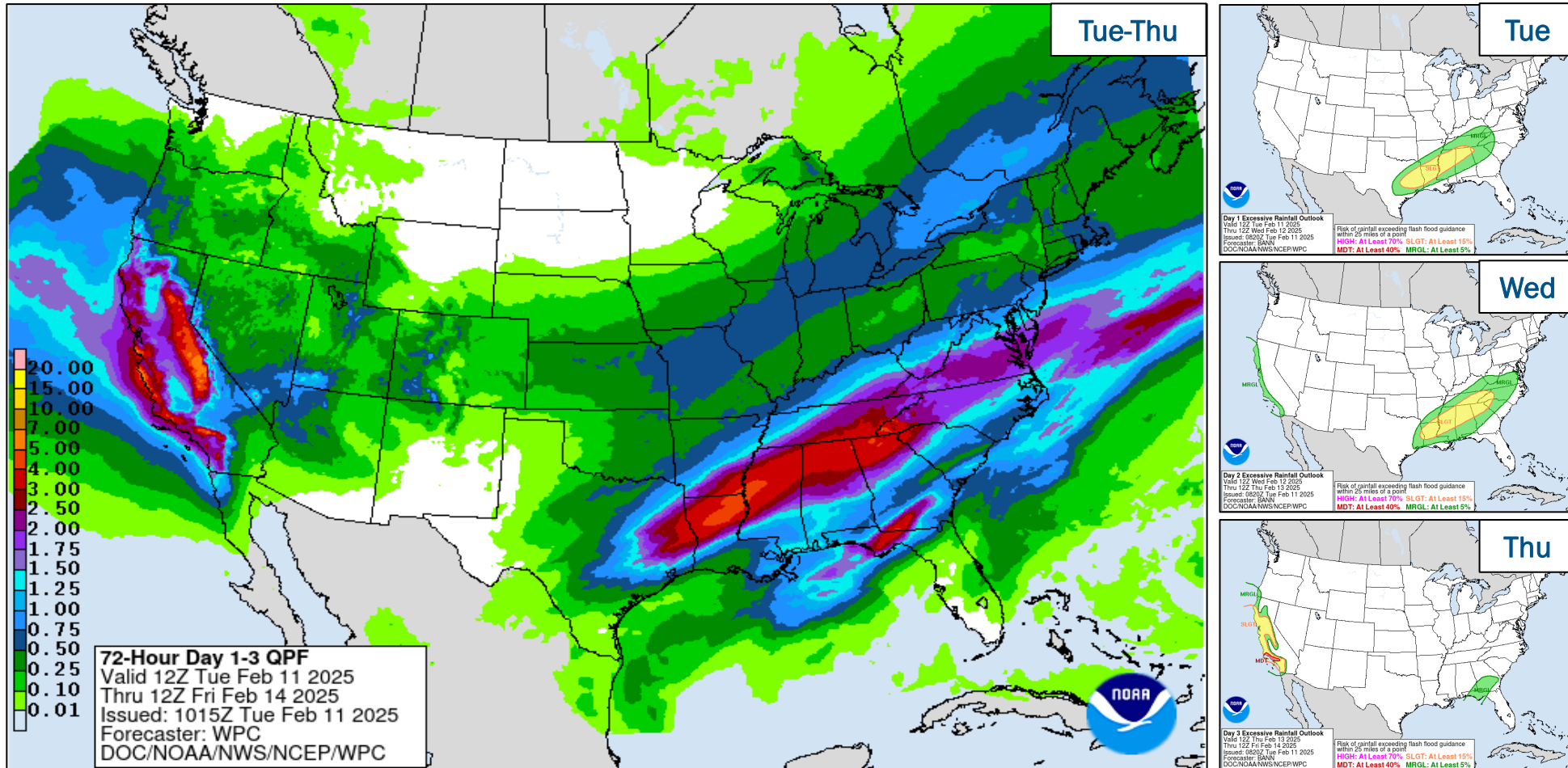
# National Weather Forecast

