Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

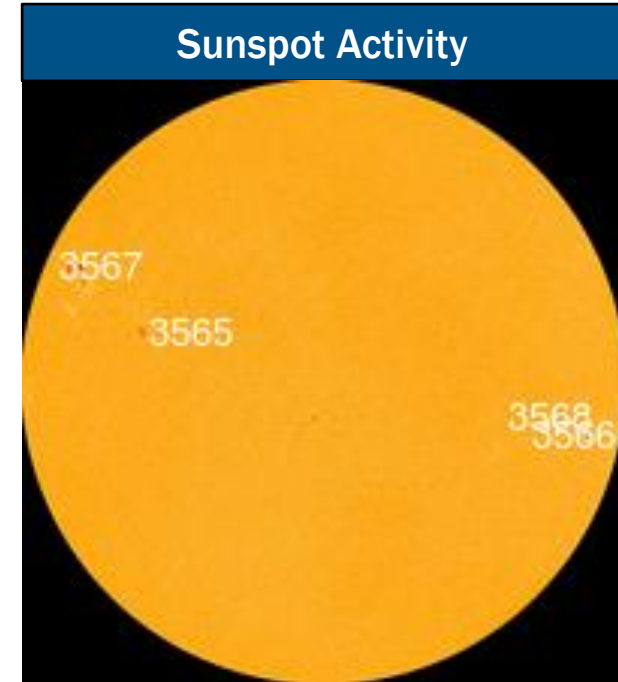
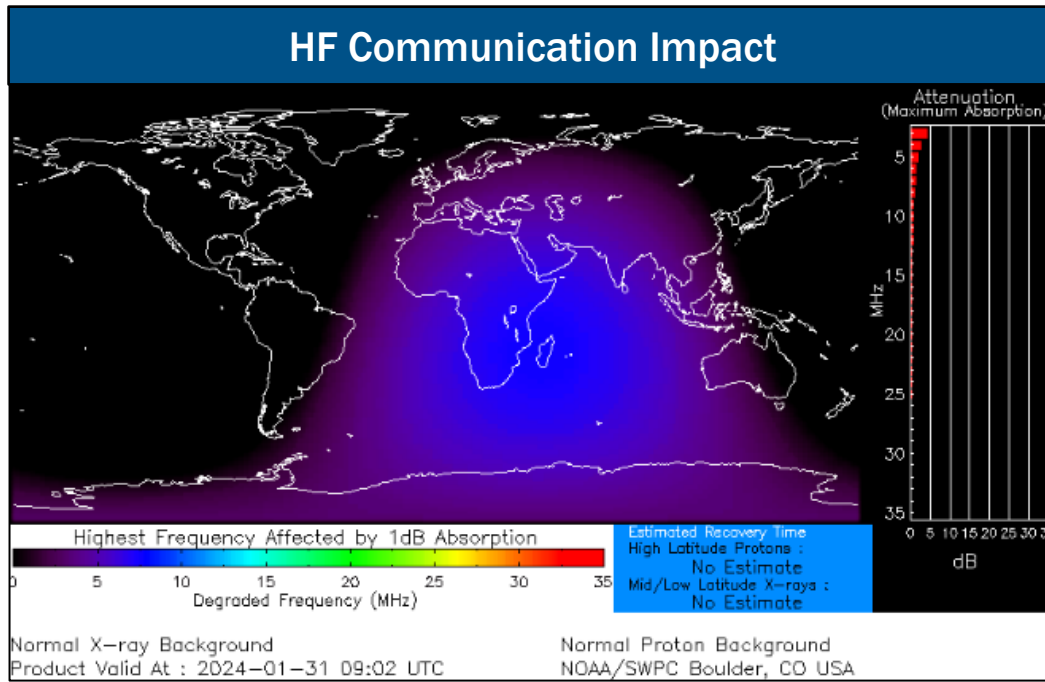
