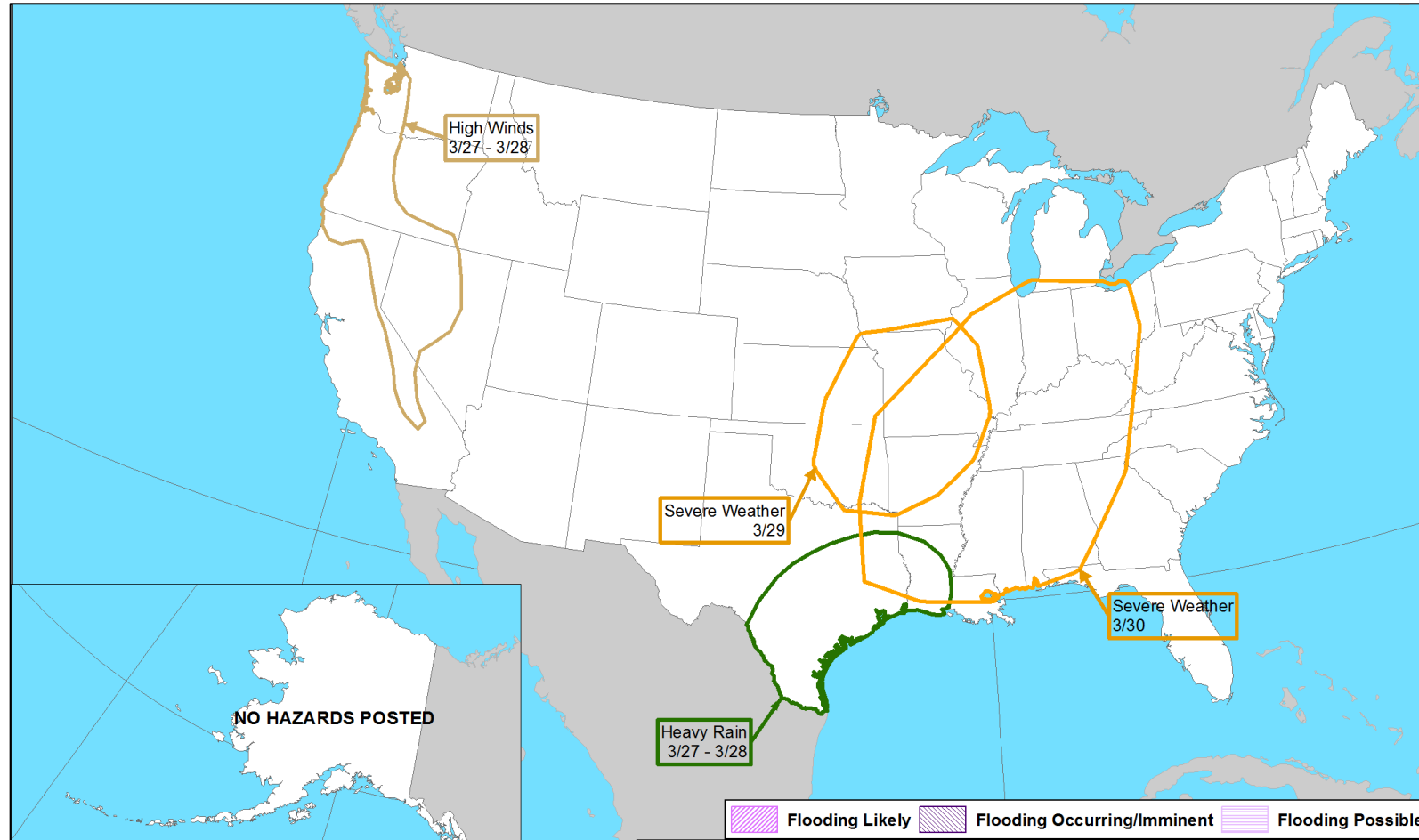
# National Weather Forecast

