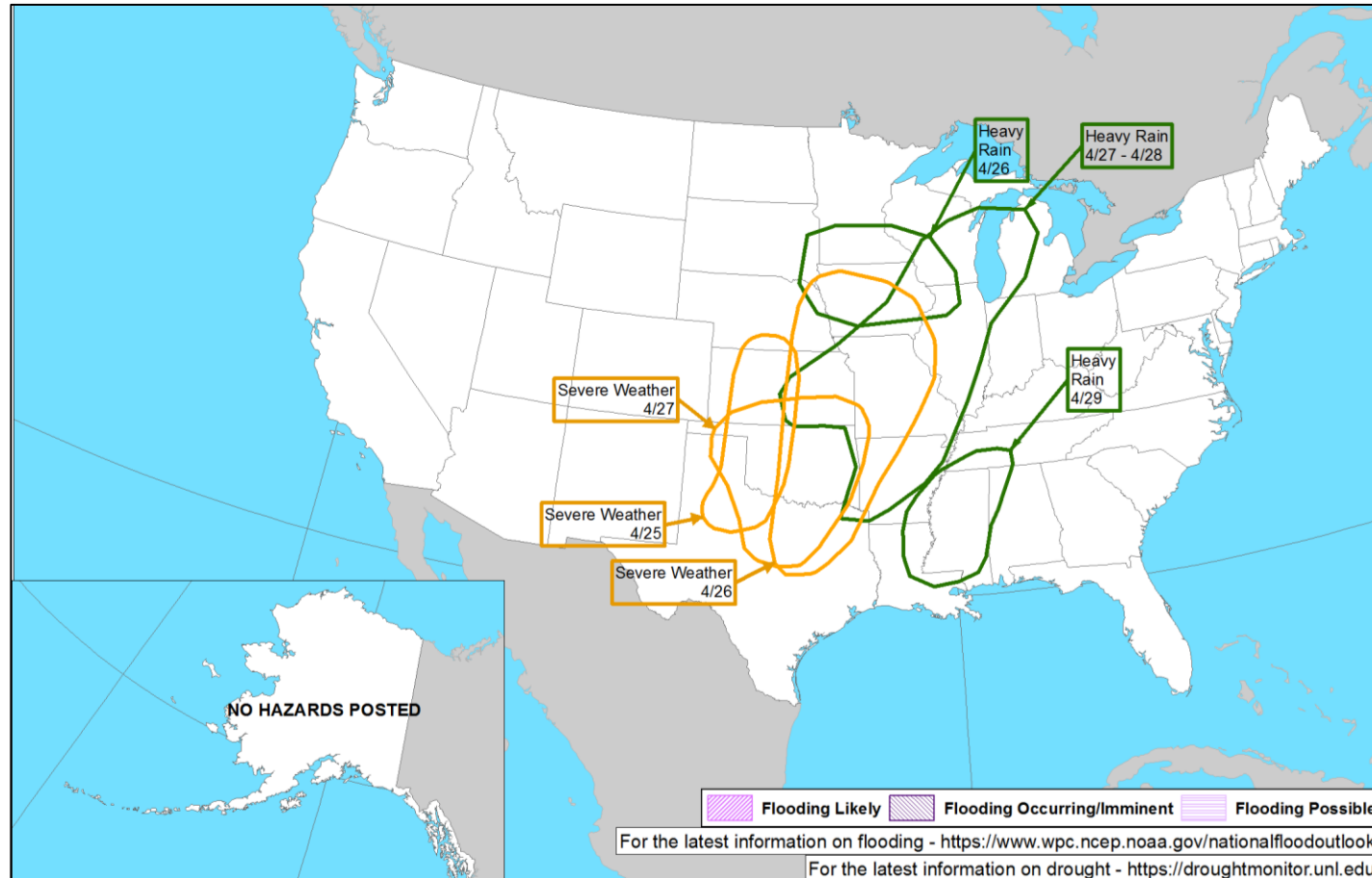
# Severe Weather Outlook

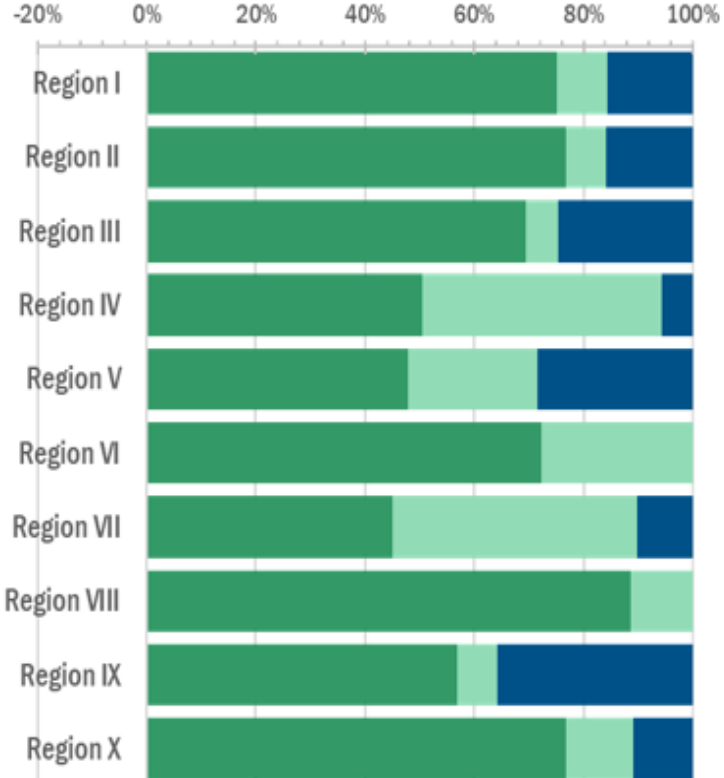

