## Situation:

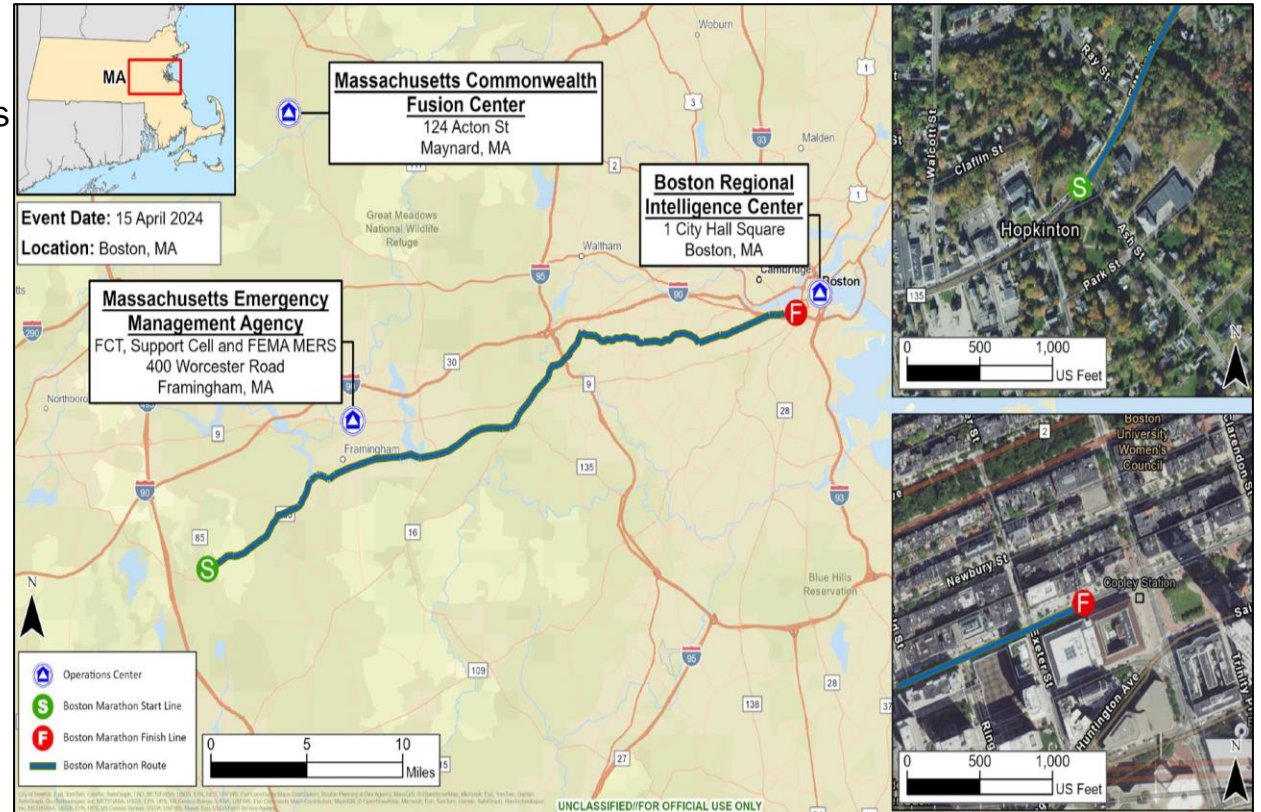
The 128th Boston Marathon will take place today in Boston, Massachusetts and 8 jurisdiction. A total of 30,000 participants and approximately 500,000 spectators are expected. This is designated as a Special Event Assessment Rating (SEAR) 1 by DHS due to its significant national importance that requires extensive interagency support.

