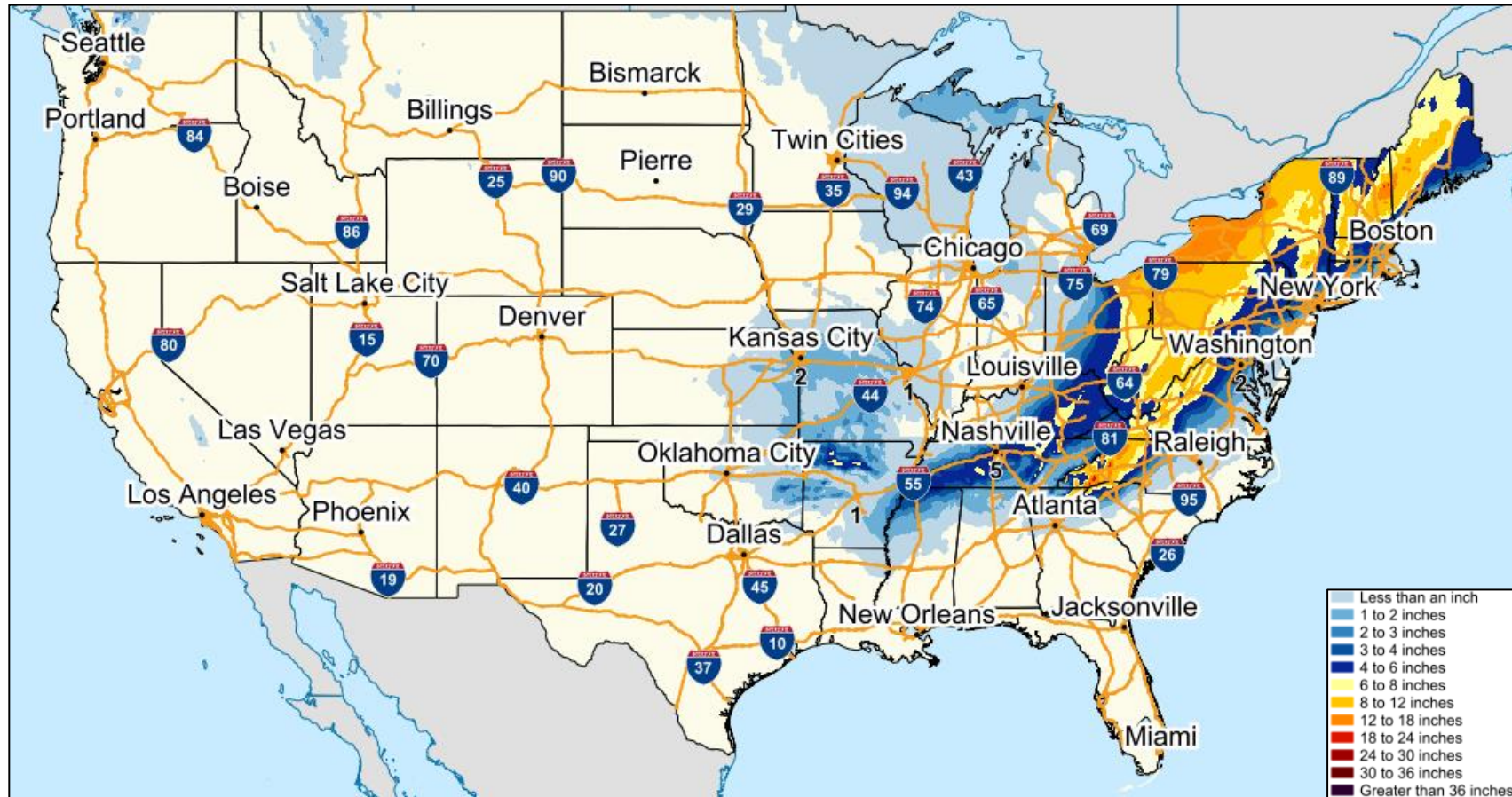

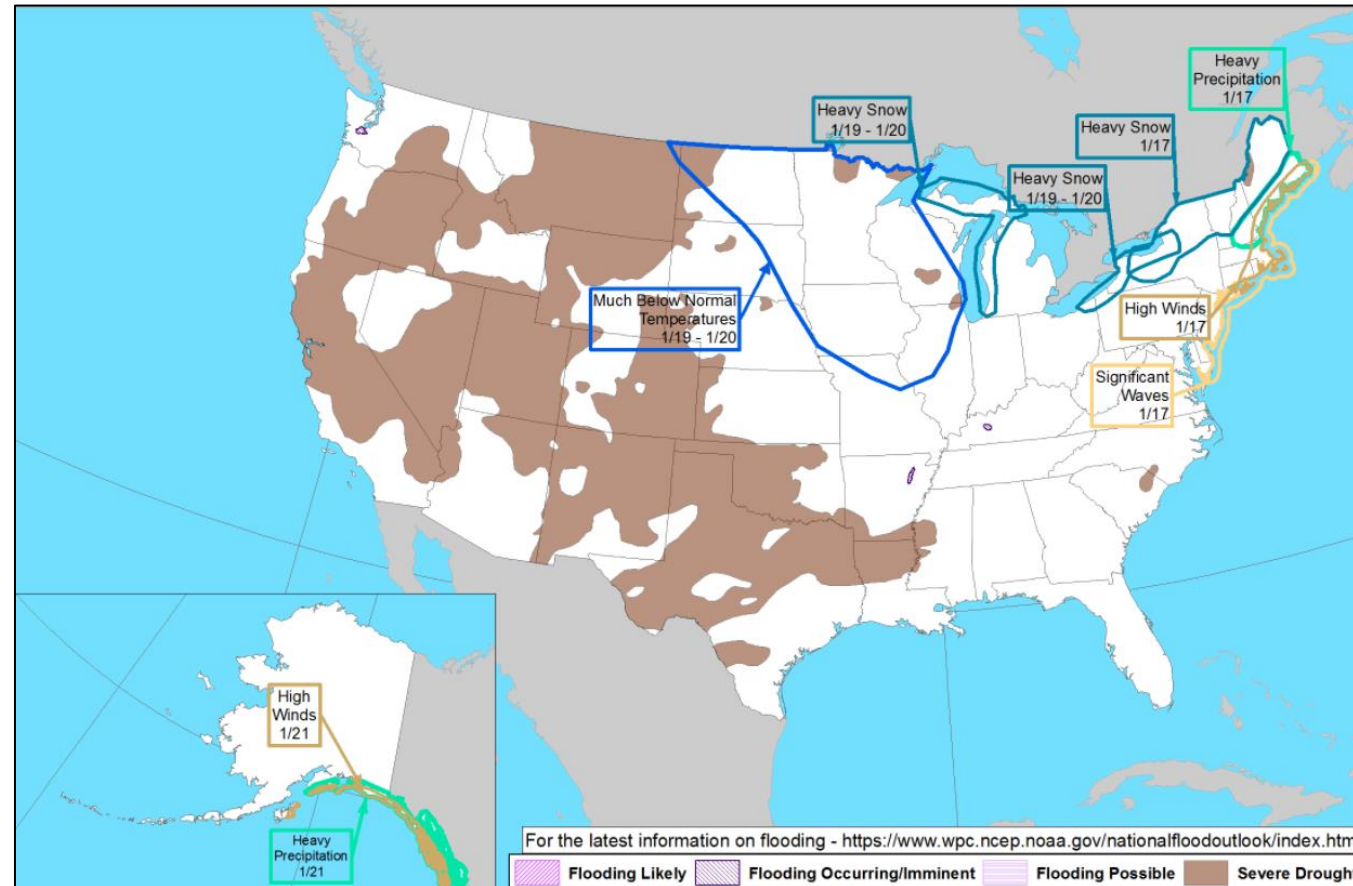
Ice Accumulation Forecast

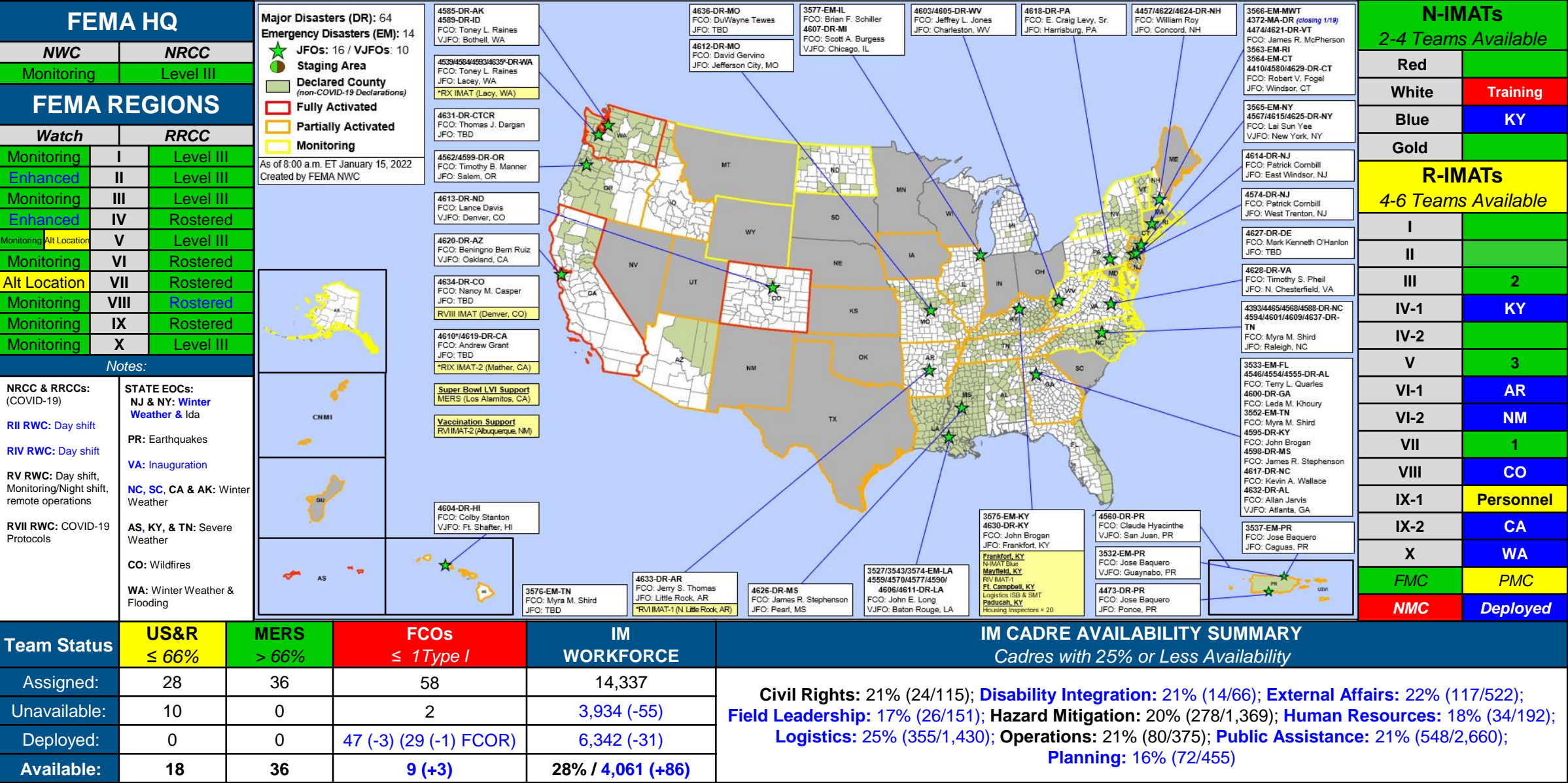
Declaration Amendments

FEMA-4630-DR-KY	7	Jan 8	Amends the cost-sharing arrangements to authorize Federal funds for debris removal and emergency protective measures, including direct Federal assistance, at 100% of the total eligible costs for a 30-day period of the Commonwealth's choosing within the first 120 days of the declaration
FEMA-4626-DR-MS	2	Jan 14	Appoints James R. Stephenson as FCO, terminates Brett H. Howard
