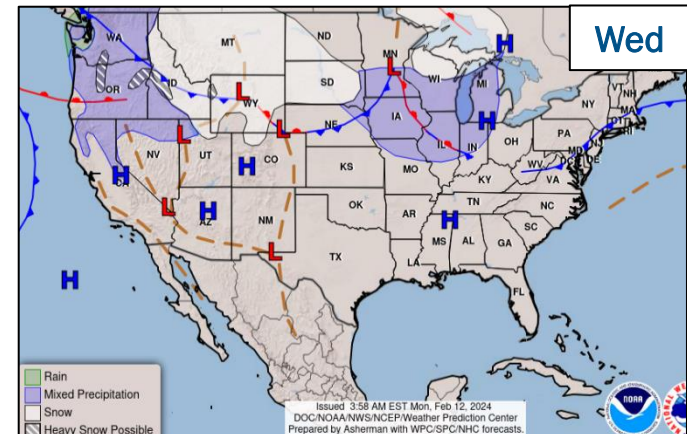

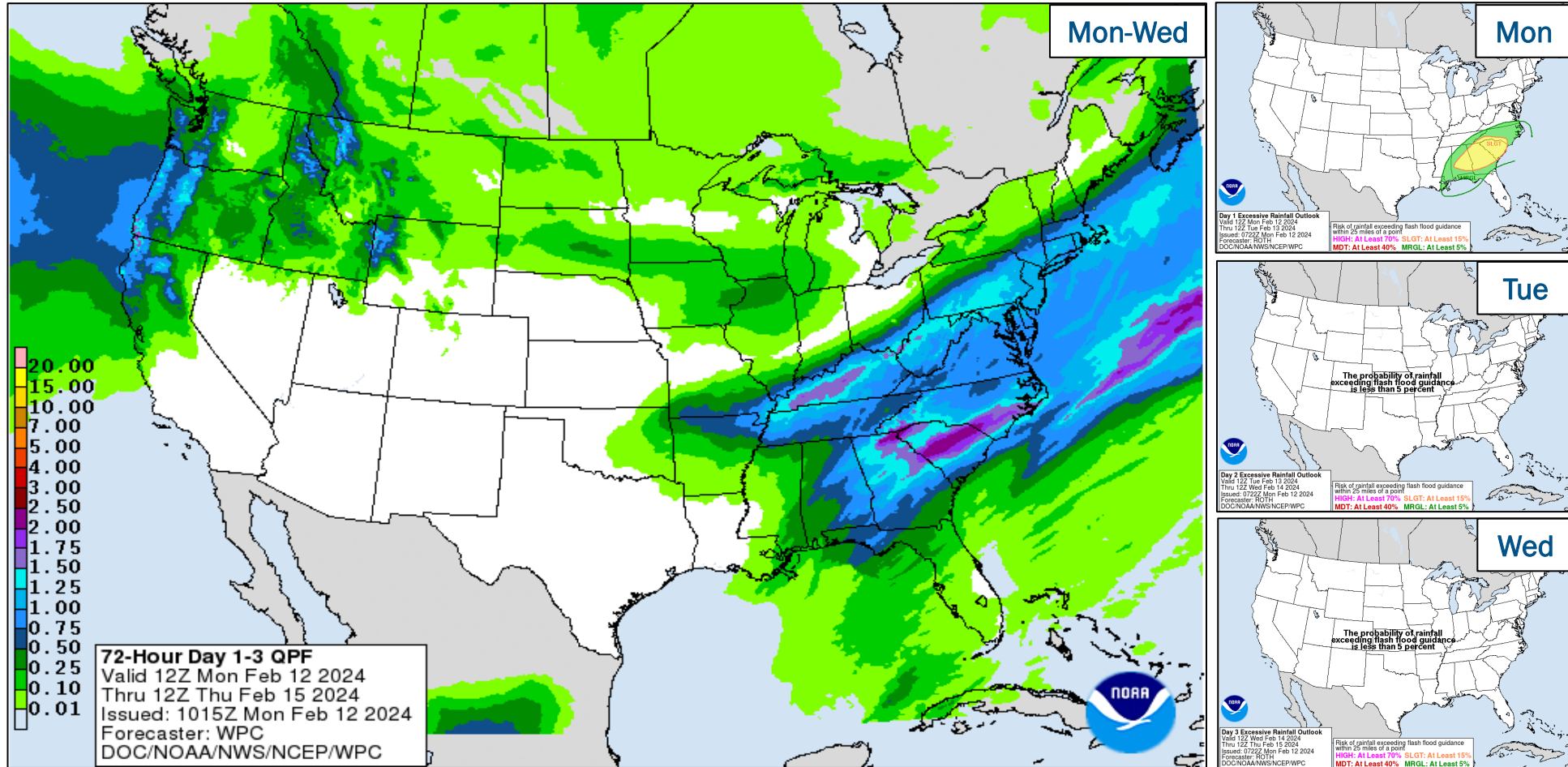

