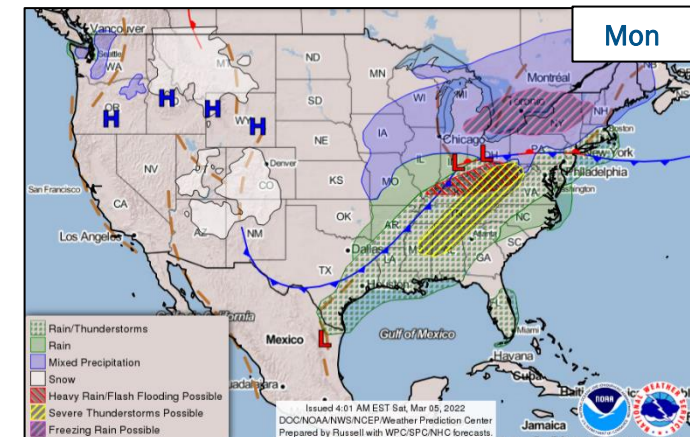
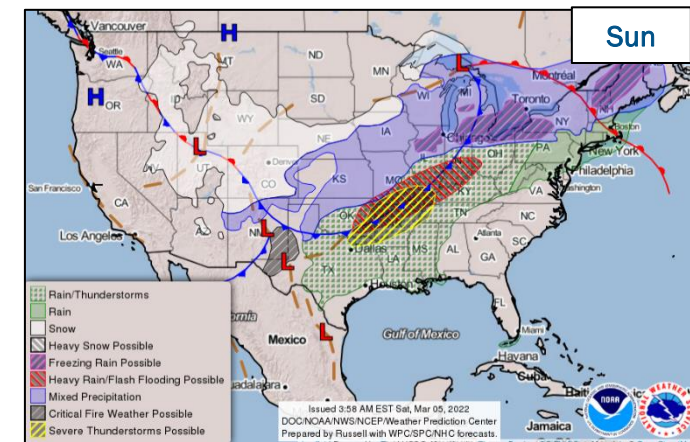
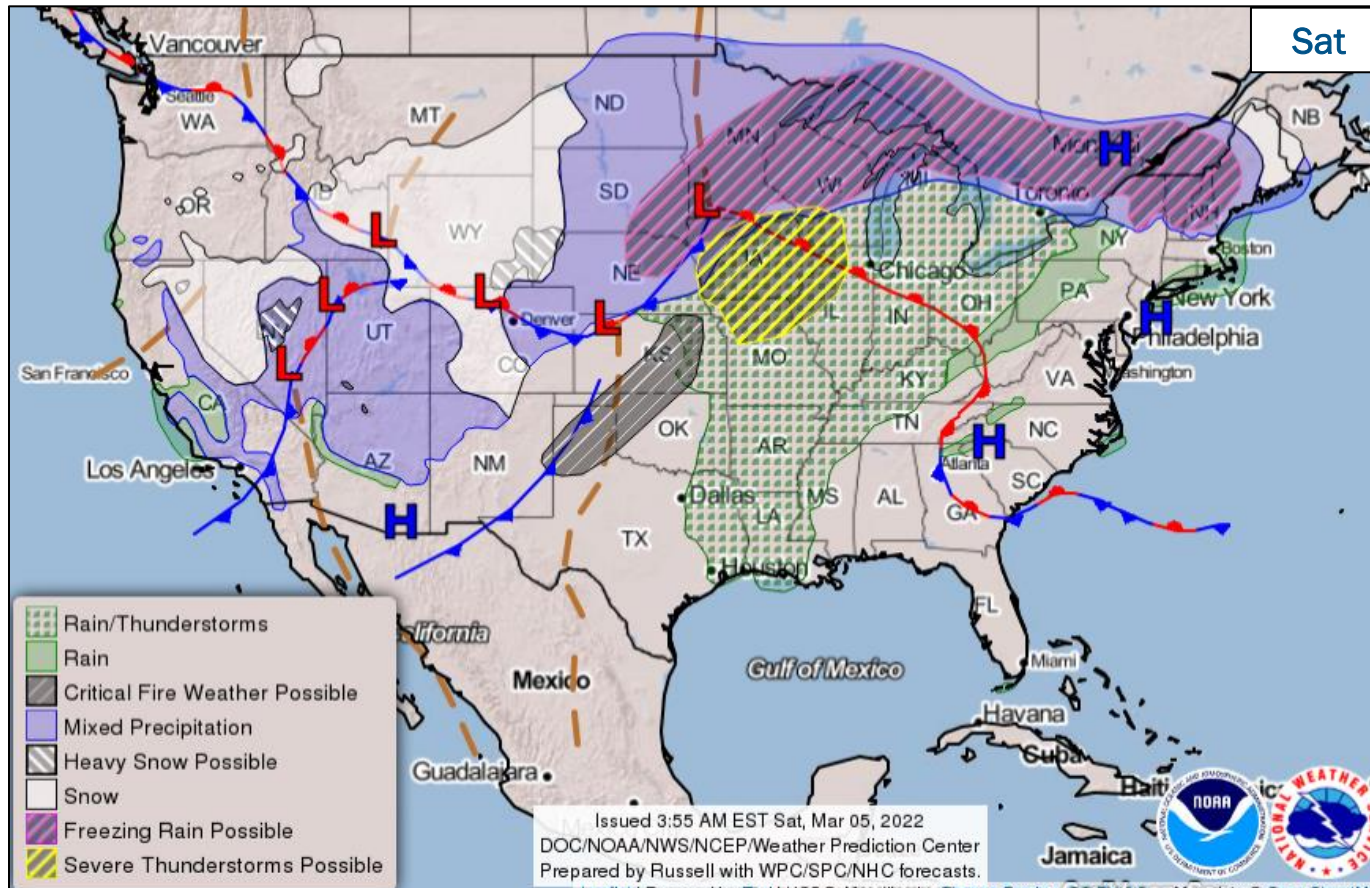
- The fire began on March 4, 2022, and is burning on