# Winter Storm – Central Plains to Northeast - FINAL

**Current Situation:** A winter storm produced heavy snow from the Central Plains into the Great Lakes and Mid-Atlantic yesterday. Snowfall is expected to continue in New England until Friday with rain and thunderstorms forecasted for the Mid-Atlantic. There are no reported impacts to Community Lifelines and no requests for FEMA assistance.

**Region II:** (Region II DSAR, as of 2:53 p.m. ET)

- NJ SEOC is Monitoring (Winter Storm)

**Region III:** (Region III Update Report, as of 11:29 p.m. ET)

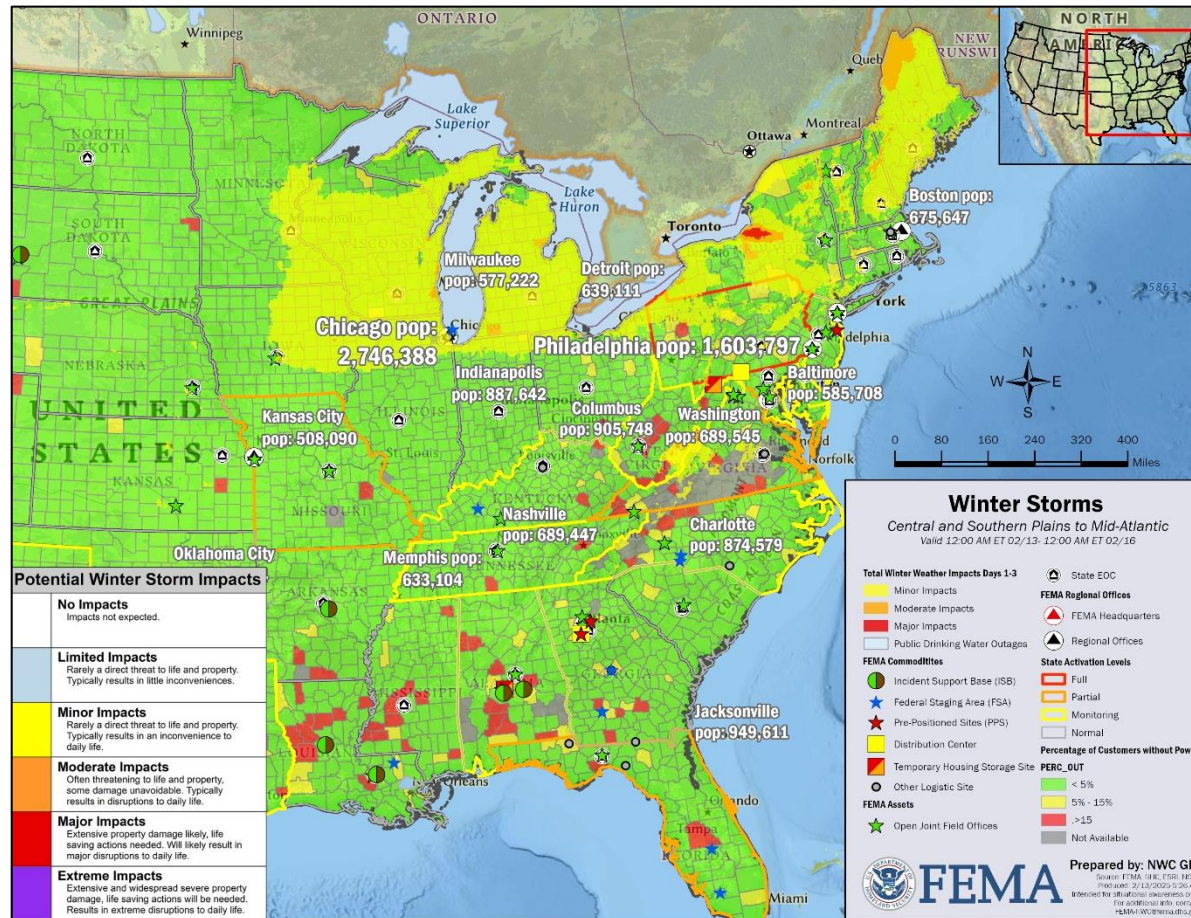
- DC, MD, WV, and DE SEOCs are Monitoring (Winter Storm)
- VA SEOC is at **Partial** (Winter Storm)
- PA SEOC is at Full Activation

**Region IV:** (Region IV DSAR, as of 2:19 p.m. ET)

- AL, NC, TN, KY SEOC is **Monitoring** (Winter Storm)

