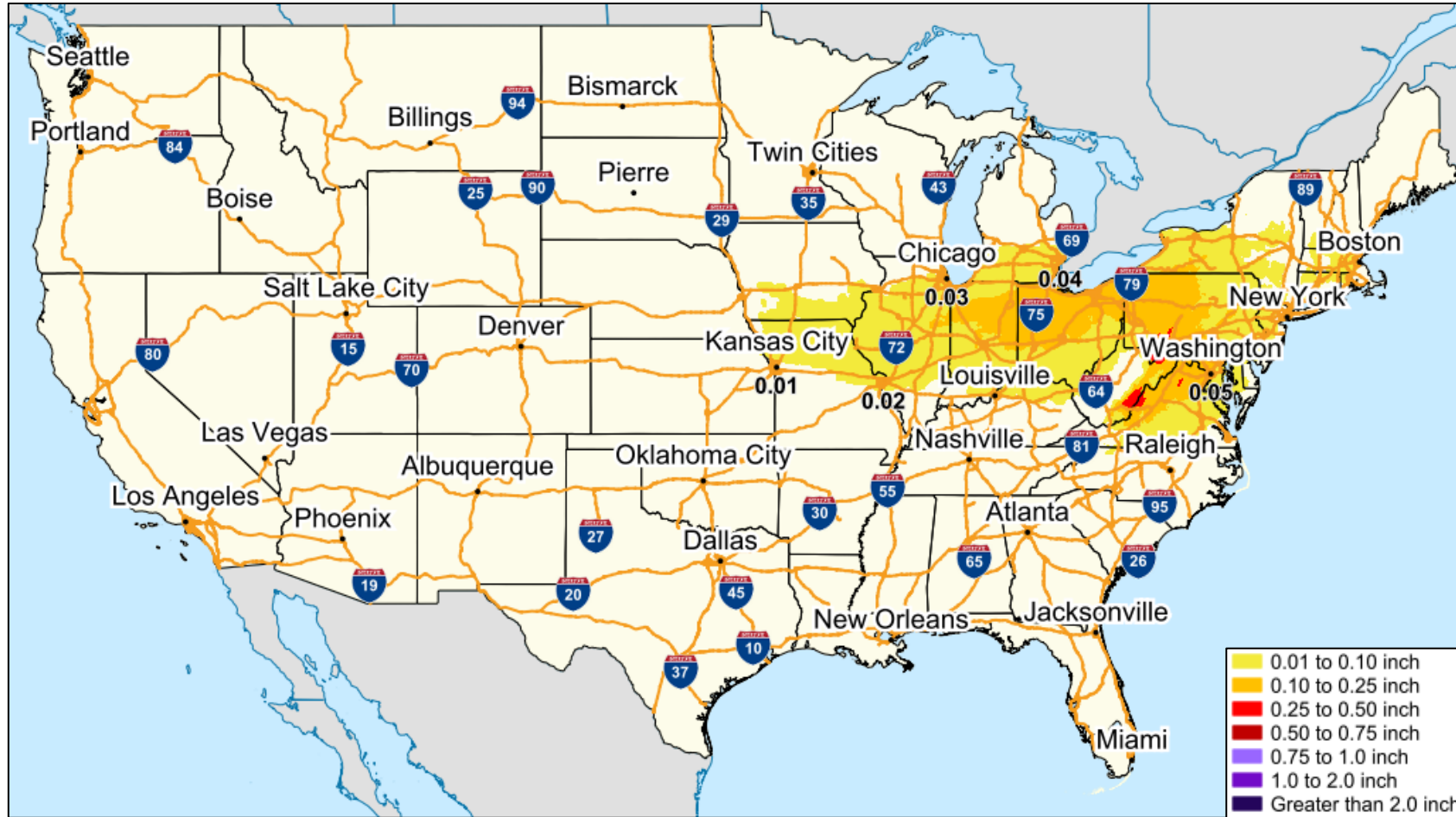
# National Weather Forecast

