# Earthquake (M6.4) – Puerto Rico - FINAL



**Situation:** This event is advancing into recovery phase, remaining focused on life sustaining activities, replenishment of commodities, shelter requirements, power restoration, crisis counseling, and damage assessments. **M4.5 was the largest aftershock in the last 24 hrs.**

## **Lifeline Impacts:**

### **Food, Water & Shelter:** Yellow

- 39 shelters open with 5,605 occupants (ESF 6, as of 5:20 a.m., Jan 21)
- Five survivor base camps being established

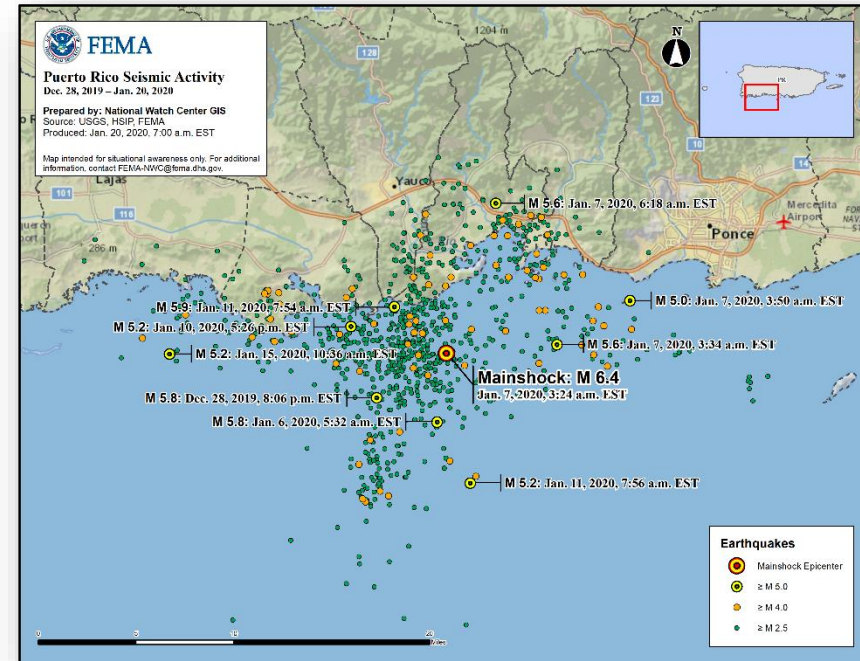

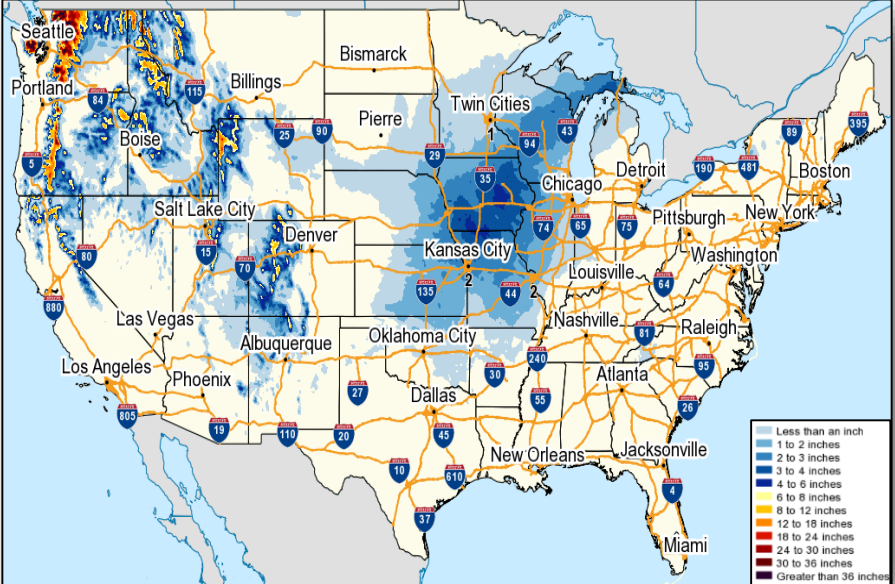

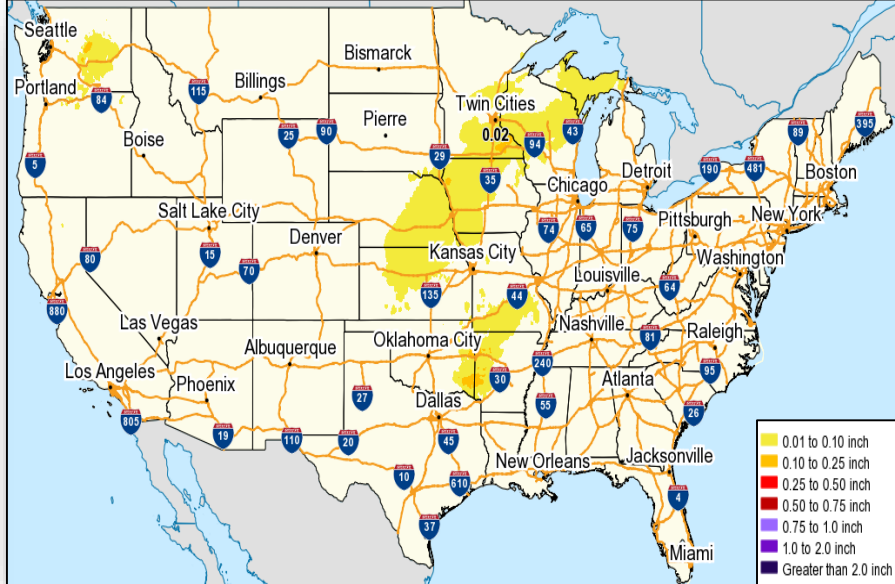




