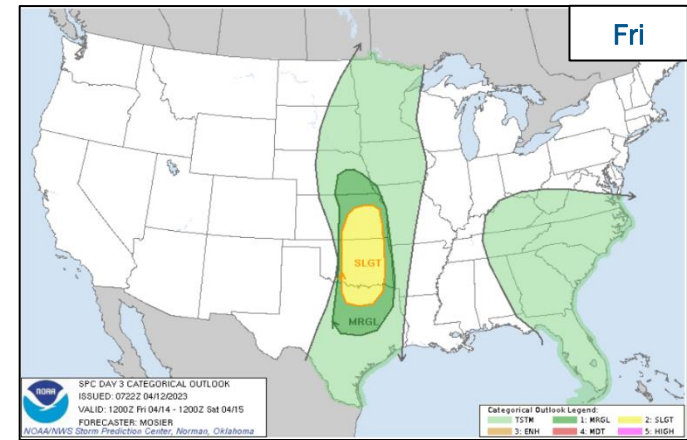
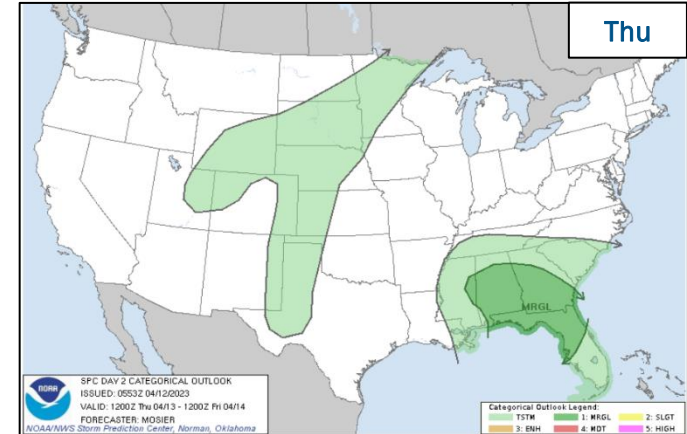
Precipitation Forecast

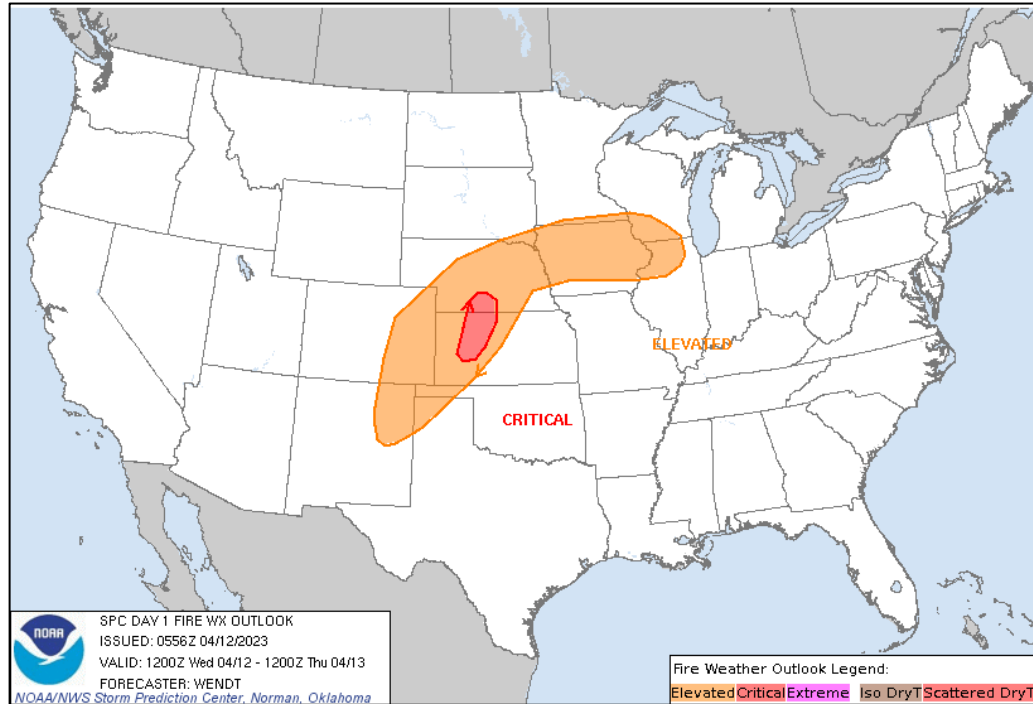
Severe Weather Outlook



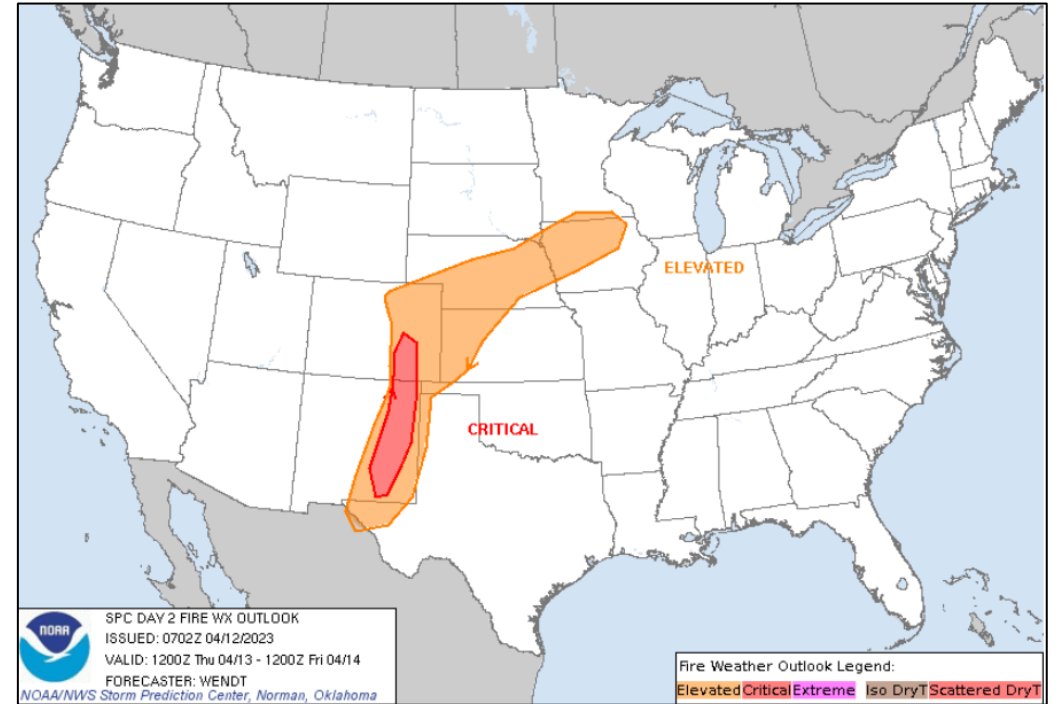
