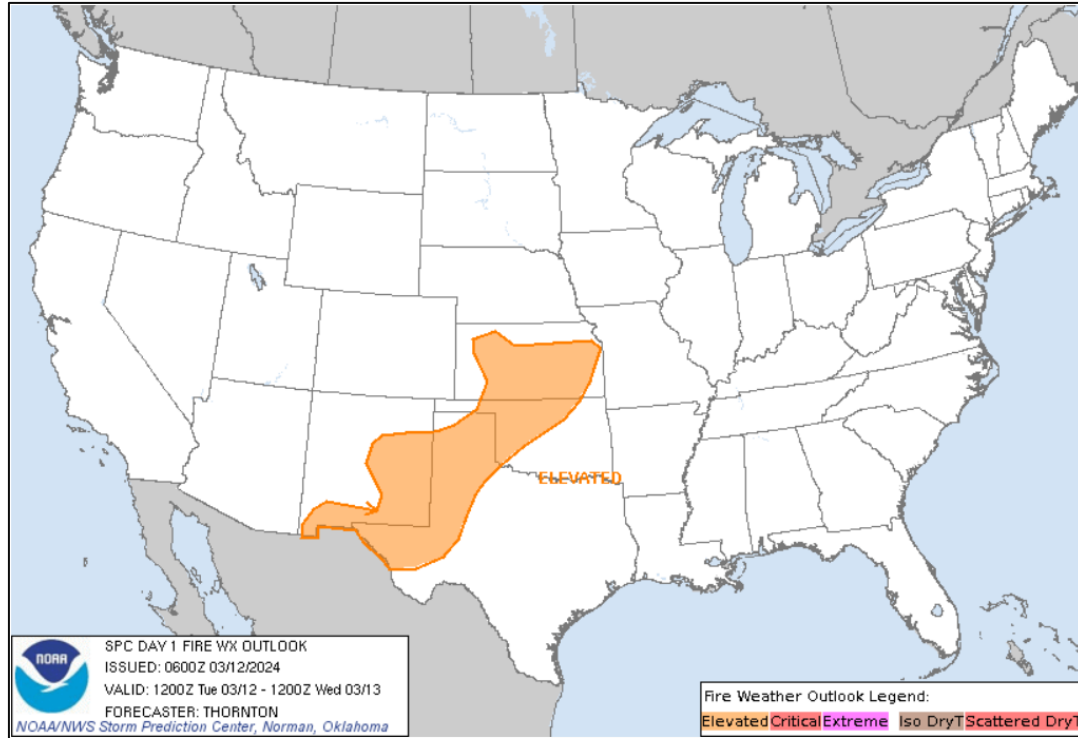
Severe Weather Outlook



