






### **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






#### **Snowfall Forecast**





### Hazards Outlook - Mar 24-28








#### **2024 Spring Flood Outlook**

- Water supply and low flow concerns in Texas and along the Mississippi River for summer and fall



Valid for March 21 - June 30, 2024 Released March 21, 2024





- Drought is likely to expand over the Northern and Southern Plains


