COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with our state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The President released Guidelines for Opening American Up Again and the Federal Government is continuing to work with governors across the country to ensure they have the equipment, supplies, and testing resources they need to reopen safely and responsibly. The HHS Secretary issued a renewal of the January 31 COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Declaration for 90 days.

- FEMA NRCC remains at Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all FEMA RRCCs activated
- FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed to 27 states/territories; LNOs deployed to 37 states/territories
- 56 major disaster declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 47,211 FEMA, DOD, HHS, VA and CDC personnel deployed/activated in support of COVID-19 response
 - 3,153 (-4) FEMA Employees deployed in support of COVID-19 response
- Testing: 6,075,703 (+192,300) cumulative as of Apr 30

Community Based Testing Sites (CBTS)

- 140,702 (+3,964) samples collected at CBTS locations since March 20
- 89,875 tests processed from Private-Partnership Testing Sites since April 5

Medical Countermeasure Development

- Umbrella Emergency Use Authorization granted for SARS-CoV-2 Antibody Tests that have been evaluated in an independent validation study by a government agency designated by FDA

Supply Chain Stabilization

- In collaboration with the Healthcare Resilience Task Force, published the Decontamination System public messaging package to healthcare facilities and other stakeholders

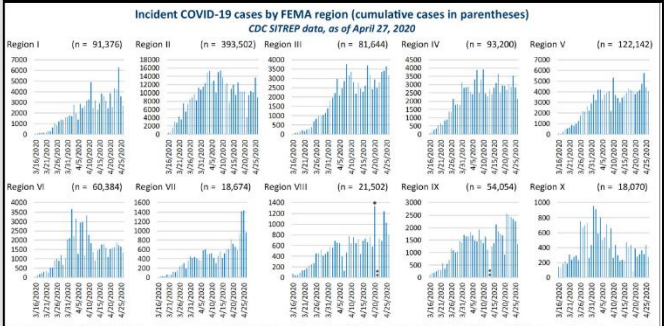
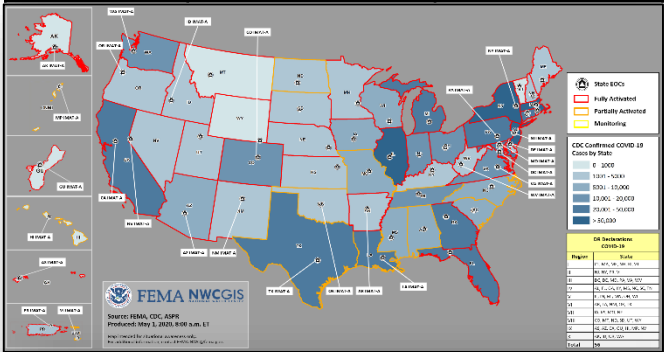
- CDC and EPA released joint guidance for cleaning and disinfecting spaces when reopening America

Data and Analysis

- Completed national level report to visualize total ventilators on hand and projected ventilator demand across the nation; product delivered to Chief of the NRCS on April 29
- Completed analyses of various scenarios following shelter in place restrictions to model expected peaks and inform the demand for therapeutic treatments through 2021; analyses provided to the Medical Counter Measures Task Force on April 29