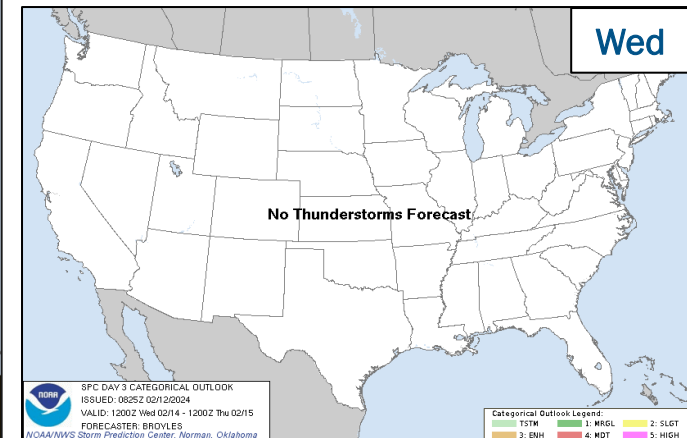
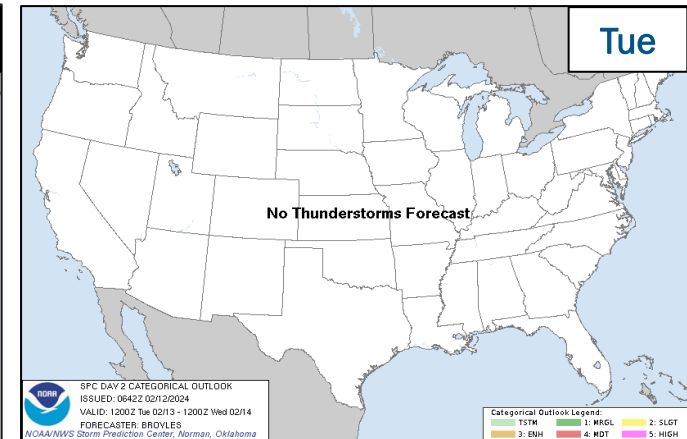
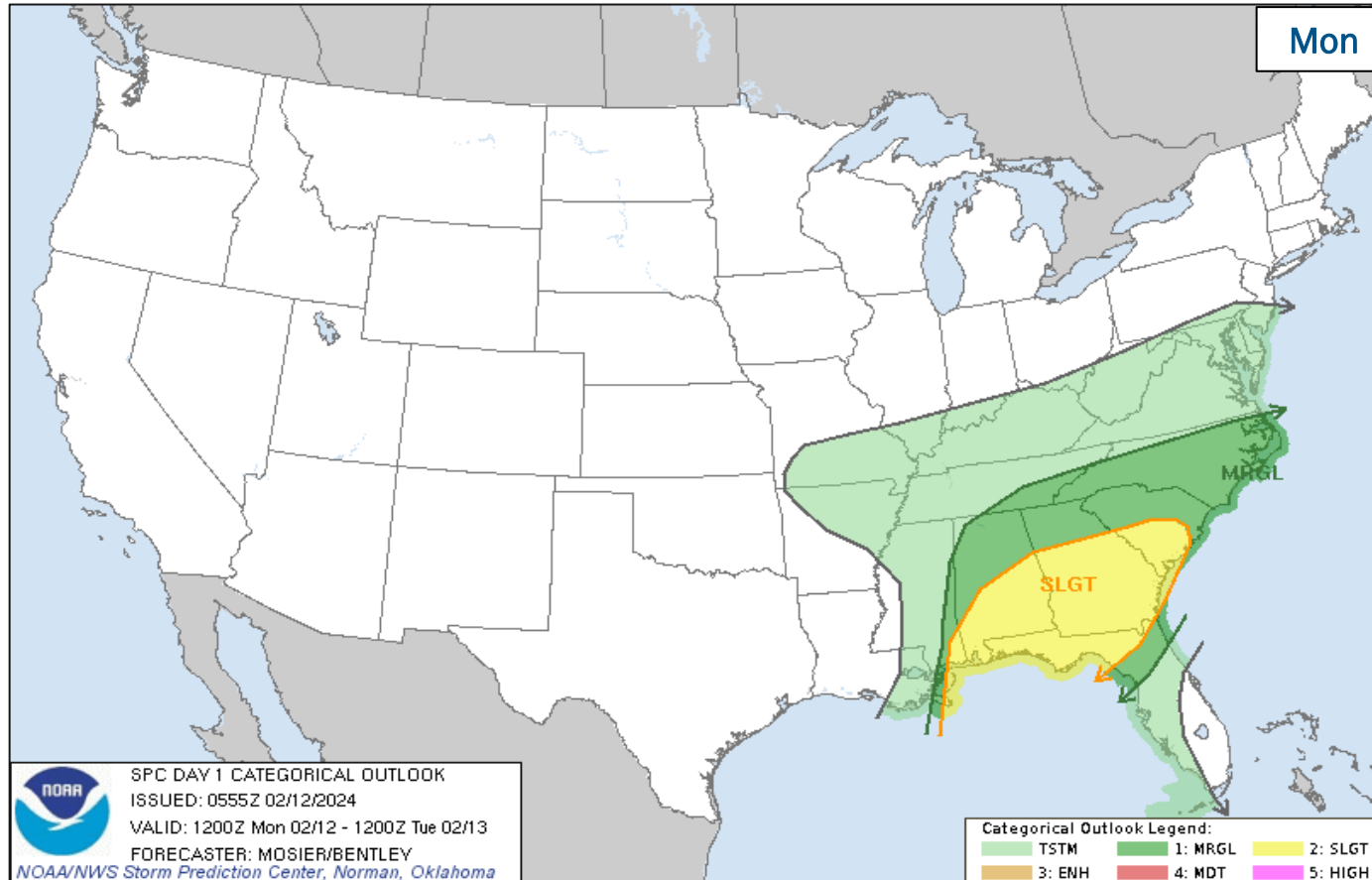