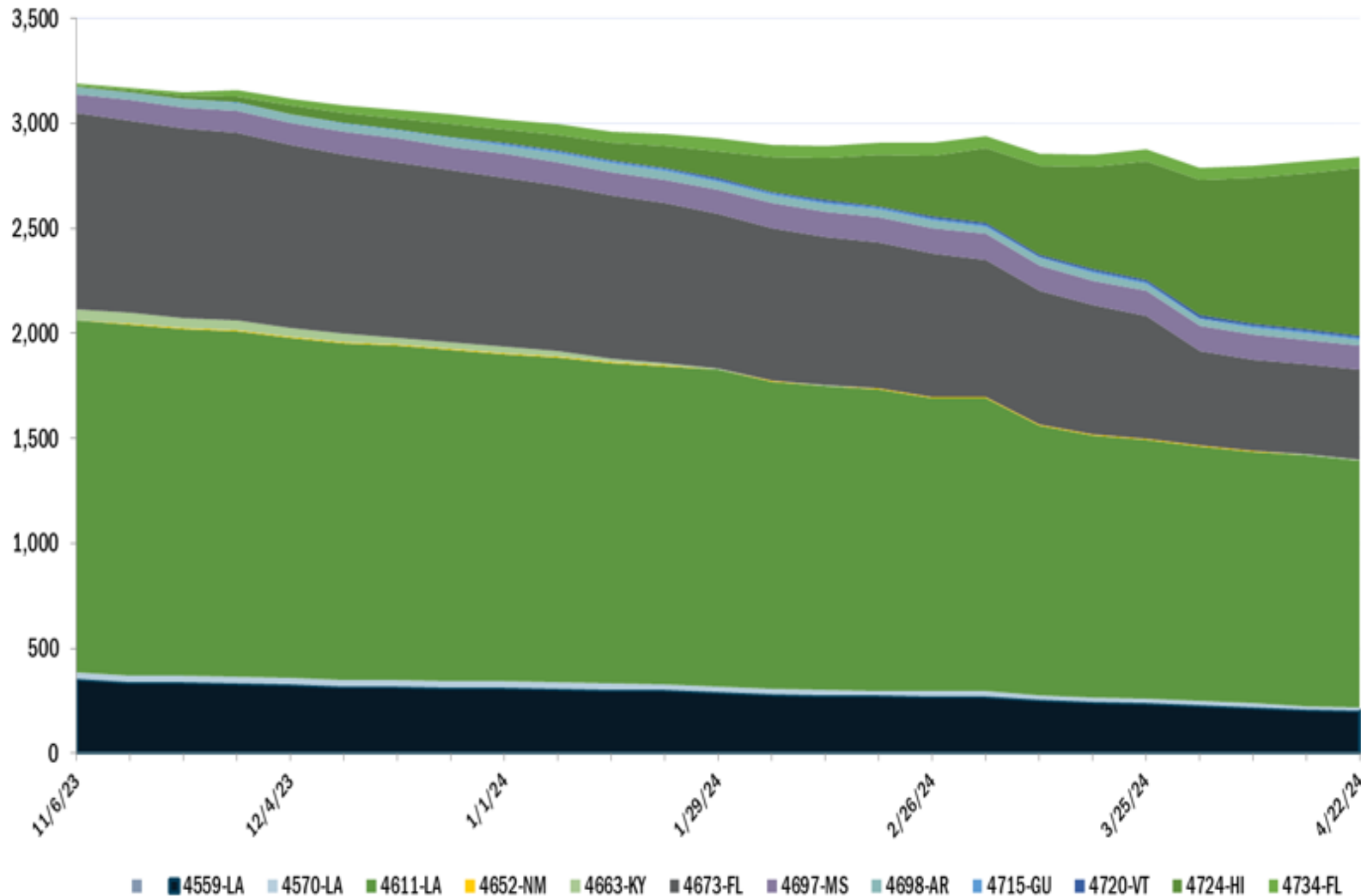

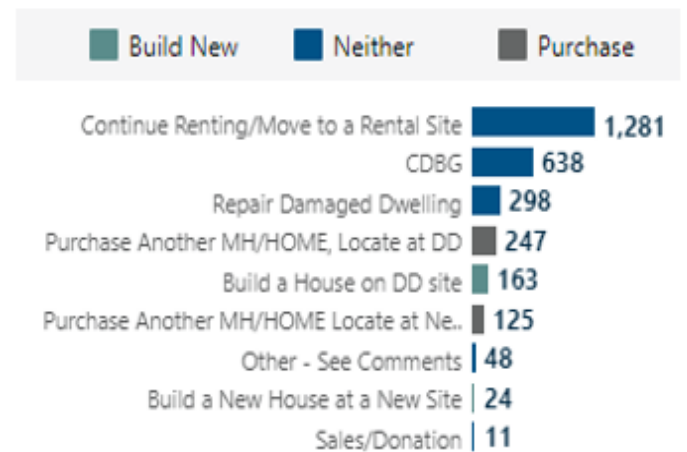