state and private land in and around Panama City, Bay County (pop 174,705), FL
- 1,000 homes (71% are primary residences), 6 commercial/residential structures, local roads and bridges, 4 fire/medial infrastructures, a utility substation, 15 industrial businesses, wildlife, environmental and cultural resources threatened
- Mandatory evacuations in effect for 2,500 people
- 1 shelter open with 7 occupants (*ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 6:47 a.m. ET*)

Response:

- FMAG approved March 5, 2022
- FL EOC at Normal Operations
- Region IV RWC and NWC continue to monitor



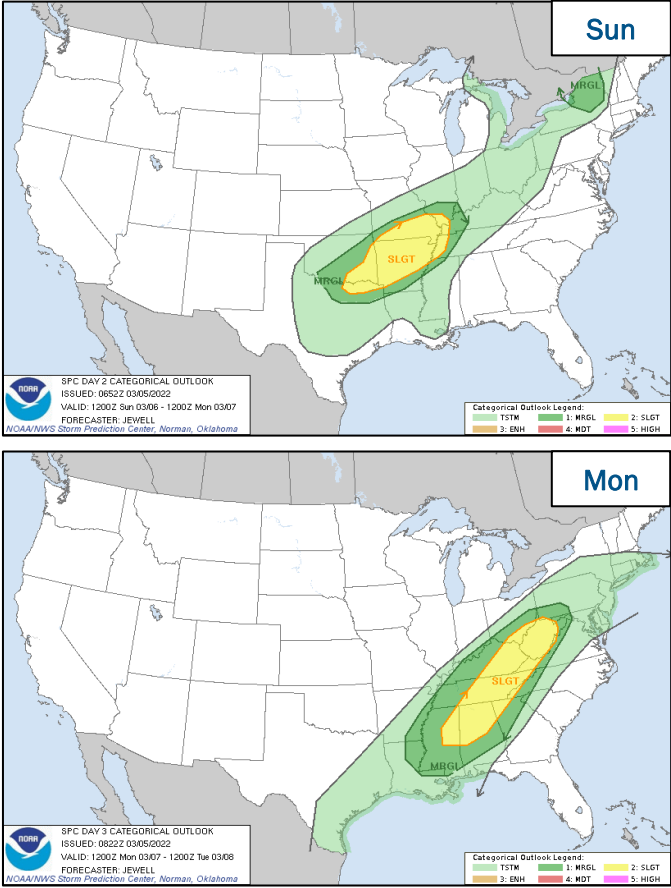
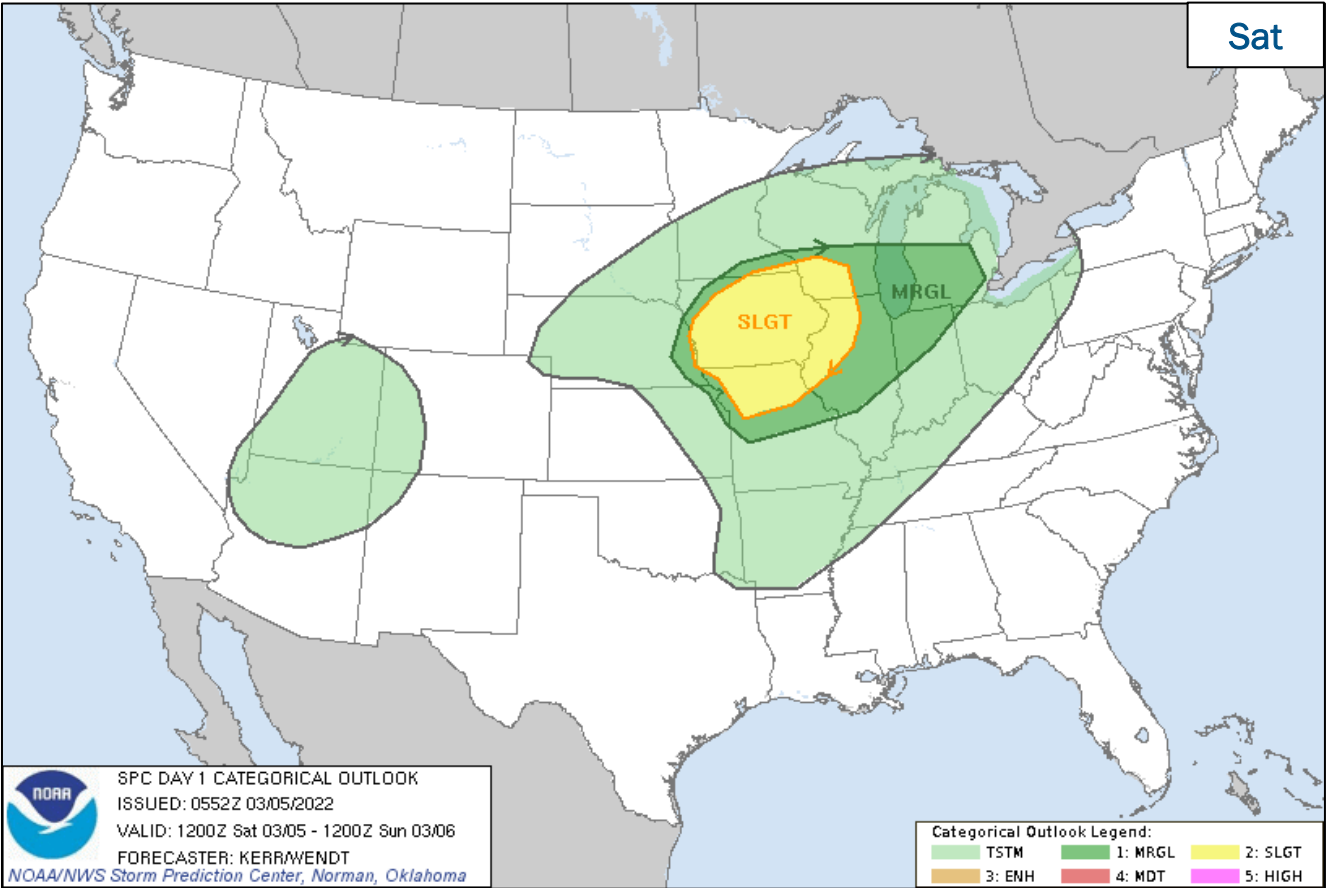

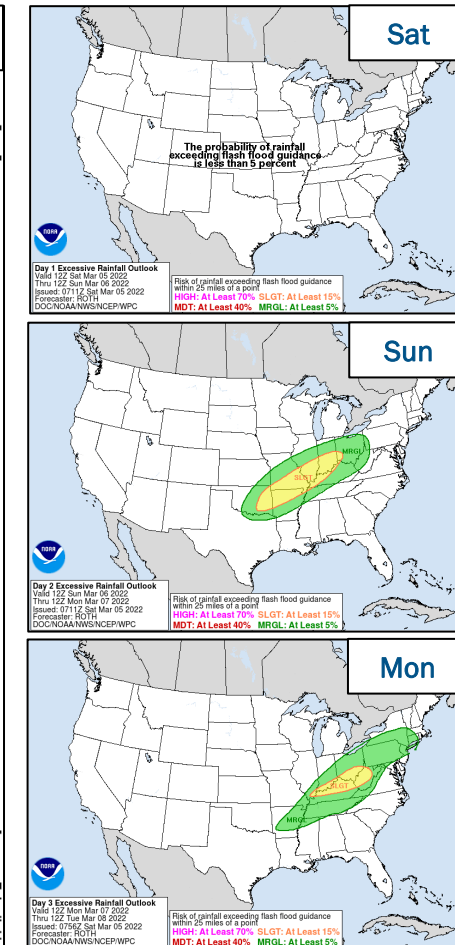
