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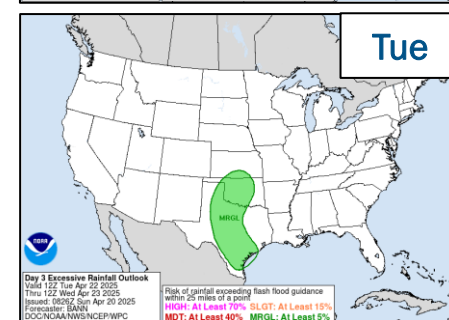

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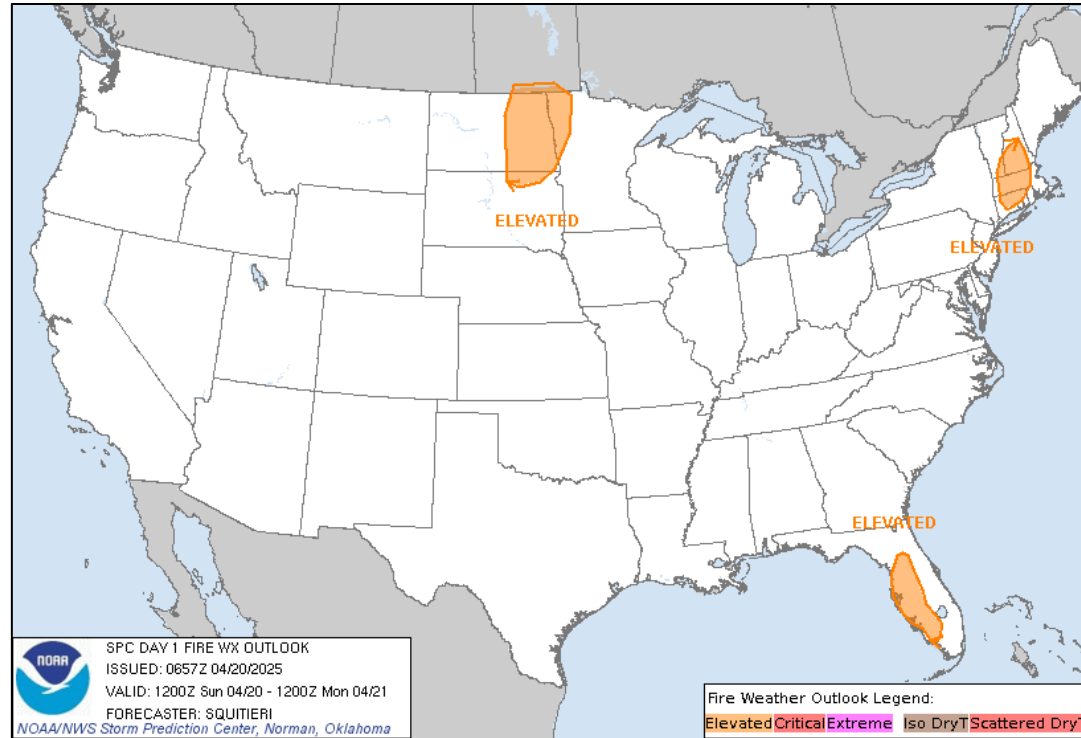
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Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

