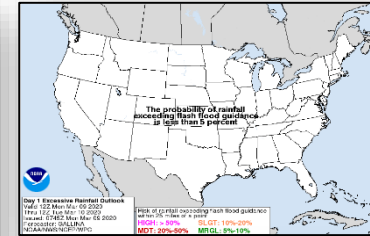
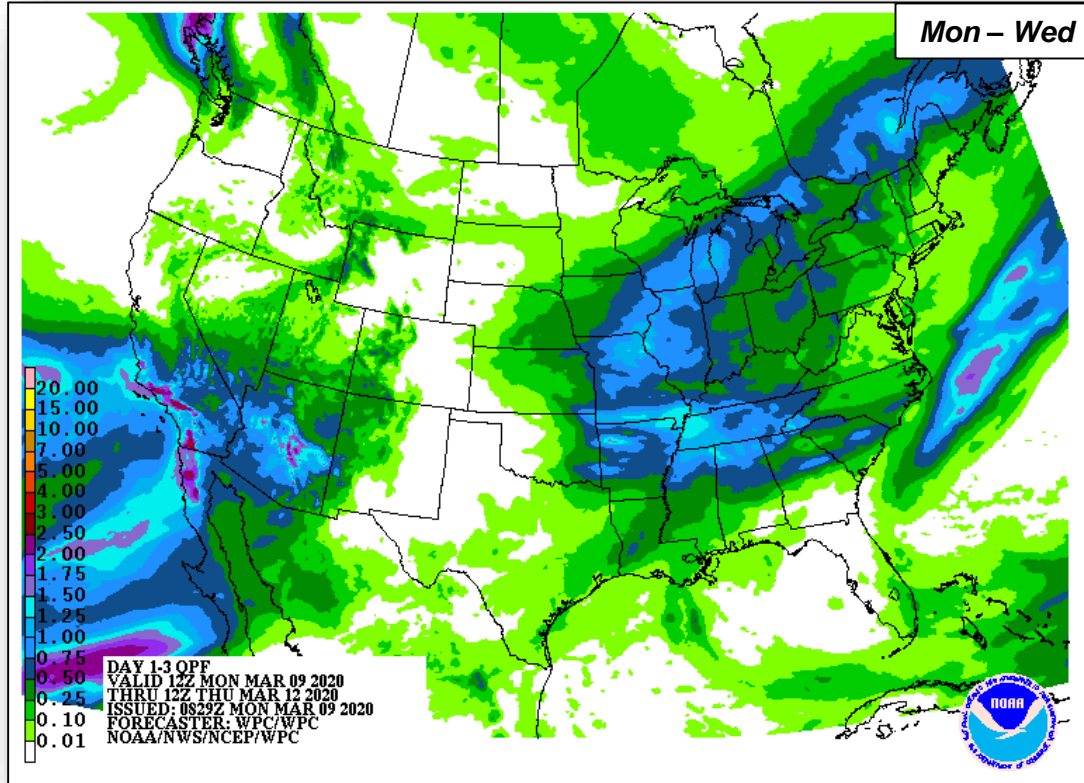
National Weather Forecast



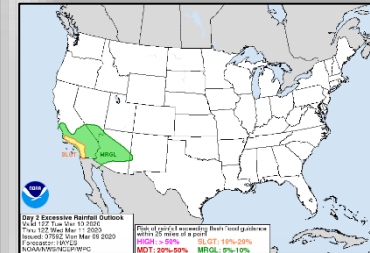
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



