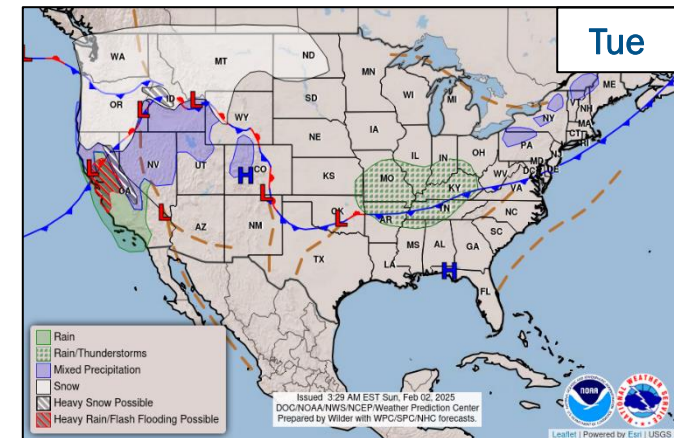

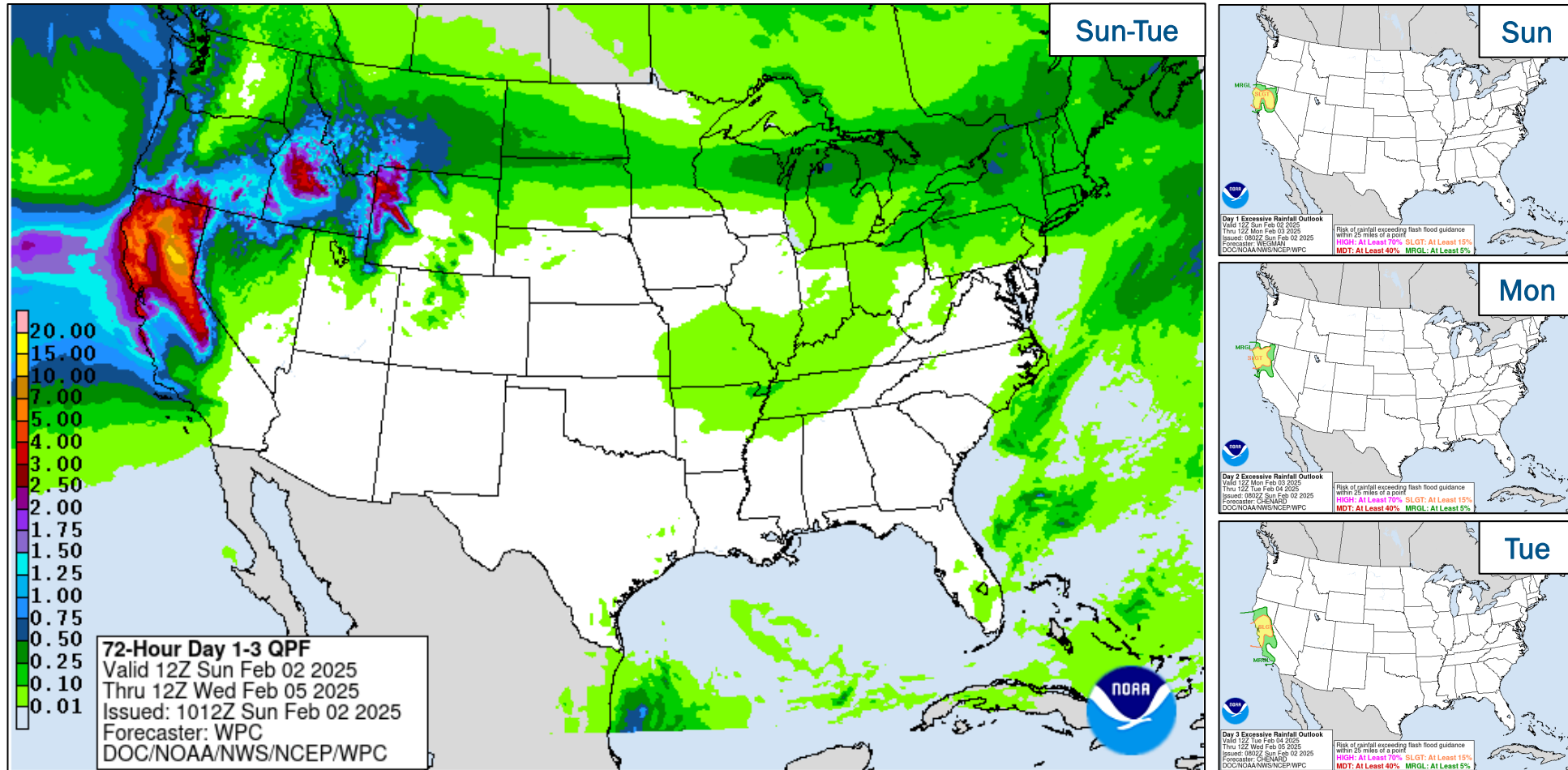