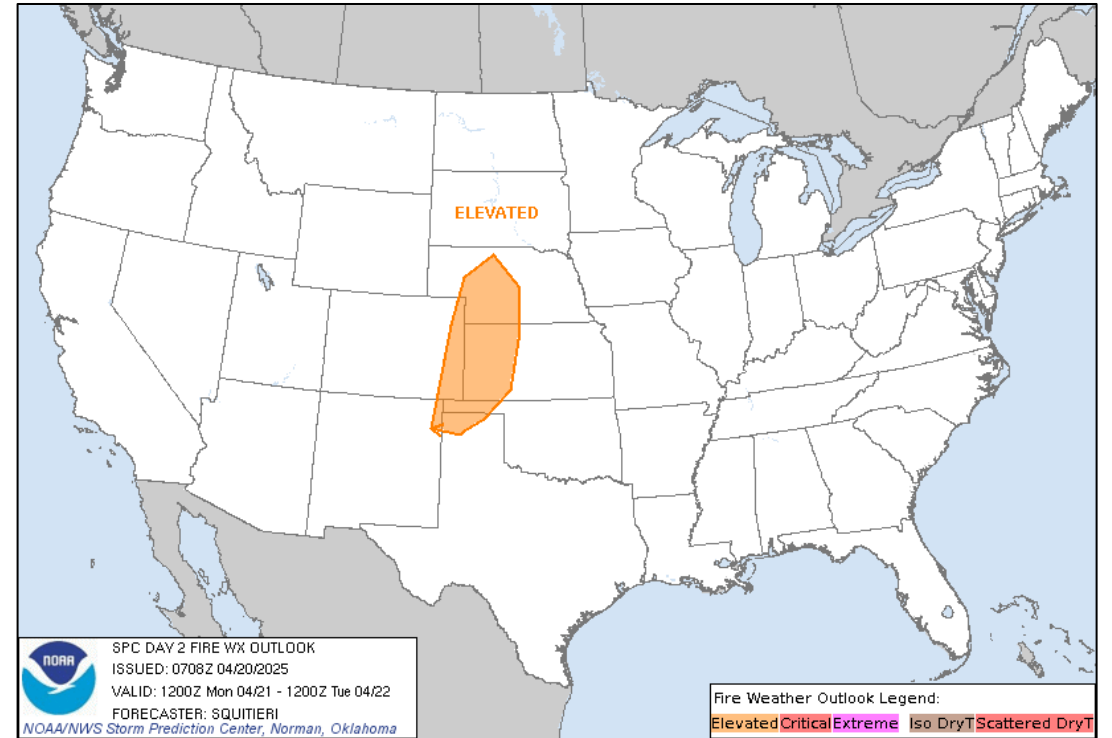

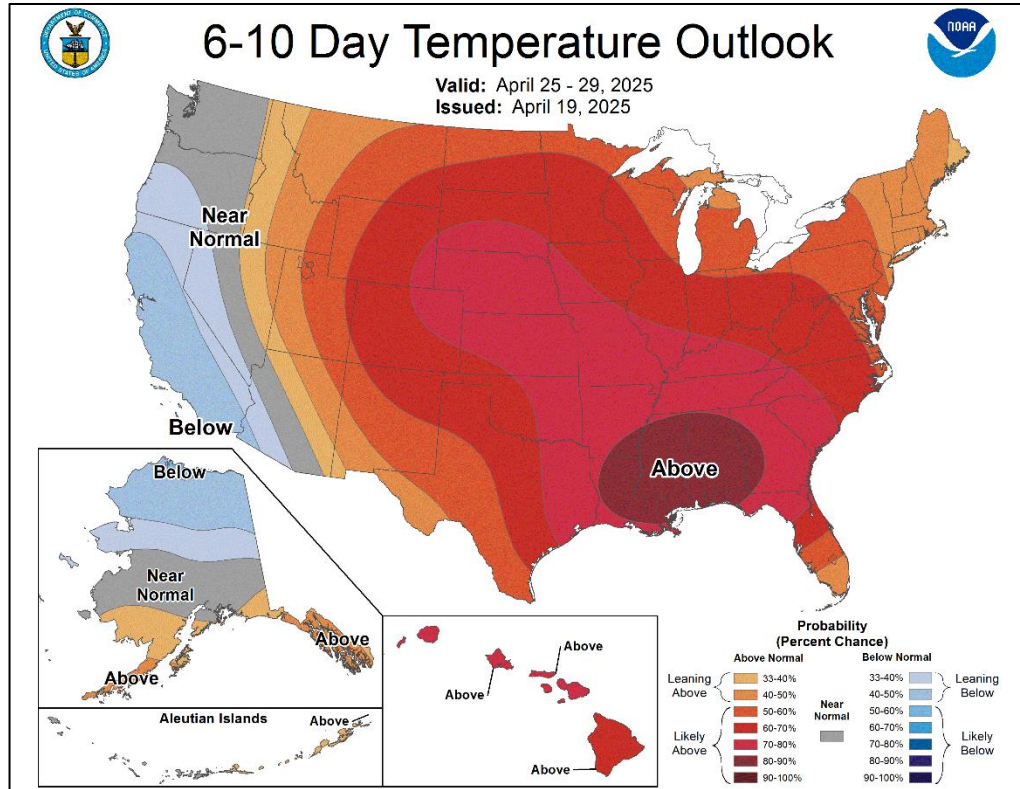

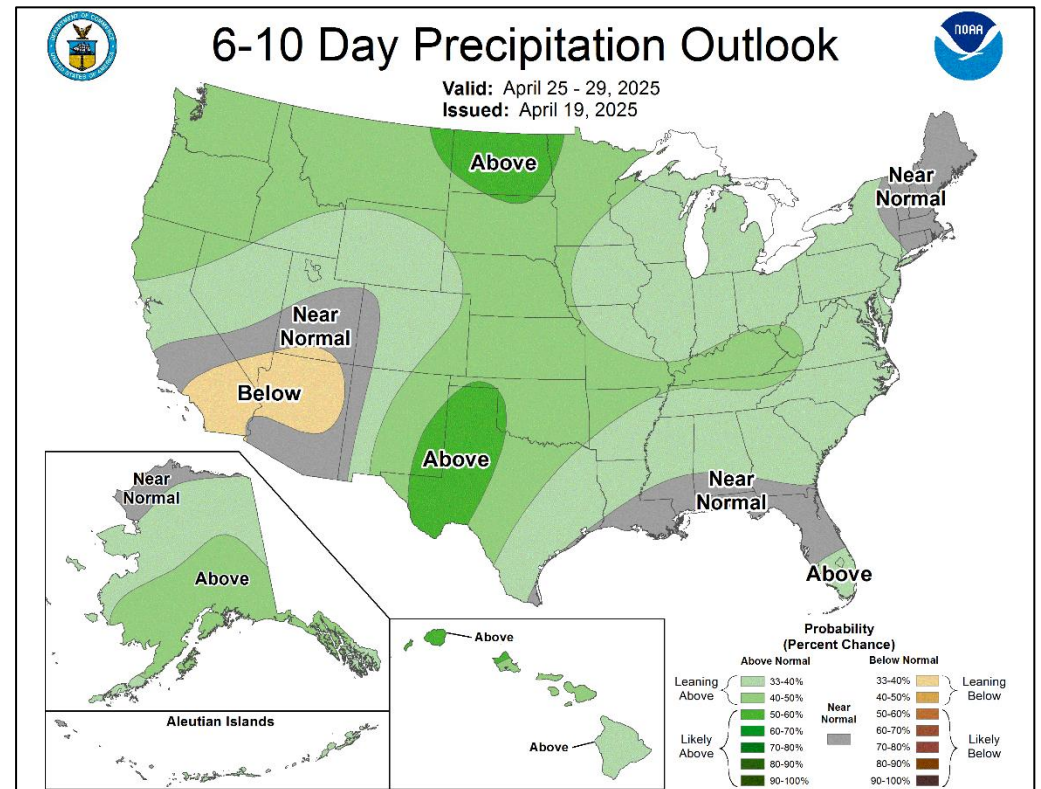
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Long