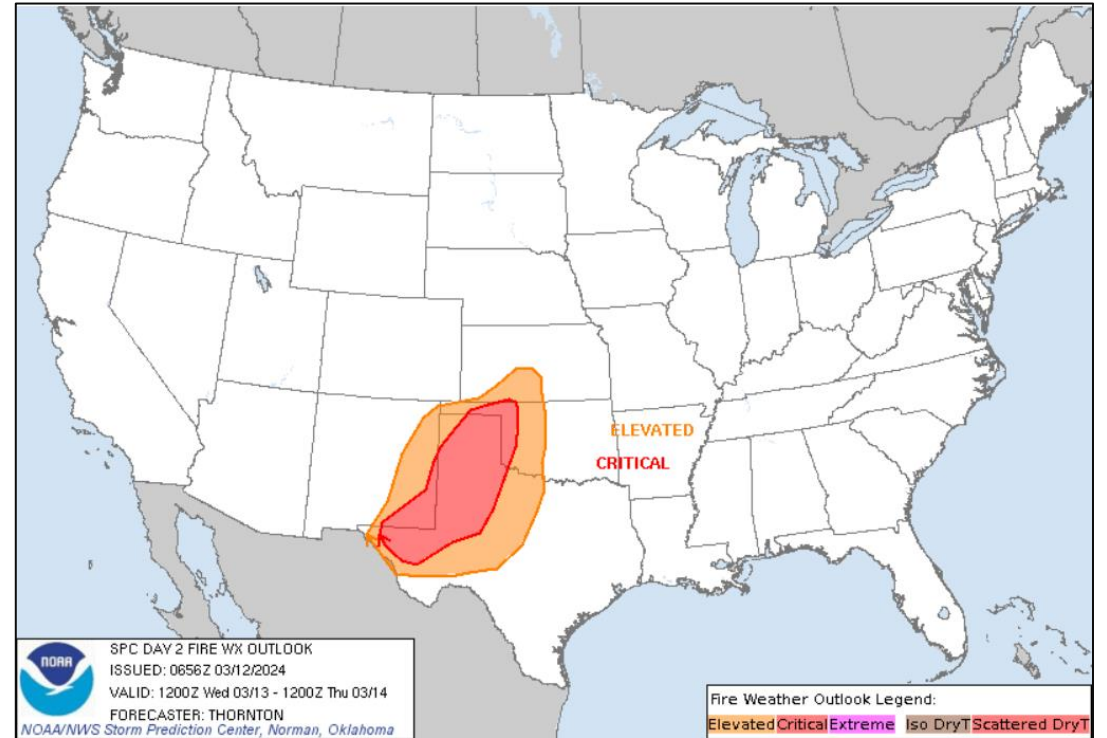

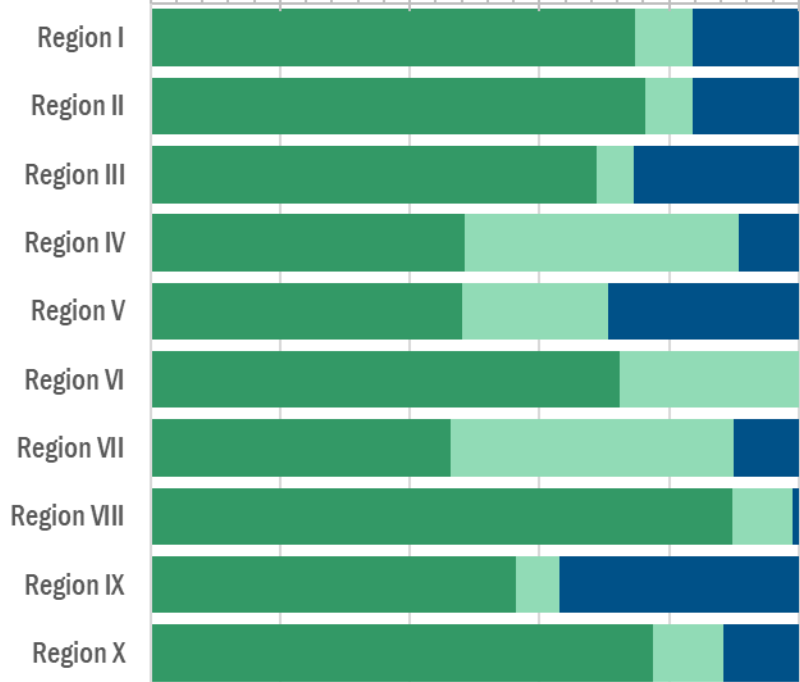
