# Severe Weather Outlook

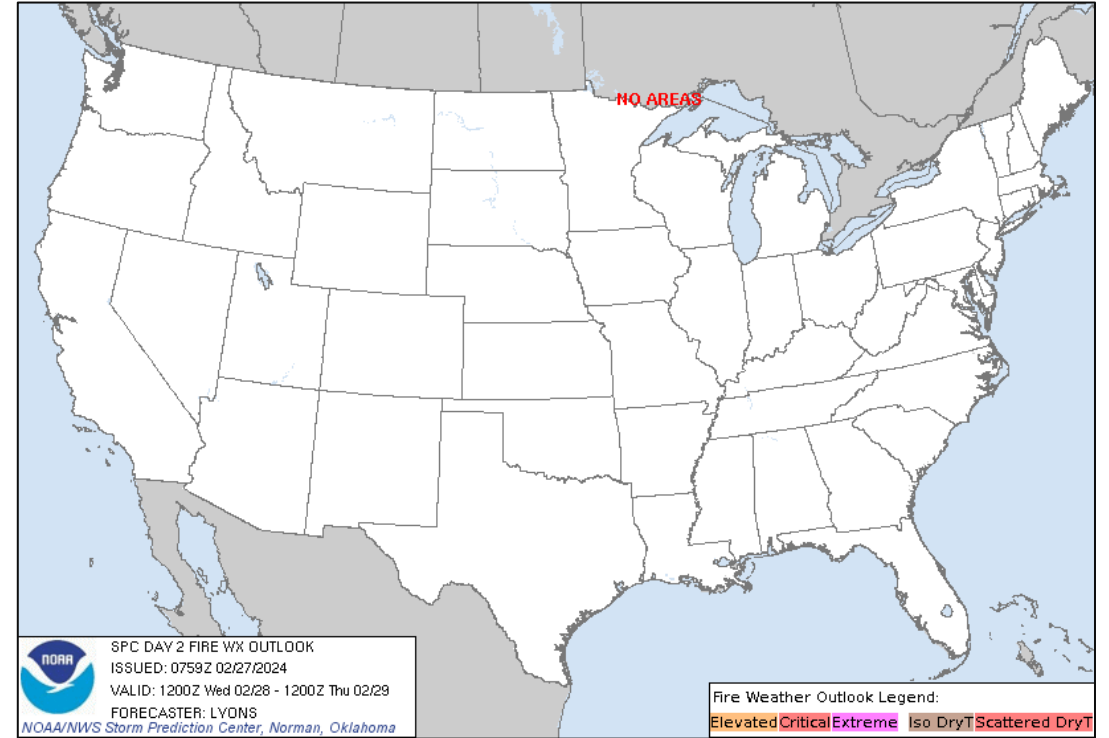

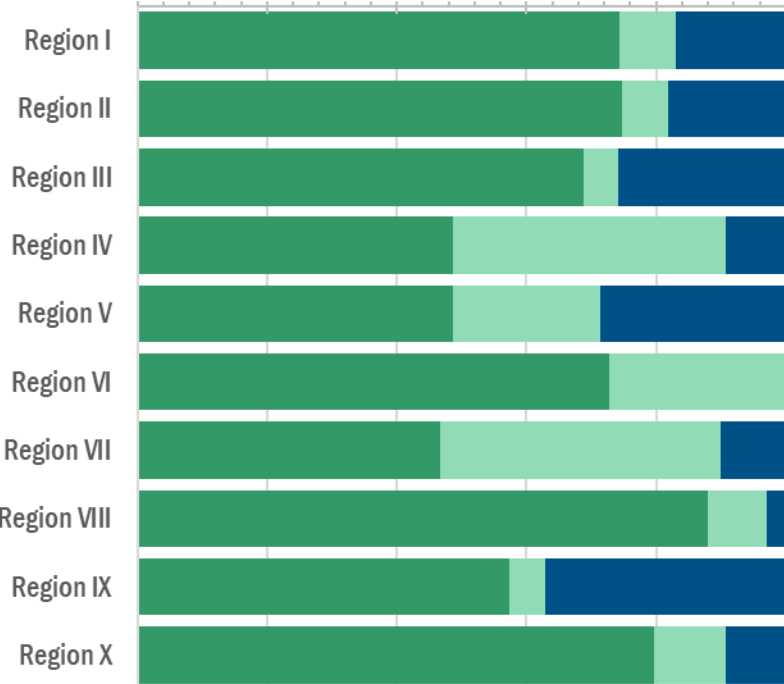

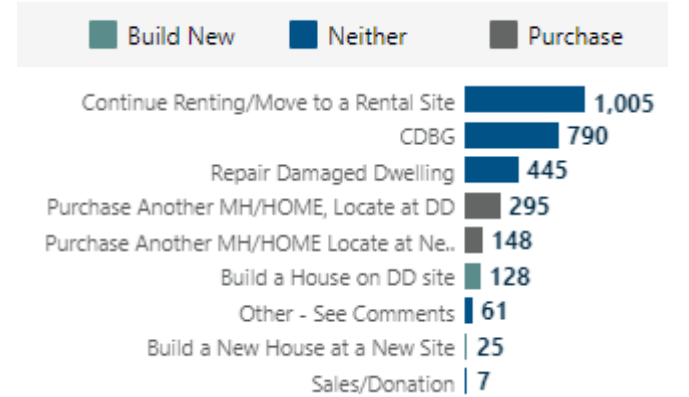
