- Heavy rain and flash flooding – Middle Mississippi, Tennessee, and Ohio valleys and Southern/Central Appalachians
- Severe thunderstorms – Lower/Middle Mississippi valleys to Tennessee and Ohio valleys
- Heavy snow – Upper Mississippi Valley
- Freezing rain – Middle/Upper Mississippi valleys to Northeast

# Severe Weather Outlook

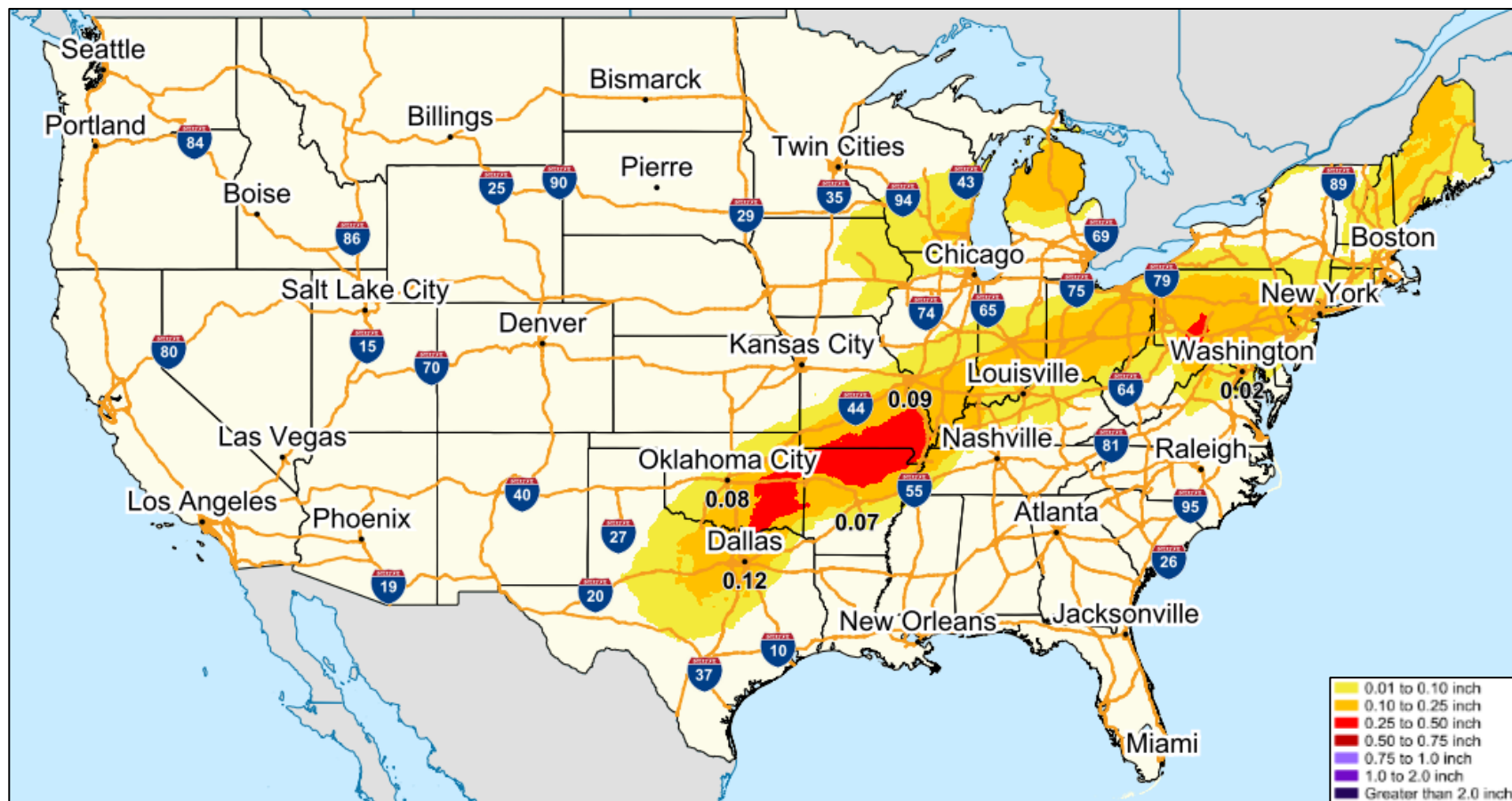

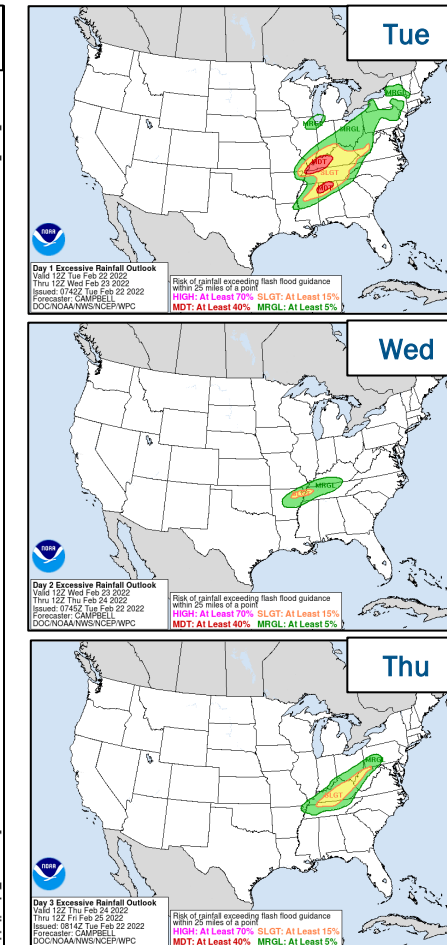
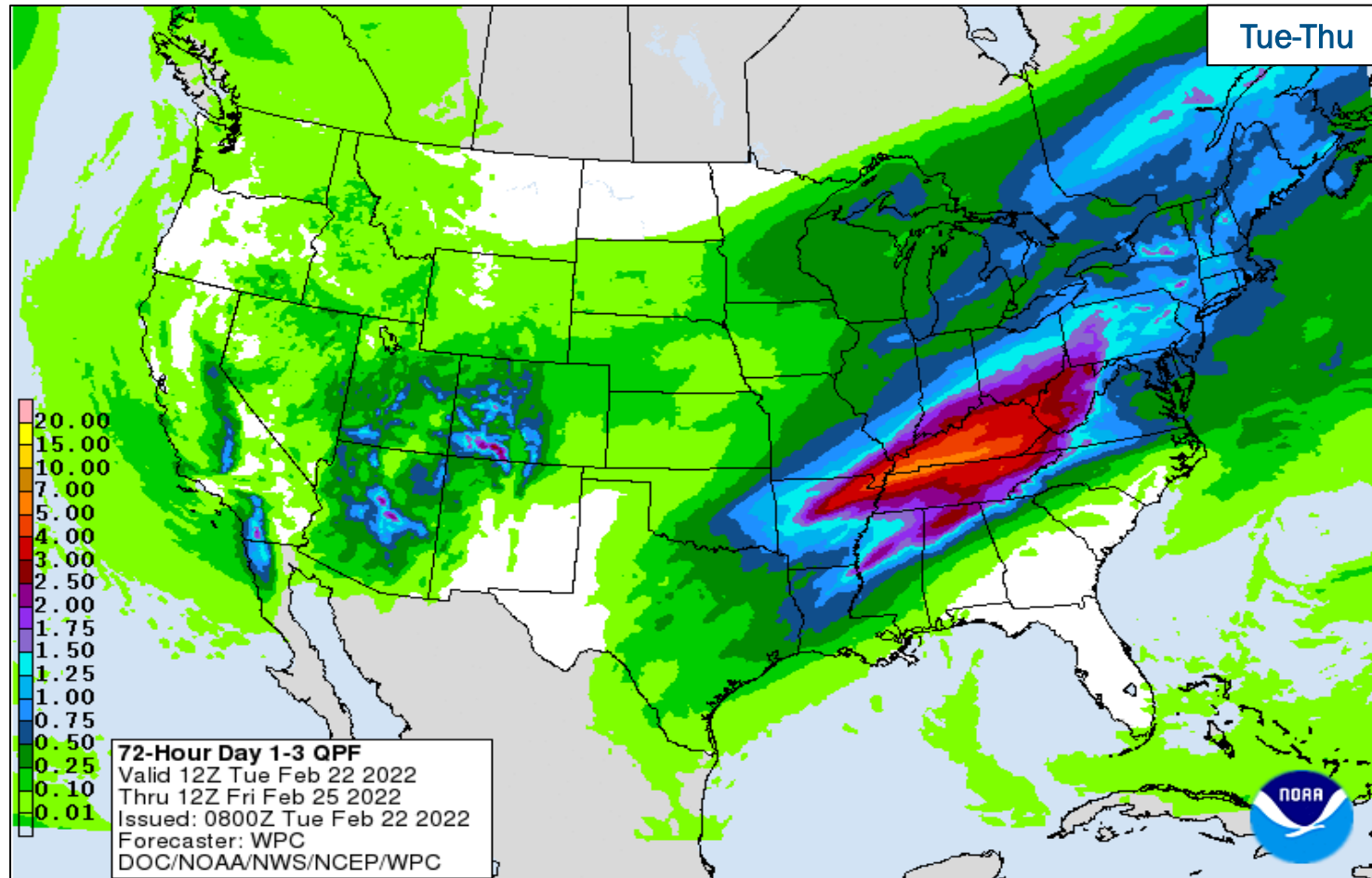