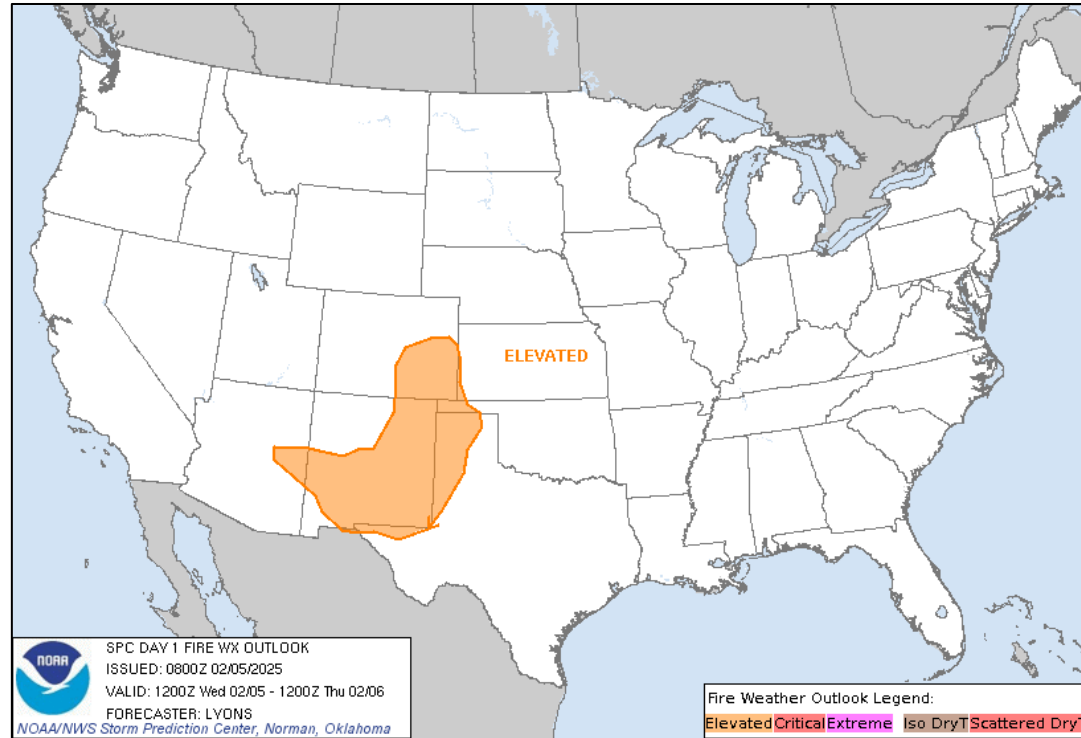

# Ice Accumulation