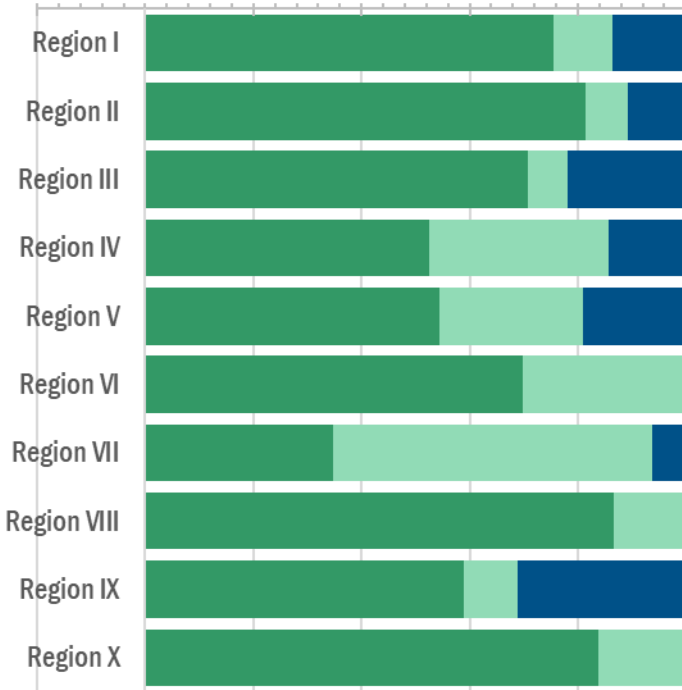

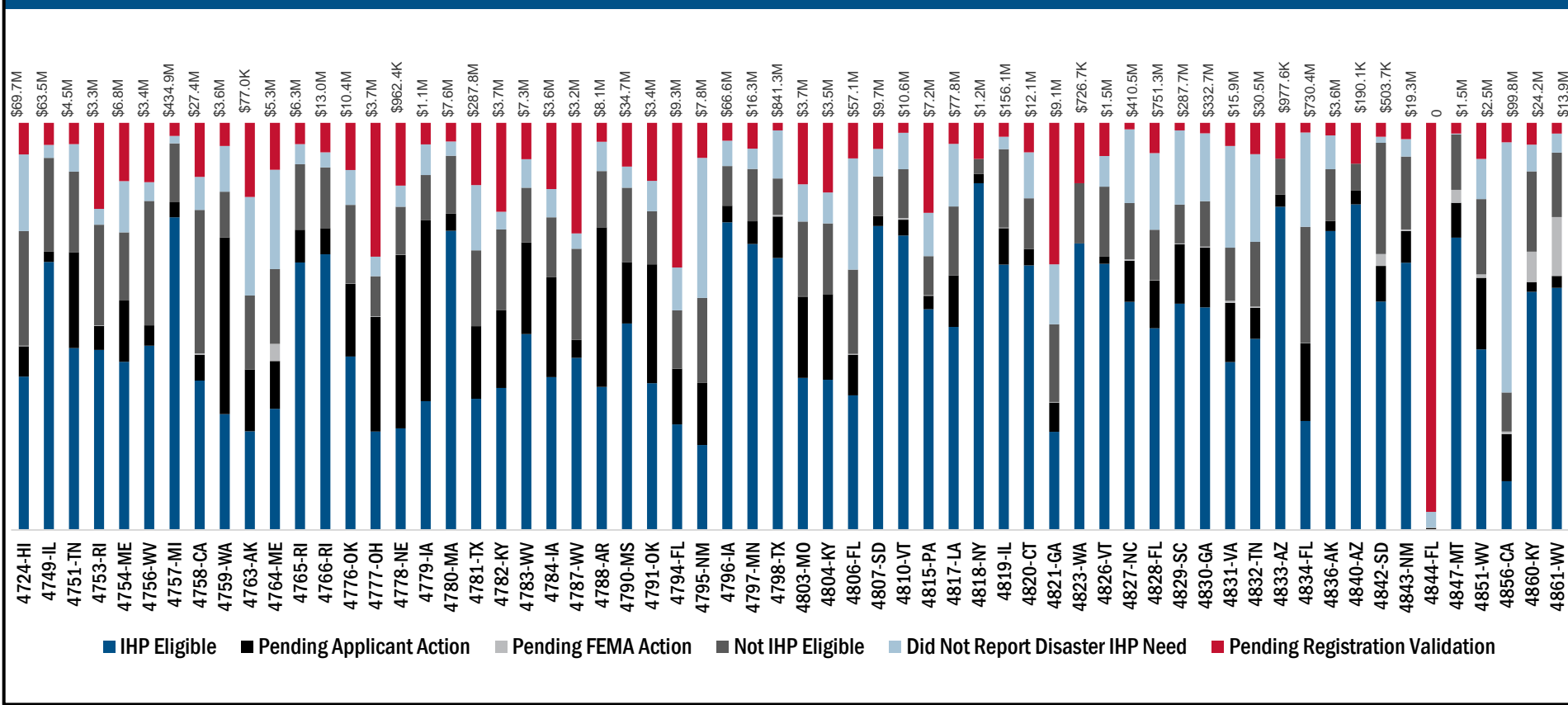

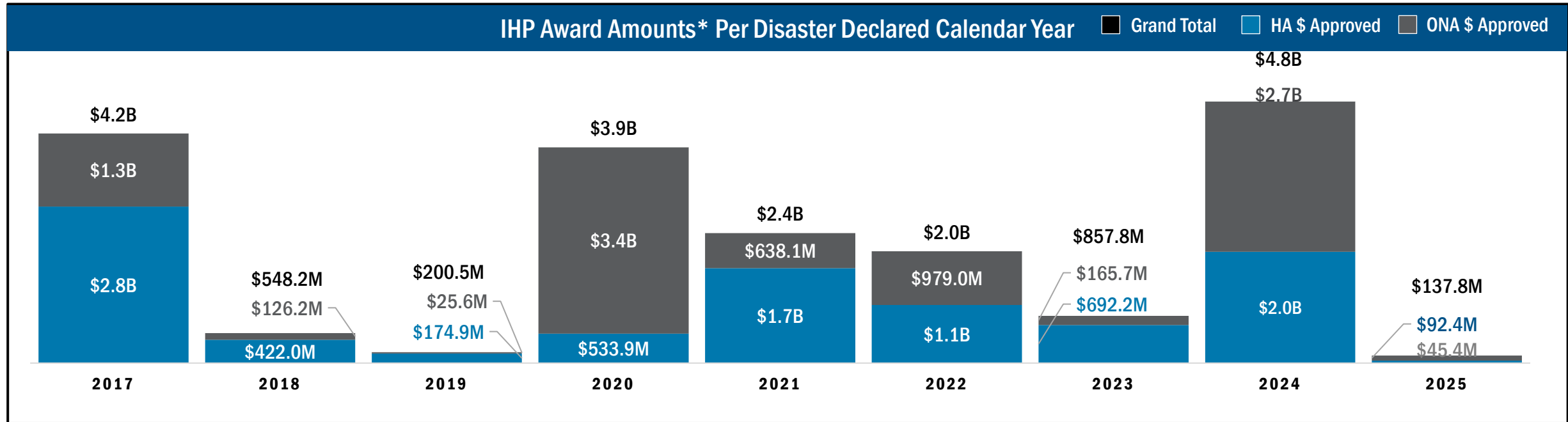