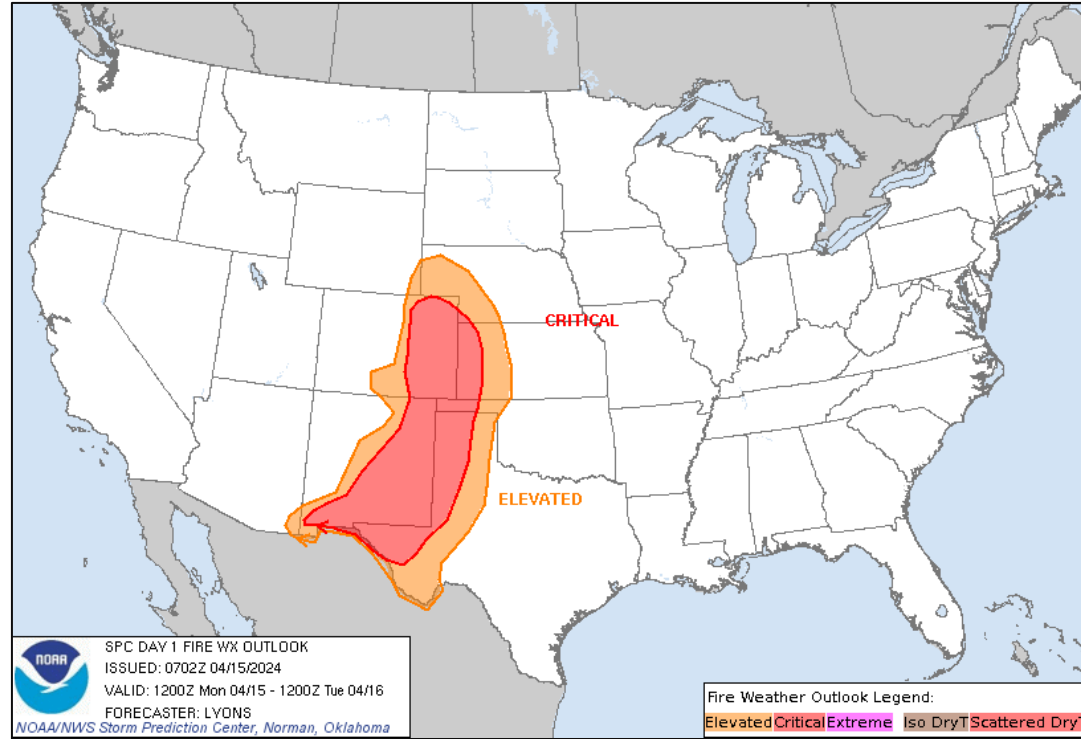
# Severe Weather Outlook



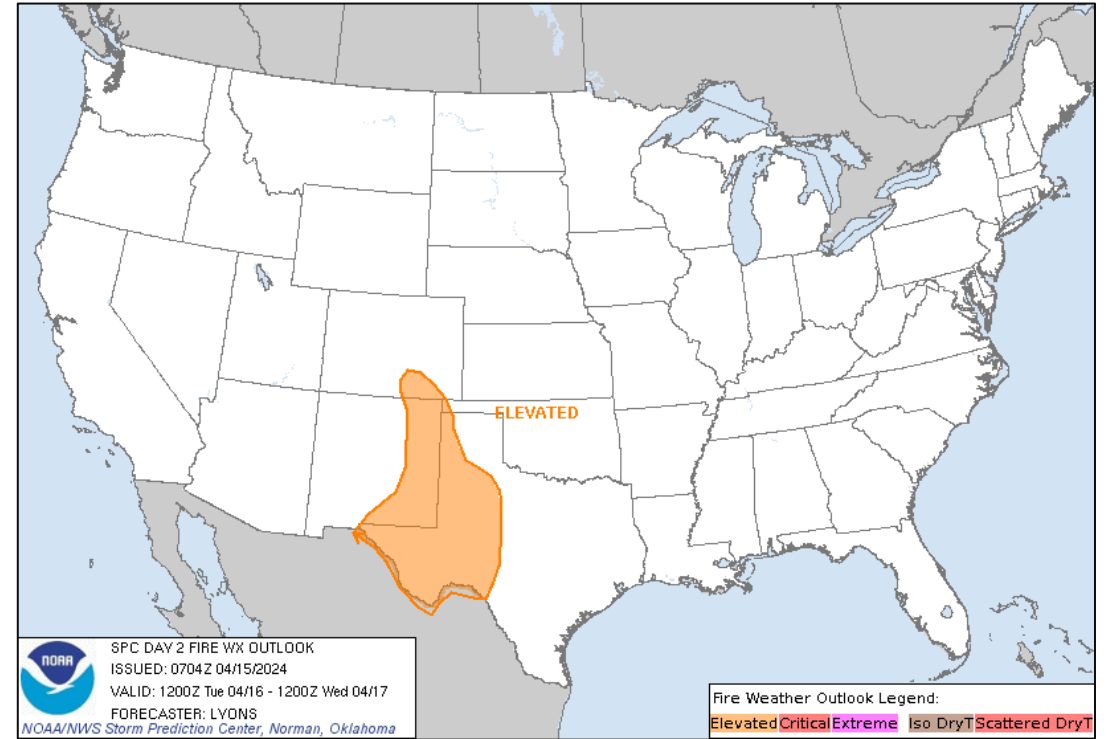

