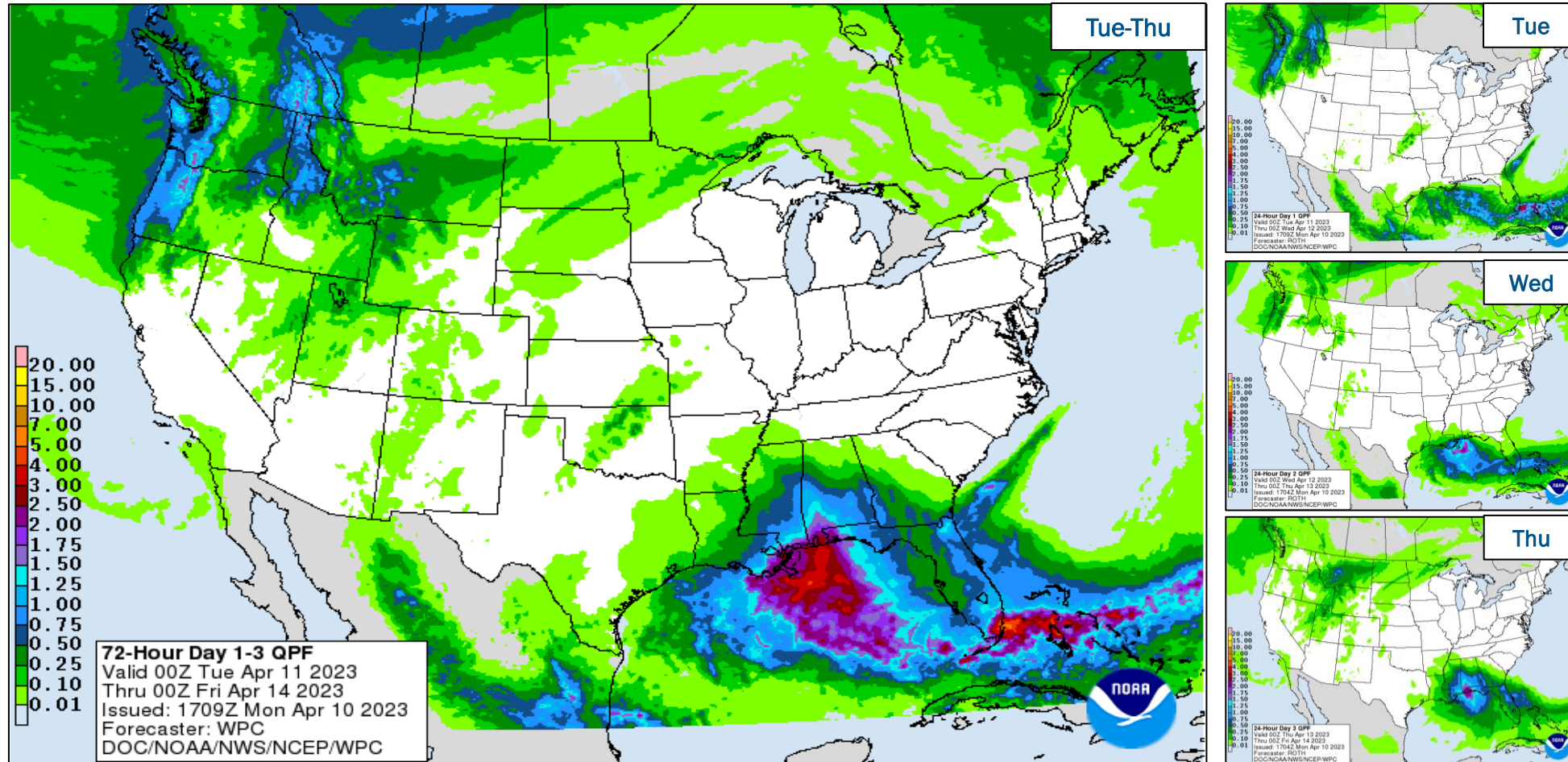
# National Weather Forecast

