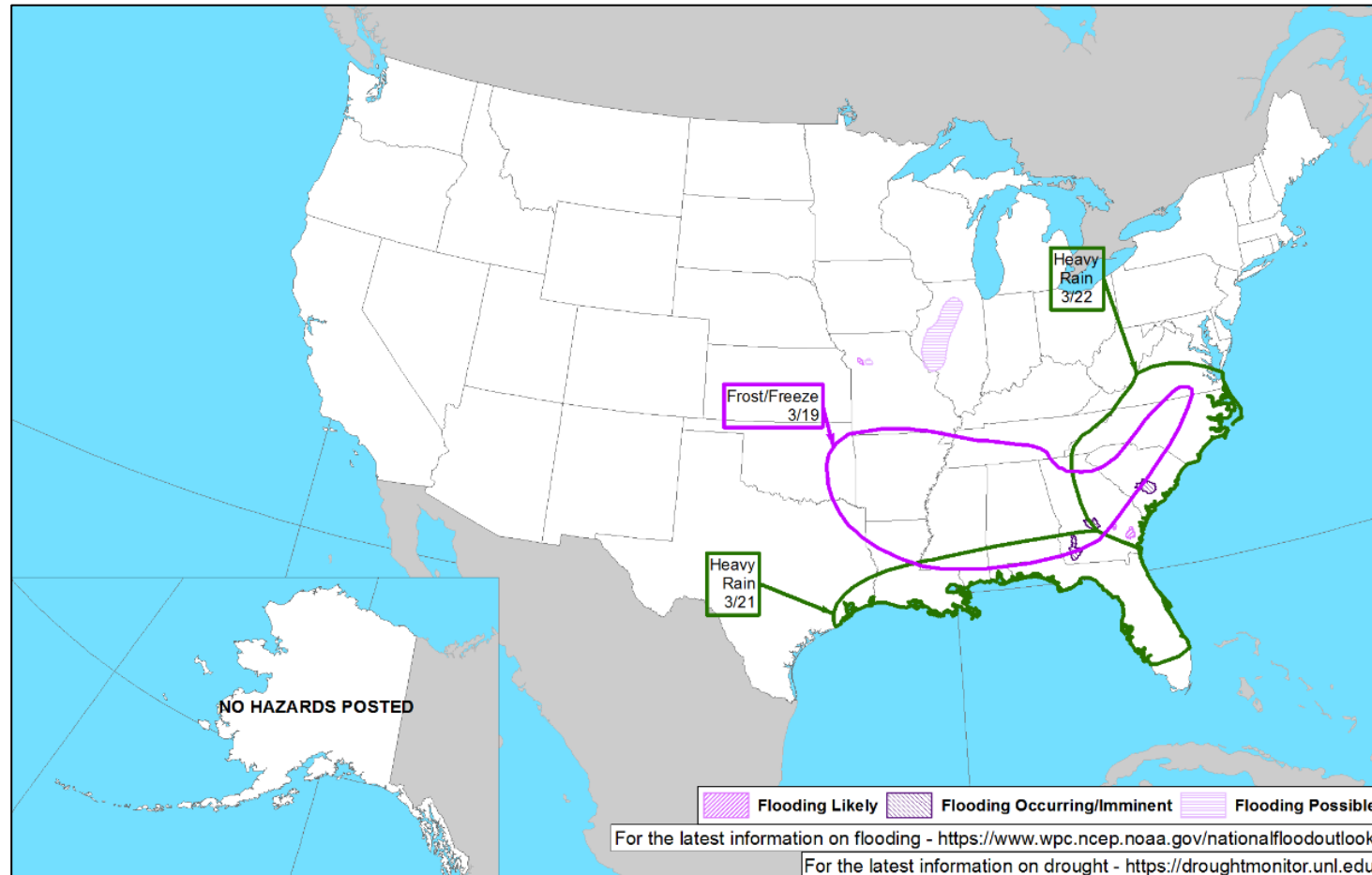
National Weather Forecast

