





- Region V RWC is monitoring; RRCC at Level III (COVID-19)
 - IL EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); IN, and OH EOCs at Normal Operations
- Region VI is monitoring; IMAT-1 deployed to AR; IMAT-2 deployed to NM
 - o TX EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); AR, LA, and OK EOCs at Normal Operations
- Region VII RWC is monitoring
 - MO EOC at Partial Activation (Winter Storm and Severe Weather)
- NWC and FEMA LNO to the SPC are monitoring; NRCC at Level III (COVID-19)






National Weather Forecast










Hazards Outlook - Feb 20 - 24