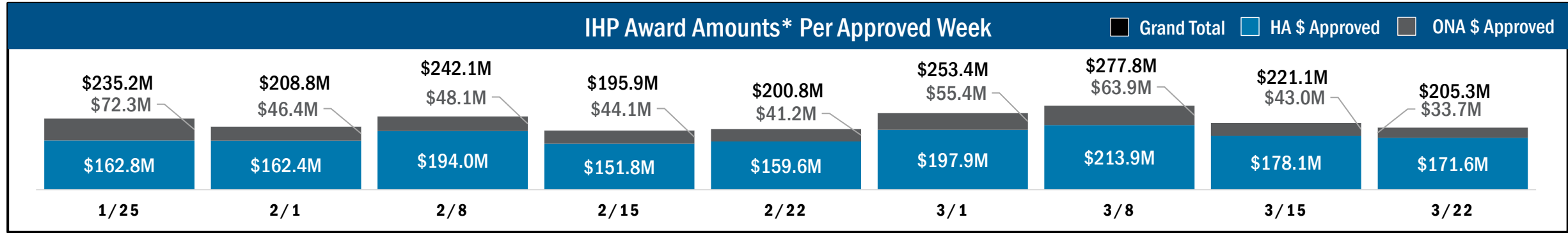
## Registrations in Active