Atmospheric River - California

<u>Situation:</u> A Moderate Risk for excessive rainfall over southern California continues today along portions of coastal southern California; heavy rain and heavy mountain snow are expected to become less intense. The potential for flooding of roadways, mudslides, landslides, rockslides, and debris flow exists; however, the riverine flood threat remains limited. All Flash Flood Warnings have been replaced by Flood Advisories for Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, and Ventura counties.








National Weather Forecast
