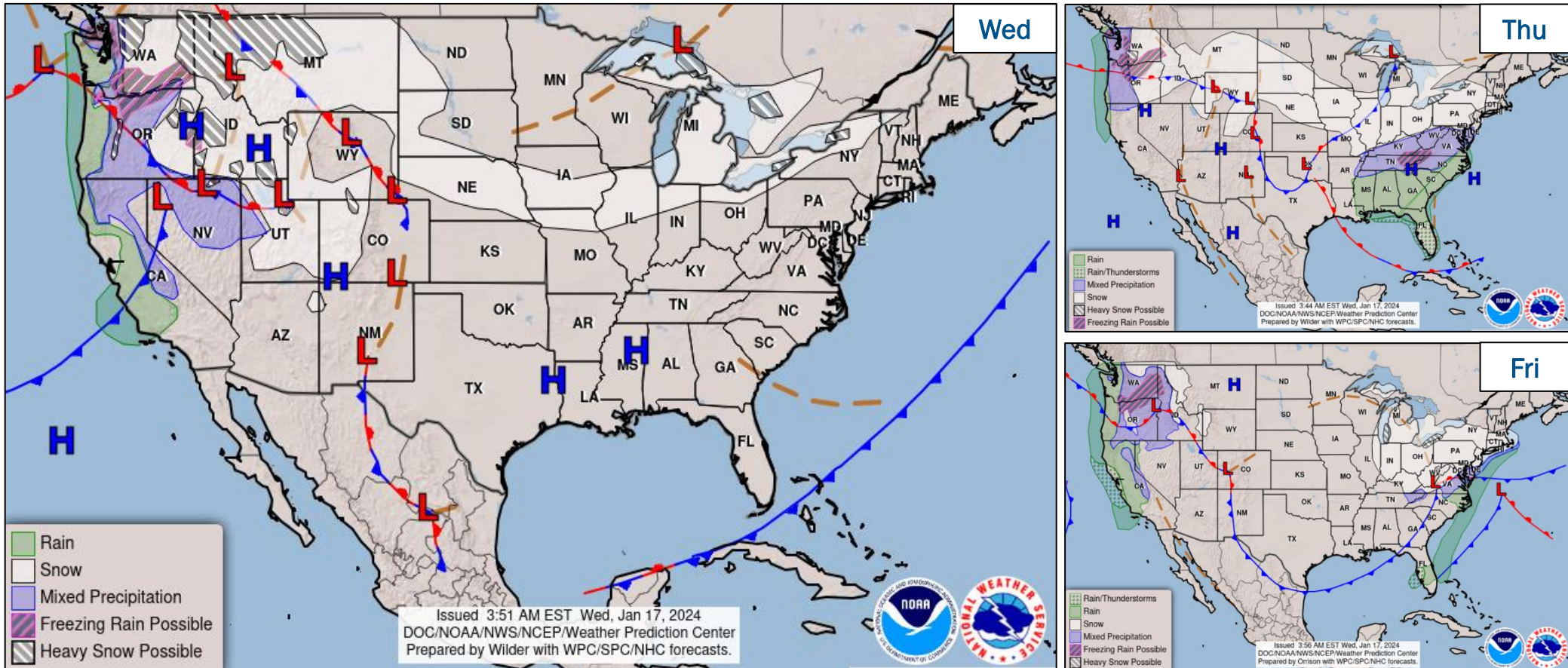

