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Situation

Tropical Cyclone 18P (Wasi) *(as of 4:00 a.m. ET)*

- 188 miles S of Pago Pago, American Samoa
- Moving SSE at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 46 mph
- Flash Flood Watch in effect
- No request for FEMA assistance

- 7 (-5) shelters open; 270 (-124) occupants *(ARC Midnight Shelter Count)*

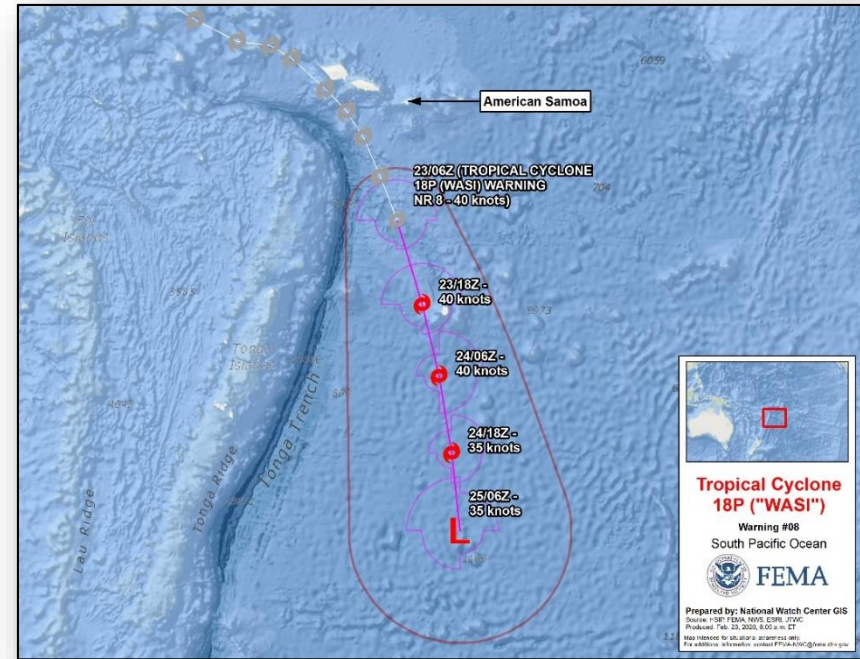
Transportation: Seaport and airport reopened