**Region VII:** (Region VII DSAR, as of 12:37 p.m. ET)

- MO SEOC is at **Partial** (Winter Storm)
  - MO Governor declared a State of Emergency on Feb 10 for winter storms
- KS Governor declared an Emergency Proclamation on Feb 9 for winter storms

Region II, III, IV, V, VI, VII Regional Watch Centers (RWCs) are Monitoring; Regional Response Coordination Centers (RRCCs) are Rostered

## FEMA HQ Response:

NWC is monitoring; NRCC is at Steady State

## Federal Response:

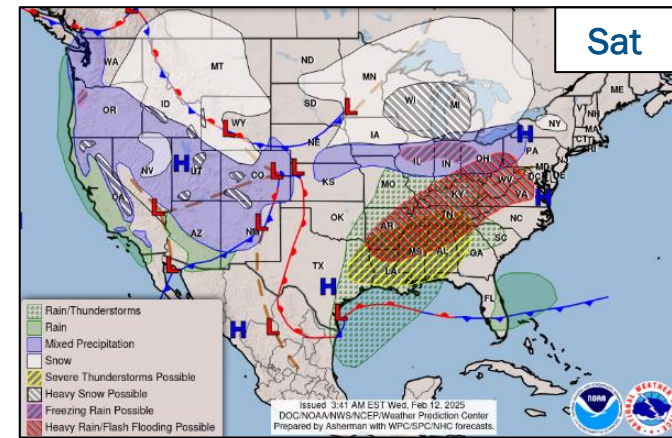
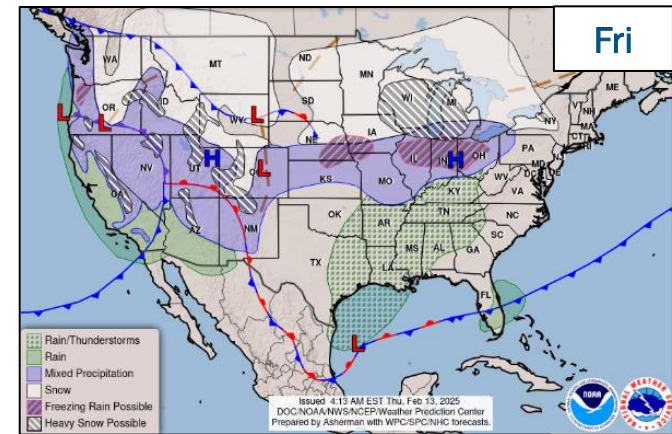
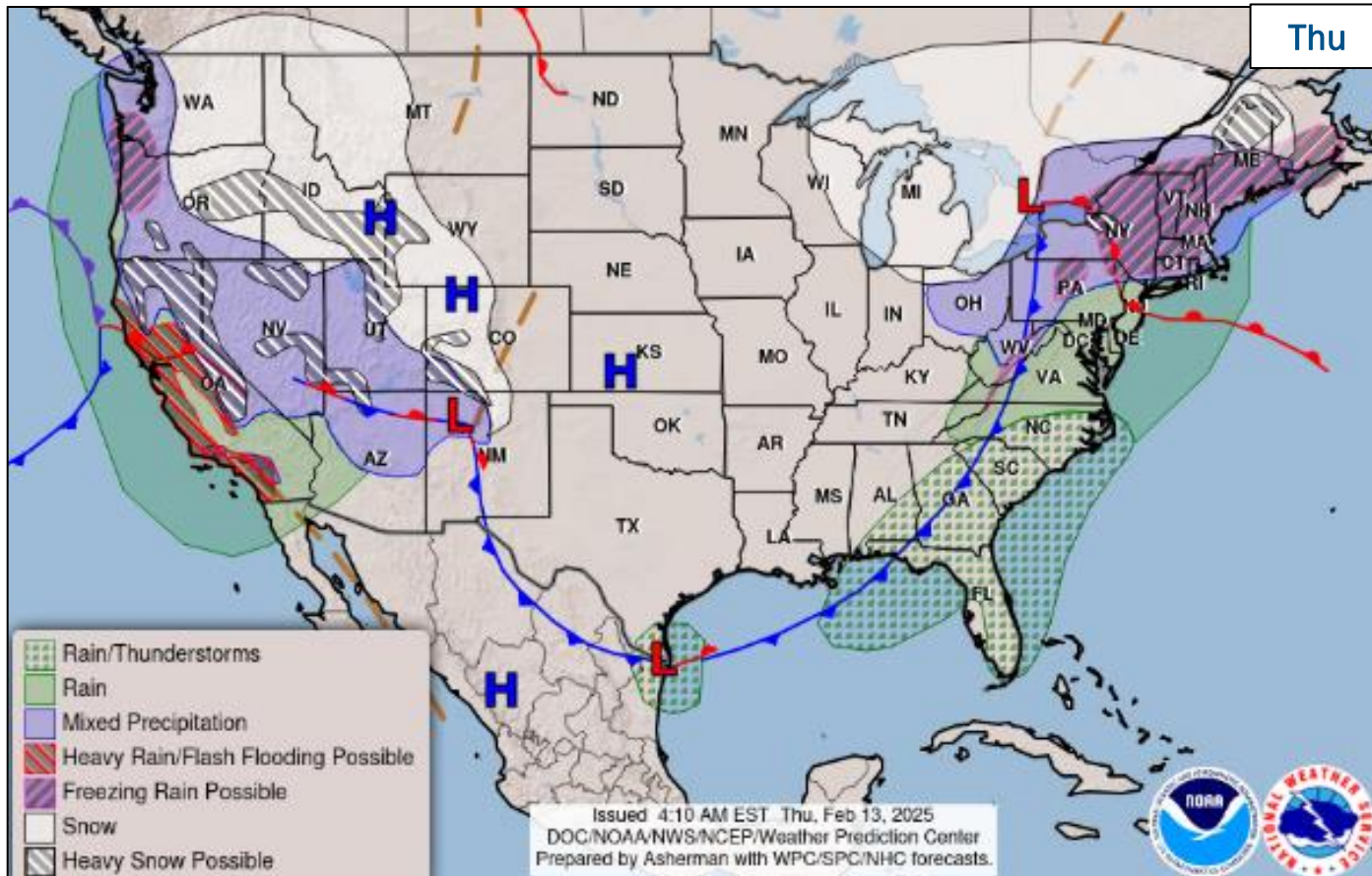