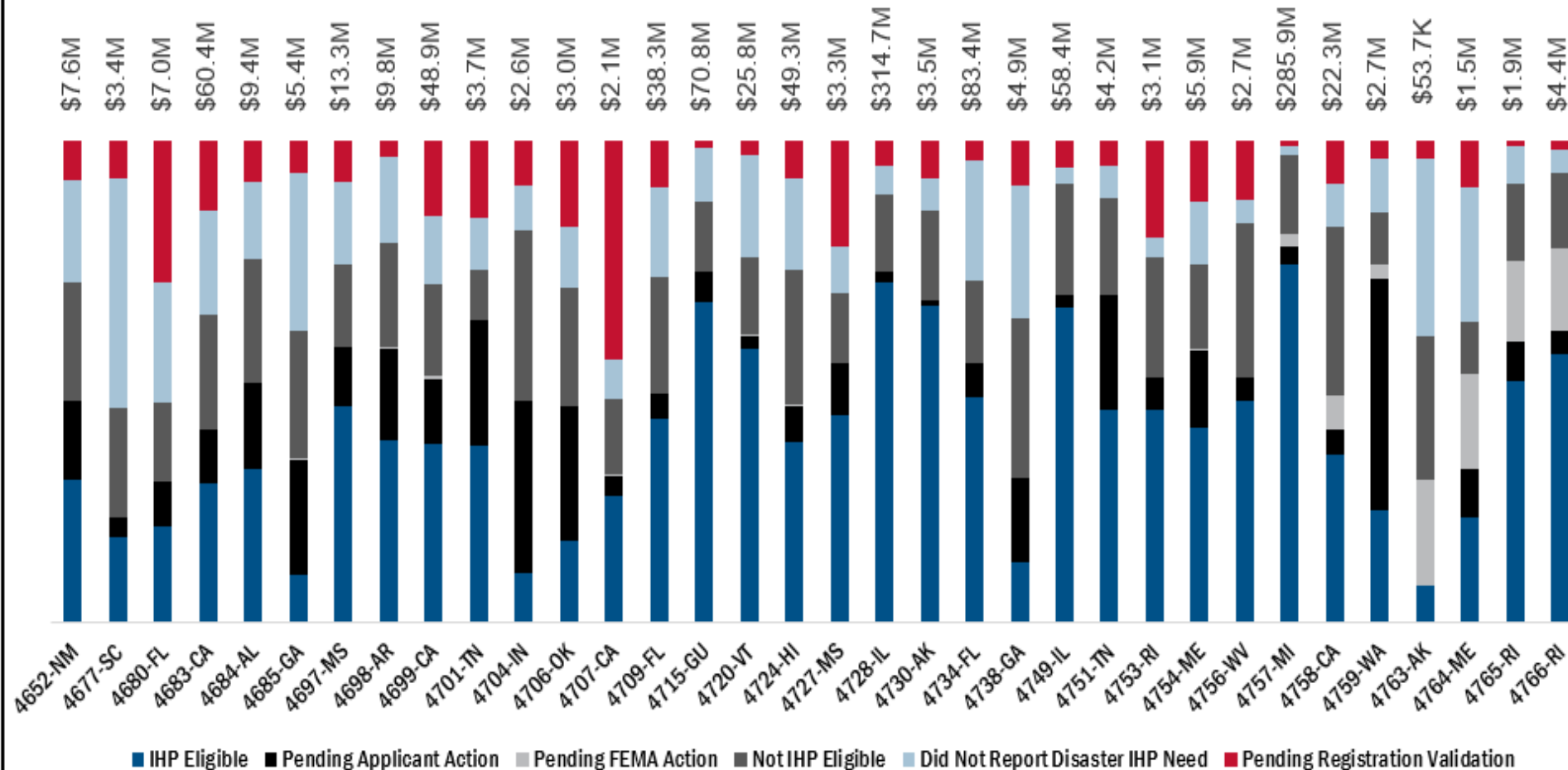

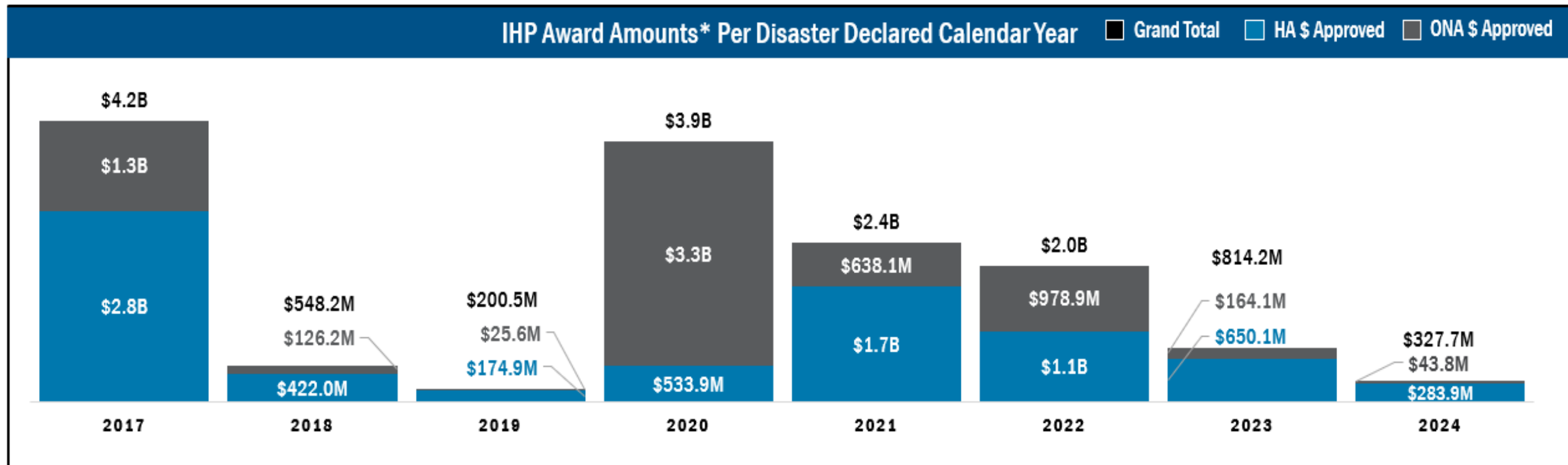