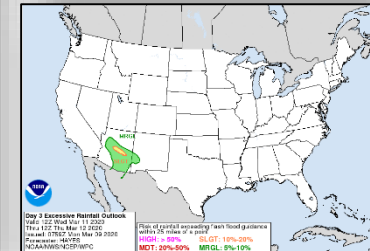

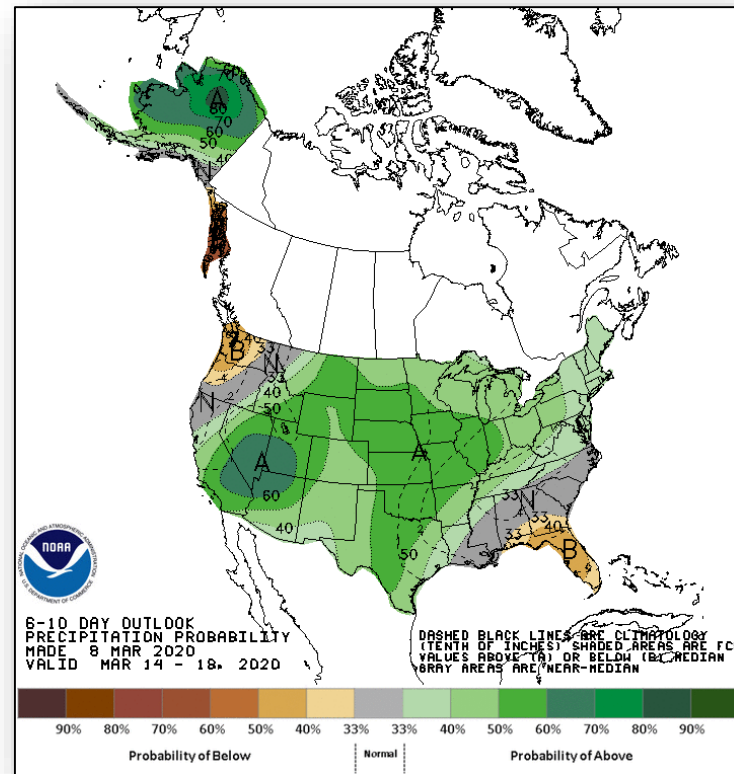
Severe Weather Outlook

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

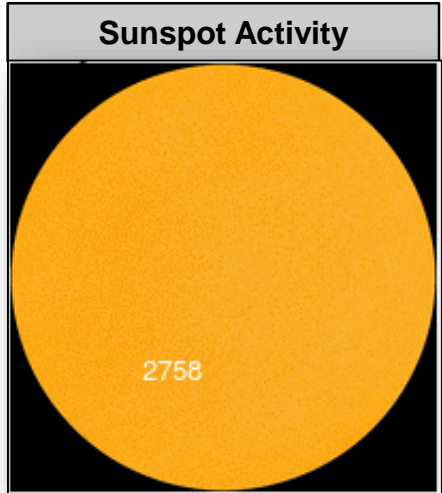
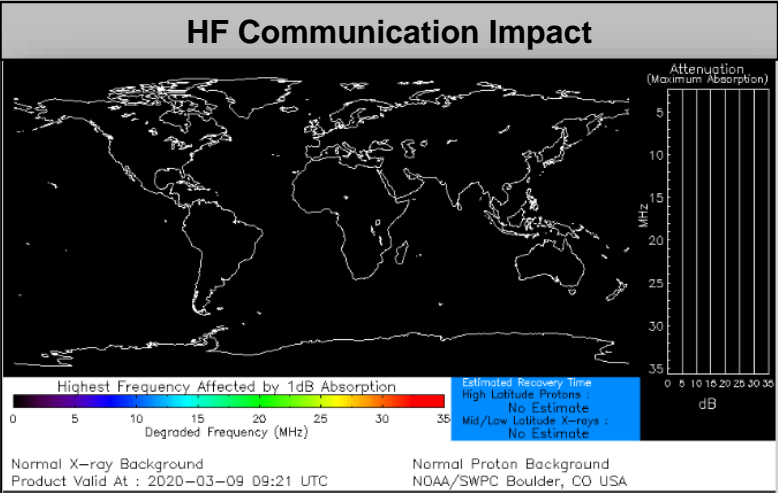
