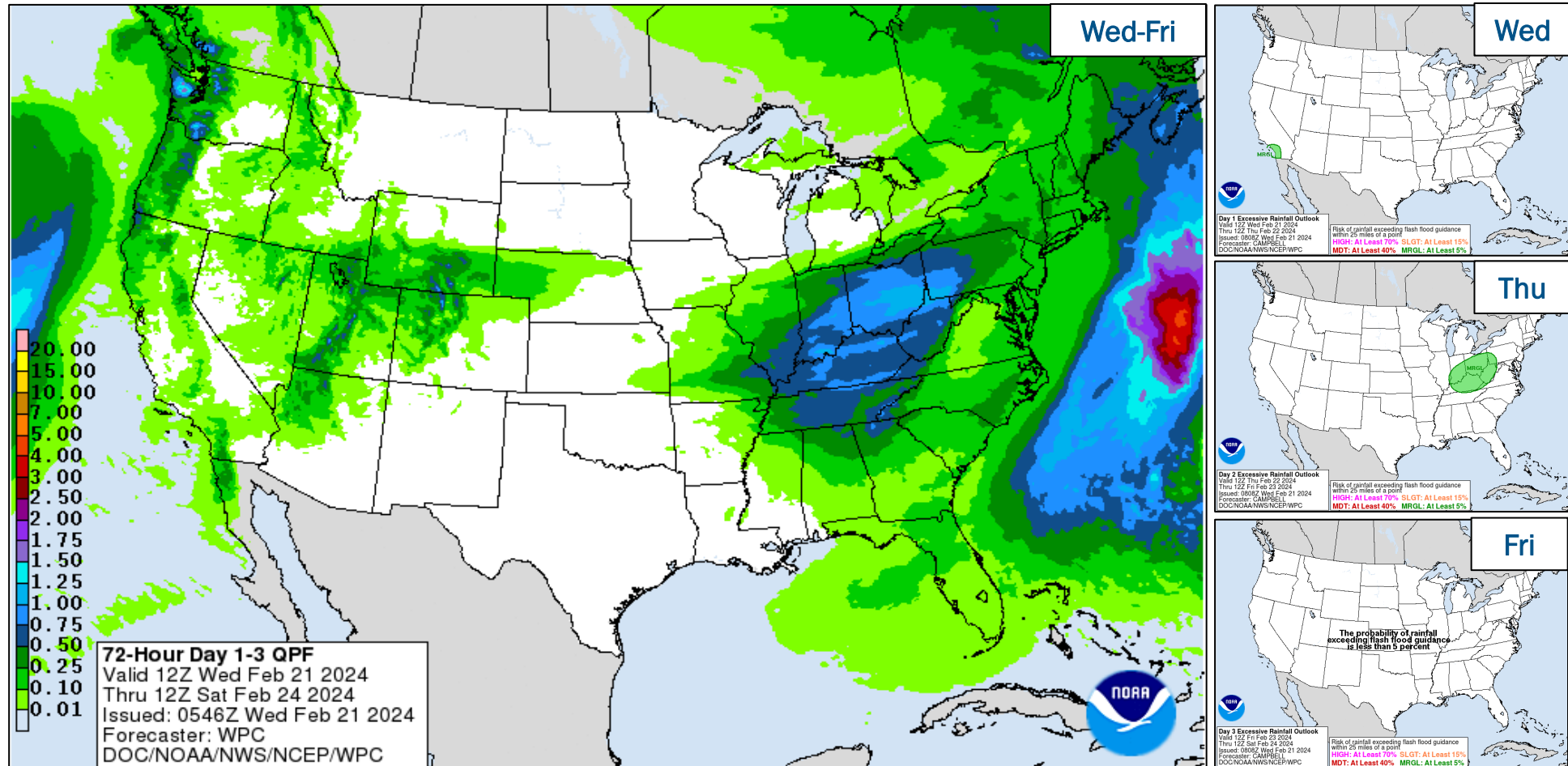

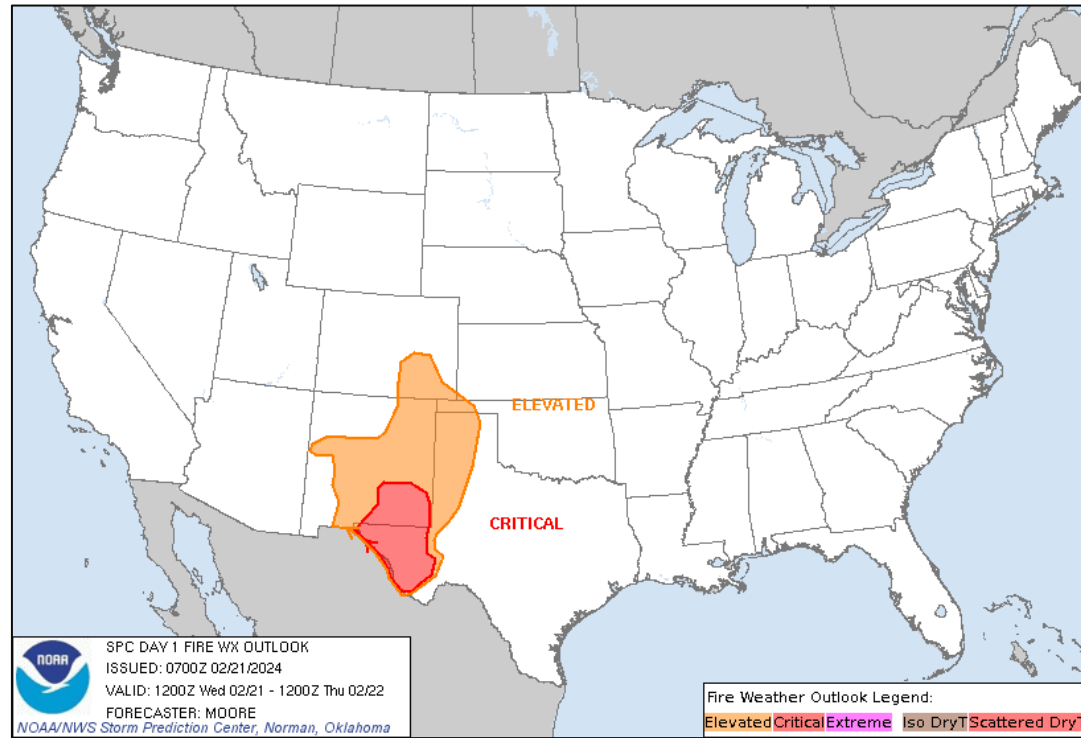