# Ice Accumulation Forecast

# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

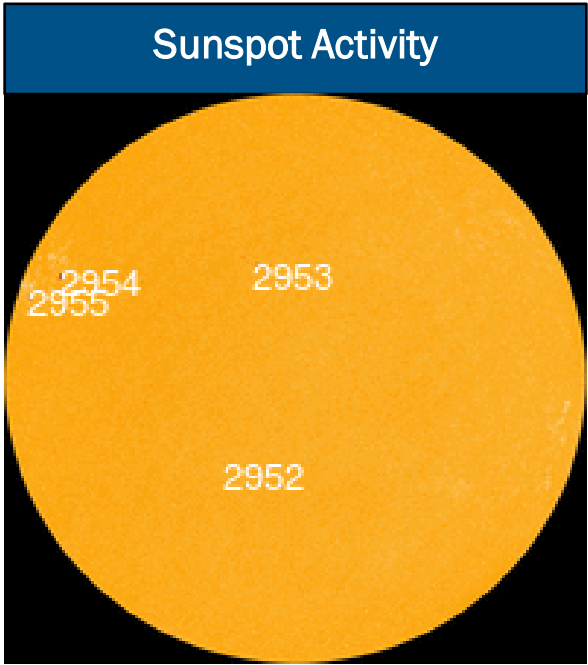
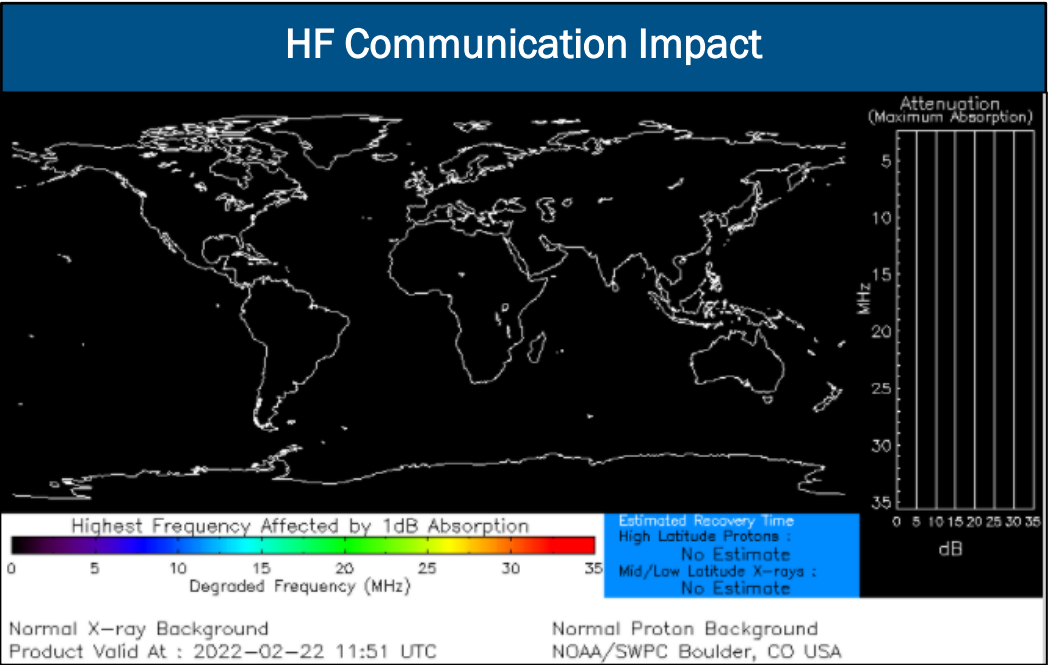