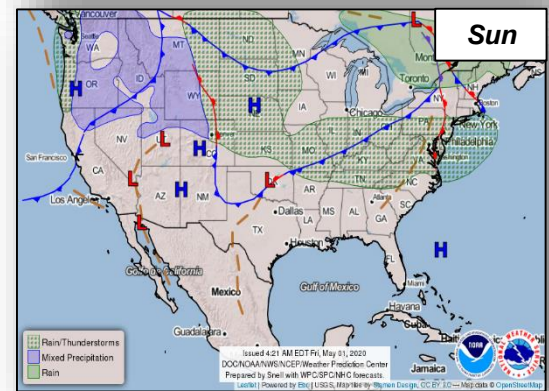
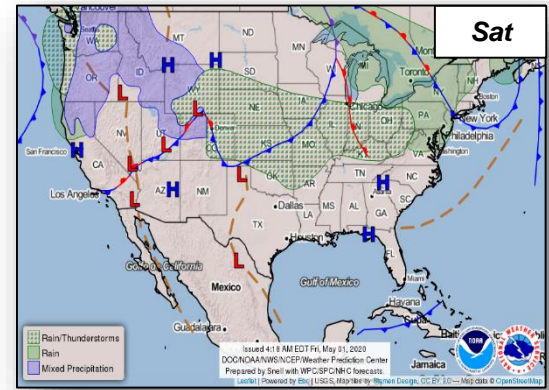
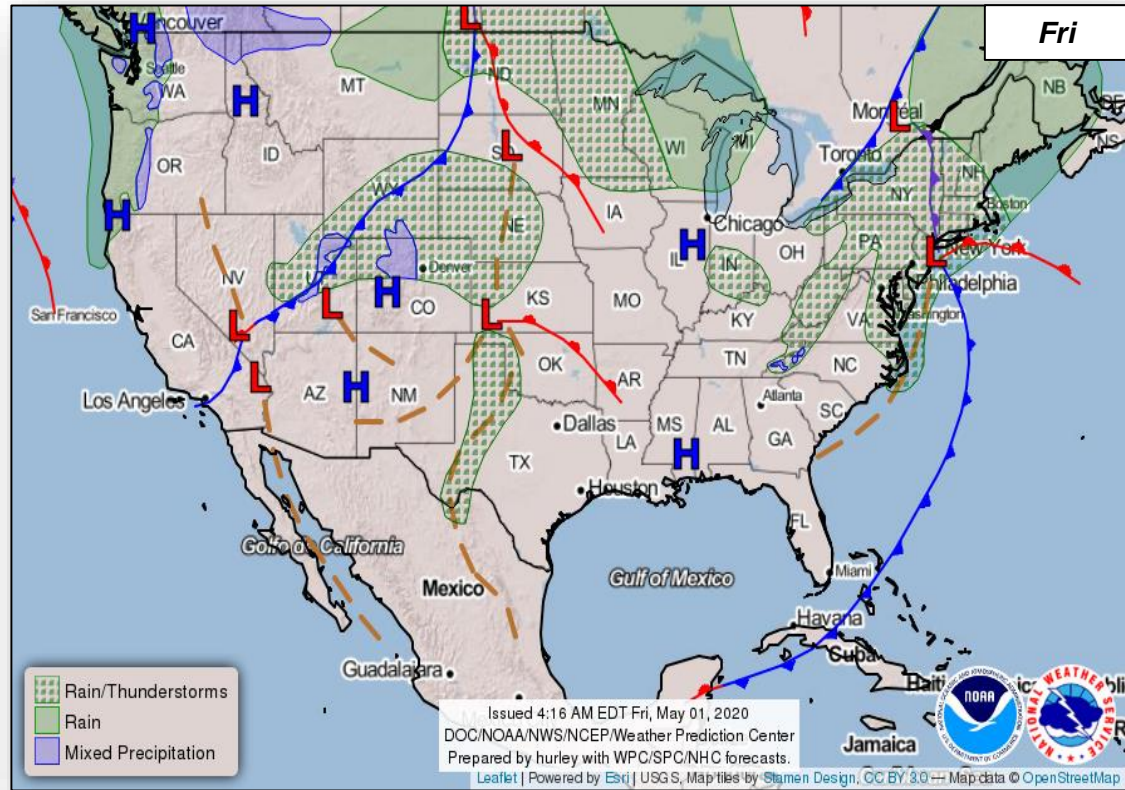