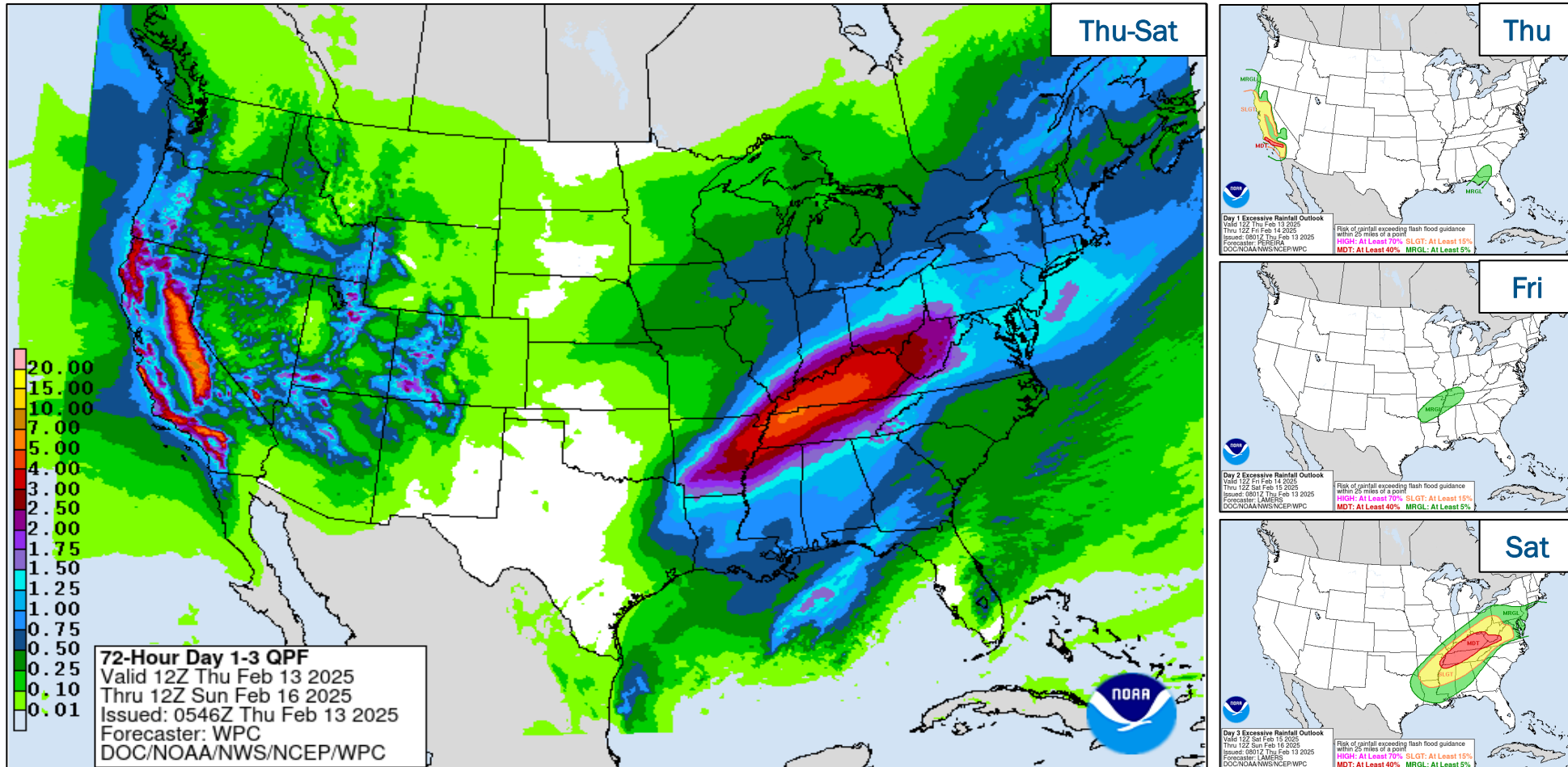
# National Weather Forecast