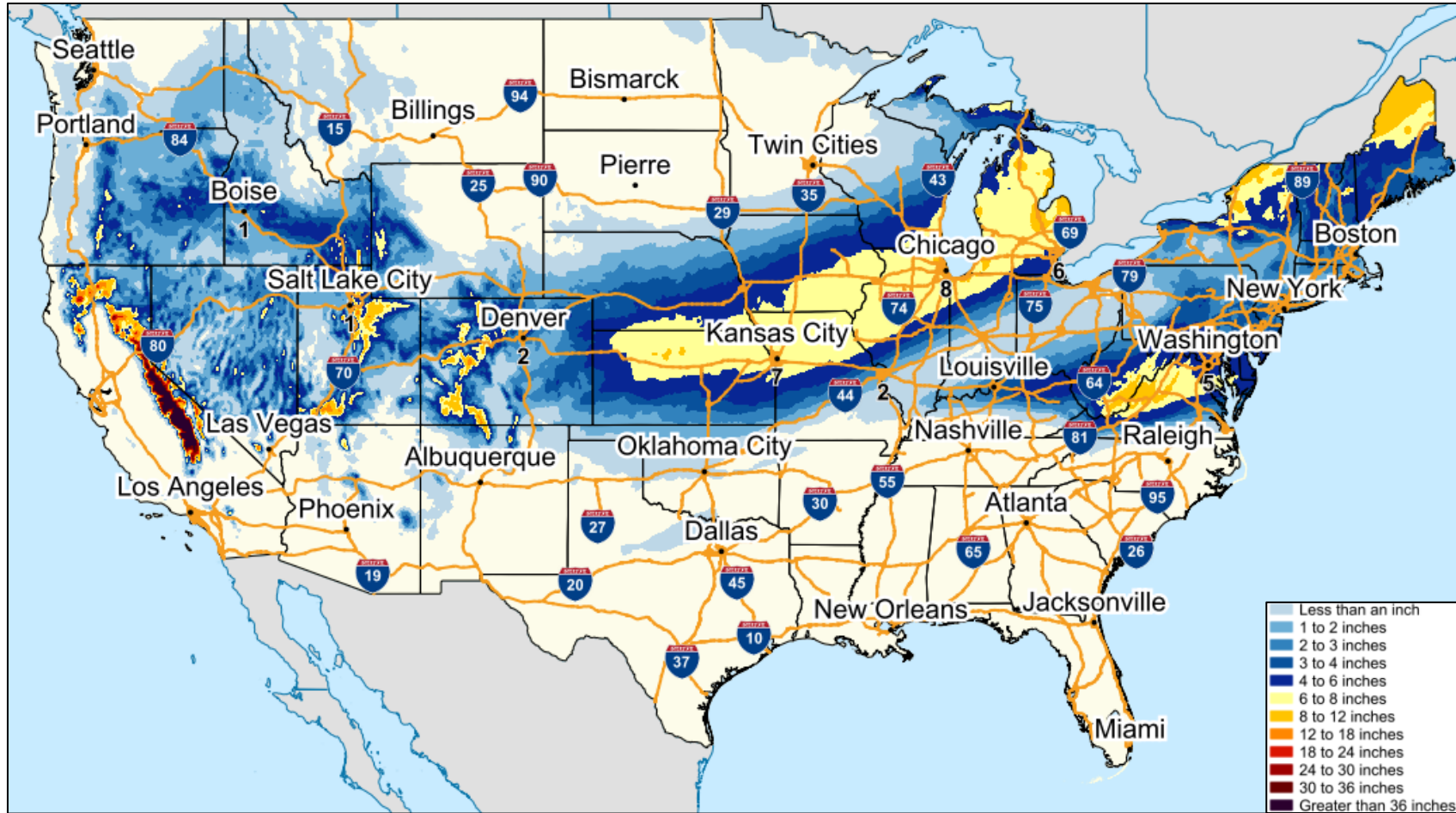
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