Public Assistance (PA) Grant Program Activity – per Region

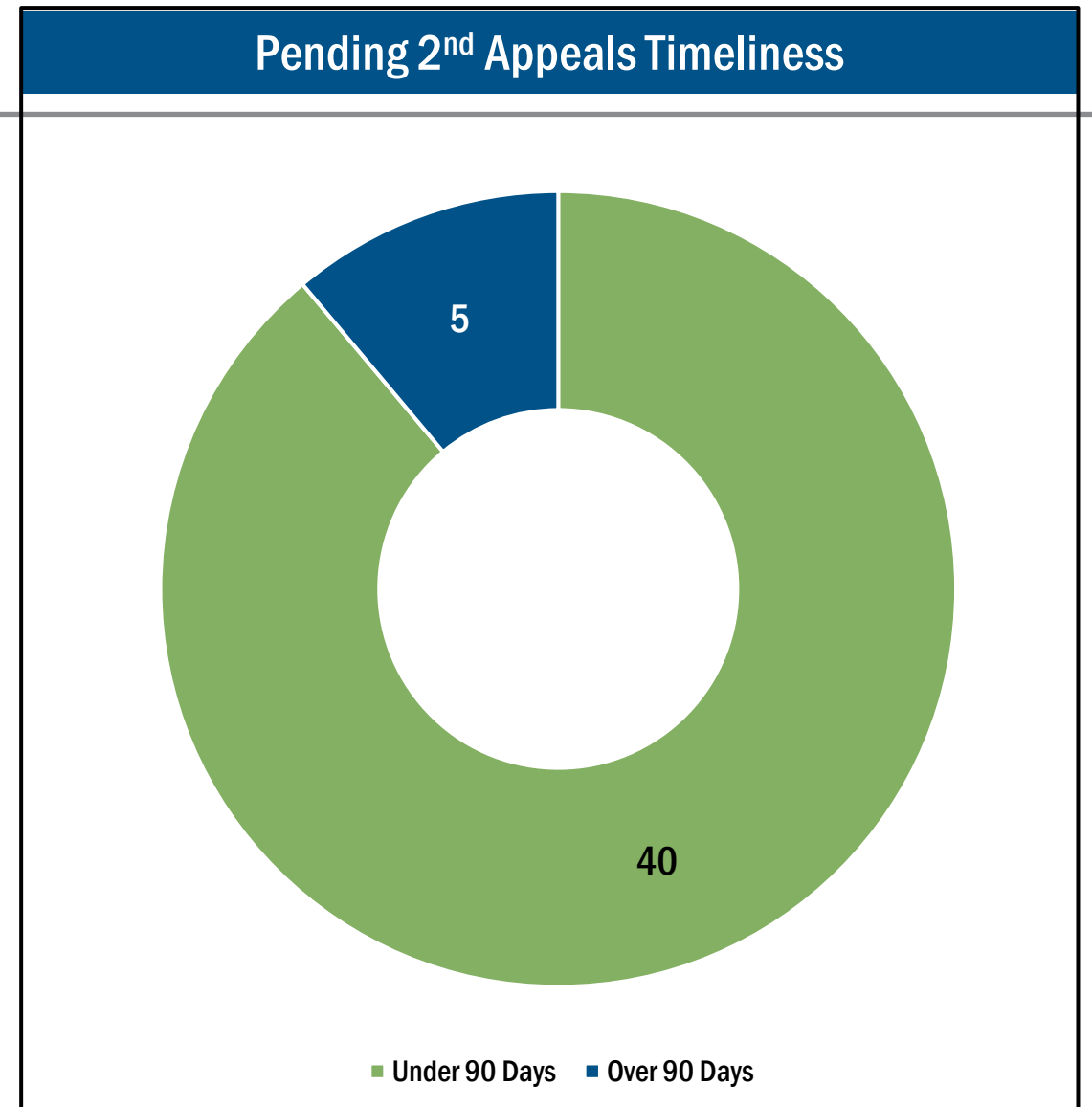
