Flooding Recovery – California – FINAL

Situation: New or renewed riverine flooding is not anticipated over the next several days and slow recession continues in rivers throughout the state. **Dry and cold conditions are forecast through this weekend into the middle of next week.** Currently, there are no major rivers above flood stage.

Lifeline Impacts: (SLB: DR-4683-CA & EM-3591-CA as of 3:00 p.m. ET, Jan 19)

Safety and Security:

- Evacuations in effect for **193 (-1,241)** people across **3 (-4)** counties
- 11** school closures impacting **3,314** students
- Oakland Zoo closed due to sink hole

Food, Water, Shelter:

- 11 (-9)** shelters open with **425 (-196)** occupants

Health and Medical:

- 21 (+1)** confirmed storm-related fatalities

Energy:

 (DOE Eagle-I, as of 6:30 a.m. ET)

- Minimal power outages (3k or 0.02%) statewide

Transportation:

- 89 (+2)** reports of road damage with preliminary repair estimates of **\$148 million**
- 21 (-9)** emergency road closures statewide

State / Local Response:

- CA EOC: Full Activation (Flooding); Governor declared a State of Emergency



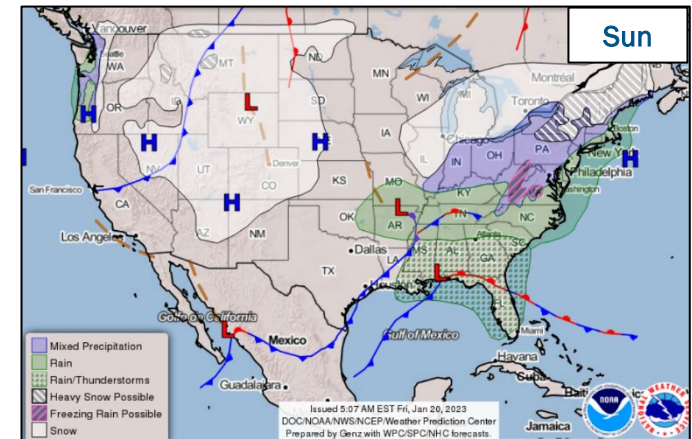
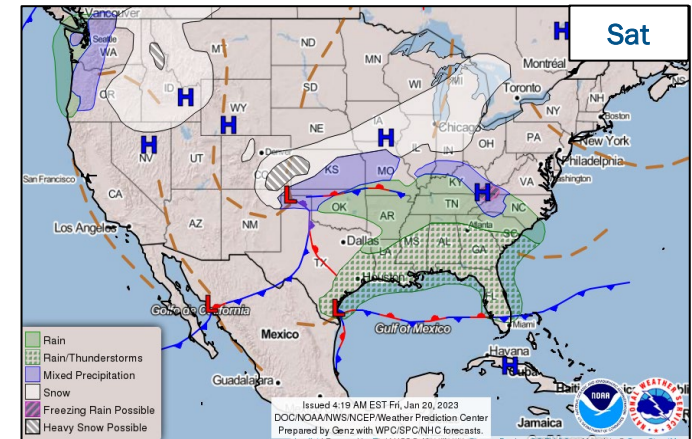
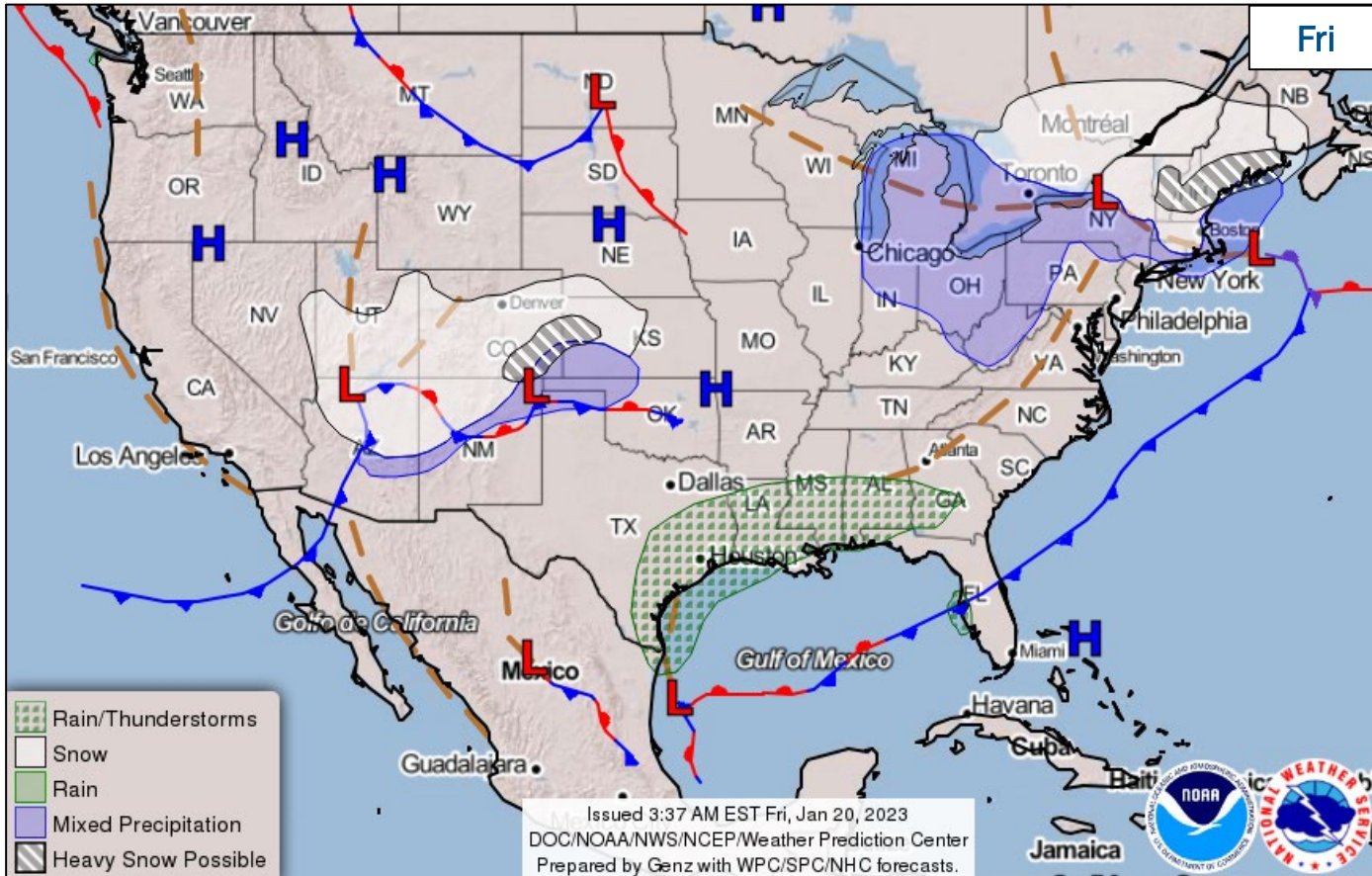
FEMA / Federal Response:

