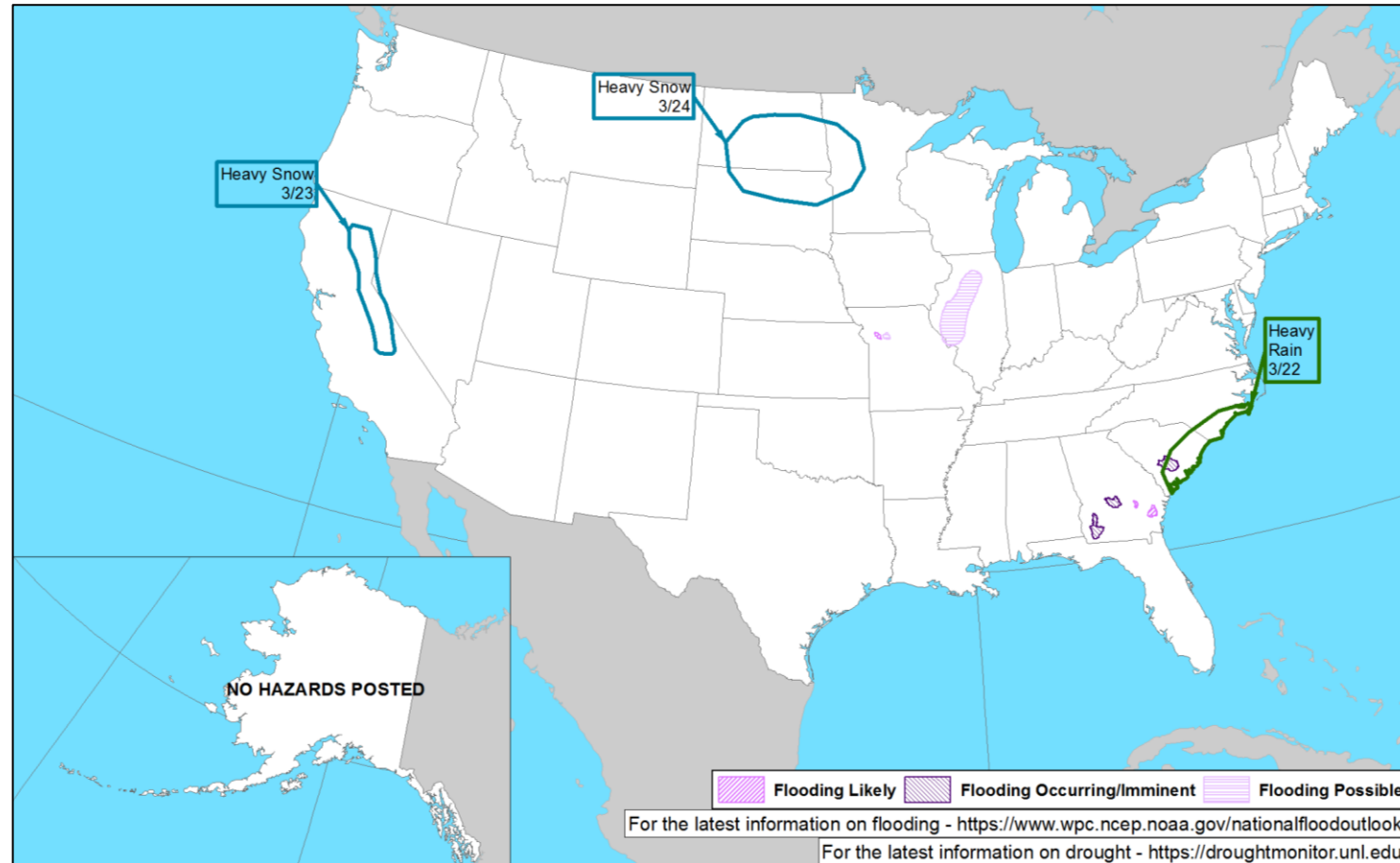
# Snowfall Forecast