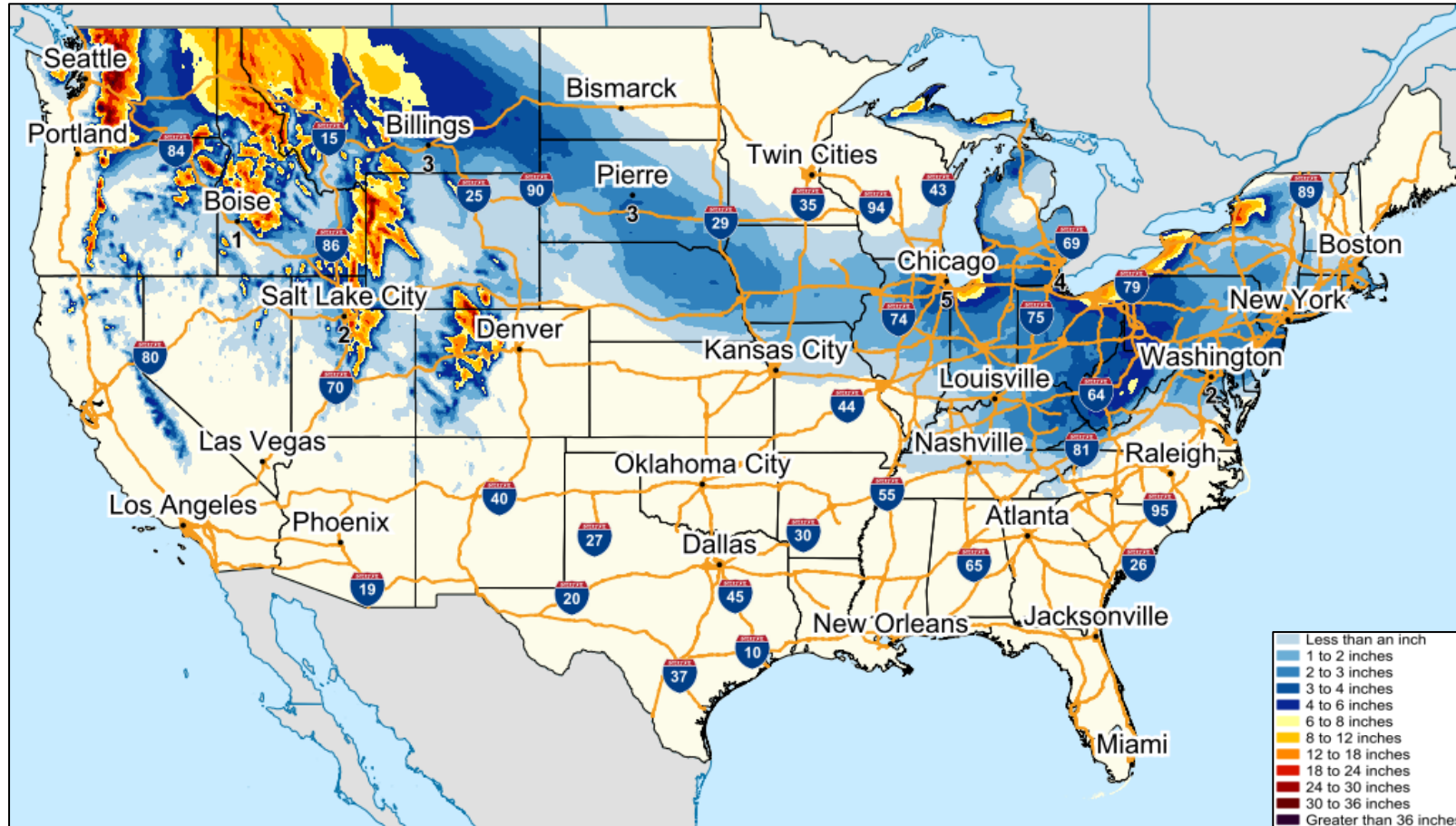

National Weather Forecast