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

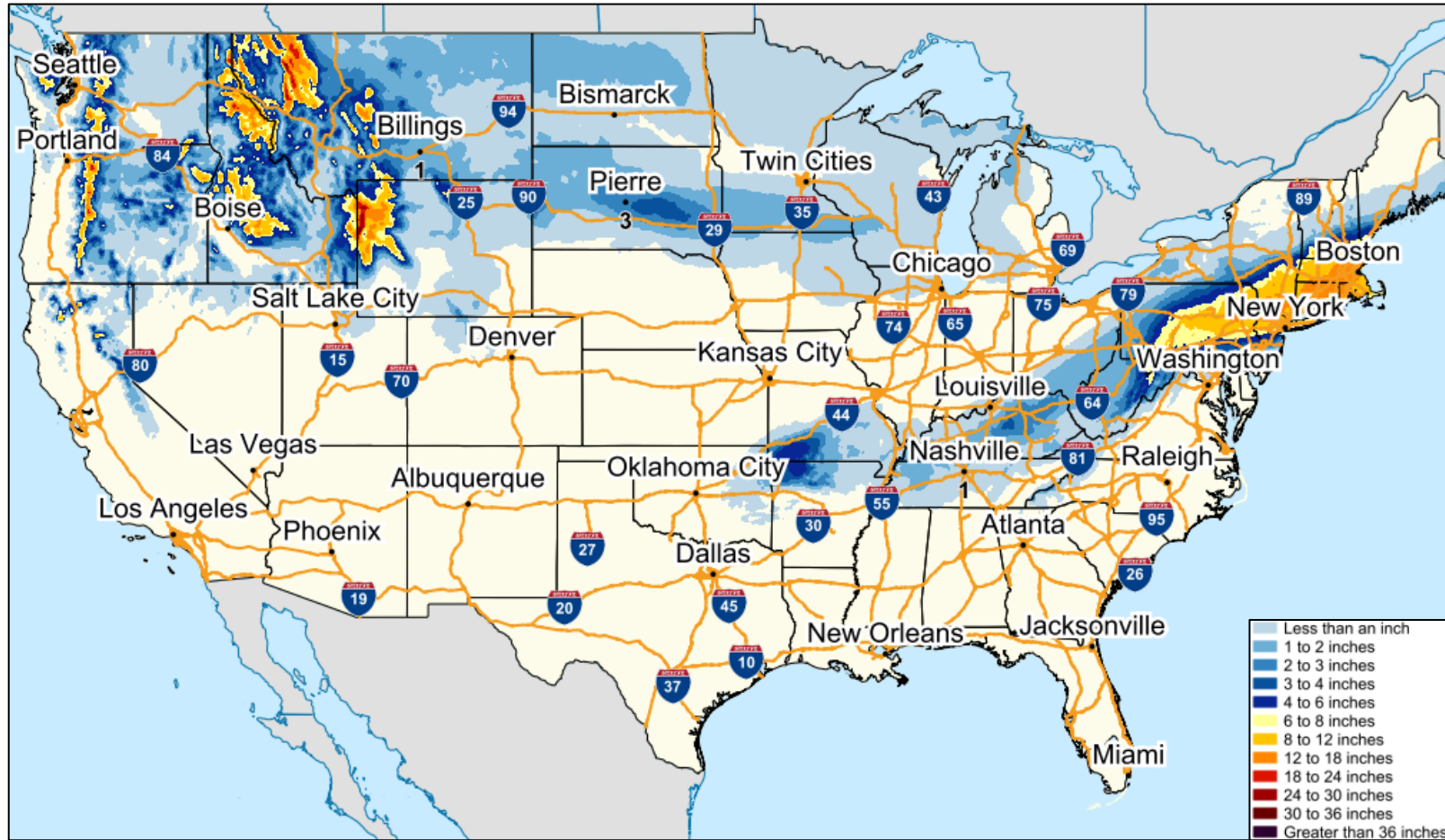
