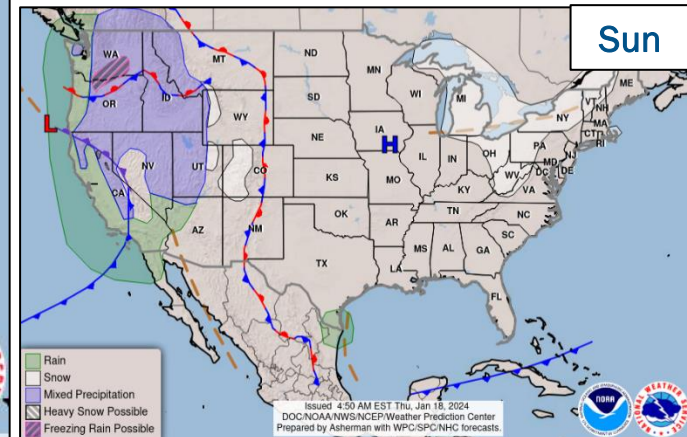

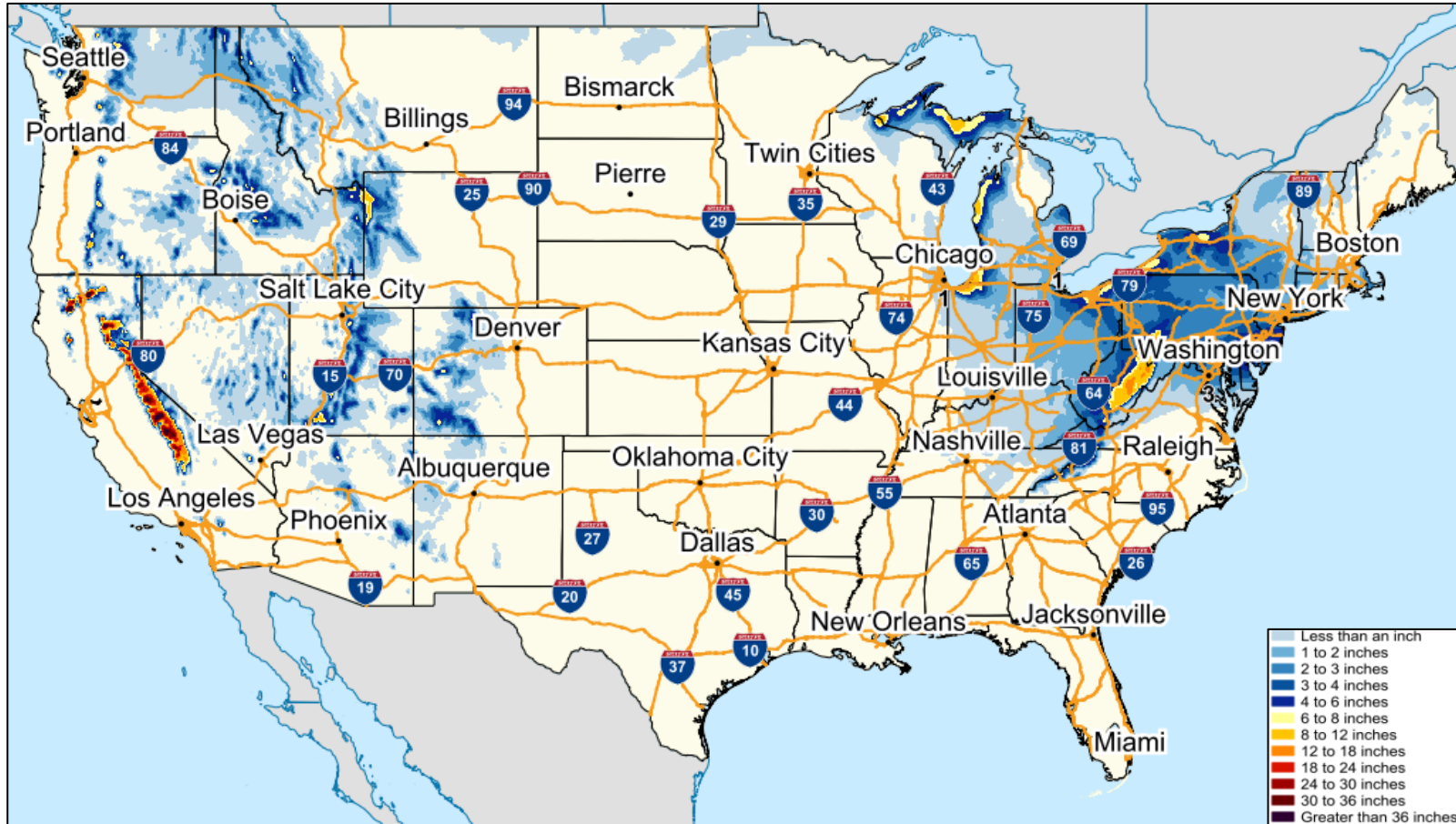

