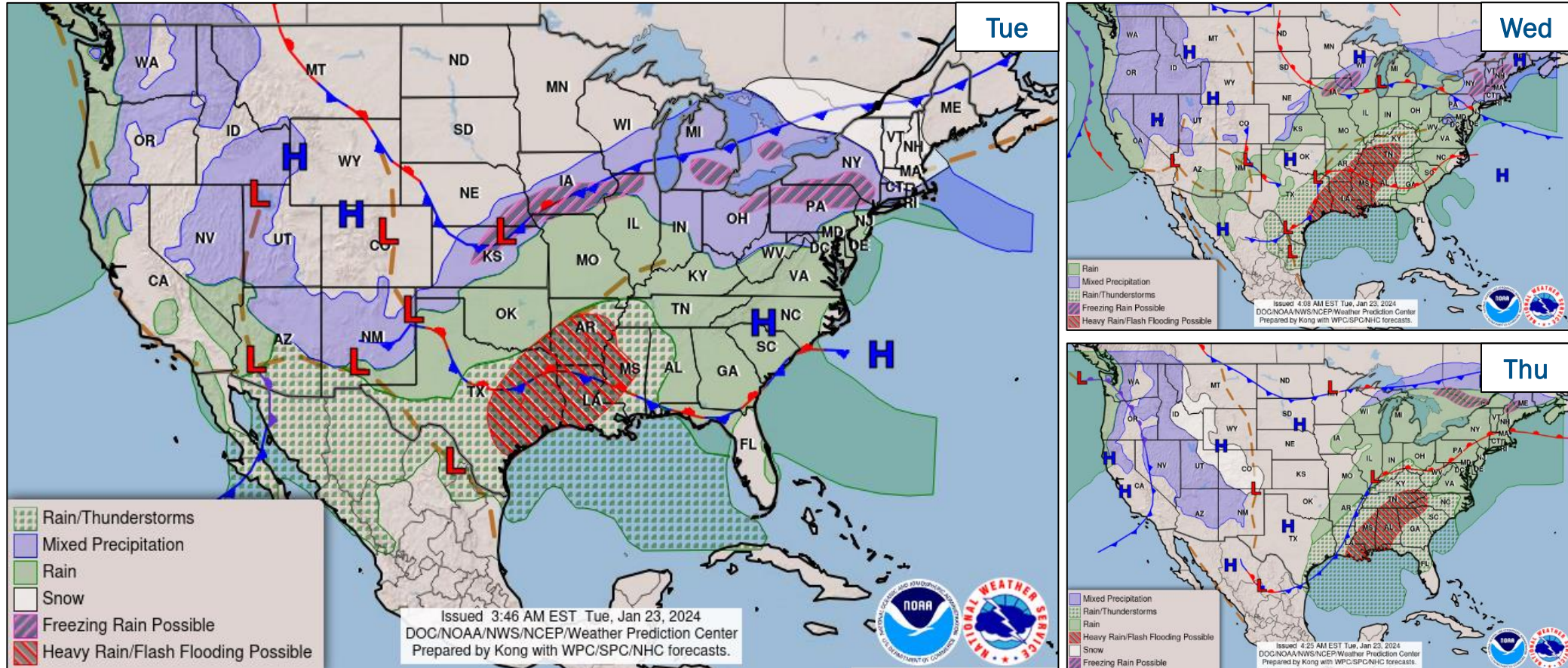

National Weather Forecast



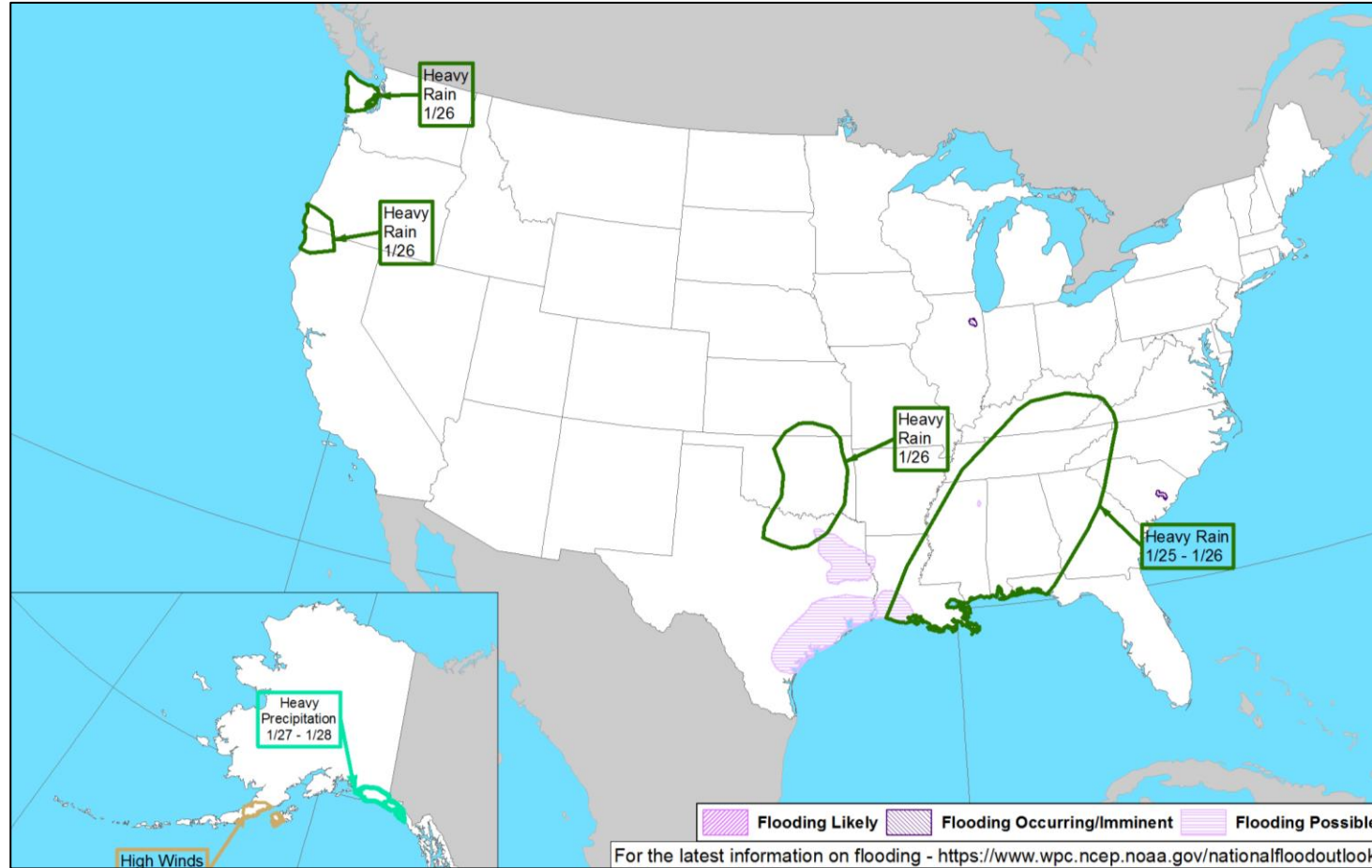