Declarations

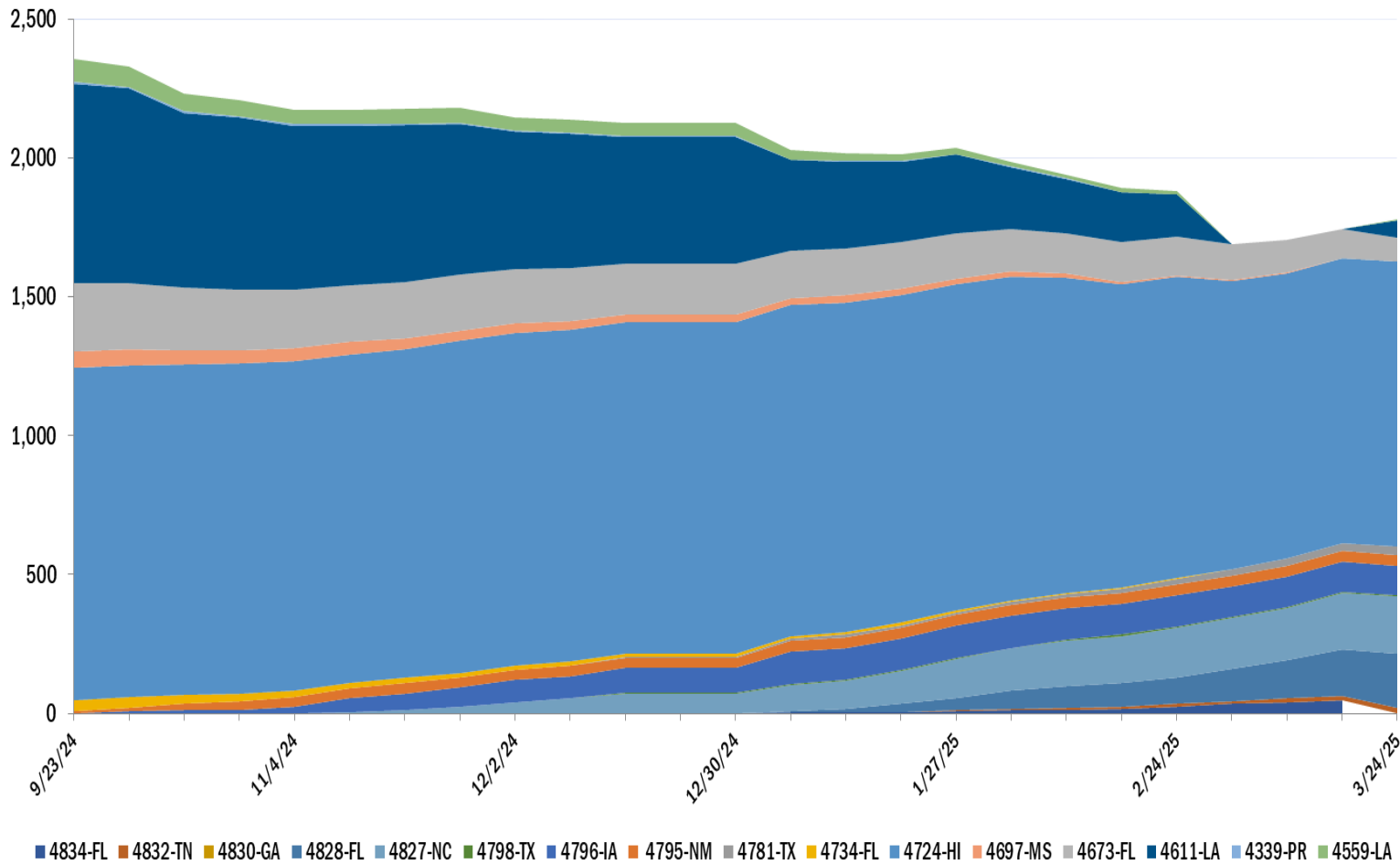

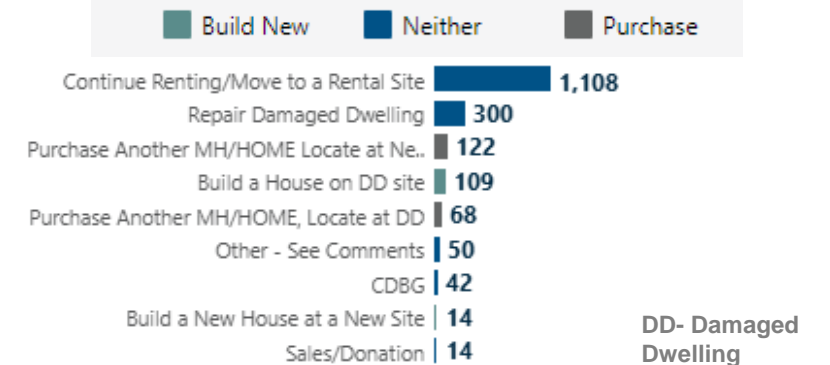