National Weather Forecast



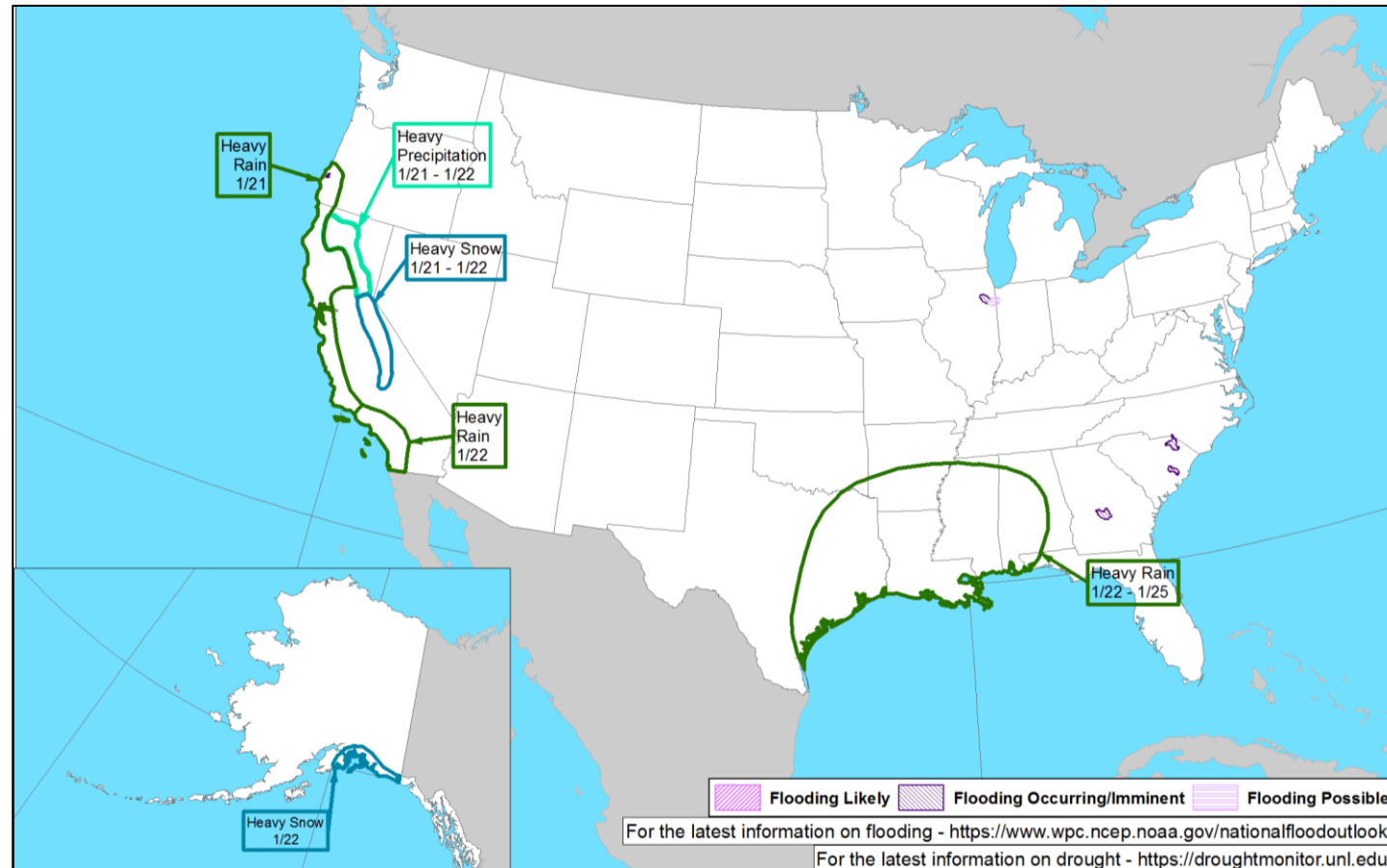

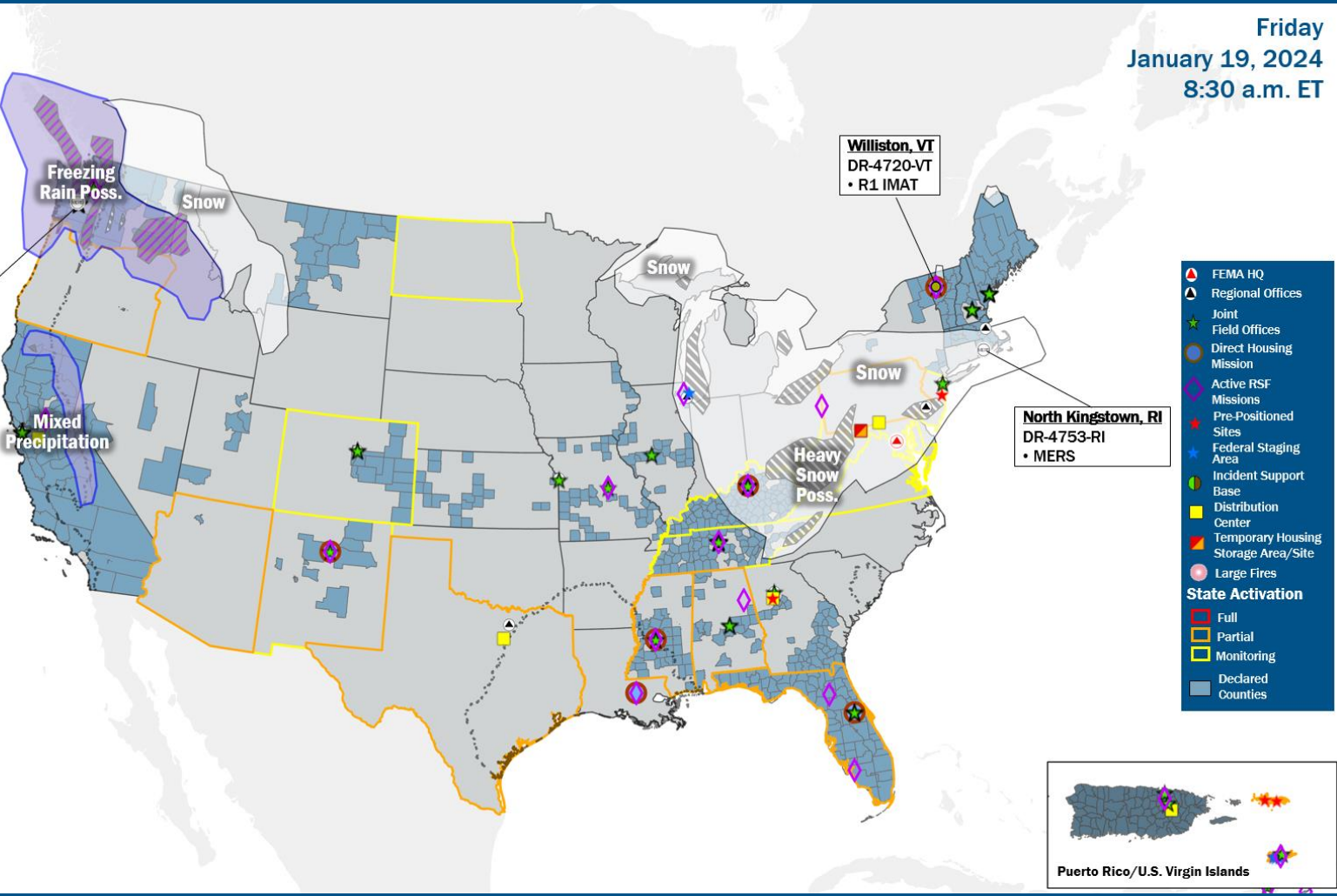