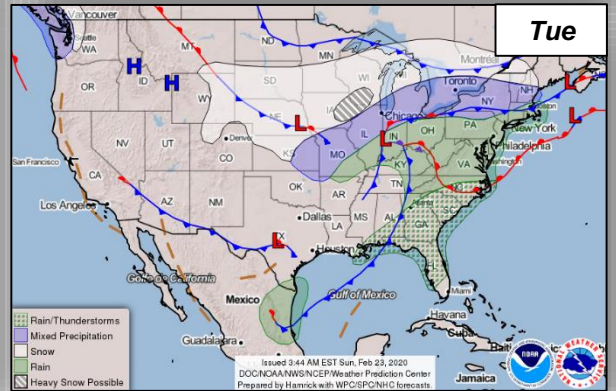
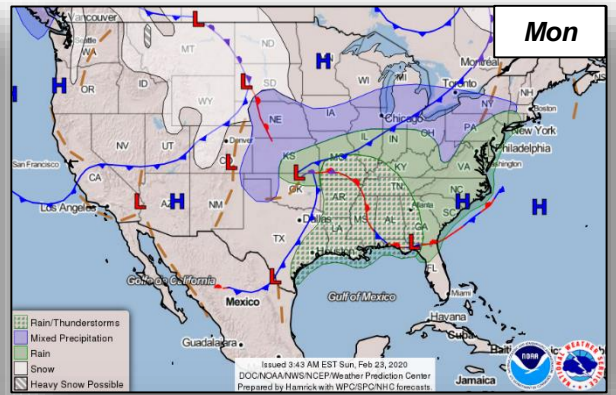
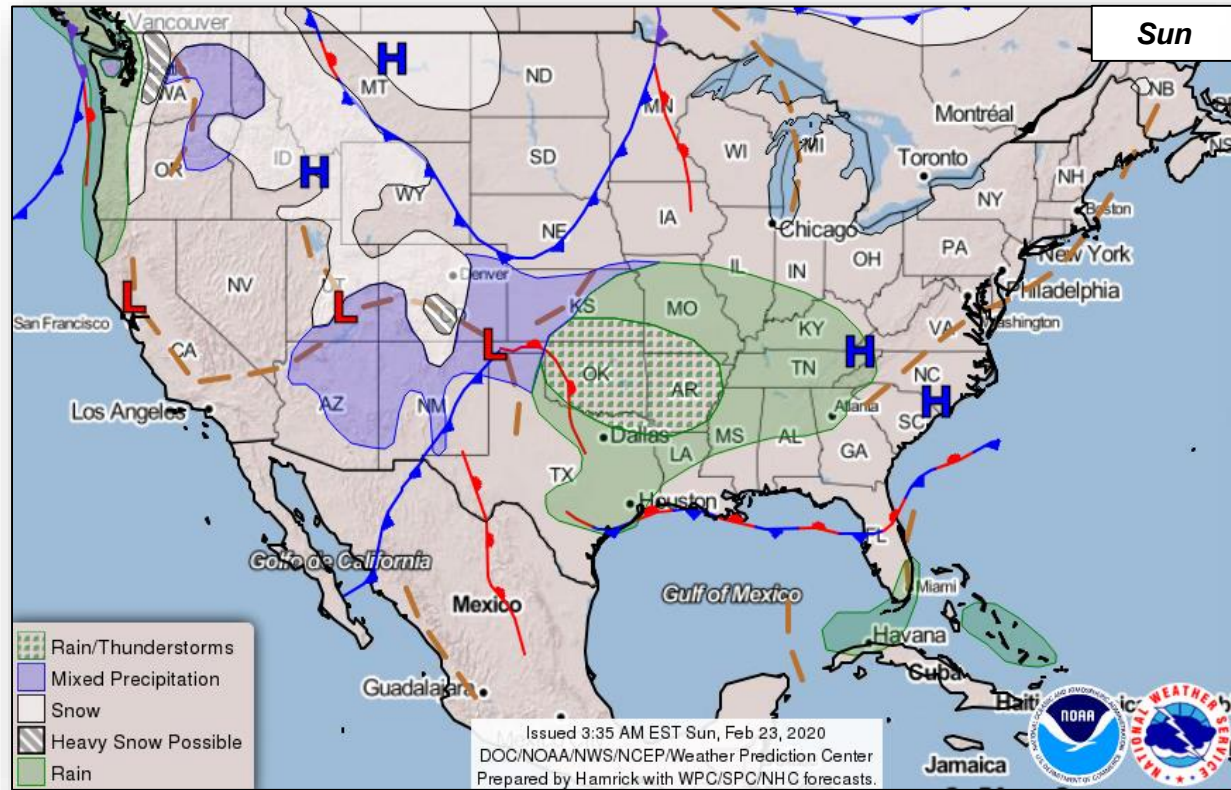
- American Samoa EOC at Full Activation (already activated for measles outbreak)