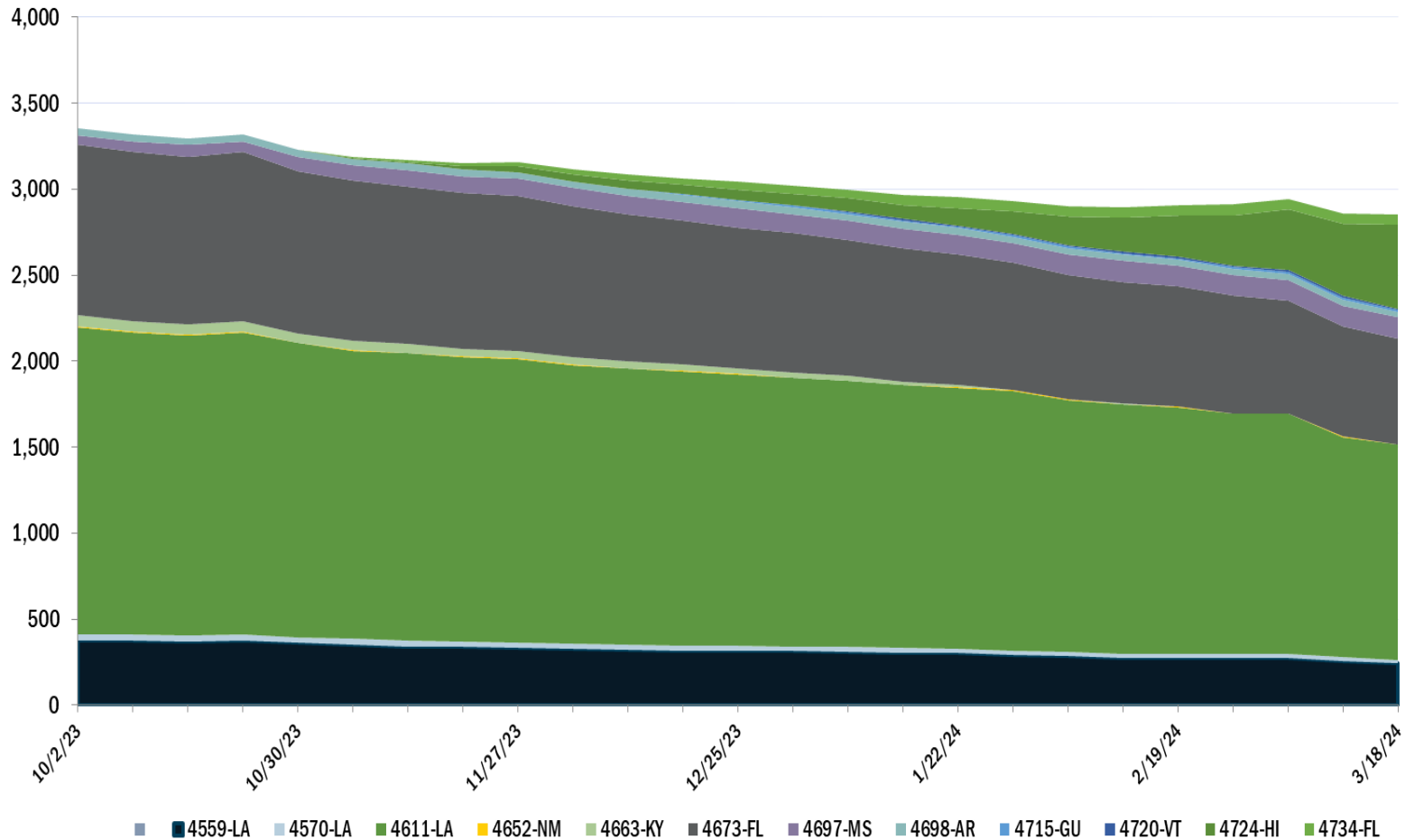

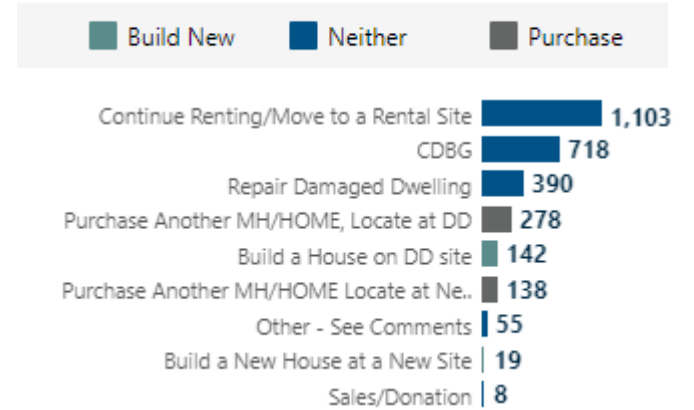