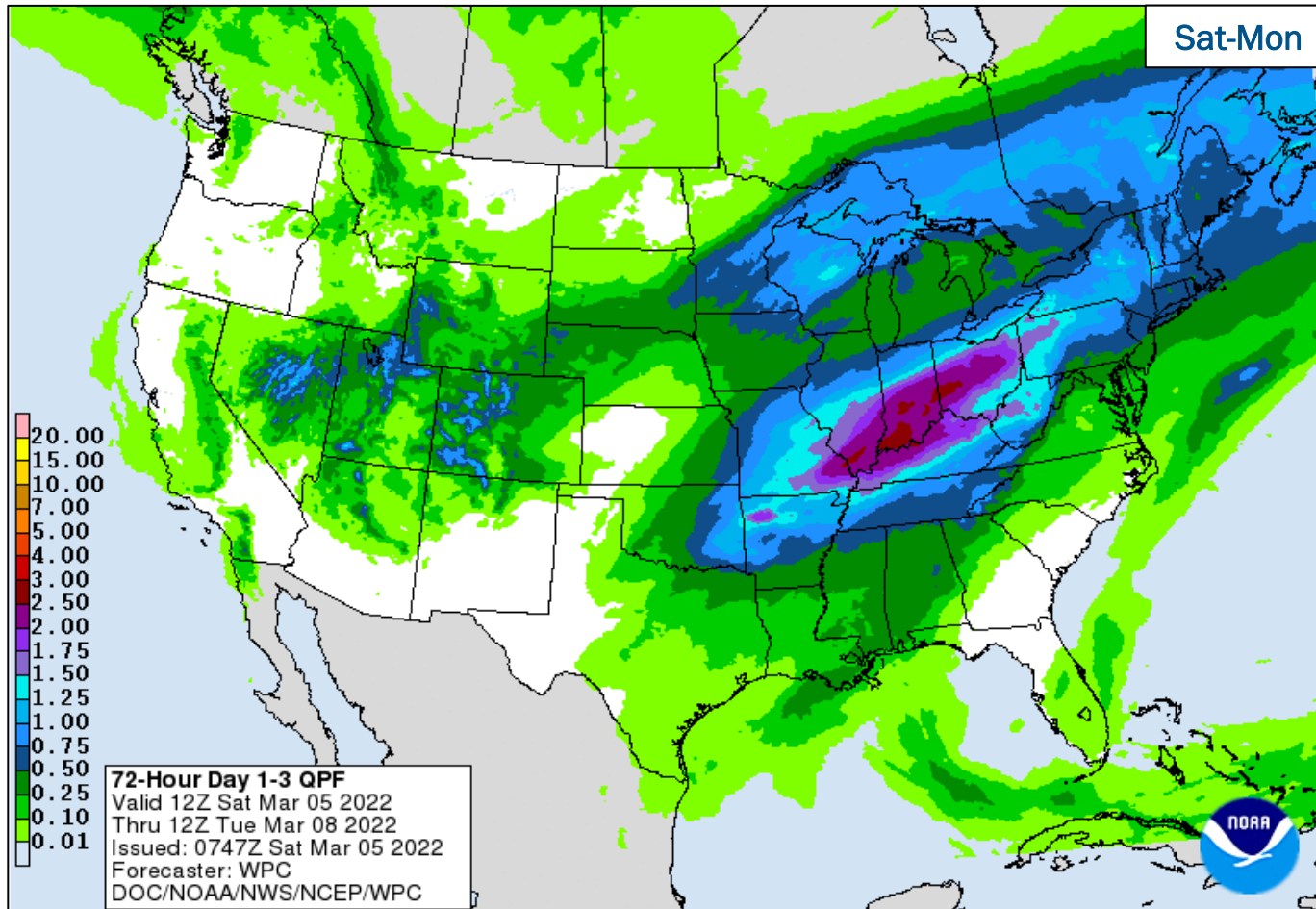
Severe Weather Outlook

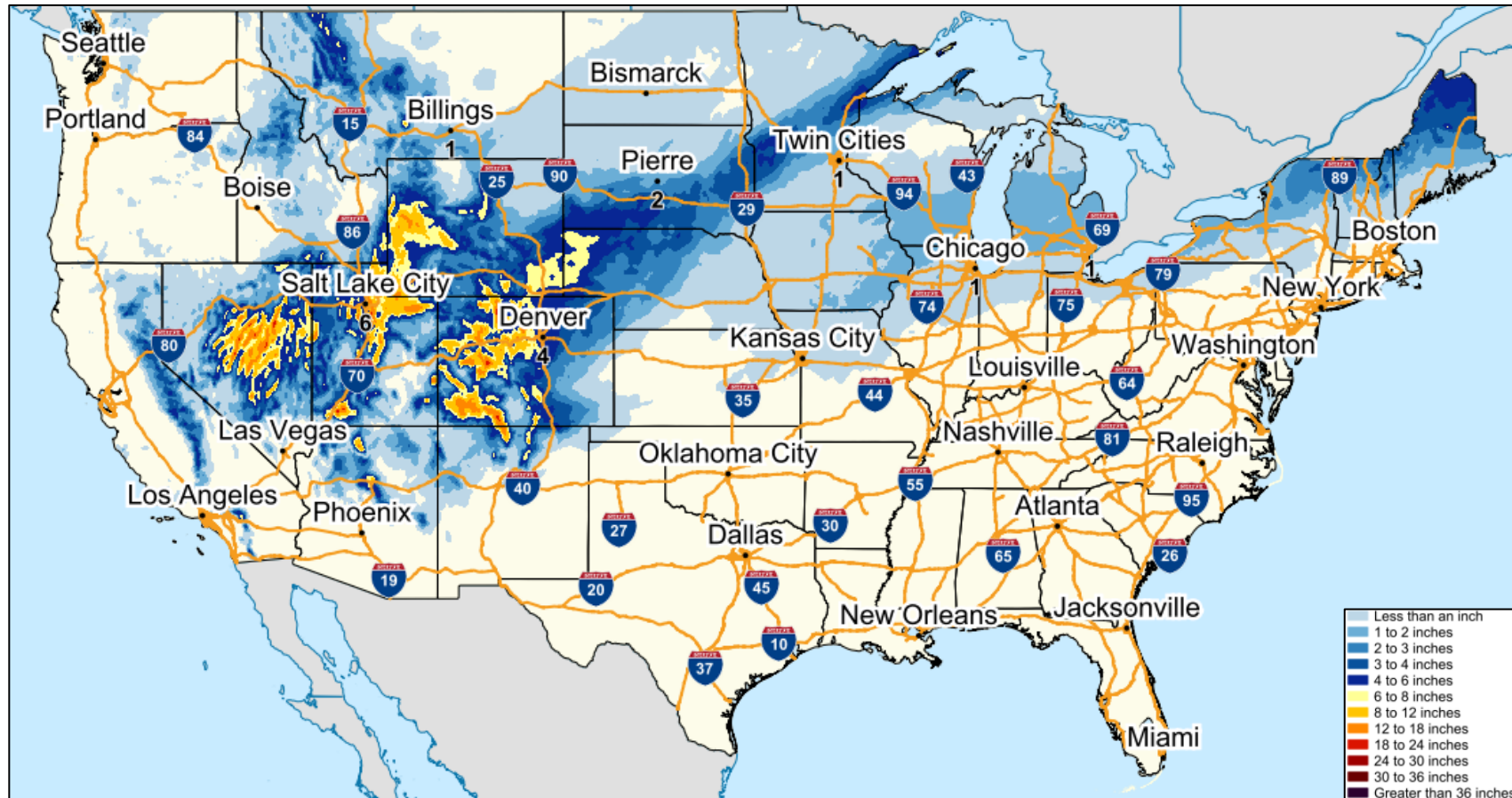
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