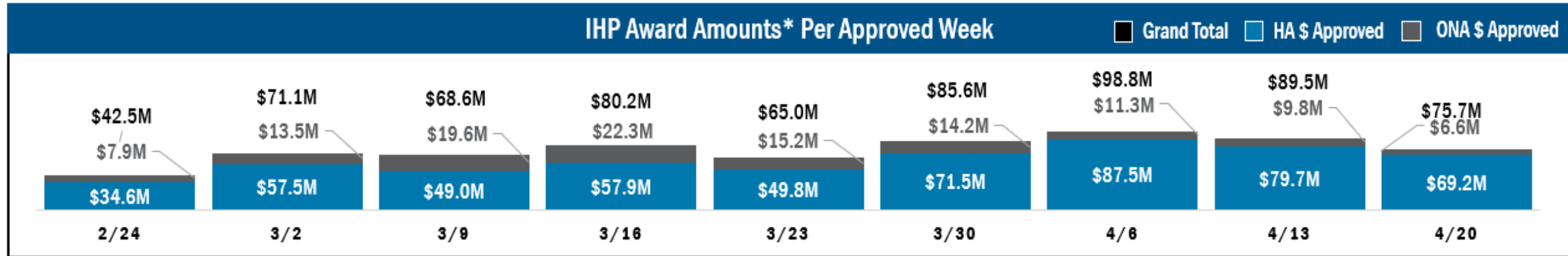
## Registrations in Active Declarations