# Winter Precipitation Outlook



**Forecast Snowfall**

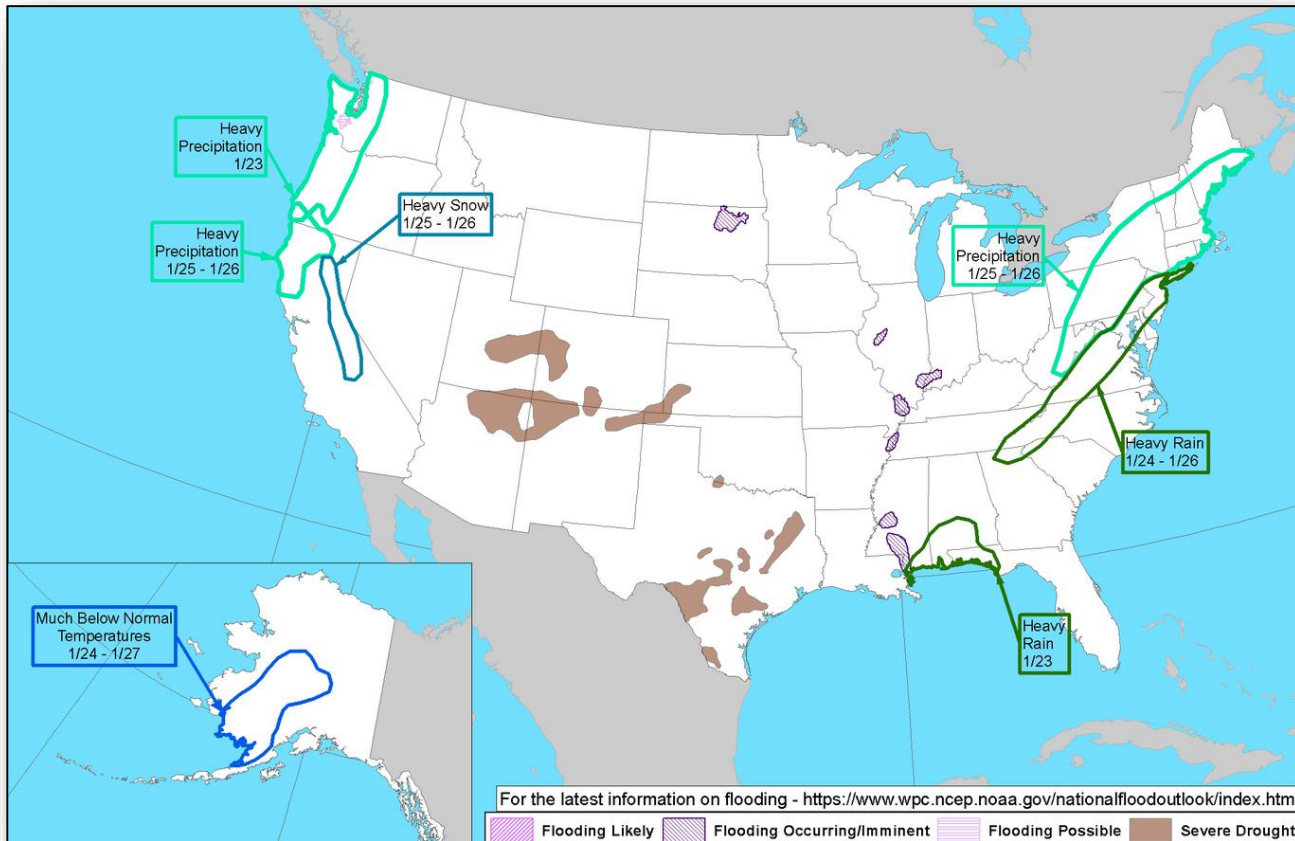


**Forecast Ice Accumulation**

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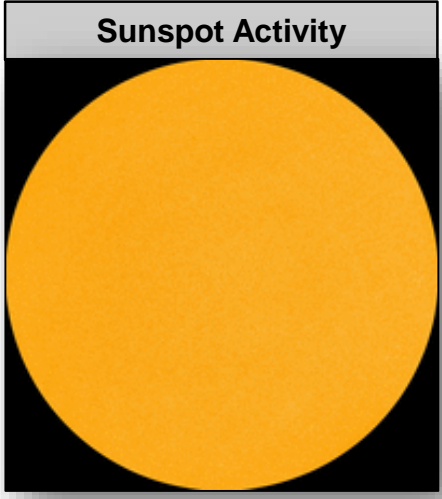
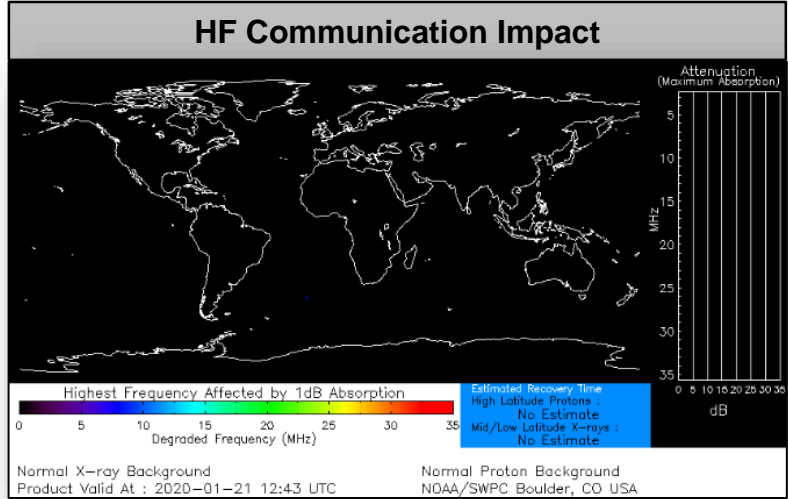

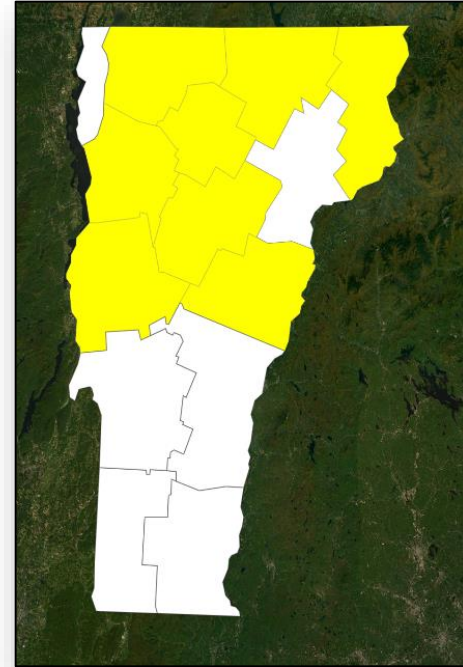