- NWC and Region IX RWC at Steady State; continuing to monitor



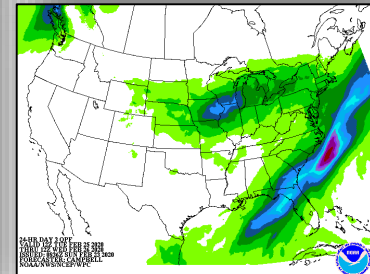
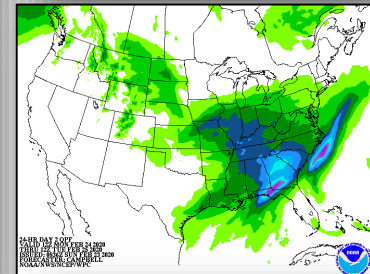
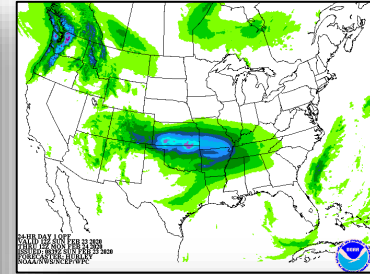
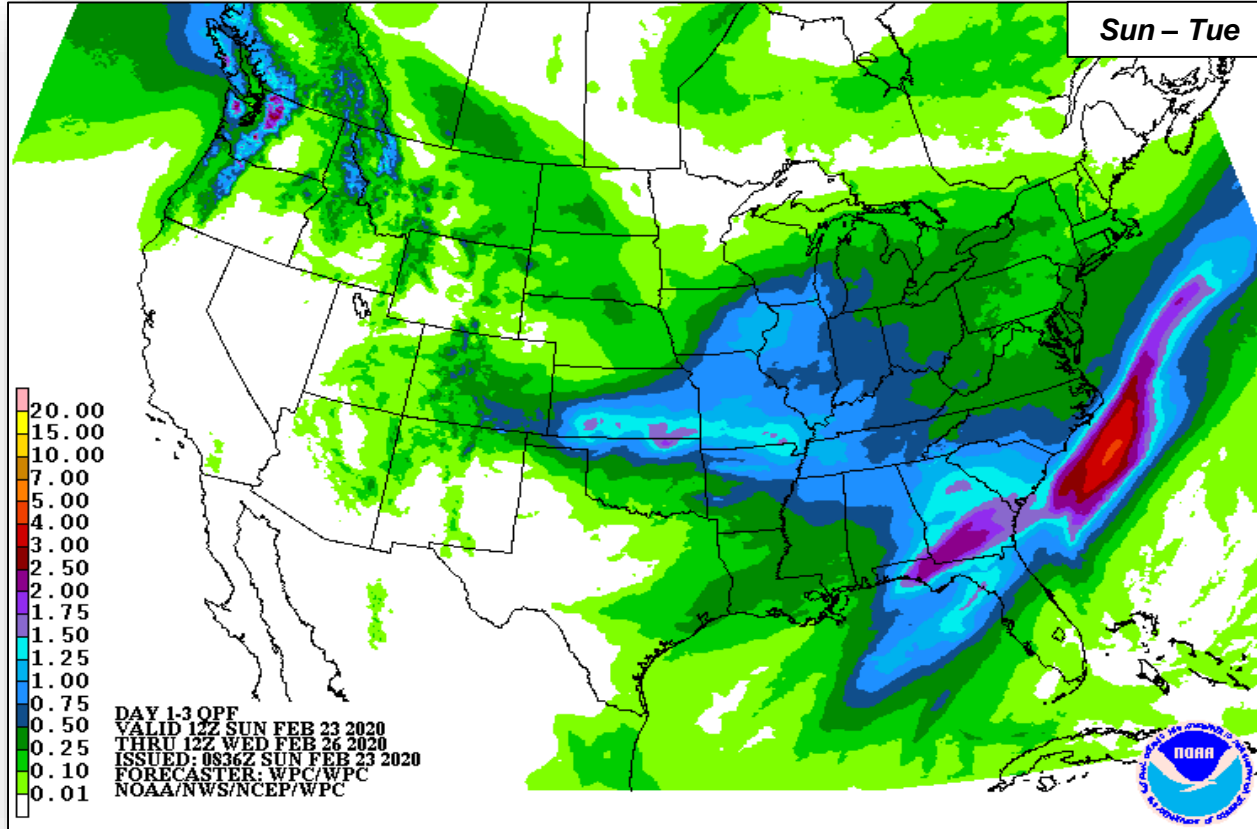
National Weather Forecast