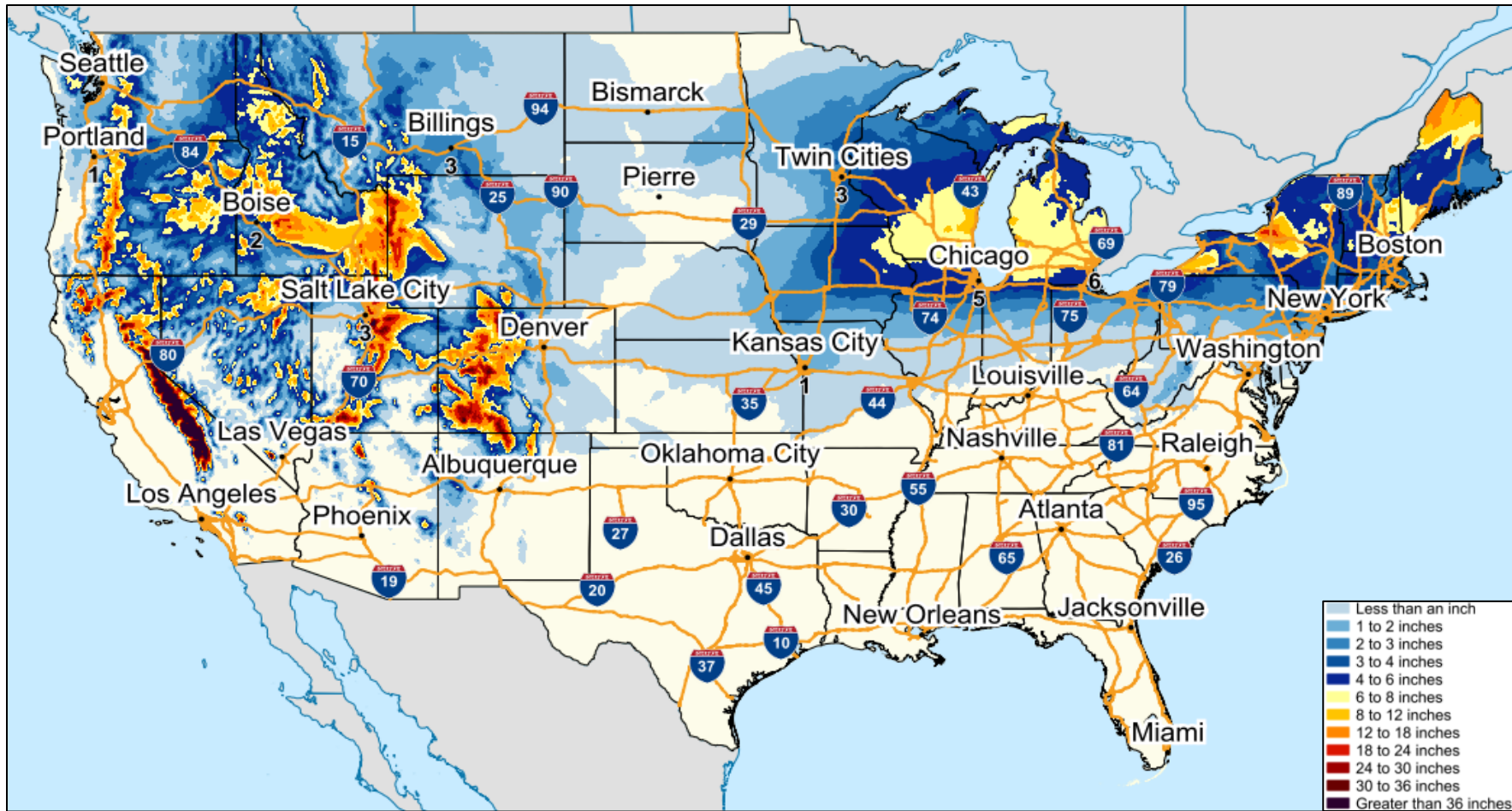
# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