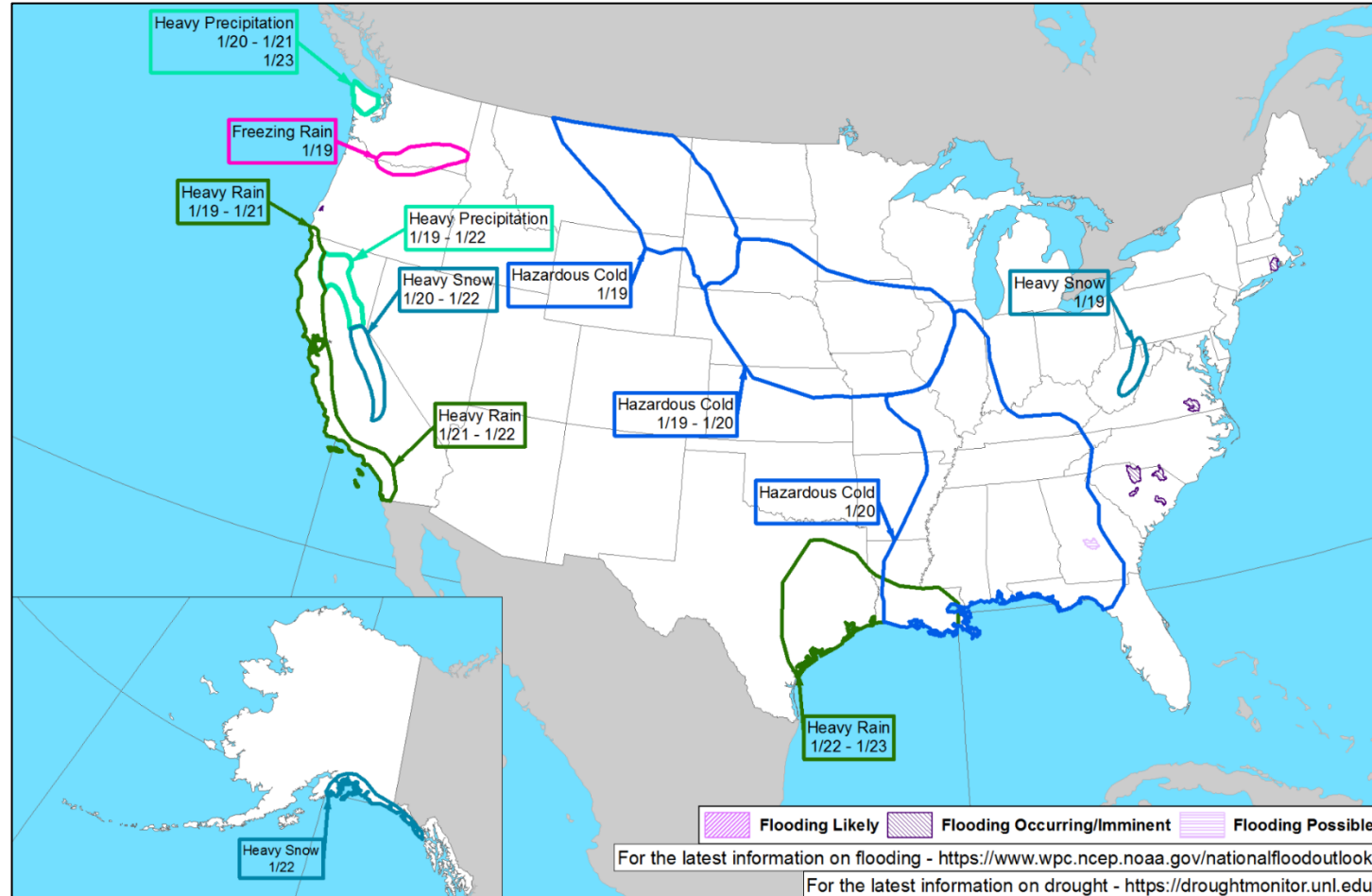

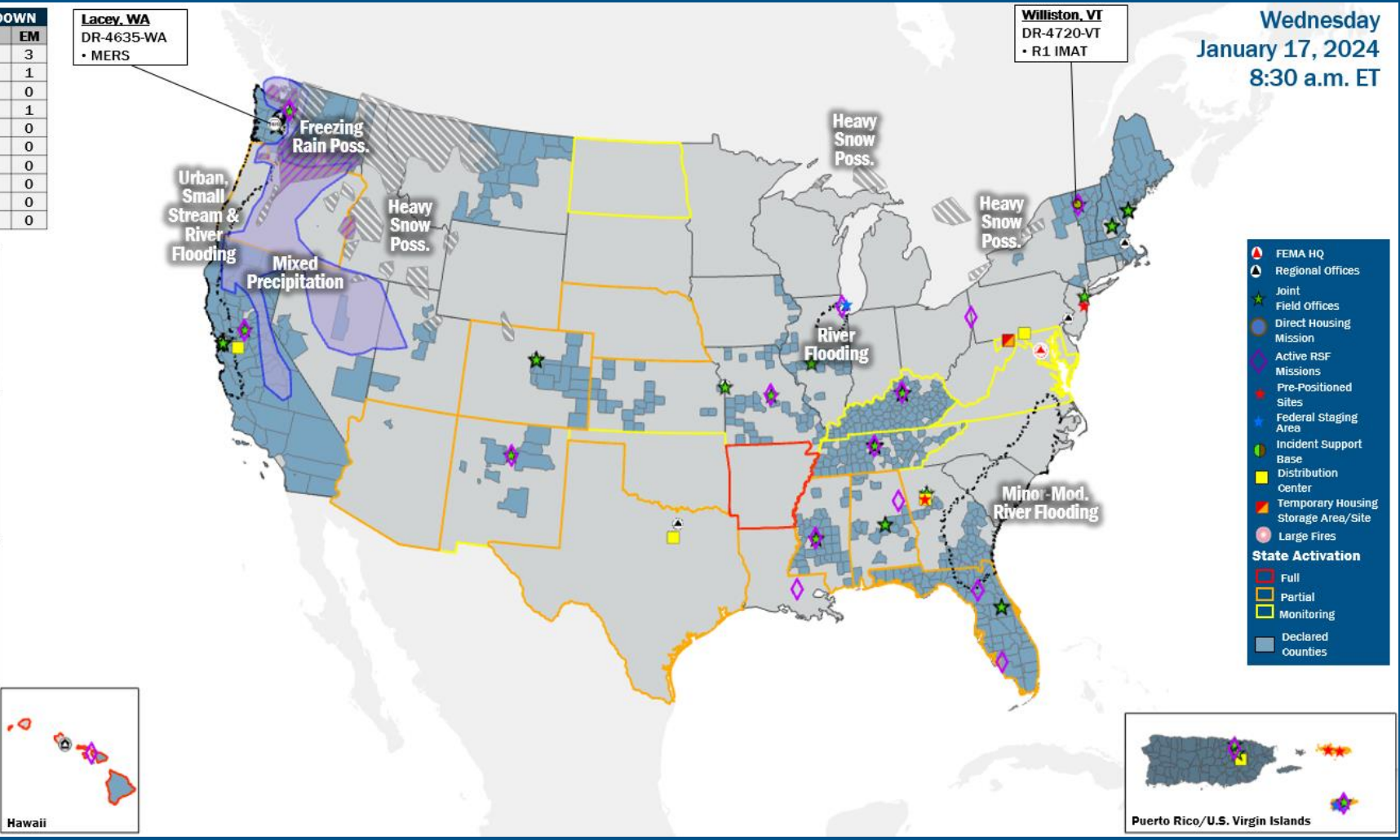

