- Earthquake/Aftershocks – Puerto Rico

Declaration Activity: None

Earthquake (M6.4) – Puerto Rico



Situation: Primary focus for FEMA is replenishment of commodity resources, meeting mass care shelter requirements, power restoration, providing crisis counseling, and conducting damage assessments. Aftershocks continue, with **M4.6**, **M4.7** and **M4.8** occurring overnight.



Lifeline Impacts:

Food, Water & Shelter: Yellow

- 23 (+1) shelters open with 3,588 (-903) occupants (ESF 6, as of 6:00 a.m., Jan 20)
- Five survivor base camps being established

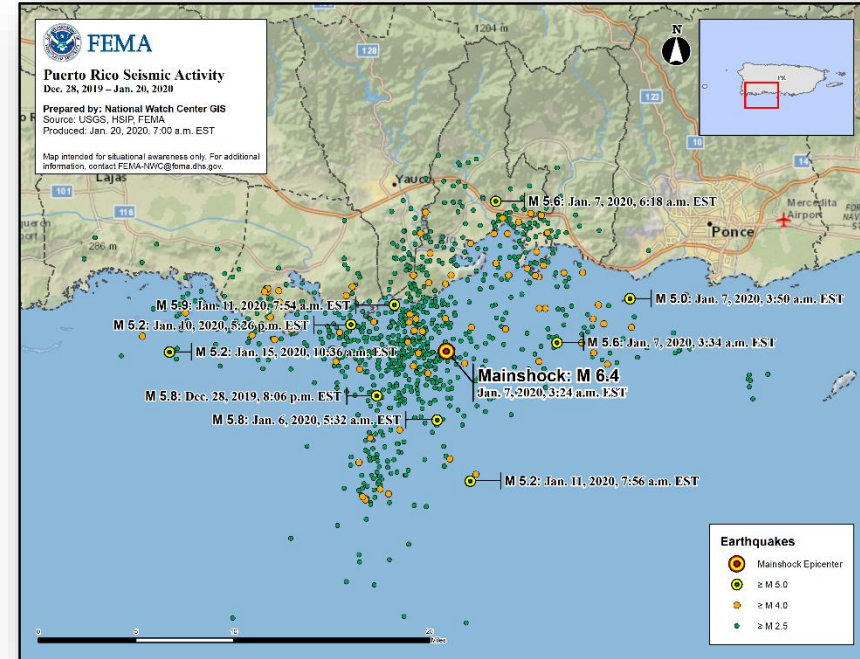

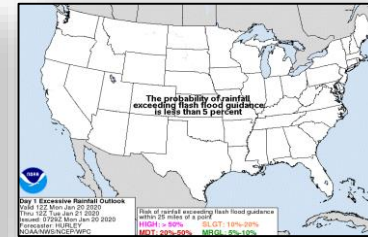
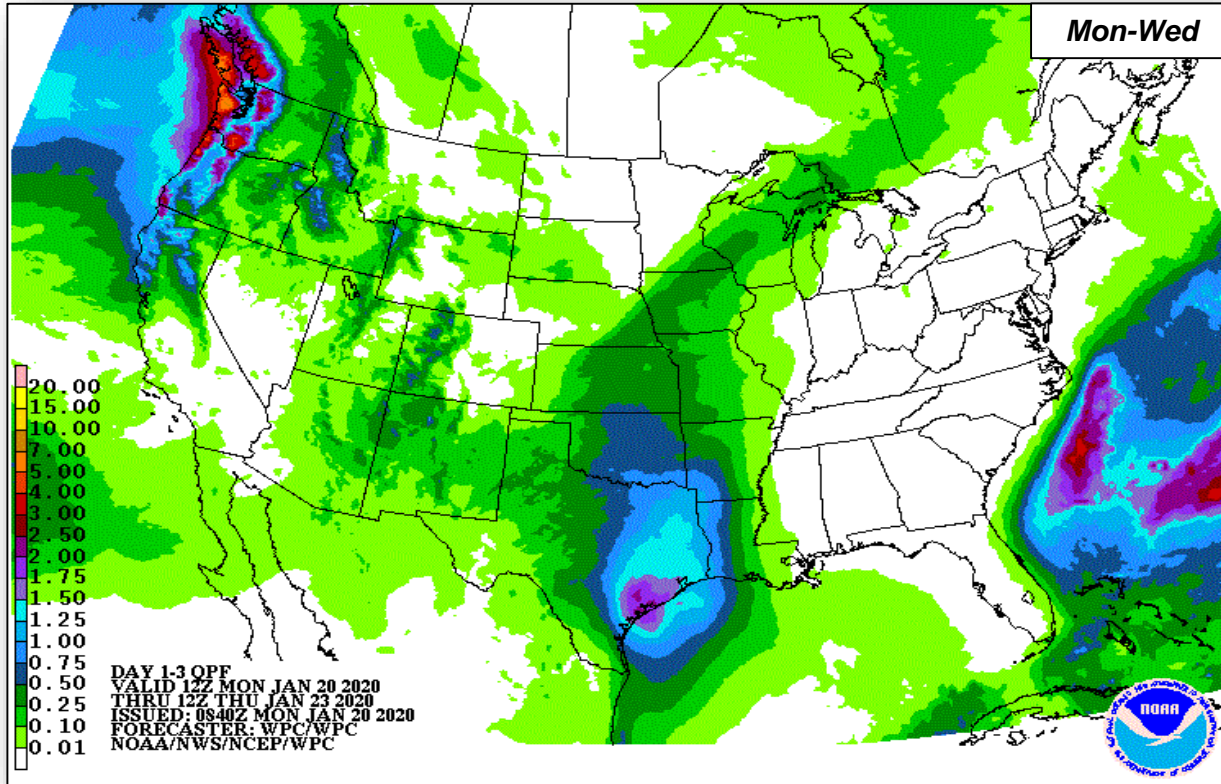
National Weather Forecast