Range Outlooks – Apr 25-29

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability



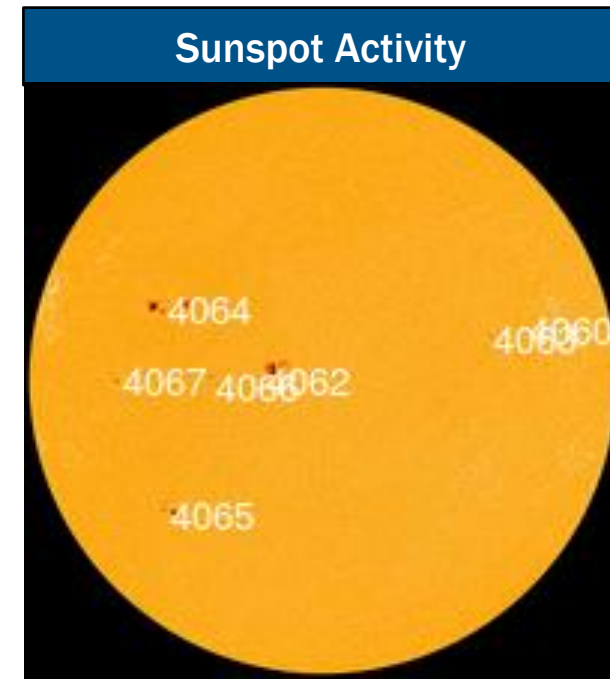
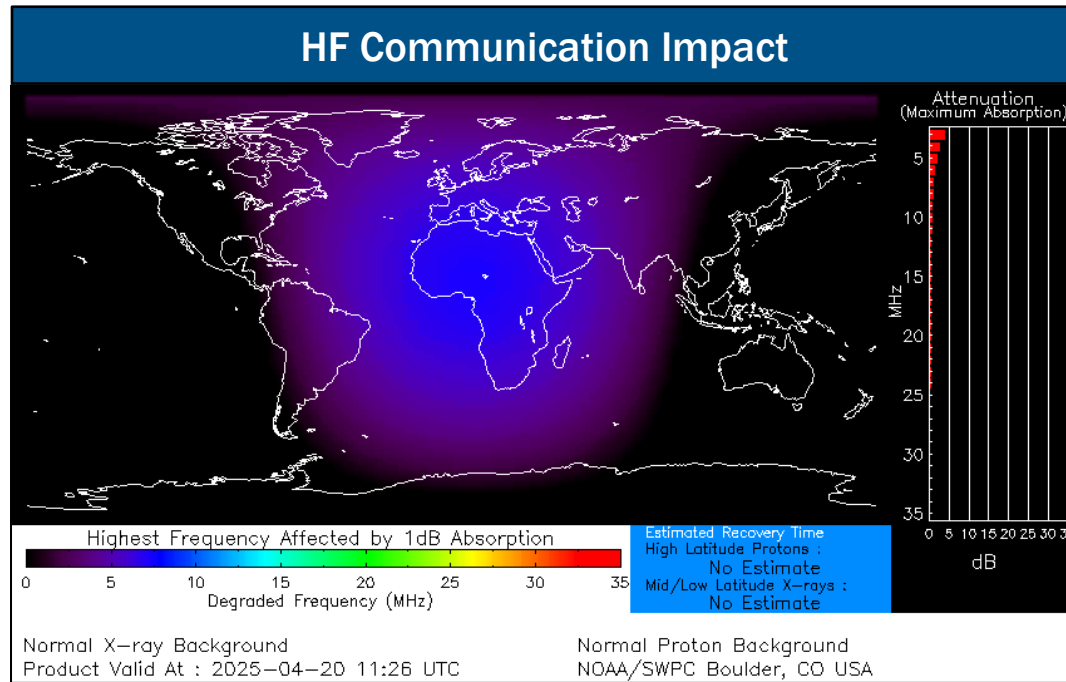