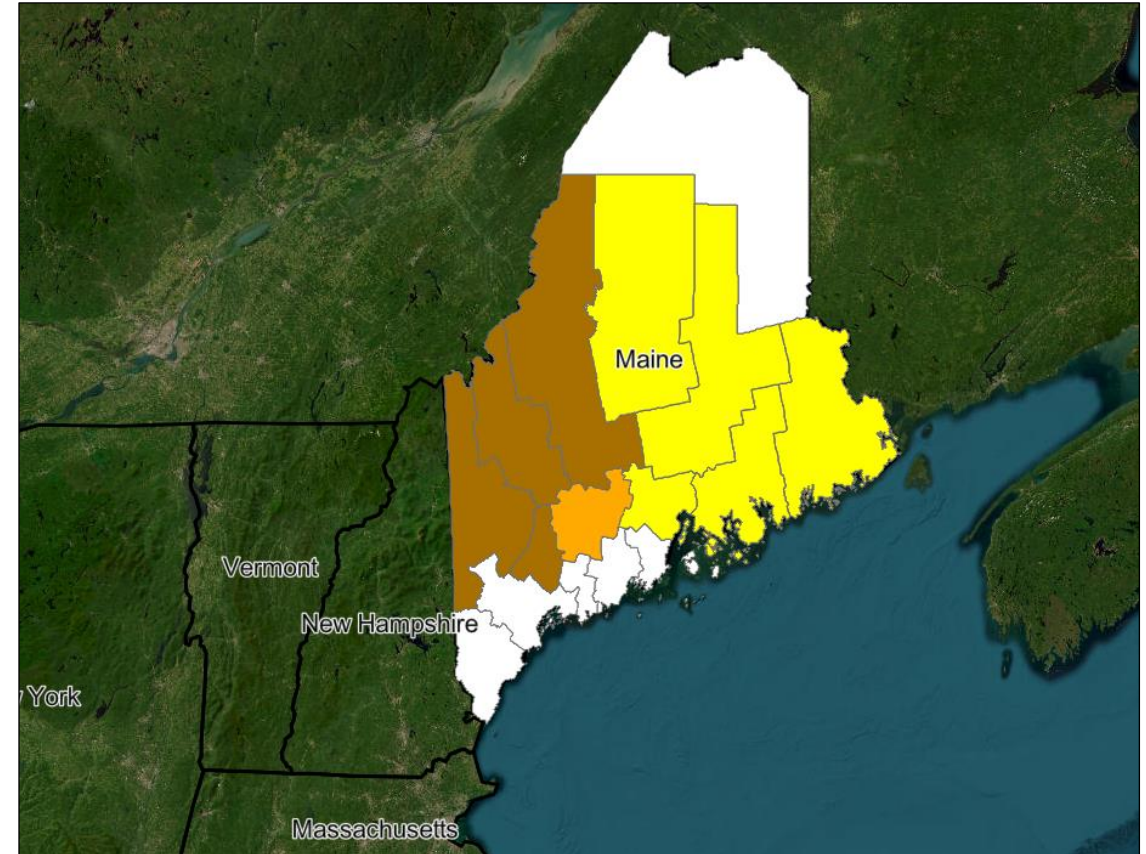