# Snowfall Forecast



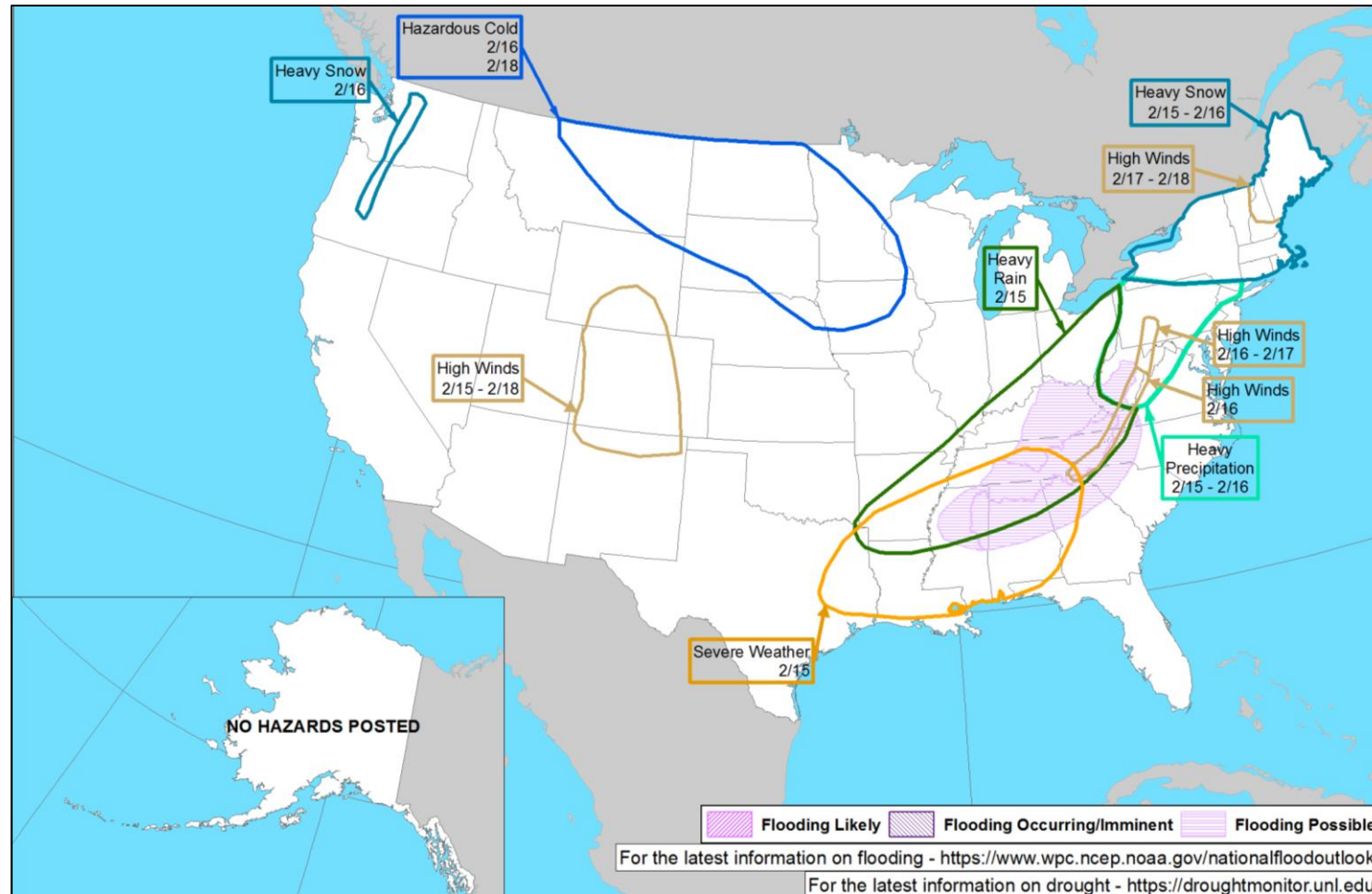