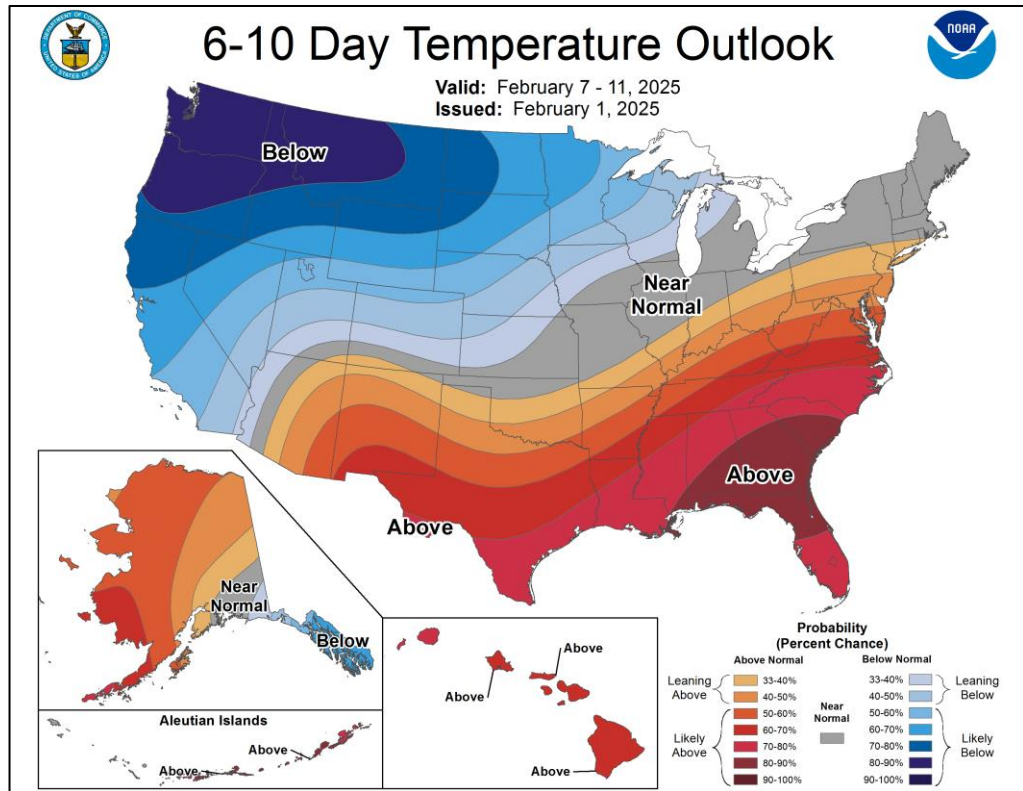
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