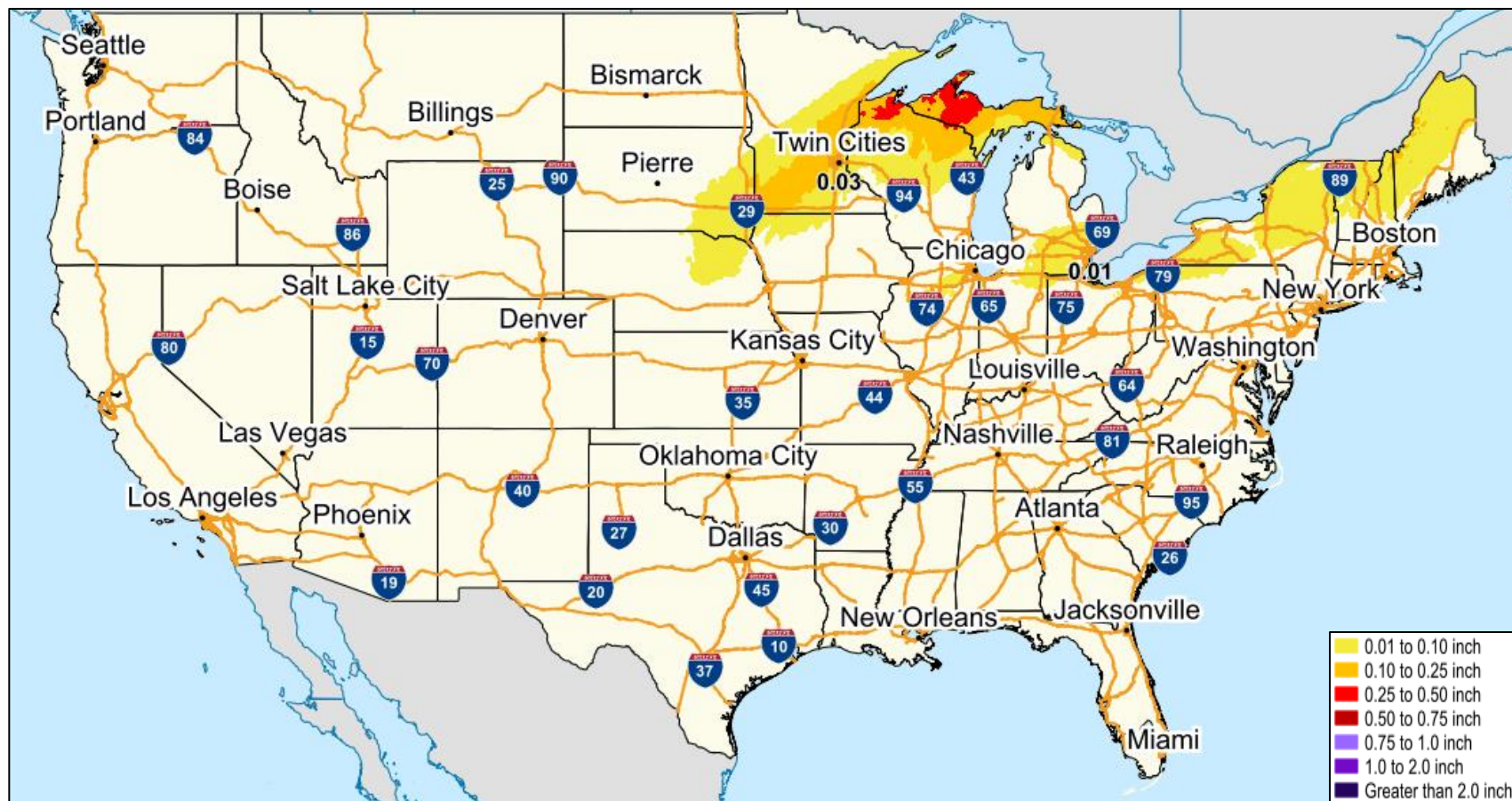
Forecast Snowfall

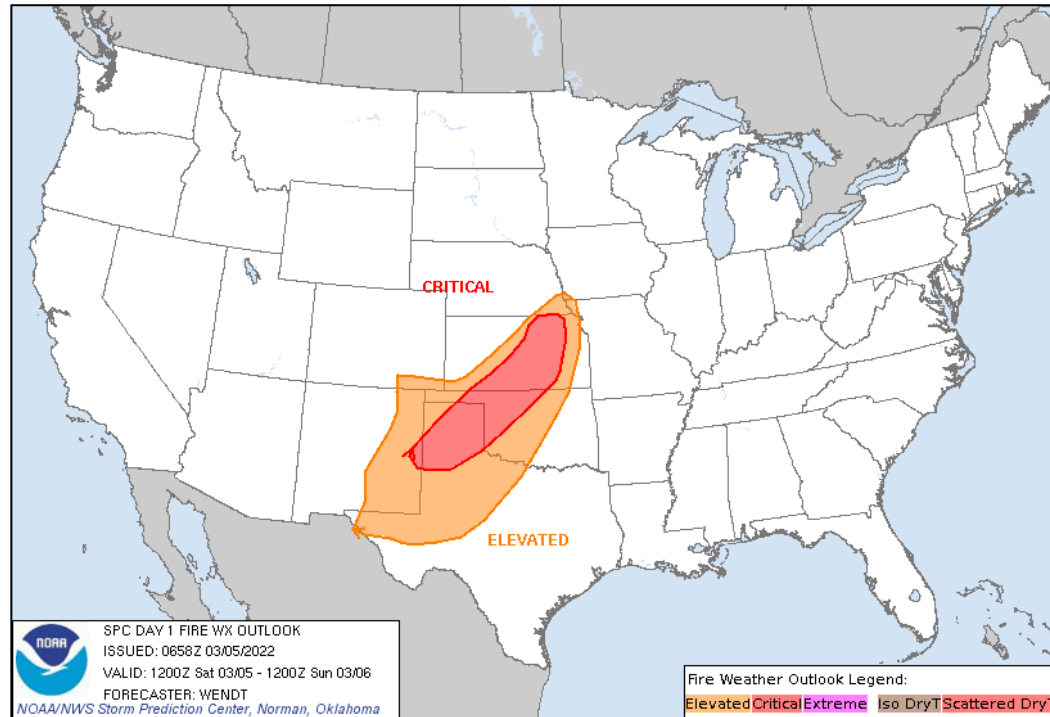
Ice Accumulation Forecast



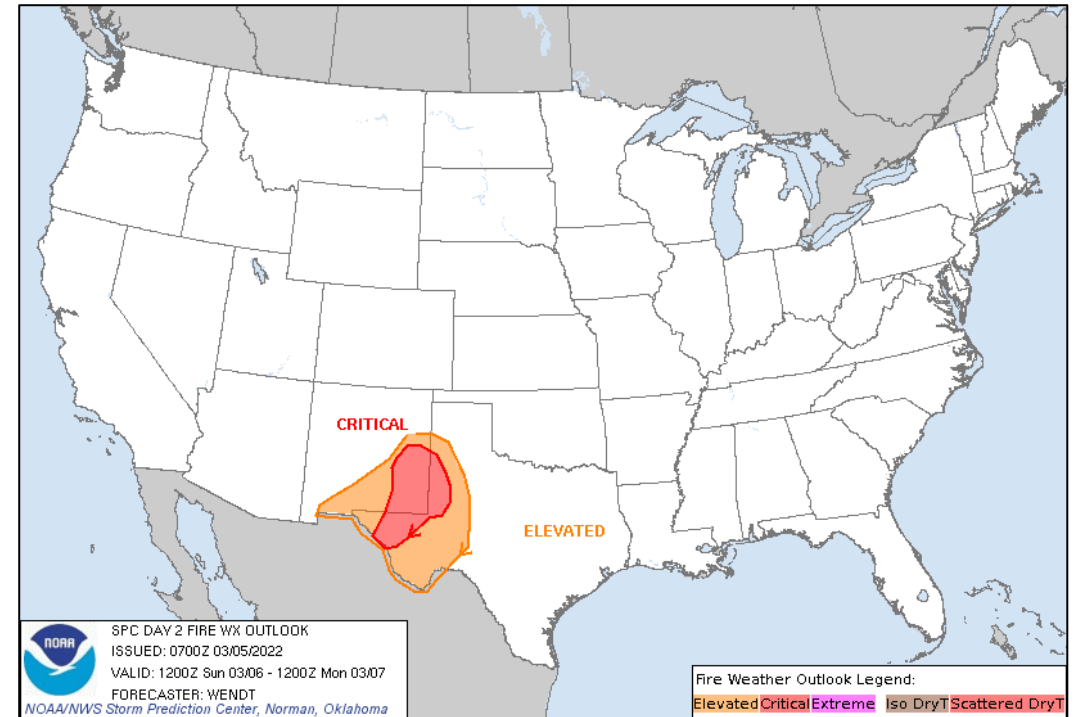