Forecast

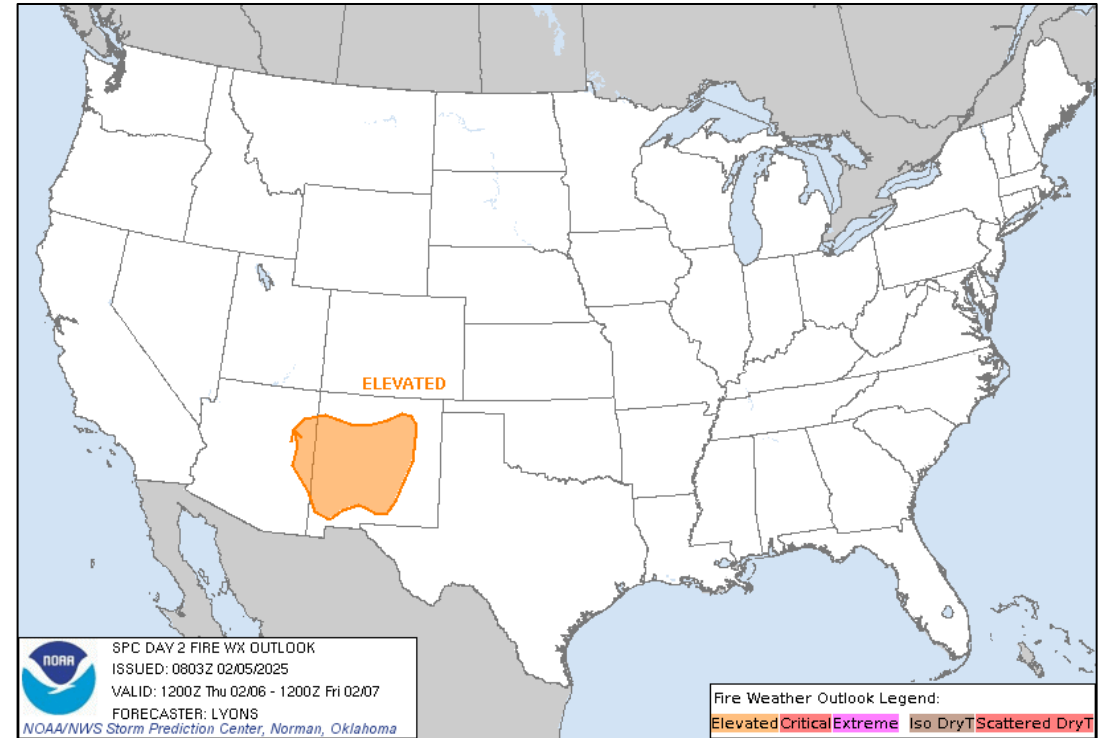