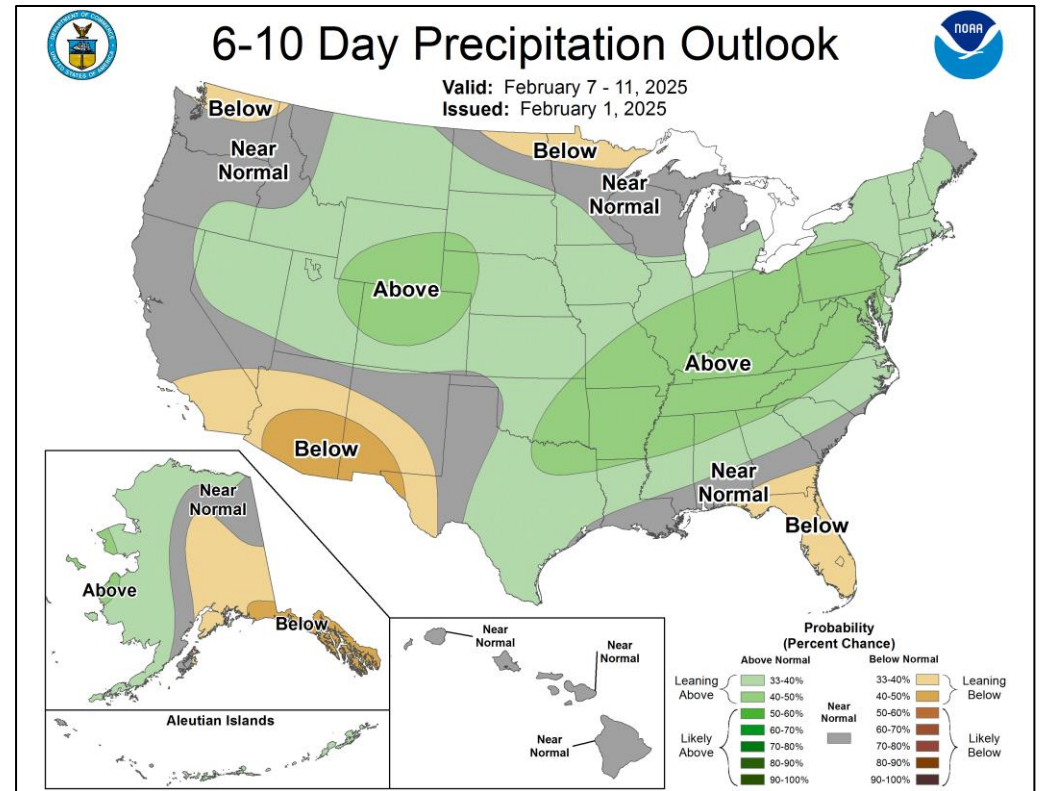

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

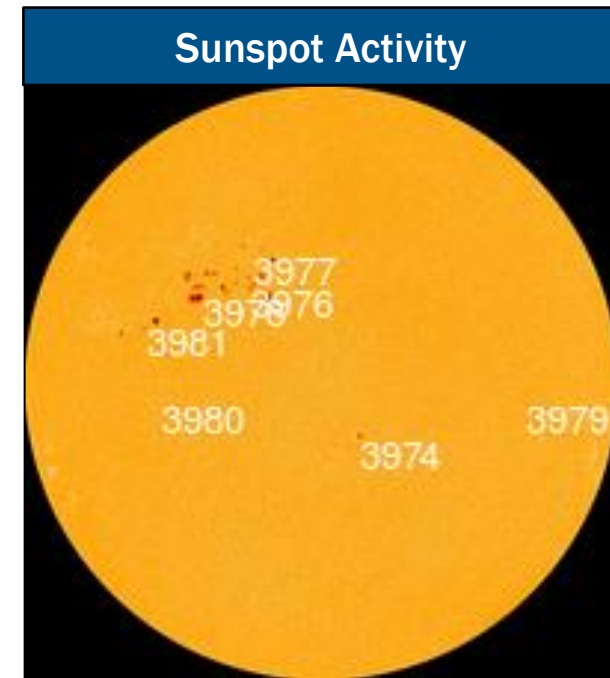