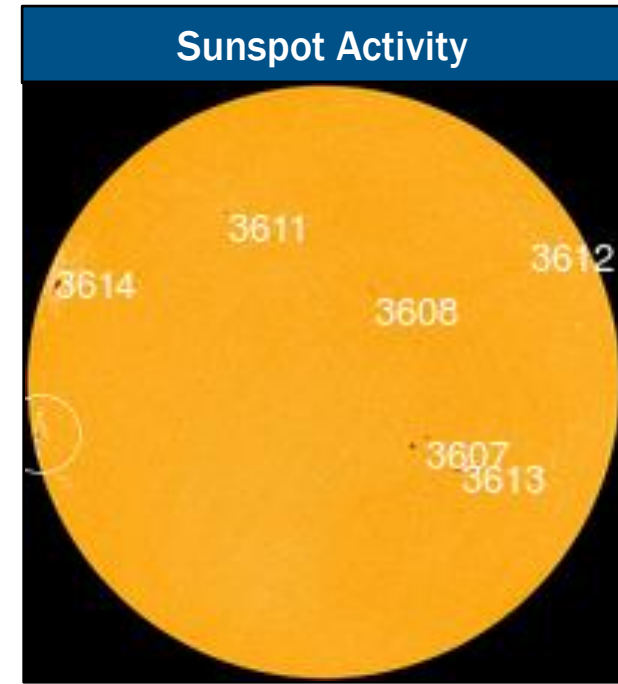