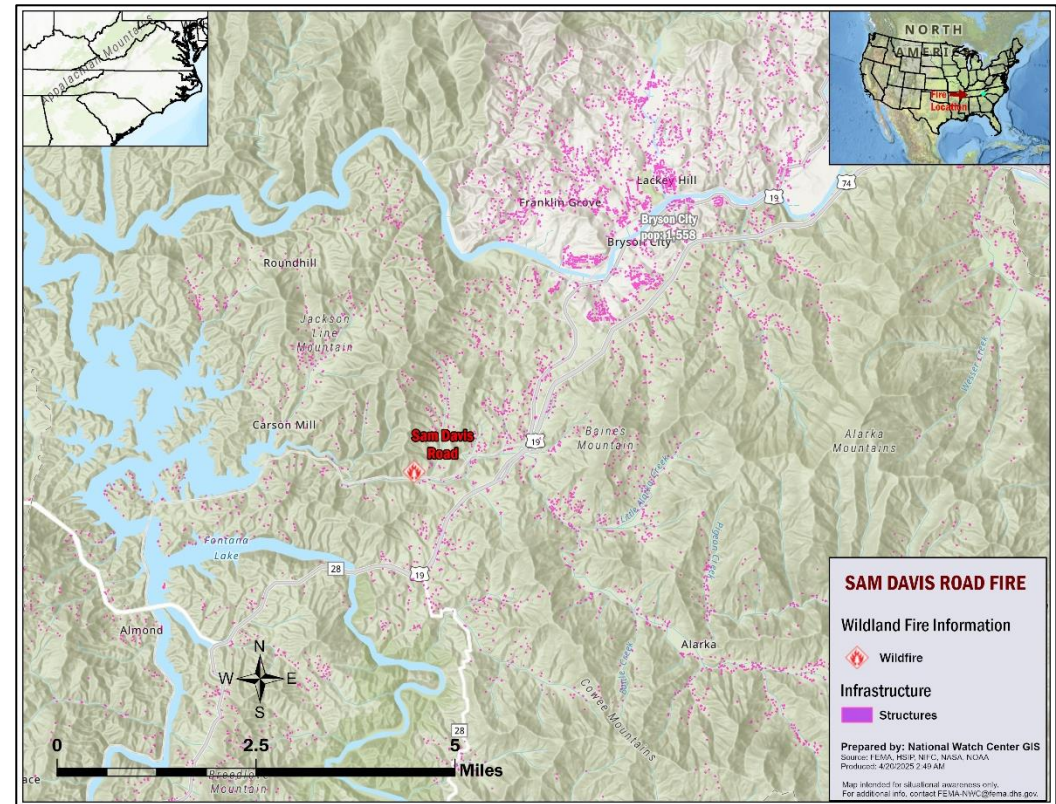
Situation: The Regional Administrator for FEMA Region IV approved a Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) for the Sam Davis Road Fire. The fire is burning on state and private land approximately five miles southwest of Bryson City, NC (est. pop 1.5k). Mandatory evacuations are in effect for 30 residencies.