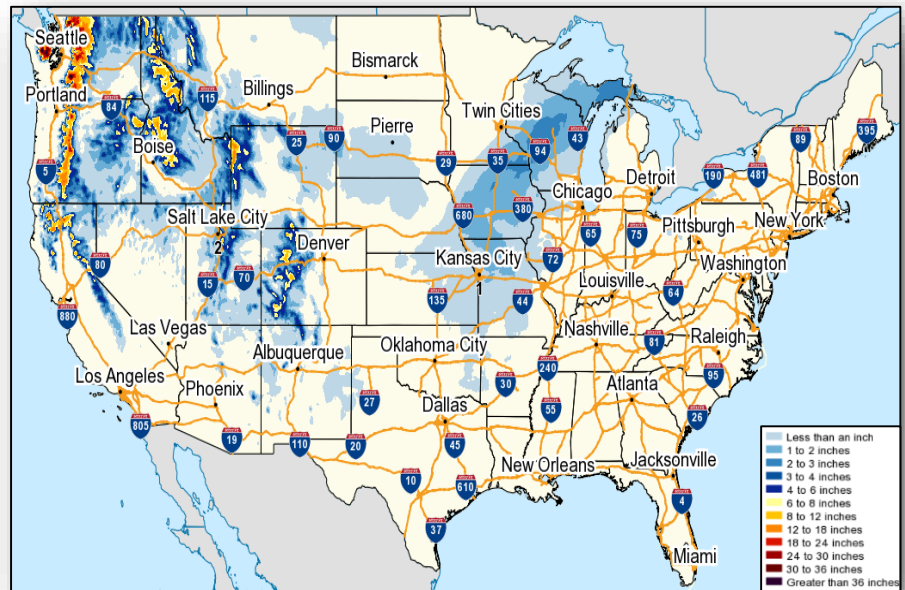

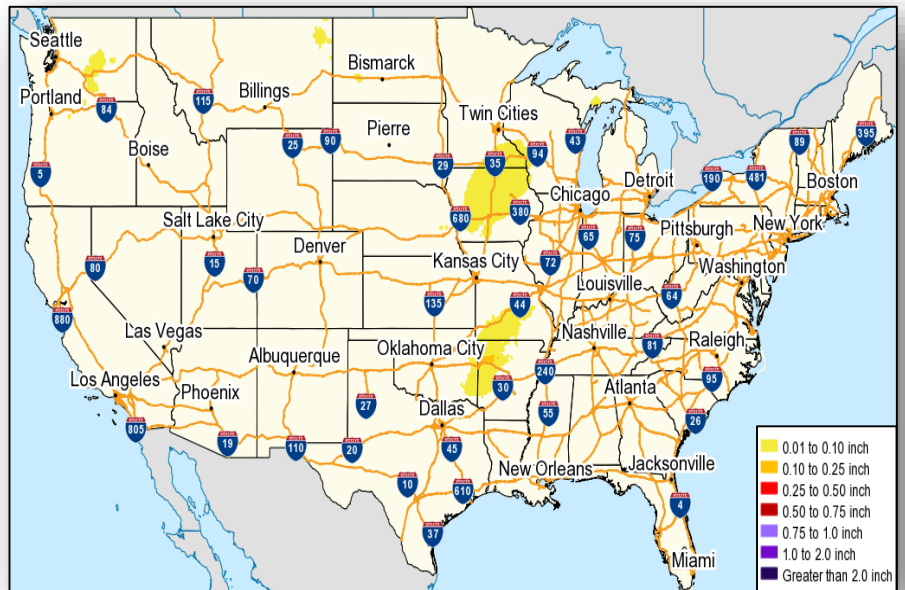

Forecast Ice Accumulation