Precipitation



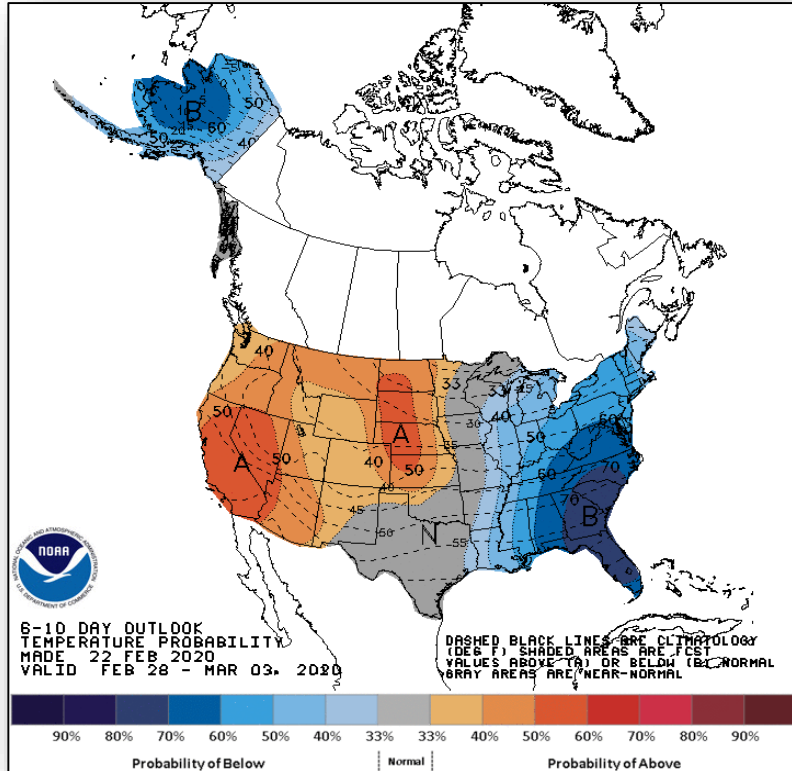
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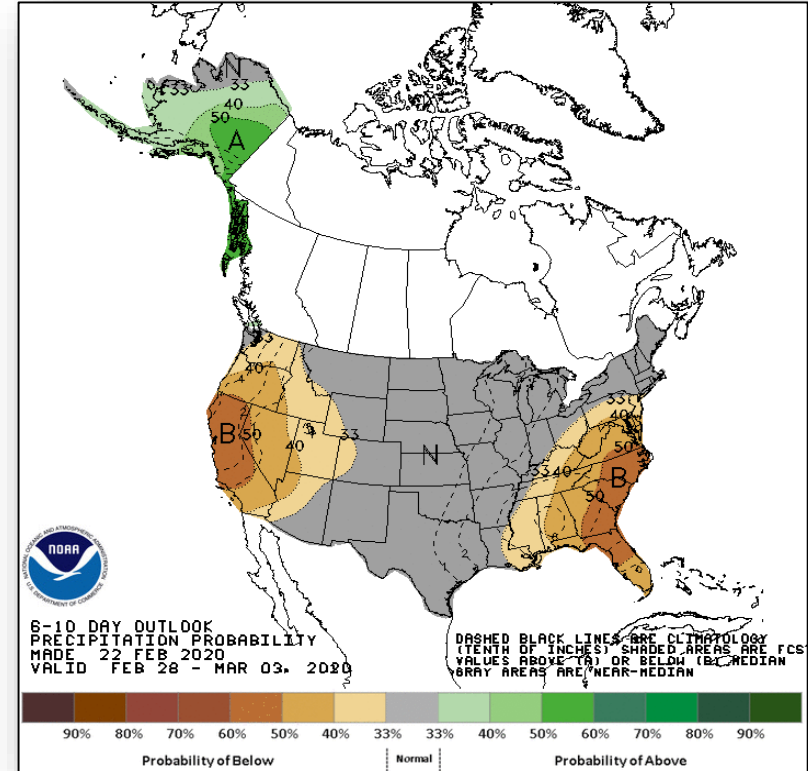
Long Range Outlooks – Feb 28-Mar 3

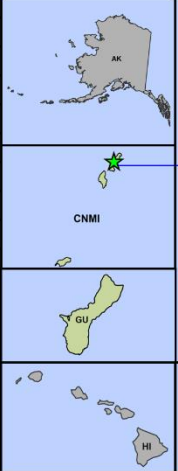