# Severe Weather Outlook

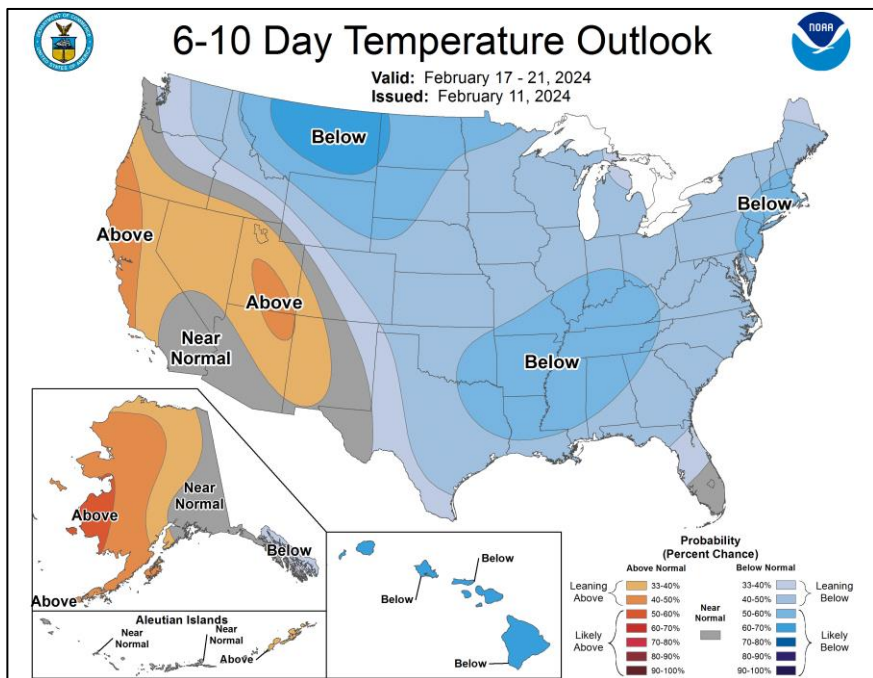