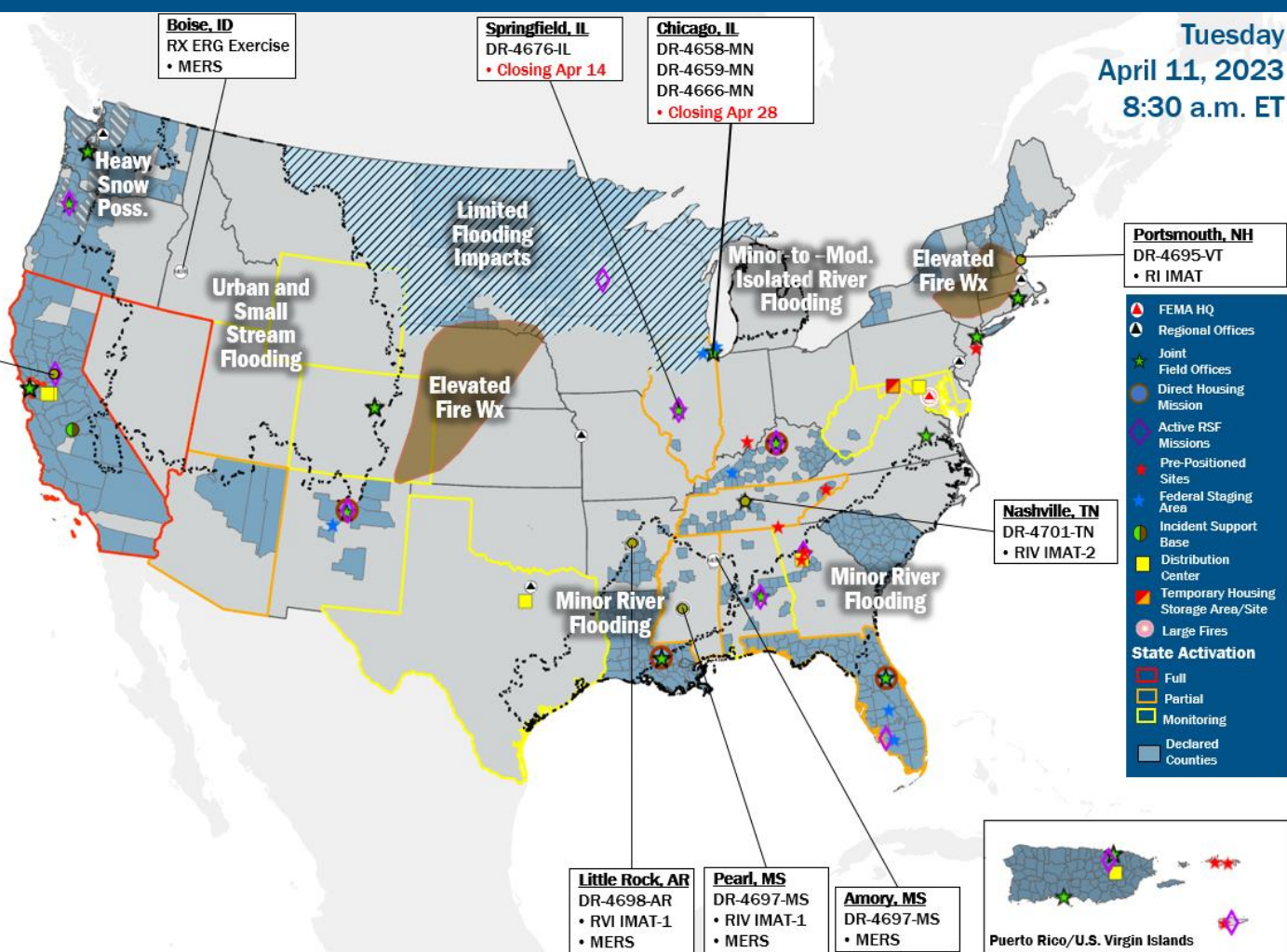

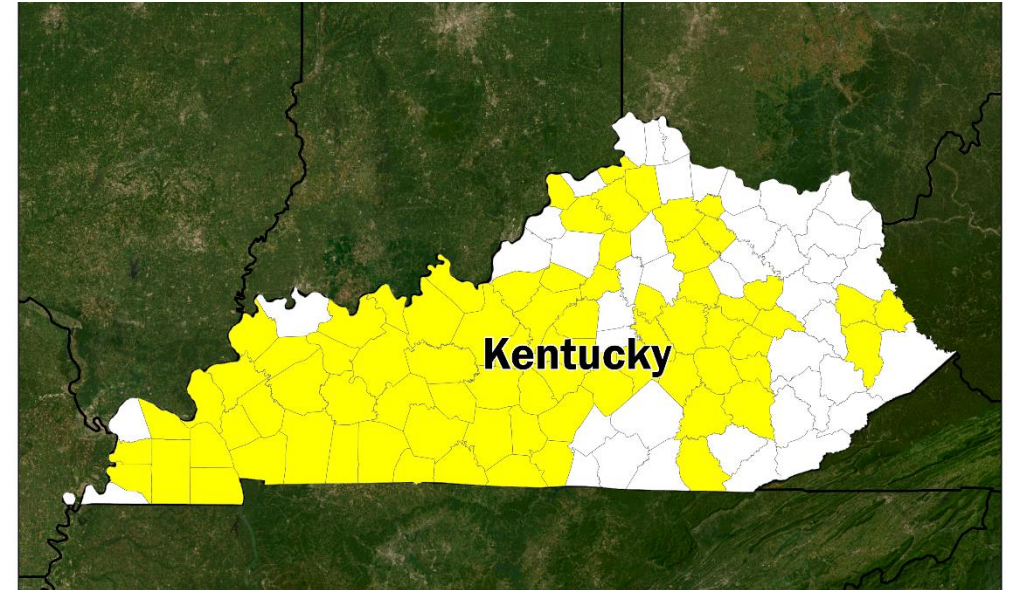