# Snowfall Forecast



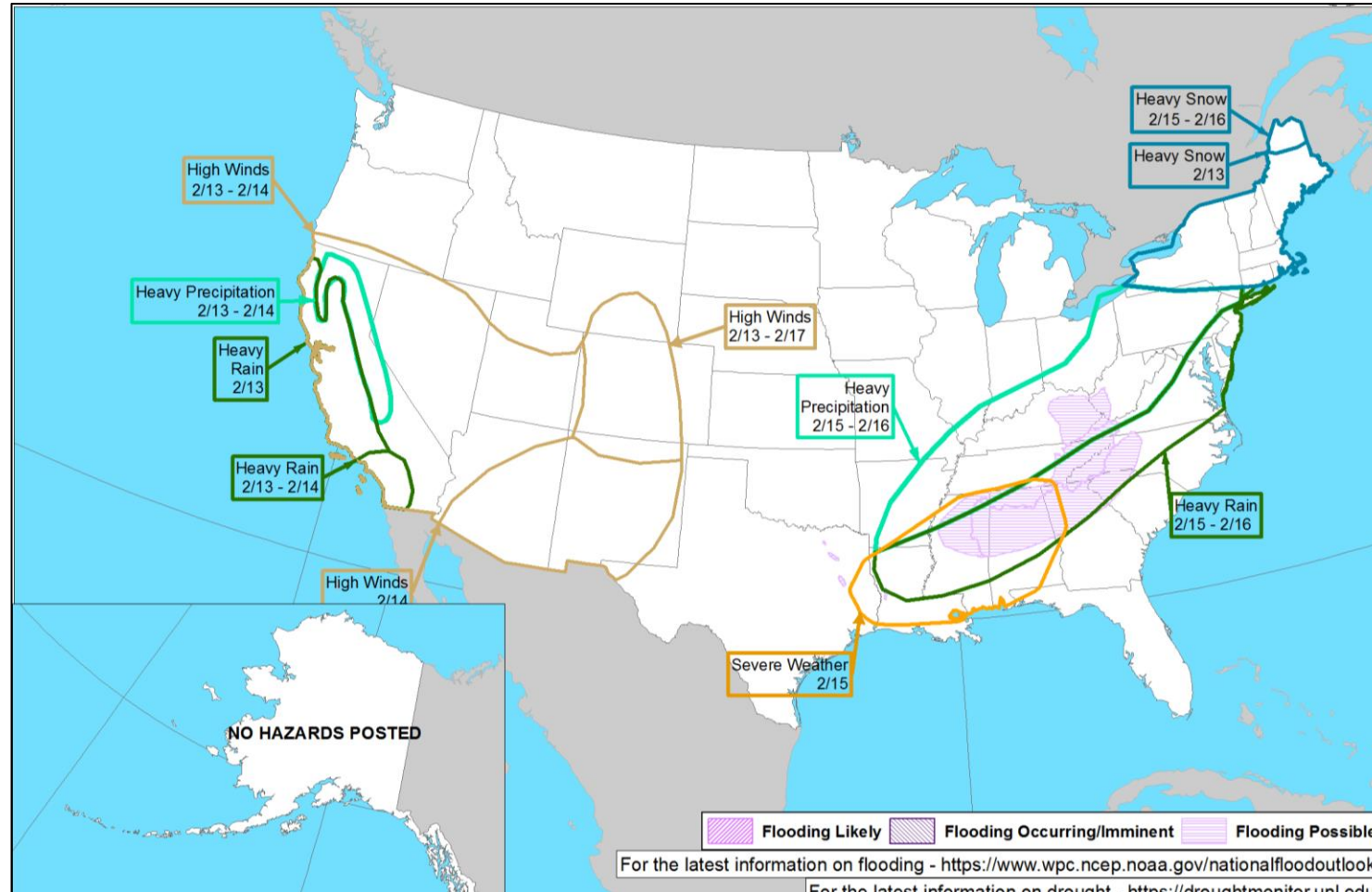