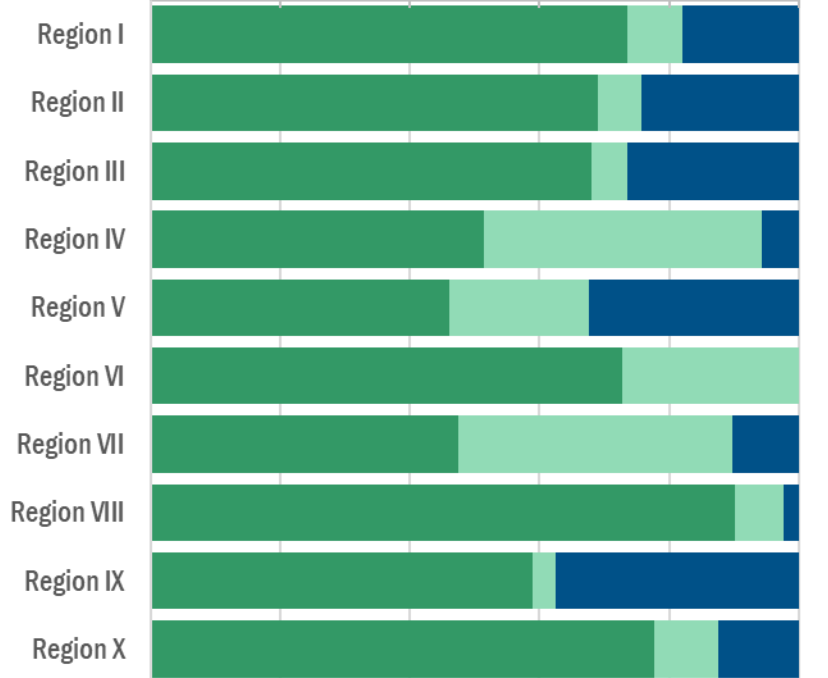

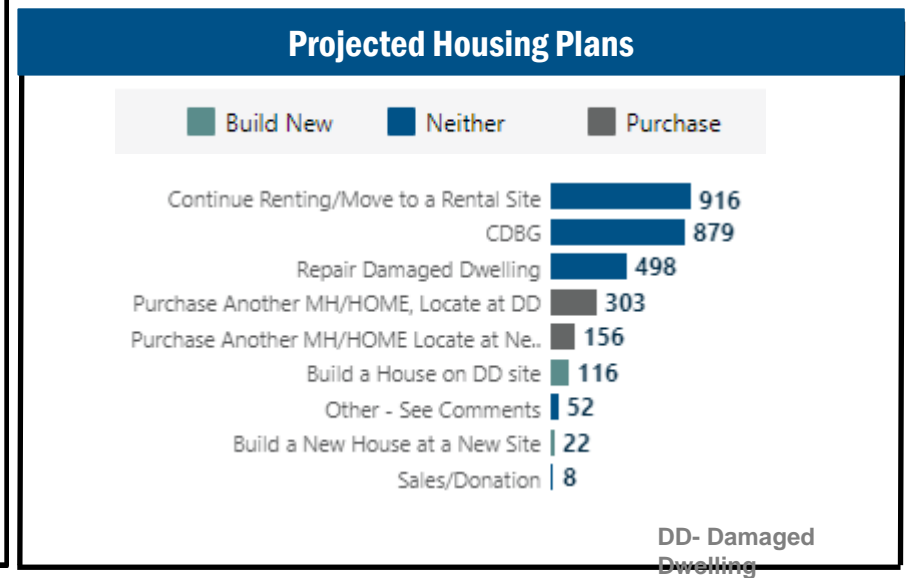