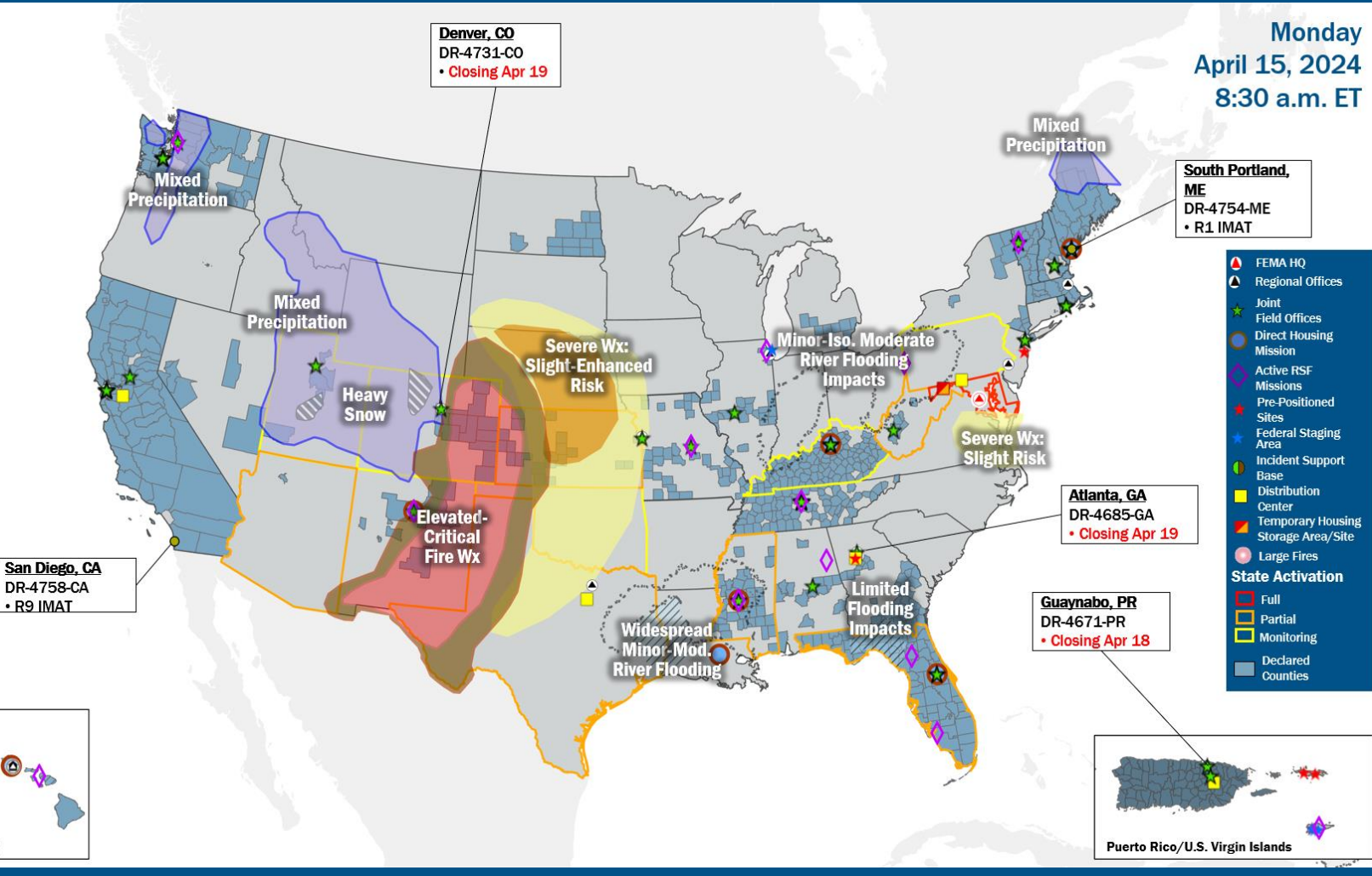
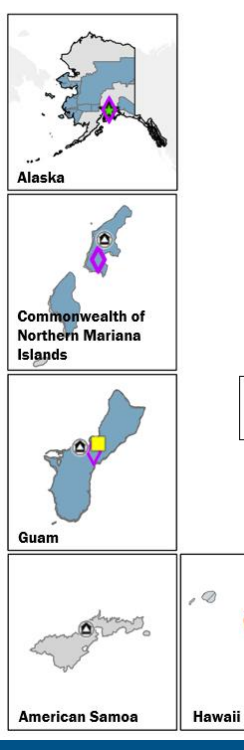