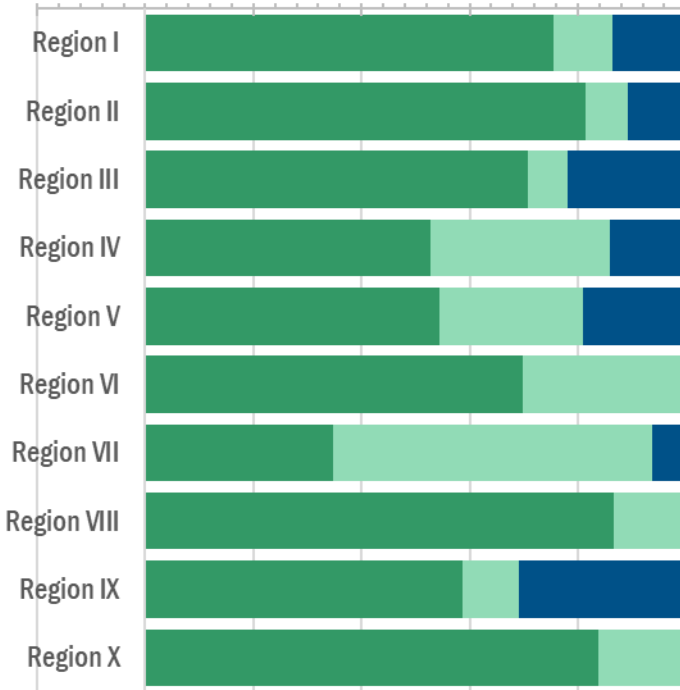

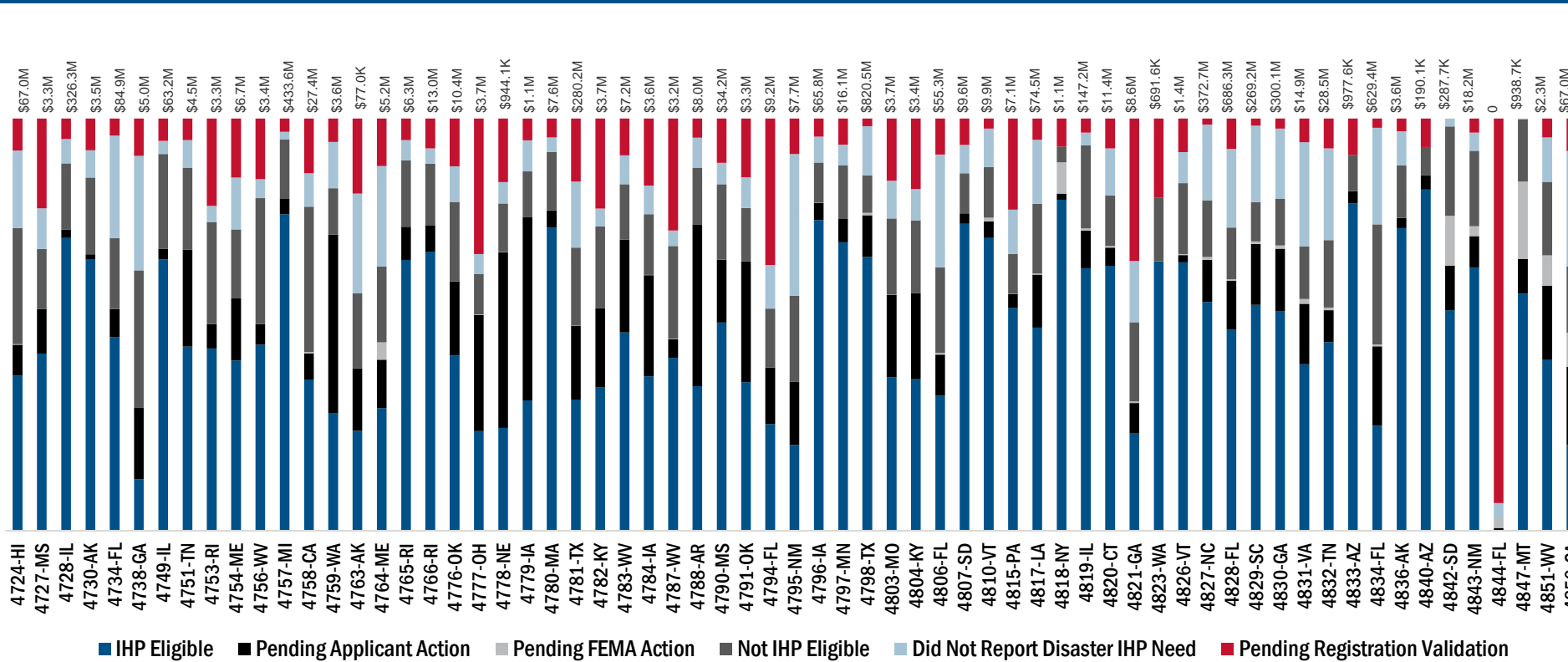