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



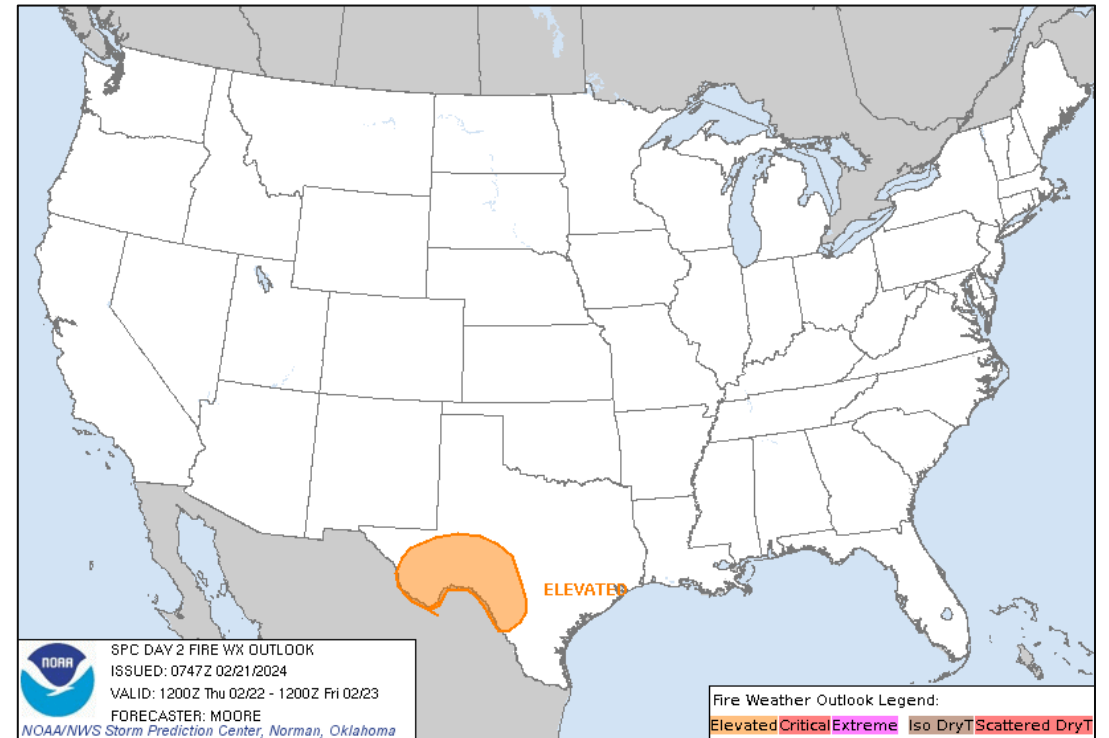

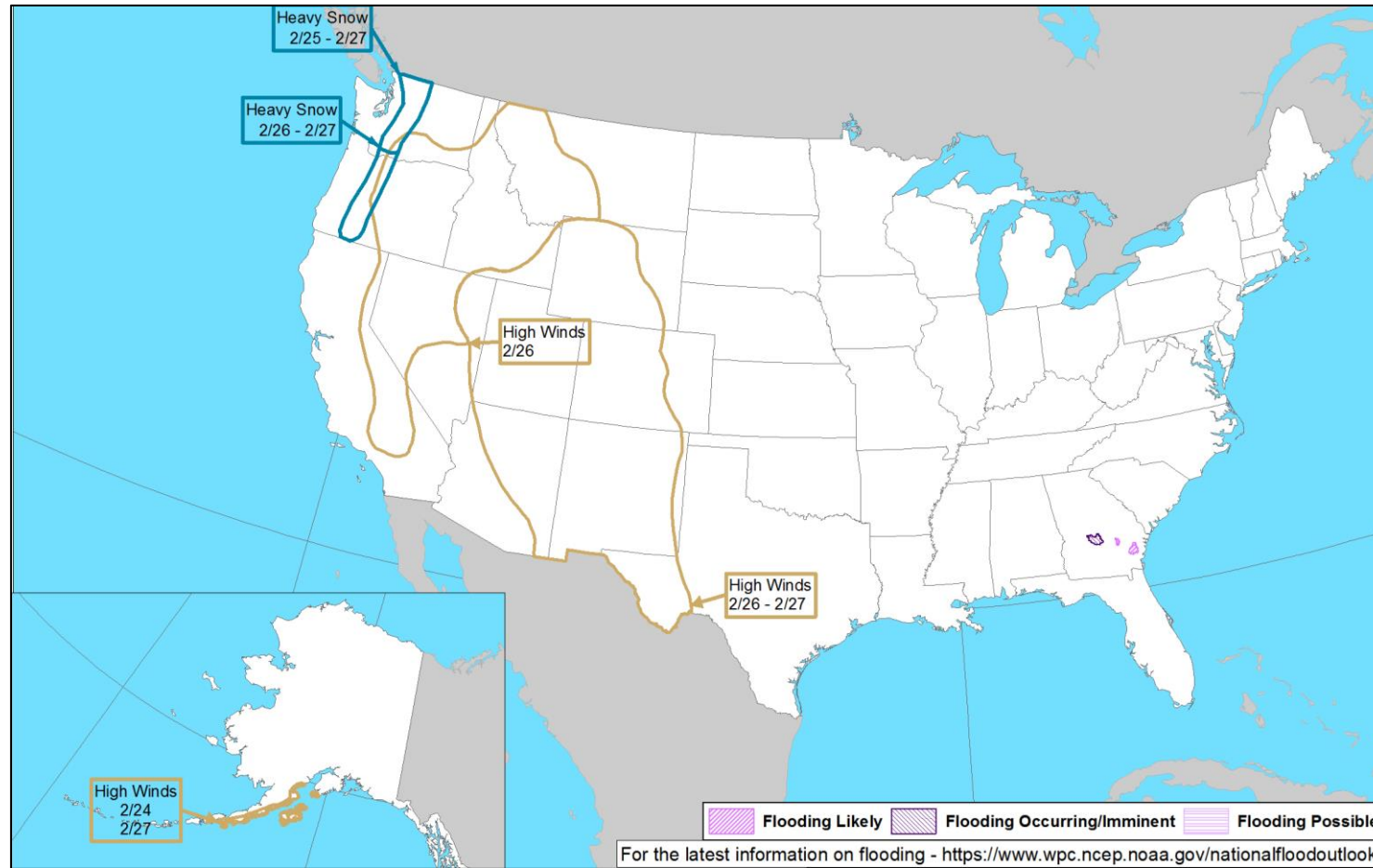