# Snowfall Forecast

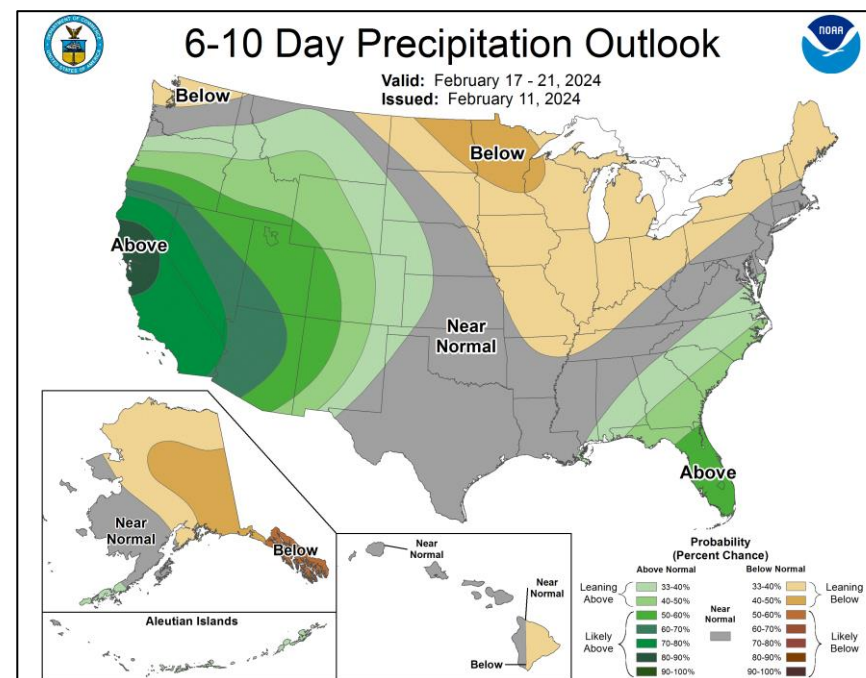

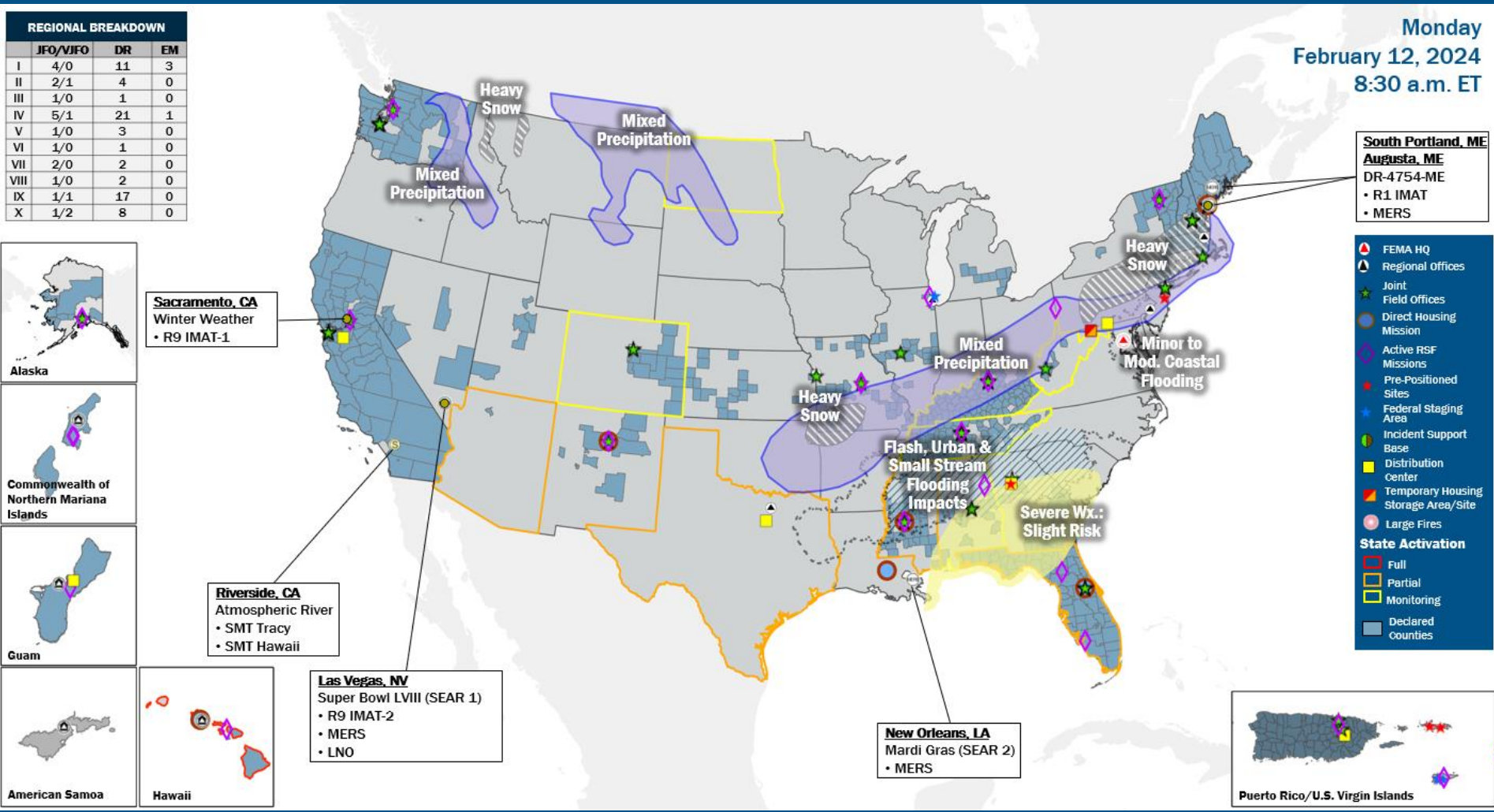