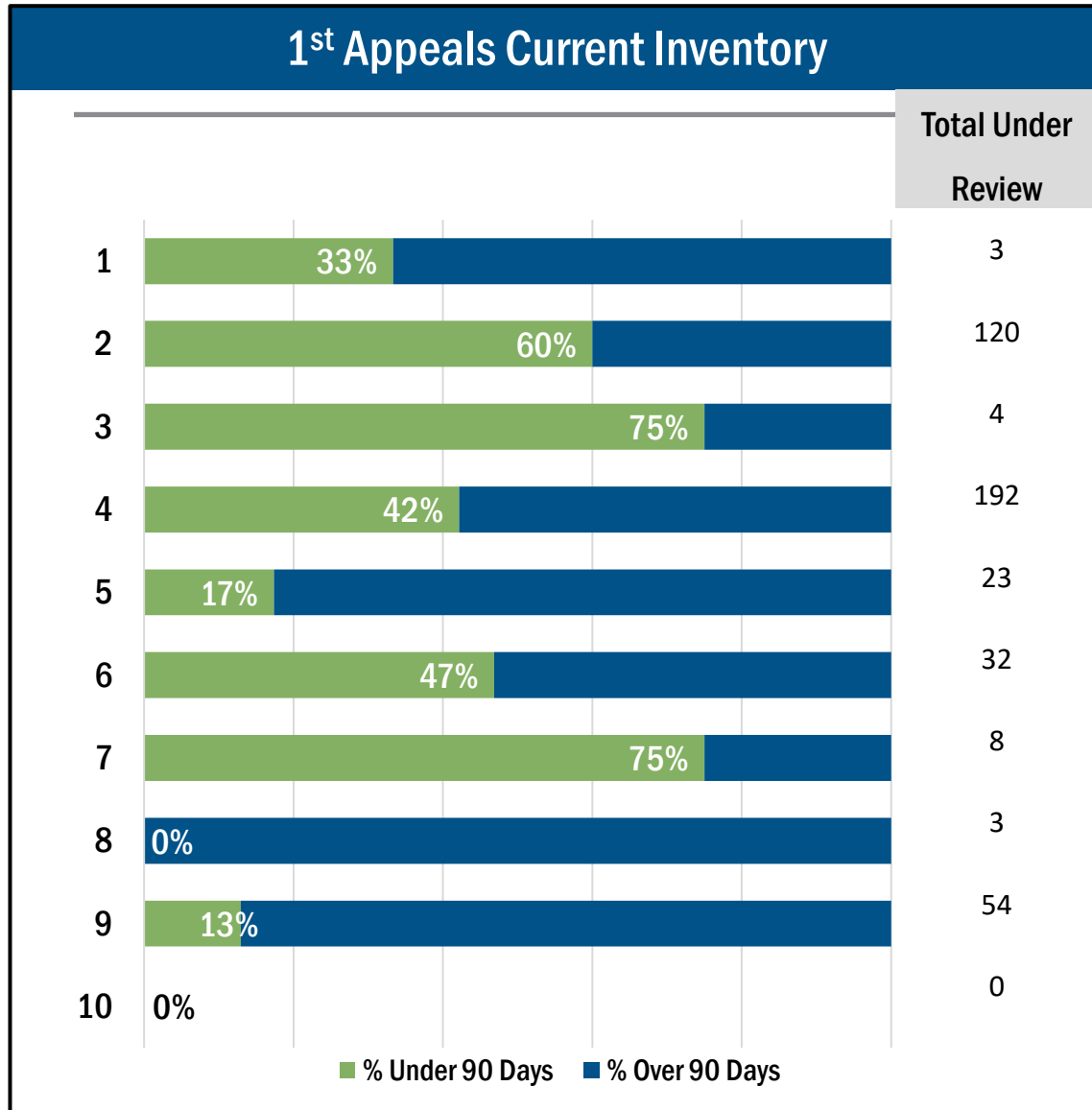

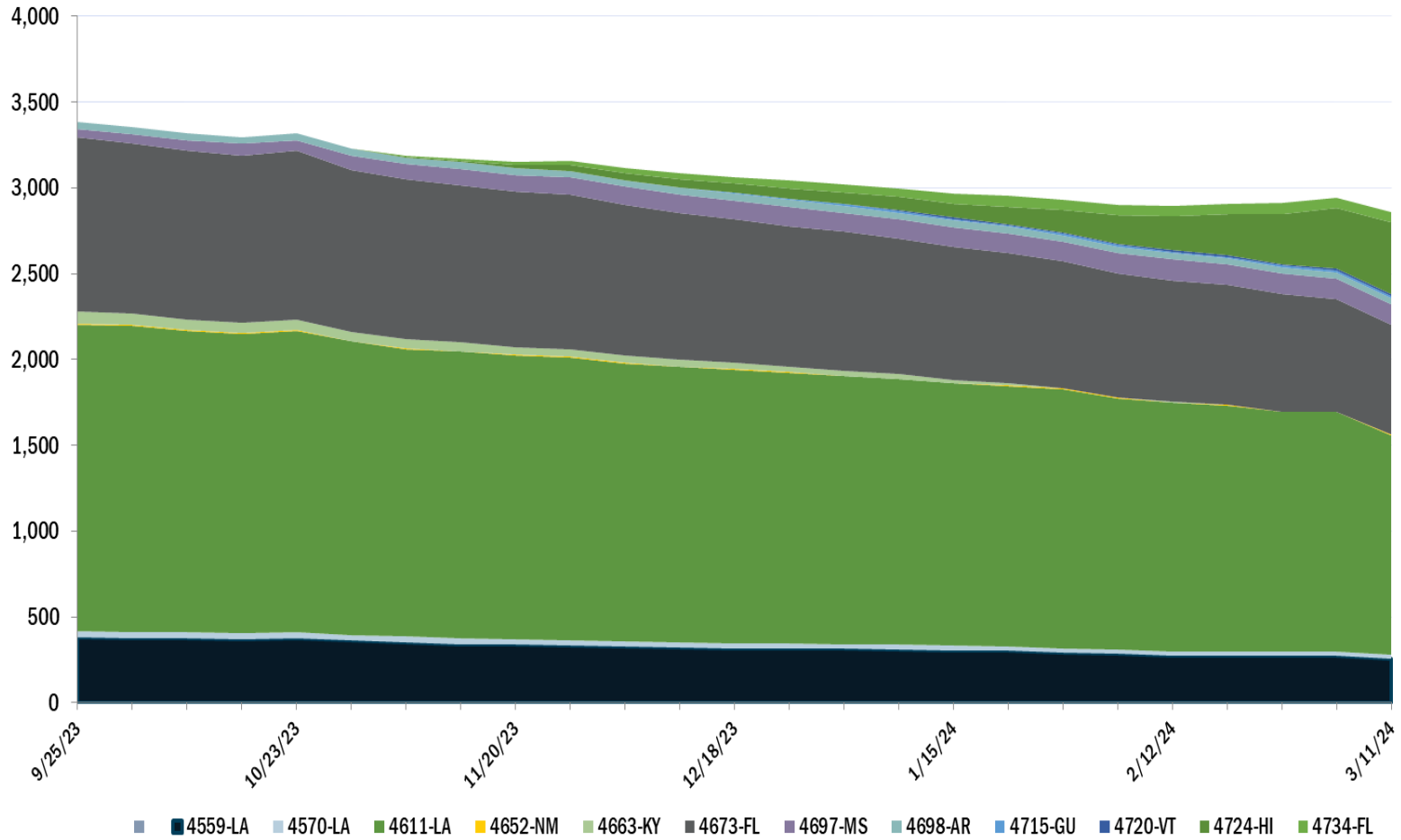

Direct Housing

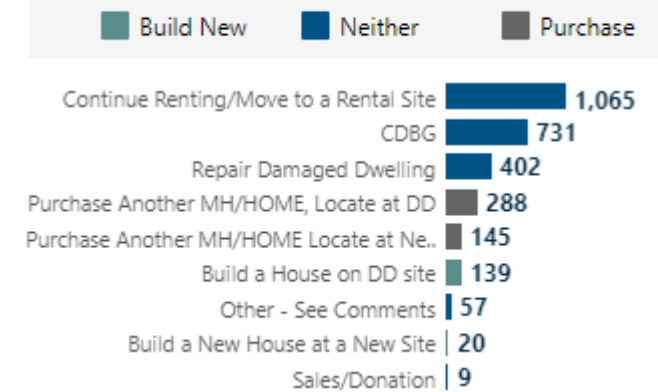