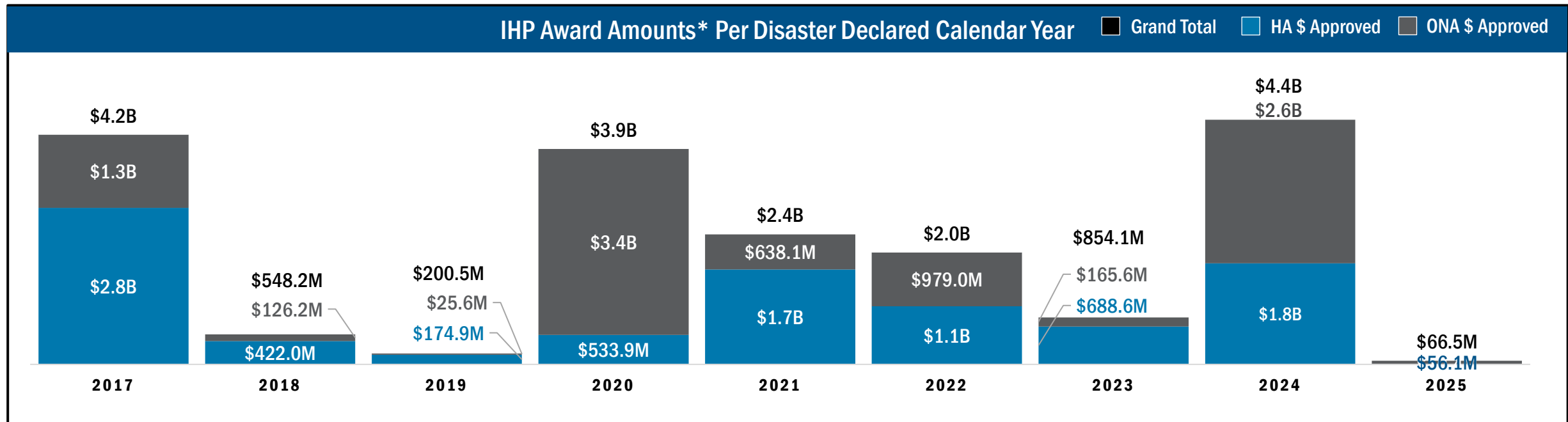
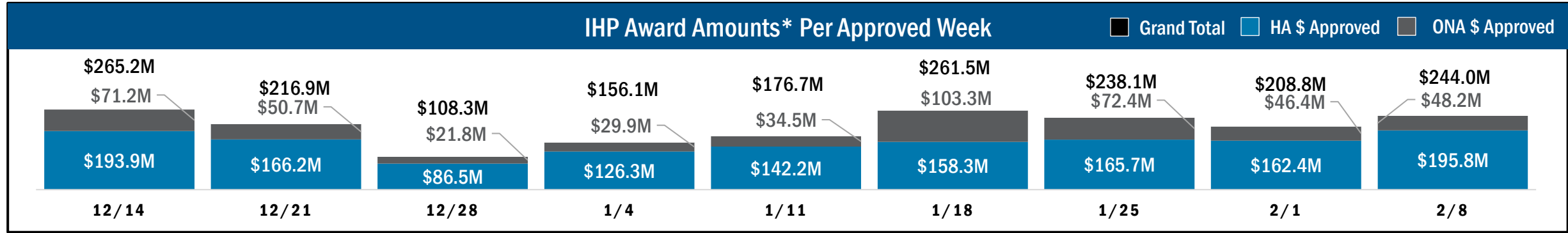