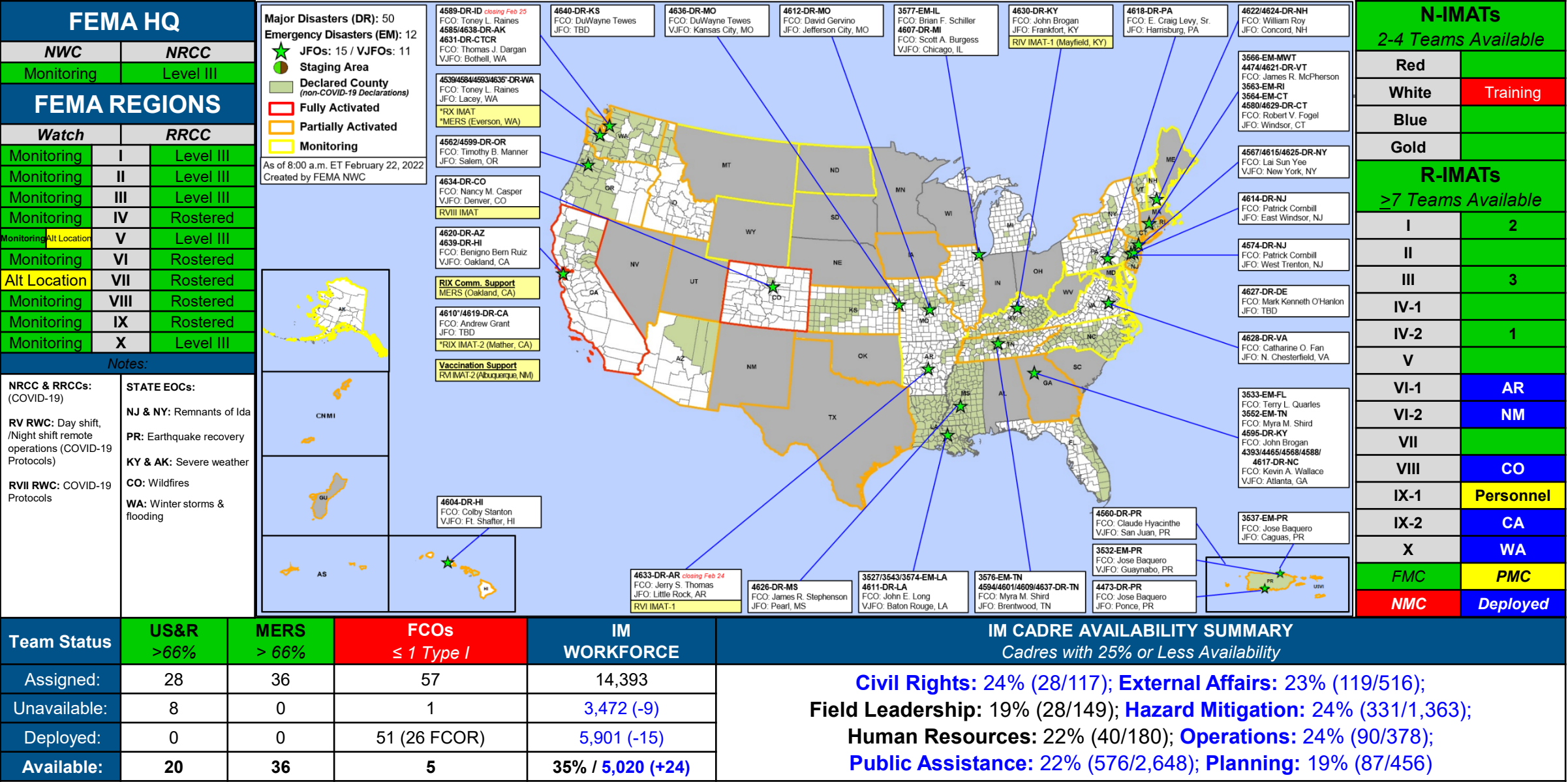