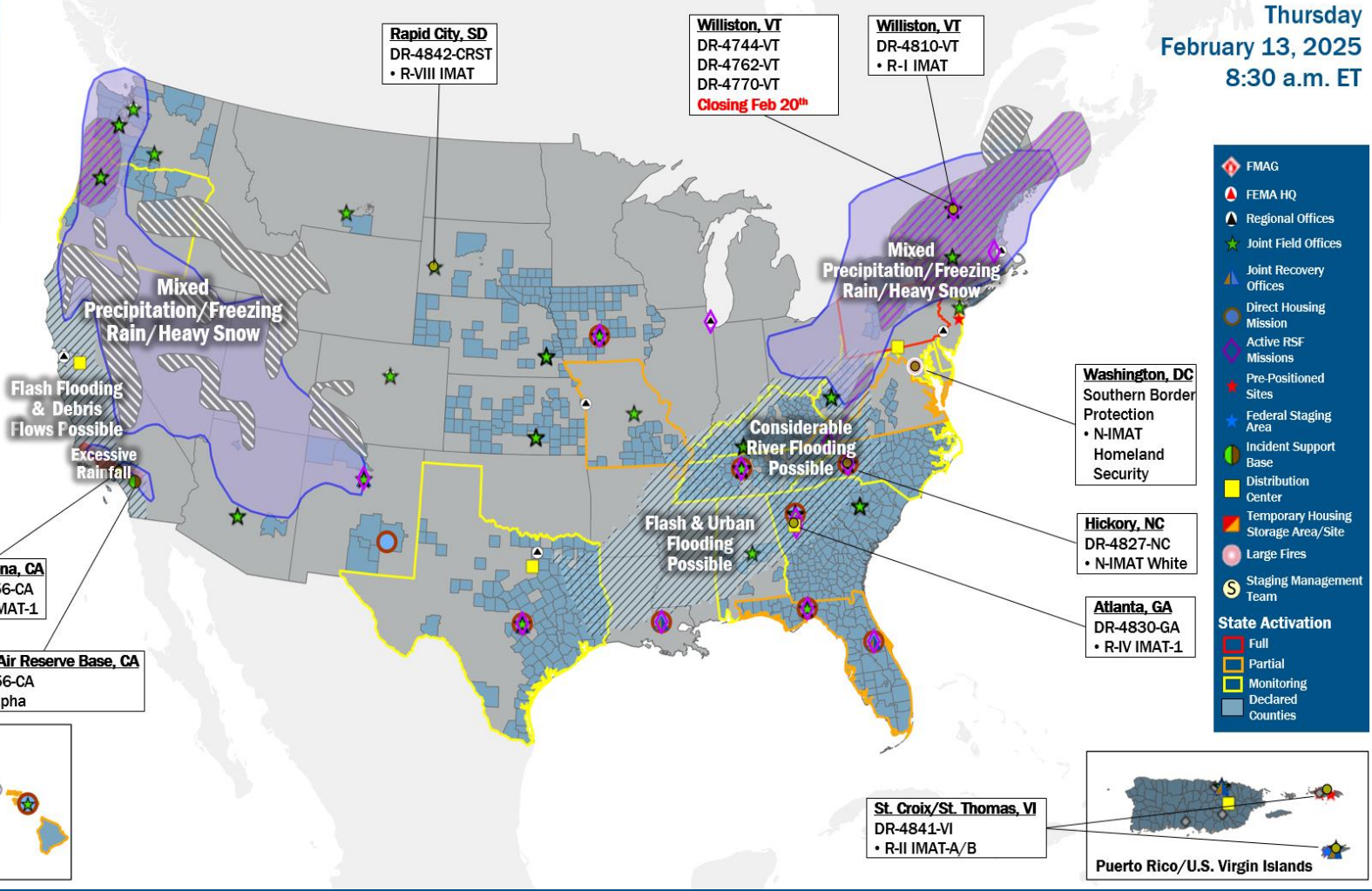