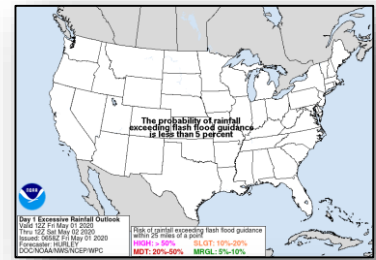
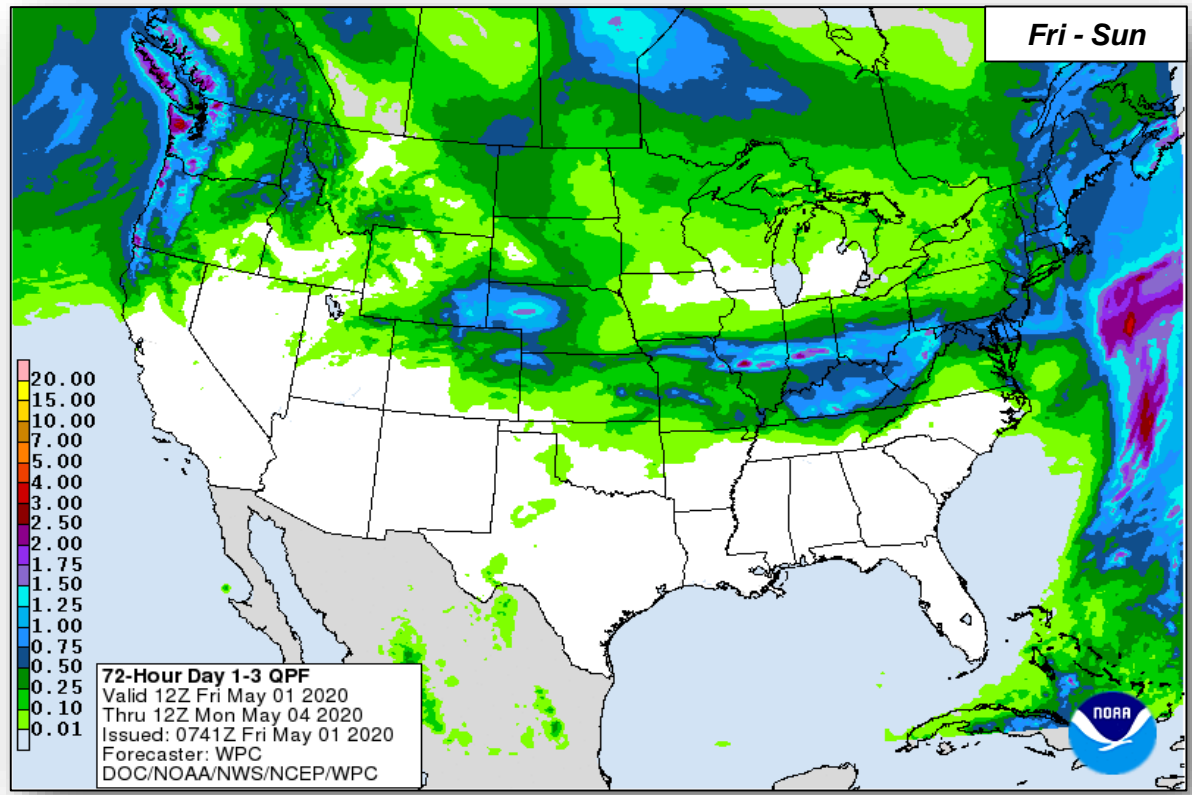
National Weather Forecast



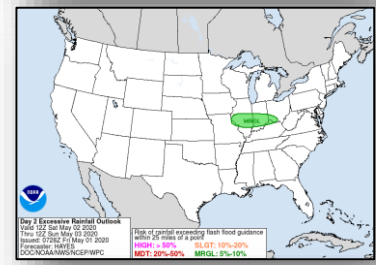
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



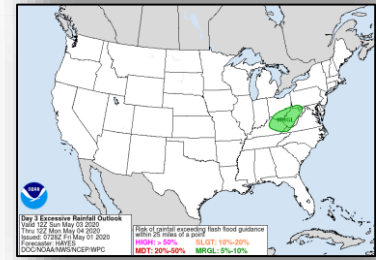

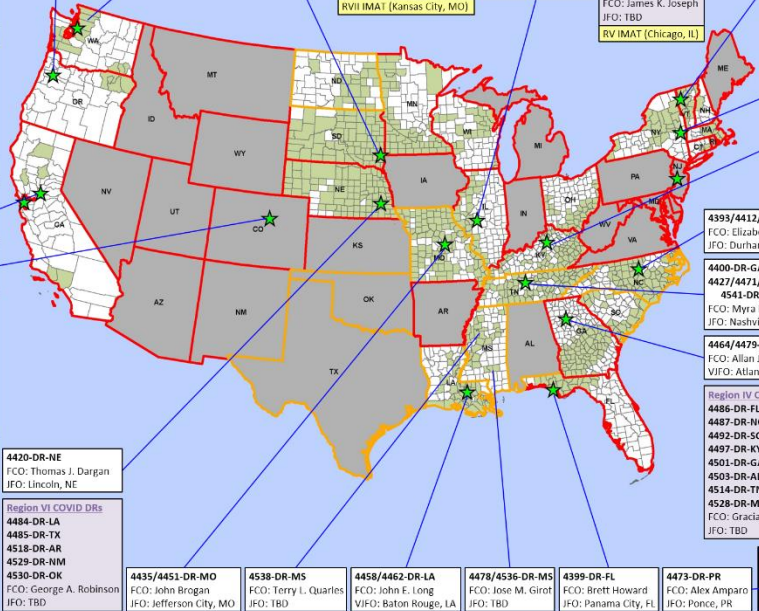