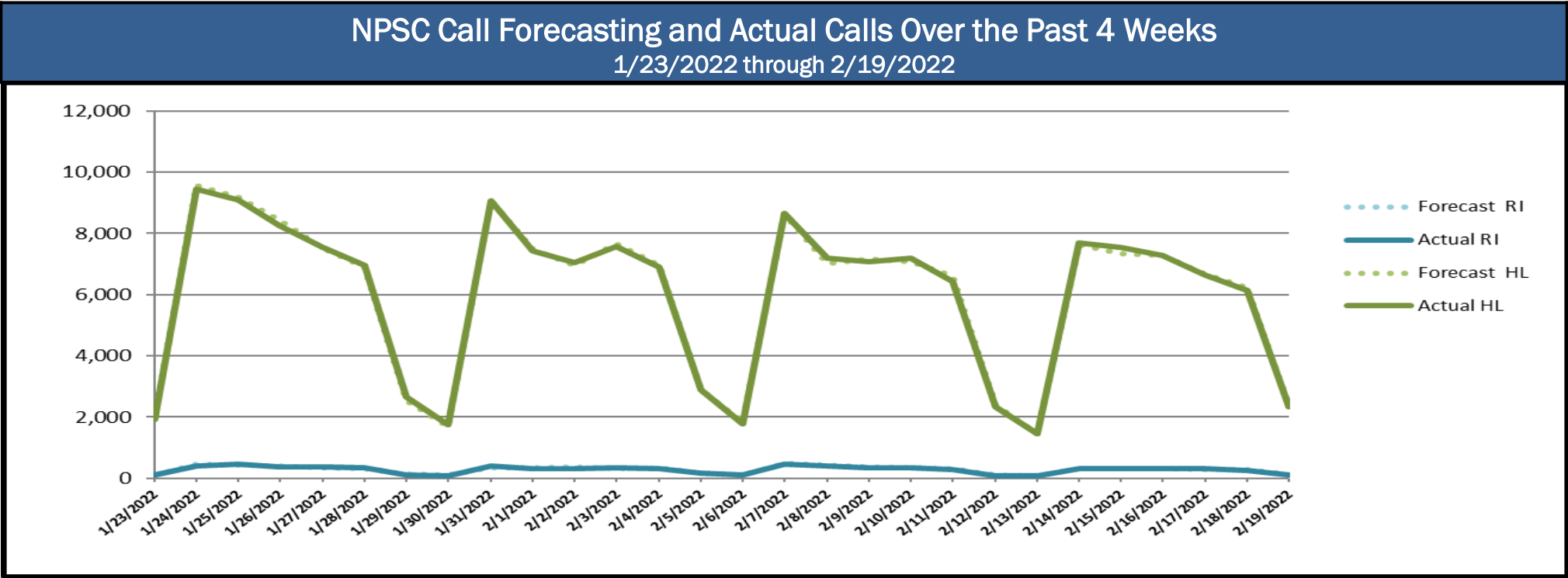

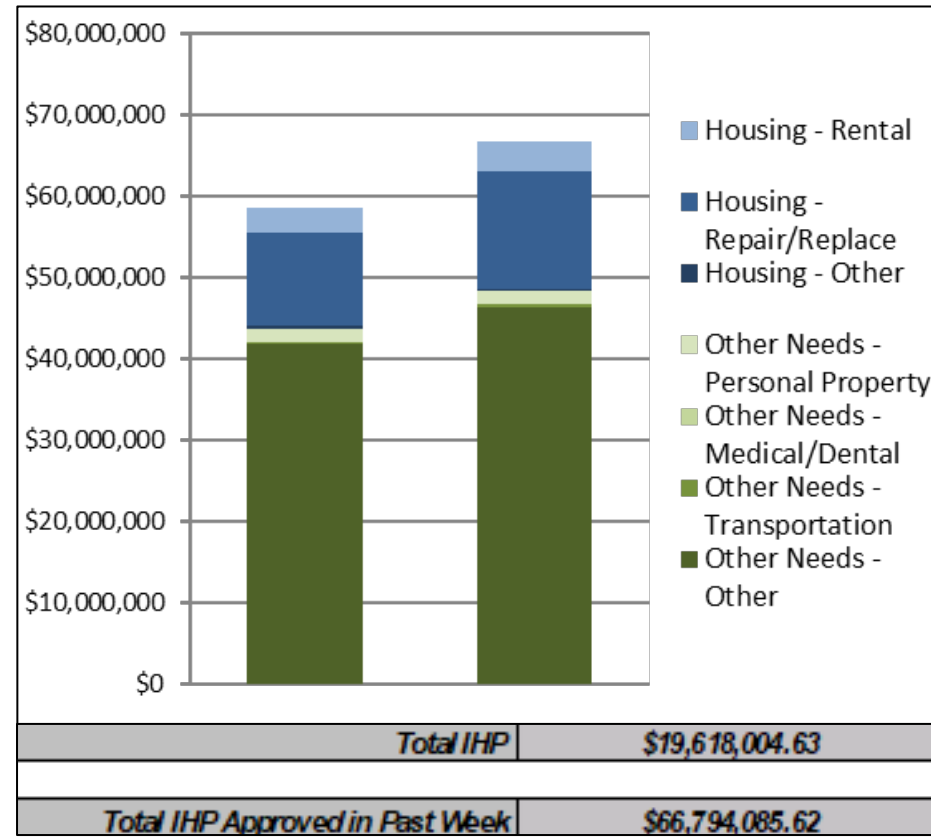