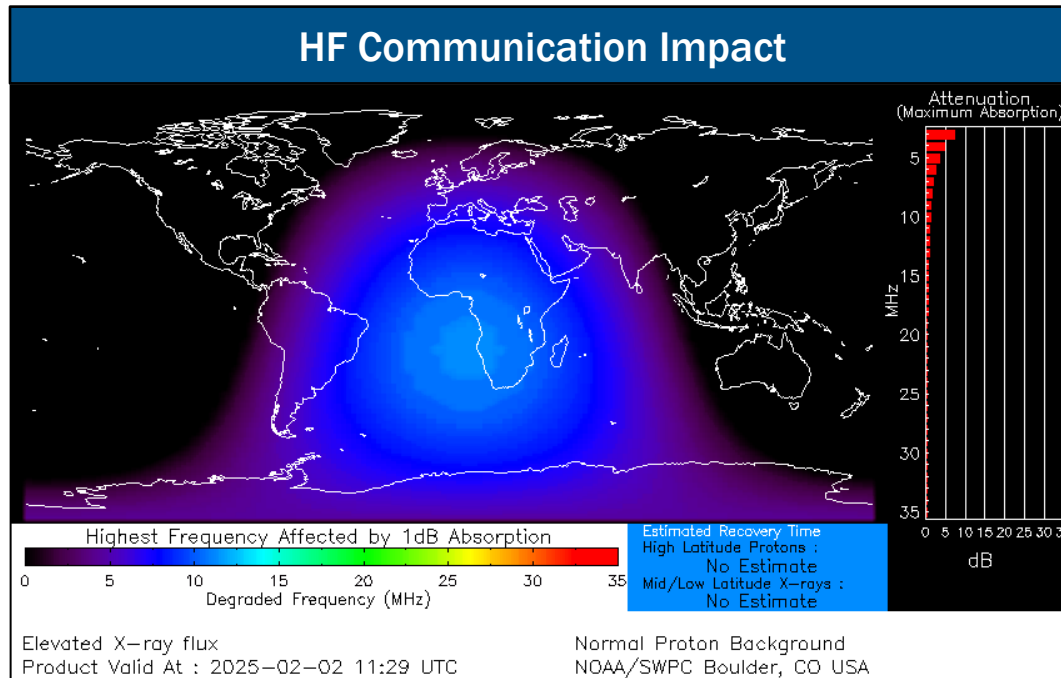

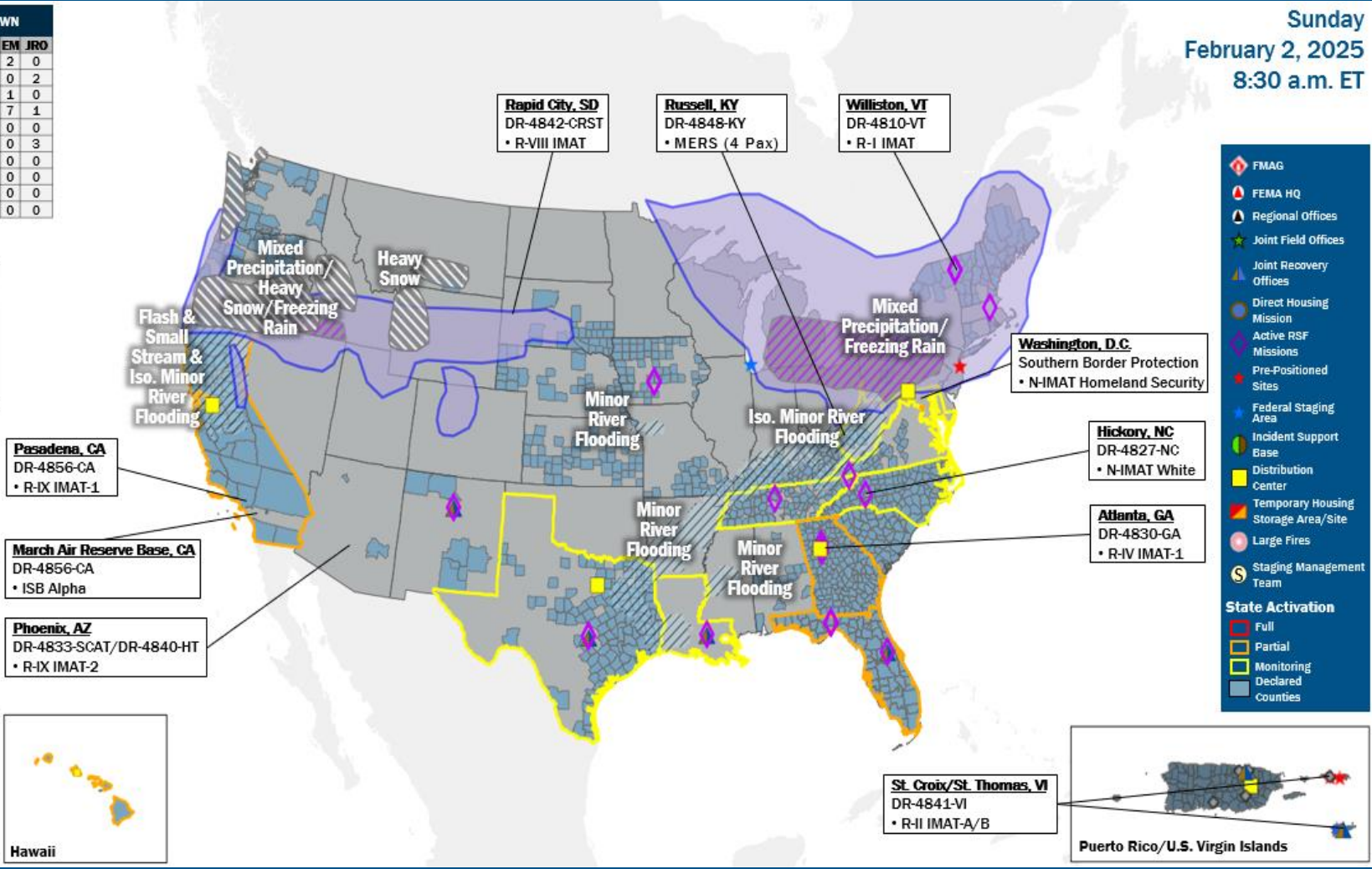