- POTUS and the FEMA Administrator conducted aerial and ground damage assessments in Santa Cruz Co
- FEMA-4683-DR-CA approved Jan 14; FEMA-3591-EM-CA approved Jan 9
- FEMA Region IX IMAT-1 & 2 and National IMAT RED deployed to CA EOC
- ISB and SMT teams deployed to Monterey and Sonoma counties
- 3 FEMA Tribal LNOs and 1 USACE LNO deployed to CA EOC
- Bothell MERS personnel, 1 IRV / 1 MEOV deployed to CA EOC; 5 MCOVs at DC Tracy, 2 MCOVs in Mather
- No further reporting anticipated; the NWC will continue to monitor in coordination with regional and federal partners and reinstate reporting if warranted

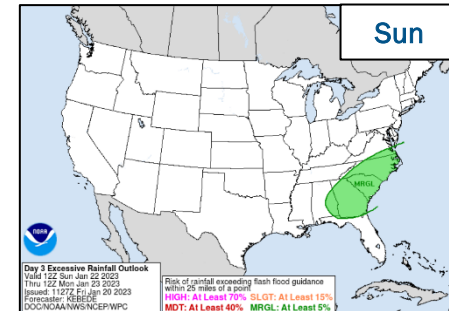
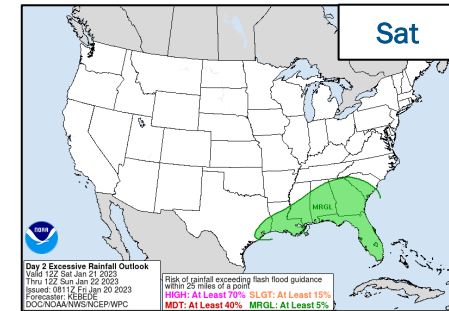
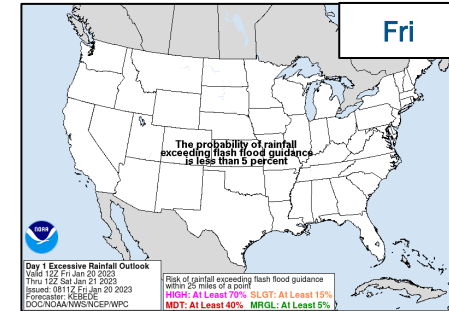
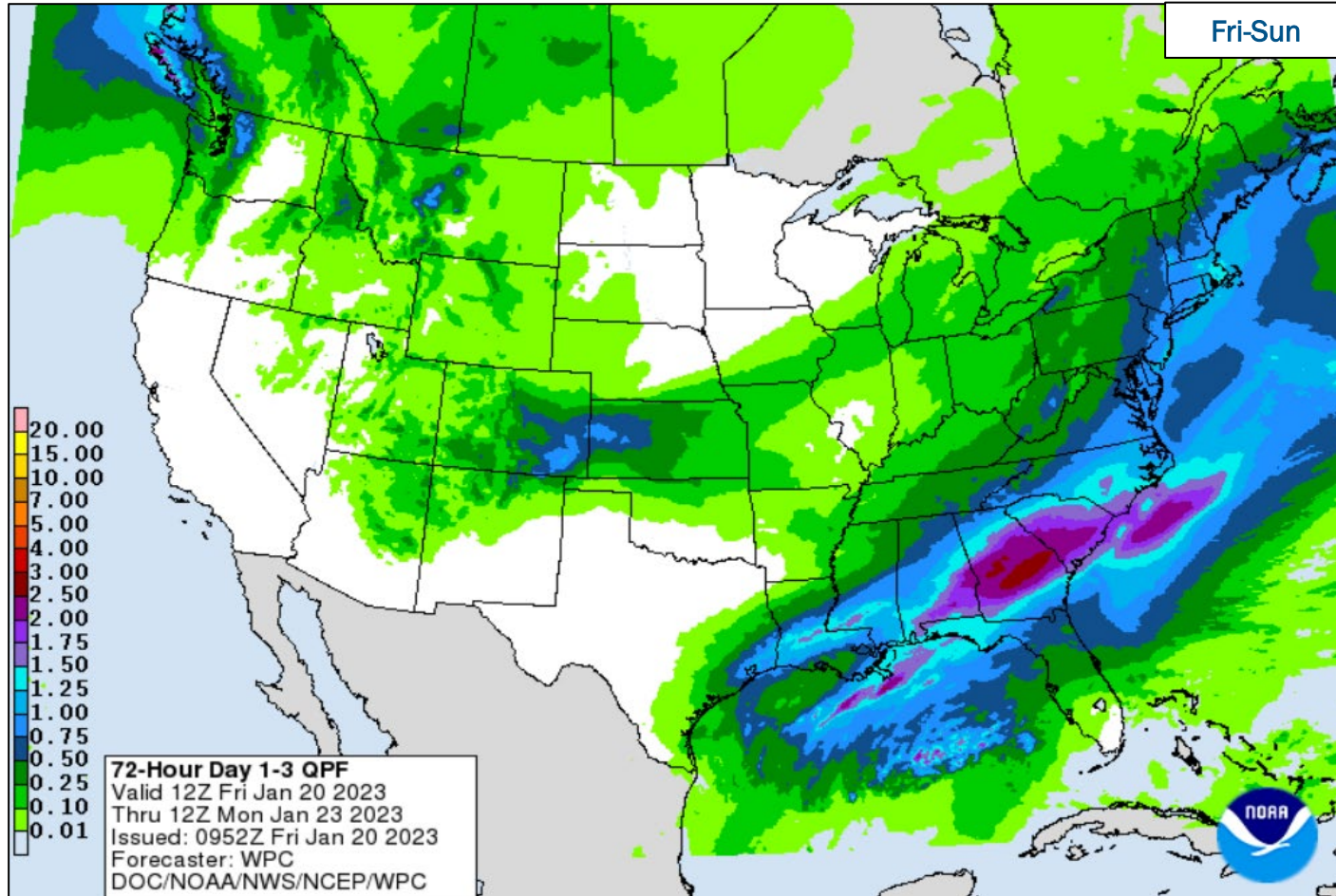
National Weather Forecast