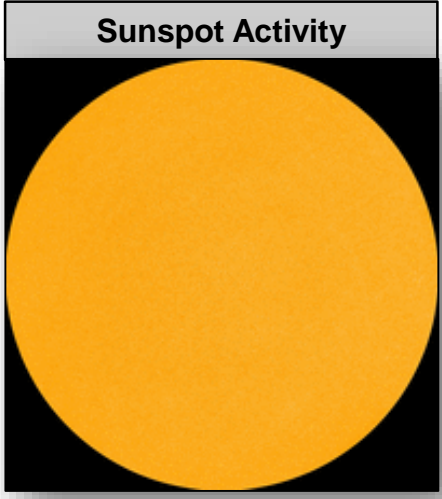
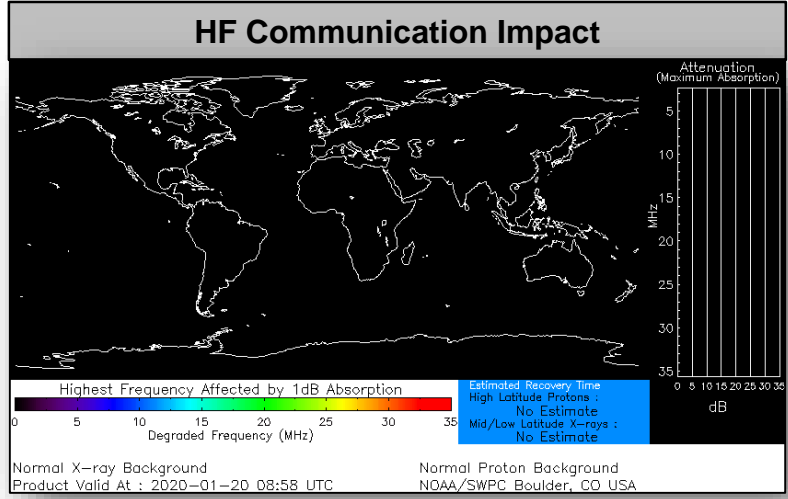

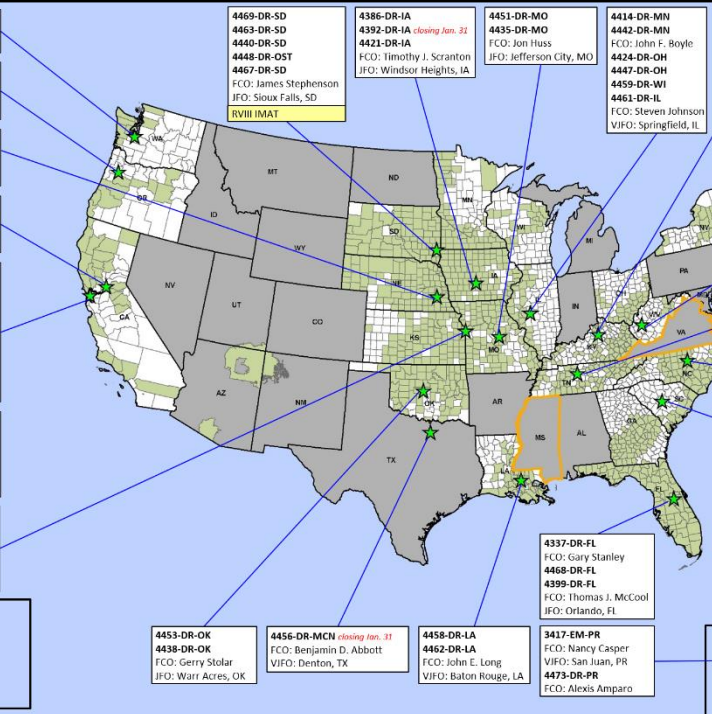