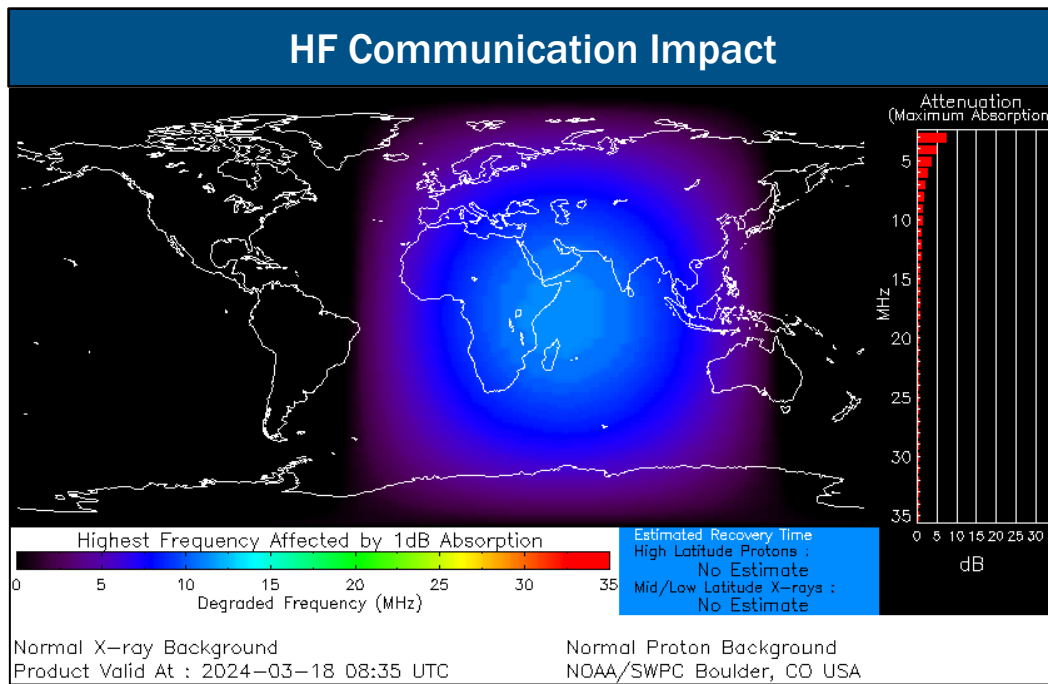

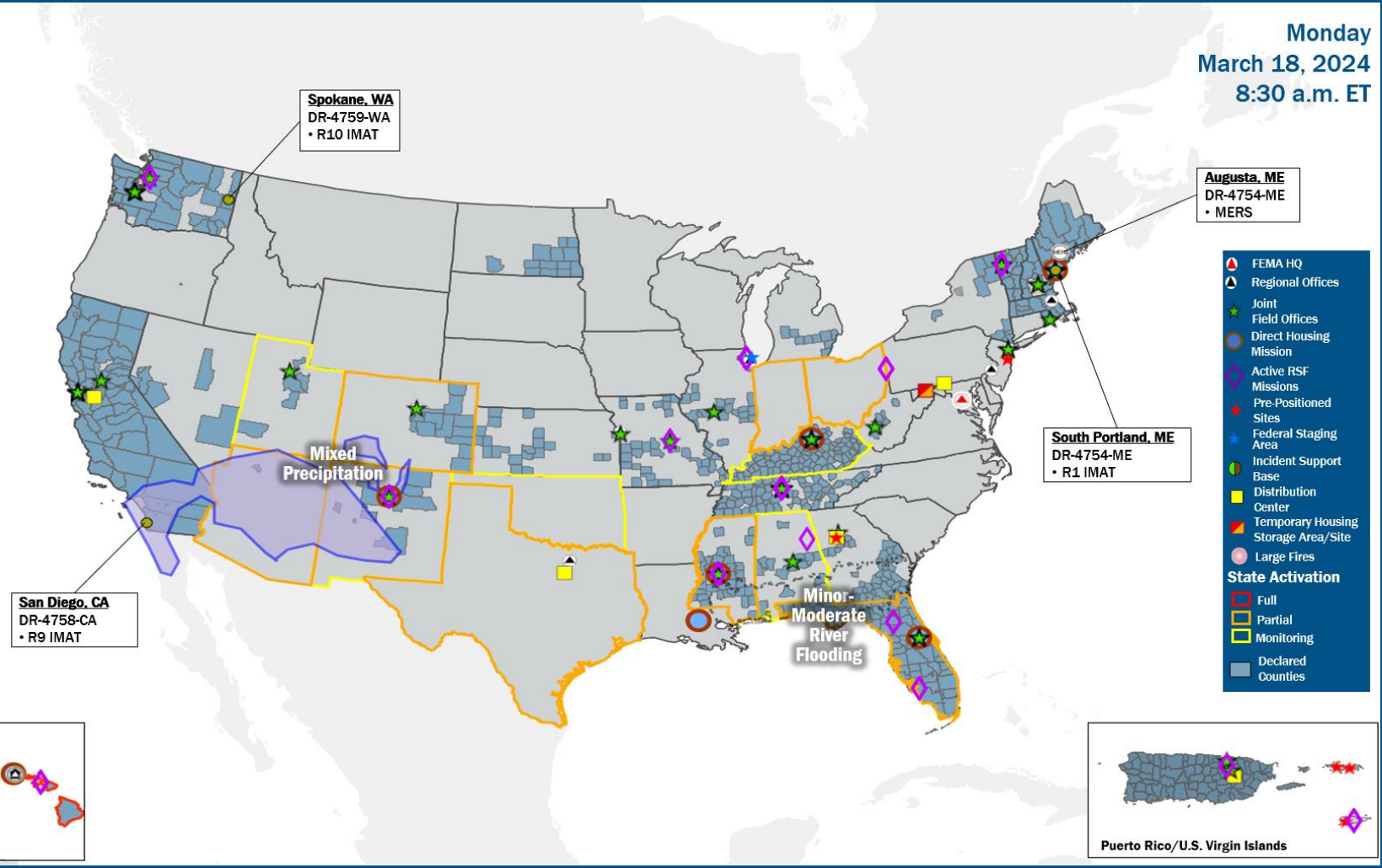