## Registrations in Active Declarations

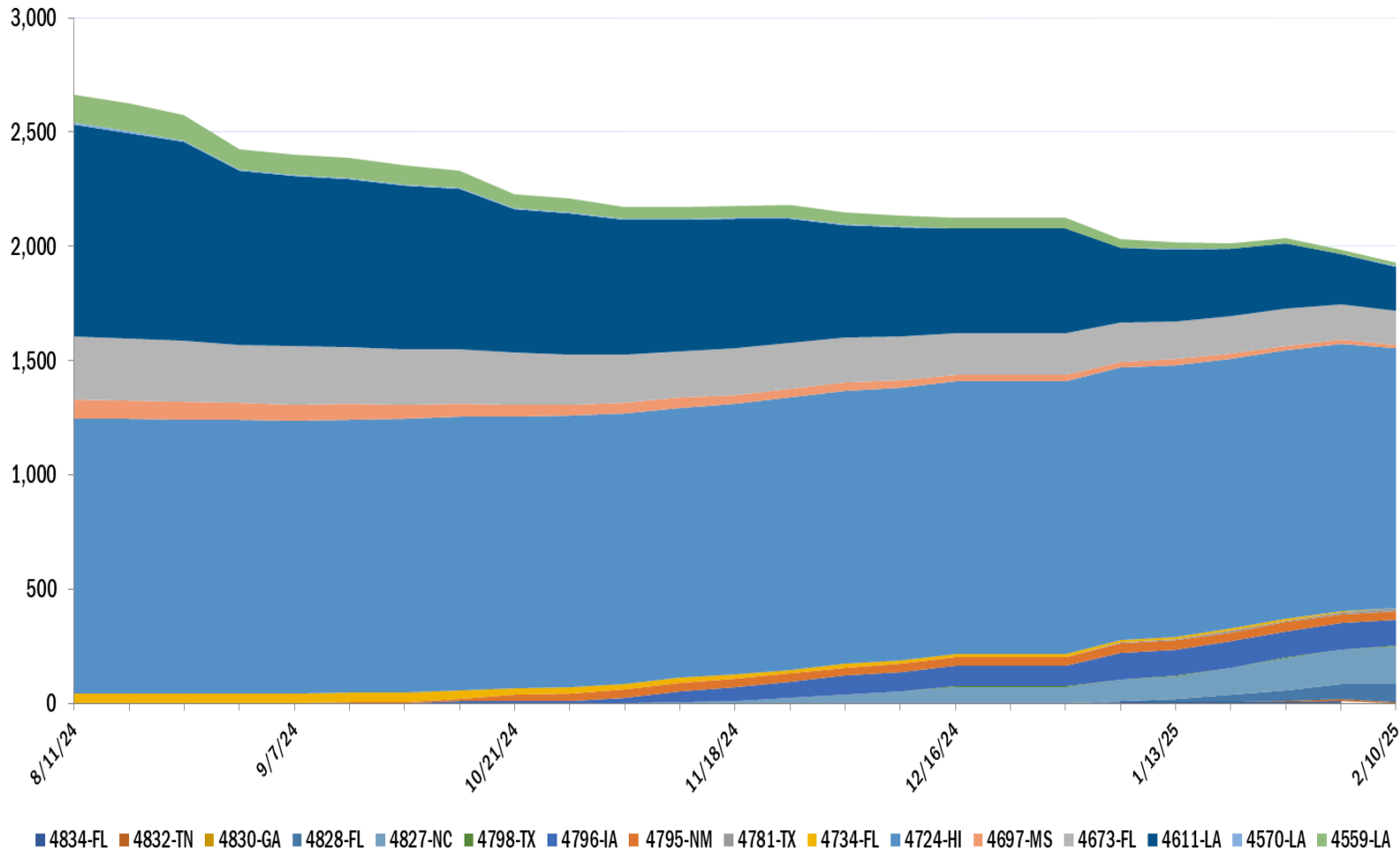