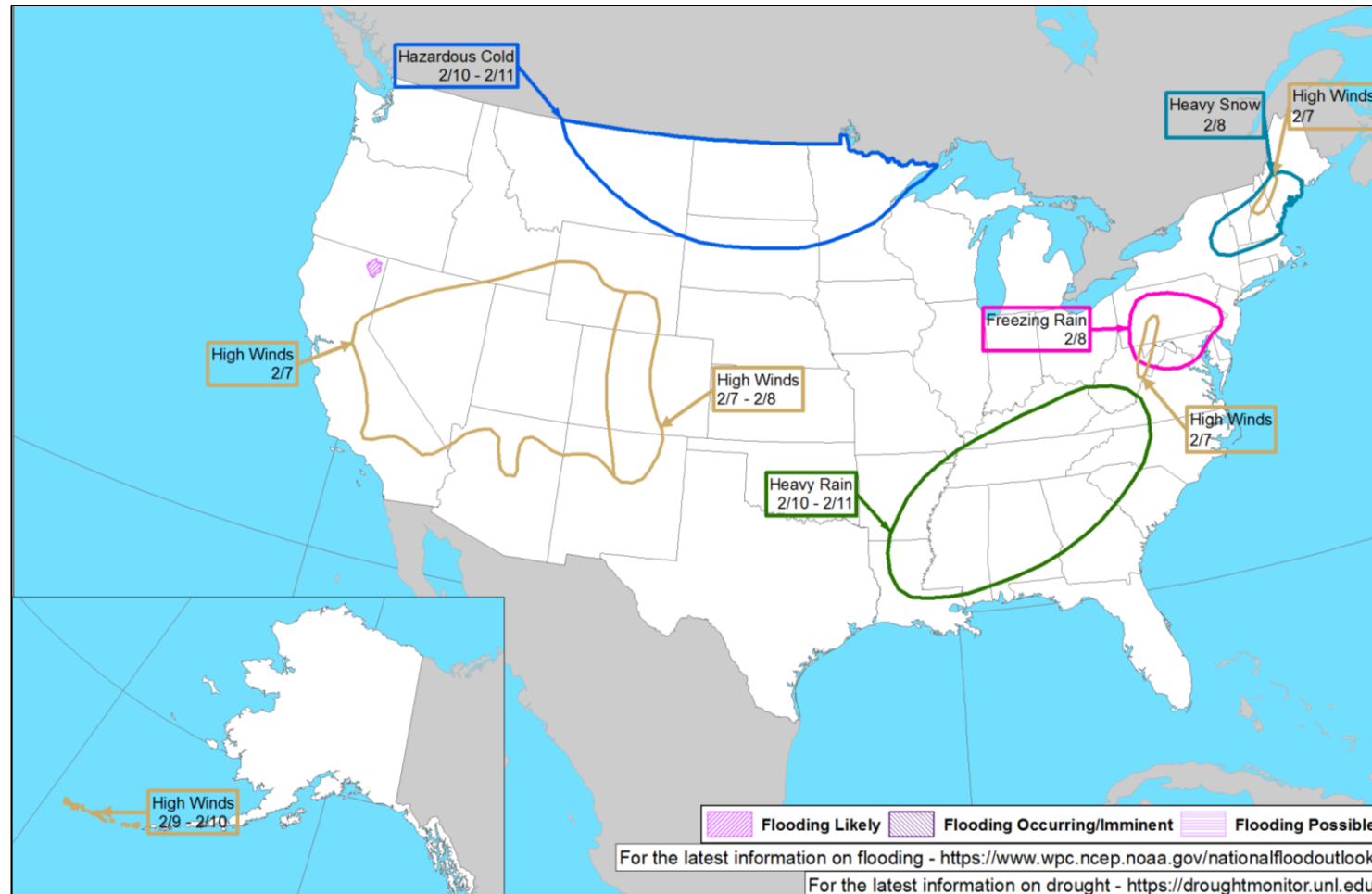

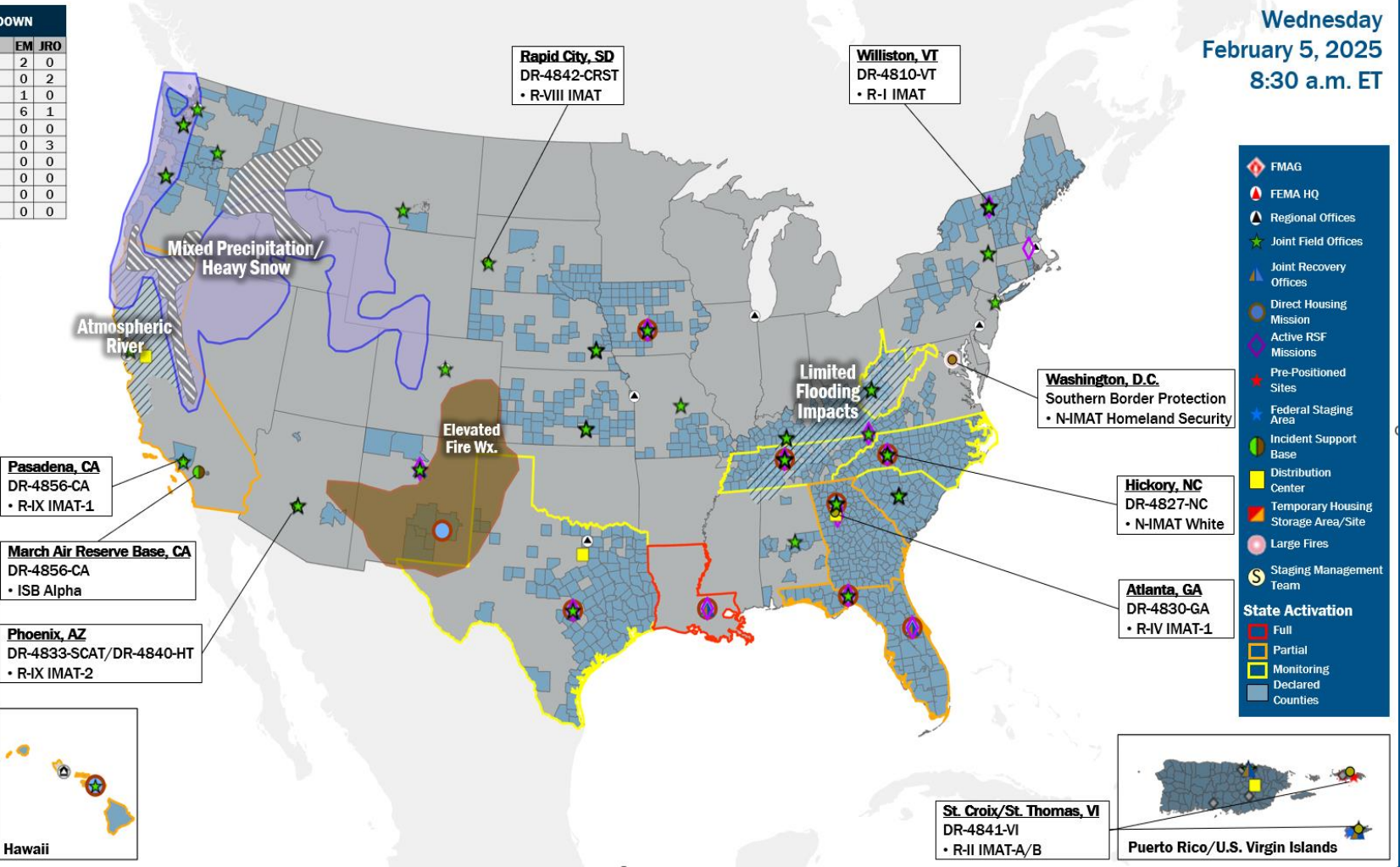