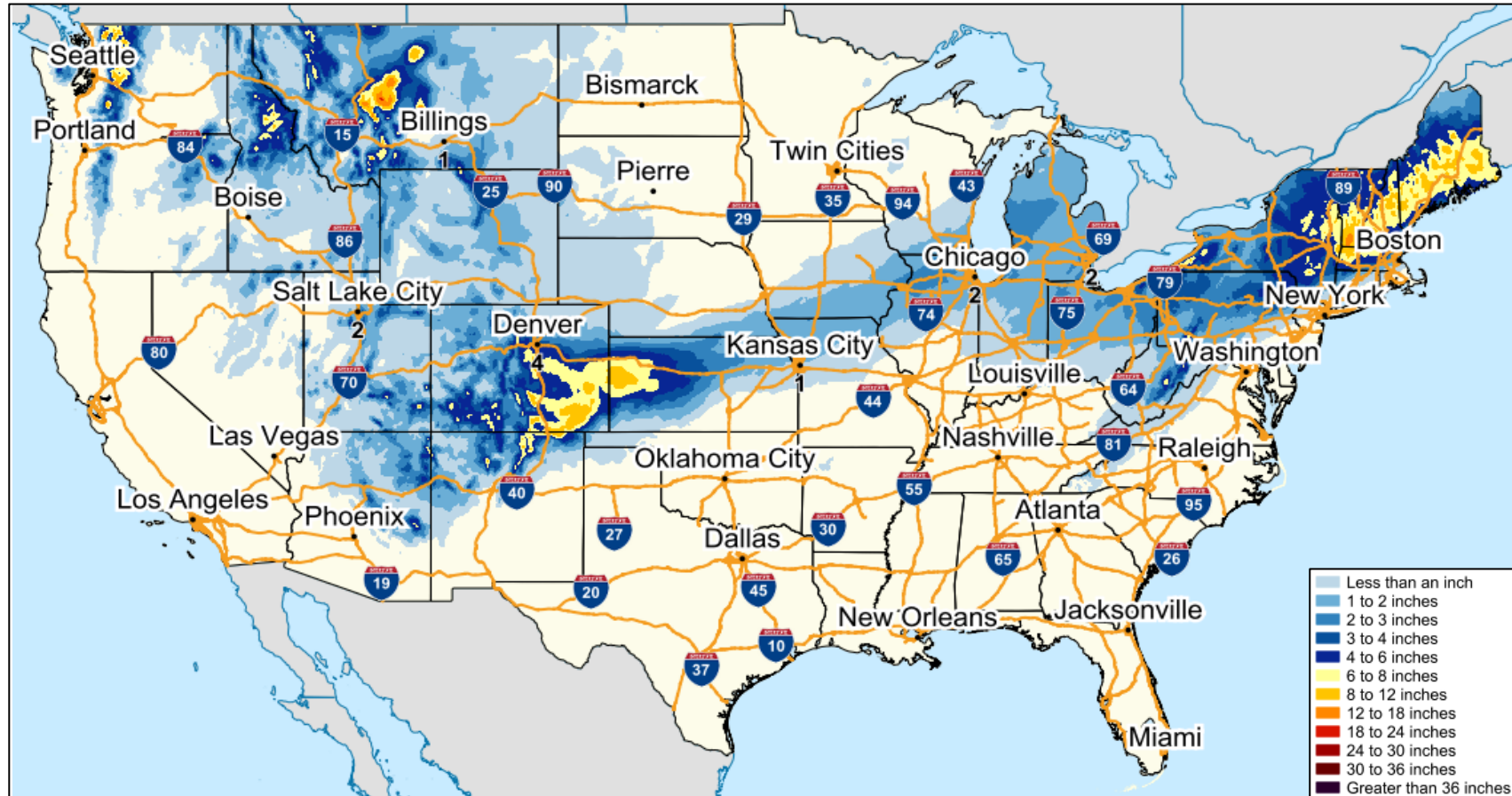
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
