Winter Storm - Central to Eastern U.S.


<u>Current Situation</u>: Bitterly cold temperatures remain in place from the Southern Plains to the Ohio Valley and Northeast. Blowing snow will create areas of hazardous travel in the Northern Plains and upper Great Lakes today. A gradual warming trend will begin today and persist through next week.

<u>Lifeline Impacts</u>: No impacts exceed local/state capabilities; no requests for FEMA assistance *Food, Water, & Sheltering*:

- KY: 1 shelter open with unknown number of occupants; 35 (+13) on stand-by (3 are ARC); 10 (+6) warming shelters open with unknown number of occupants; 72 (+25) on standby
- TN: 3 shelters (1 is an ARC shelter) and 1 warming center open; unknown number of occupants
- AR: 2 locally operated warming centers open
- OK: 9 locally operated warming centers/shelters open
- TX: 4 (-1) ARC shelters open with 34 (-2) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 6:47 a.m. ET) Energy:
- TN: 77.5k (-7.5k) (3.09%); NY: 25.3k (-2.7k) (0.32%) (Ulster County has 25.3k or 28% of customers without power) (DOE Eagle-I 7:30 am Feb 6)

State / Local Response

- Region IV No requests for federal assistance
 - TN EOC is at Partial Activation (COVID-19; de-activated for Winter Storm)
- Region VI No requests for federal assistance
 - TX EOC is at Partial Activation (COVID-19; de-activated for Winter Storm)
- Region VII
 - KS EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19; de-activated for Winter Storm)
 - MO EOC at Normal Operations (de-activated for Winter Storm; not activated for COVID)




FEMA / Federal Response

- Logistics: ISB and SMT teams deployed to OK and AR; 29 generators in Muskogee, OK




National Weather Forecast





Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Forecast Snowfall

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability







