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Severe Weather – FEMA Regions VI & VII

Situation: Overnight, a regional outbreak of severe weather with multiple intense (Radar indicated EF3+), long-tracked tornadoes, as well as very large hail and severe thunderstorm gusts, occurred over parts of the South and Central Plains. Reported damage in impacted areas so far have included local vehicle accidents and water rescues, downed trees, and damages to roofs and various structures. (NWSChat, 01:30 a.m. ET)

Lifelines: (RVI SPOTREP as of 12:00 a.m. ET, May 7)

Safety and Security:

FEMA Region VI:

- OK: Local searches expected for this morning
 - 5 injuries / 0 fatalities
 - State assets requested for activation

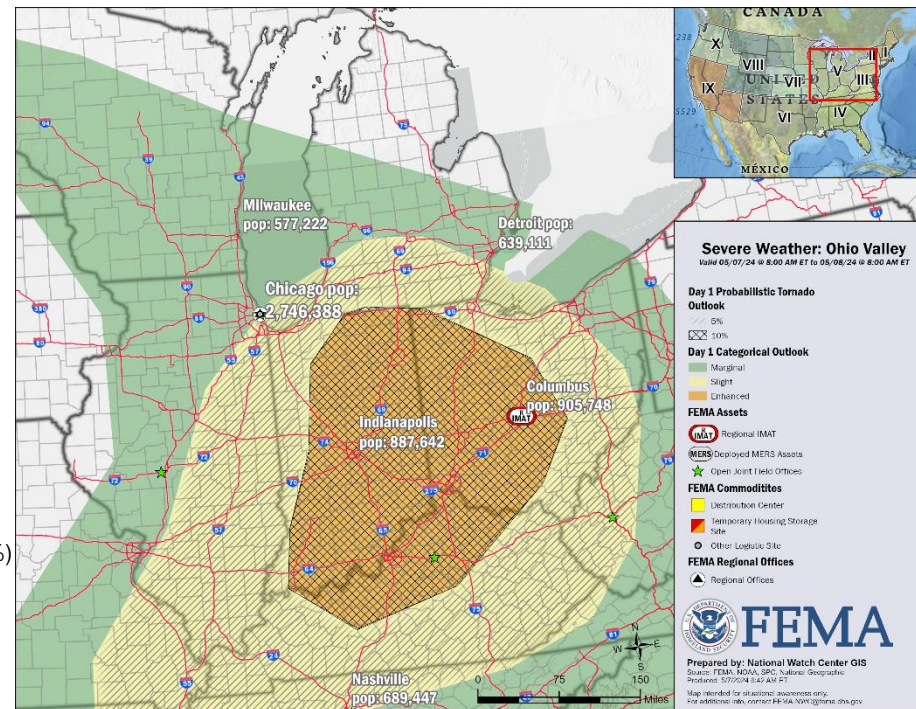
Food, Hydration, Shelter:

FEMA Region VI:

- OK: ~30-40 homes damaged or destroyed; State assessments ongoing
 - Barnsdall nursing home received significant damage; patients evacuated
 - 2 ARC shelters open / 13 occupants

Energy: (DOE EAGLE-I as of 7:30 a.m. ET, May 7)

- OK: Minimal power outages
 - Oklahoma County – 4k customers without power (1%)
 - Washington County – 4k customers without power (22%)
 - Osage County – 2k customers without power (10%)
- AR:
 - Crawford County – 5k customers without power (15%)
 - Marion County – 1k customers without power (15%)



State / Local Response:

FEMA Region VI:

- TX SEOC at Partial Activation
 - Gov declared a State of Disaster
- OK EOC at Partial Activation (Wildfires/Severe Weather)

FEMA Region VII:

- NE, KS, and MO EOCs: Partial Activation (Severe Weather)

FEMA Response:

Region VI:

- RWC at Monitoring; RRCC at Level III
- R-IMAT 1 deployed to OK EOC; R-IMAT 2 is available

Region VII:

- RWC at Monitoring; RRCC is Rostered
- IMAT-1 remains deployed to NE (4778-DR)

HQ:

- All 4 ISBs are available
- FEMA NWC continues to monitor in coordination with FEMA Regions VI and VII



Flooding – Texas – FINAL

Situation: The threat of moderate to major river flooding continues across portions of southeast Texas. Recovery efforts are still ongoing, Texas state agencies continue to support requests for governmental help. Flood Warnings remain in effect for portions of southeast Texas. Currently, there are 6 (-6) rivers in major flood stage, 18 (-2) rivers in moderate flood stage, and 43 (+2) in minor flood stage. Flood Warnings continue for 2.4m (+300k) people in the effected area. (AHPS as of 2:00 a.m. ET, May 7)

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA Region VI ESAR as of 6:59 p.m. ET, May 6)

Safety and Security:

- TX: 160 total evacuations
- TX: 202 rescues/398 total contacts (individuals who experienced flooding but needed no assistance)
- Texas A&M TF 1 and 2, TX National Guard, and TDEM remain engaged and available to support local response activities

Food, Hydration, Shelter:

- 13 (+3) ARC shelters open w/ 152 (+26) occupants across 5 counties

Water Systems:

- TX: A boil water notice issued impacting 29K customers

Transportation:

- TX: TXDOT reported a total of 86 roads impacted by high water, with 34 roads closed

State / Local Response:

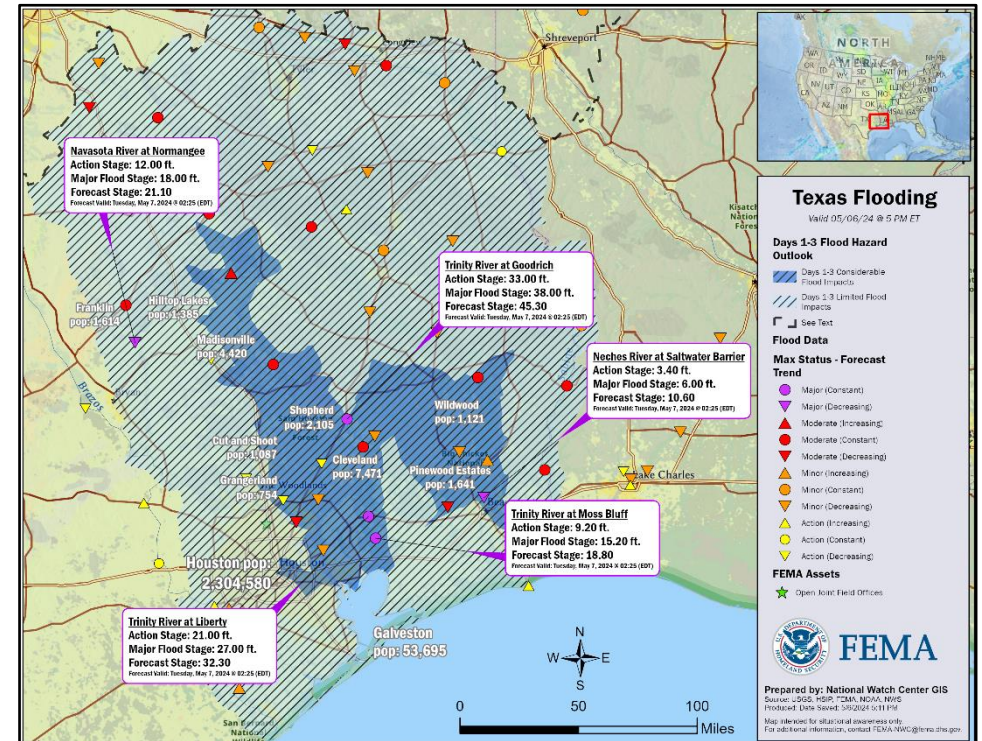
- TX: SEOC remains at Partial Activation (Severe Weather)
- TX: Gov declared a state's disaster

FEMA / Federal Response:

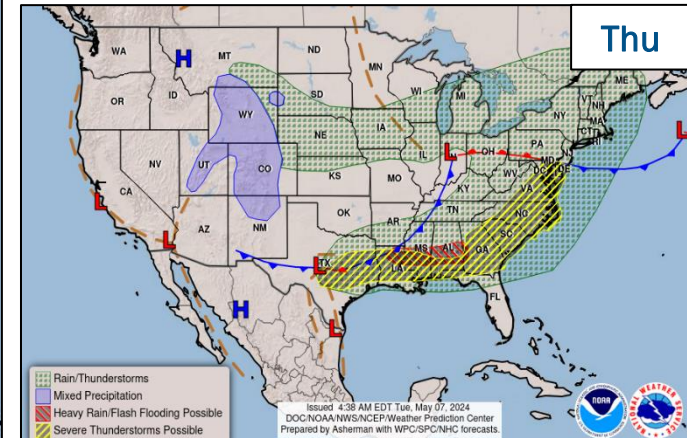
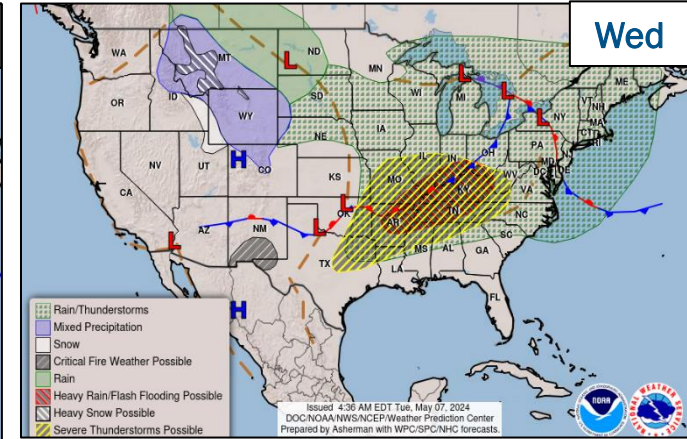
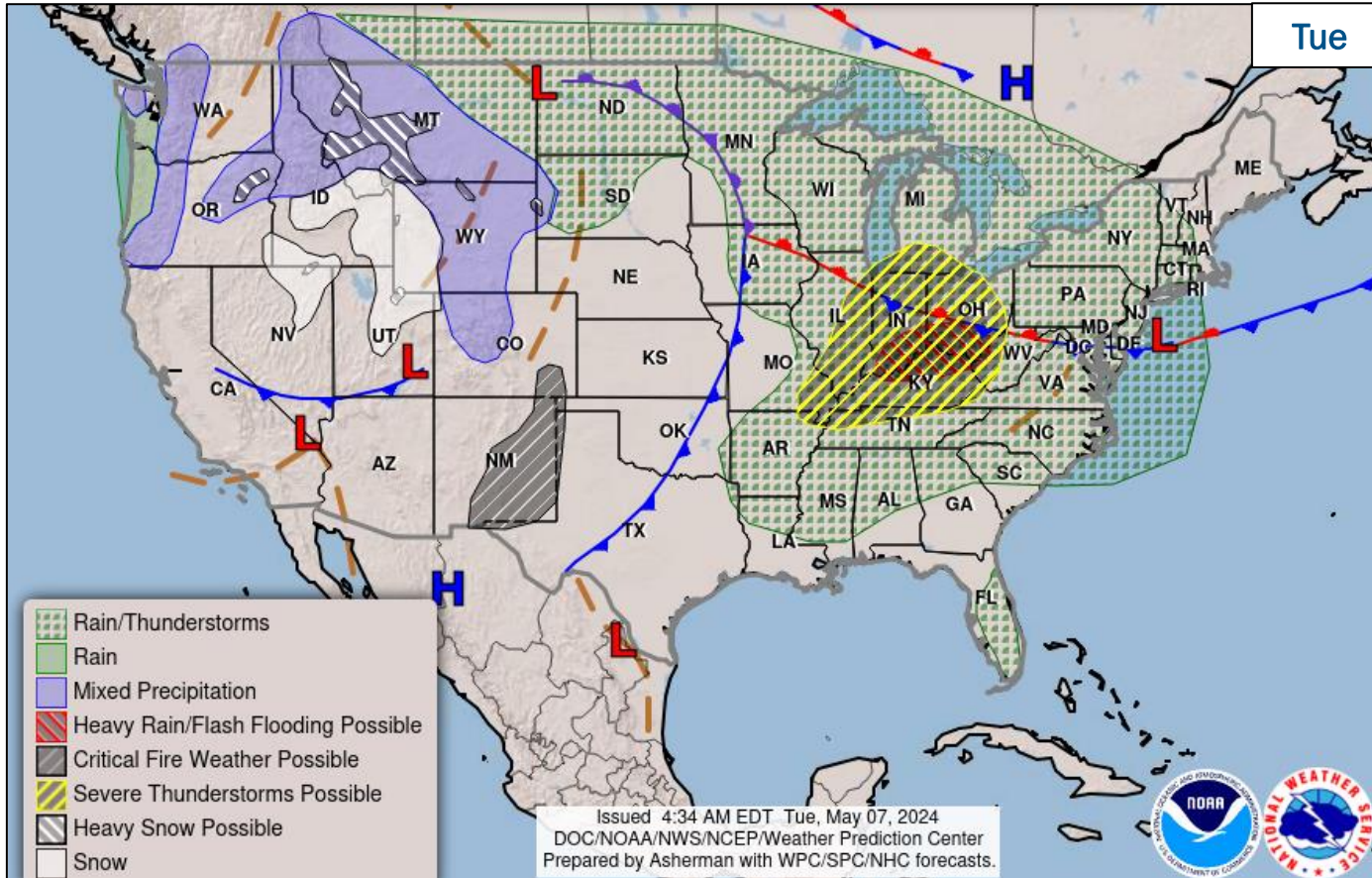
- FEMA RVI at Monitoring; RRCC is at Level III
- R-IMAT 1 remains deployed to OK; R-IMAT 2 is available
- Region is coordinating with HQ Response Geospatial Office on any potential imagery requirements

HQ:

- NWC is at Monitoring; NRCC is Activated (Sustained Operations)
- Response remains in close coordination with FEMA Region VI for any potential requirements; however, currently there have been no requests for FEMA assistance



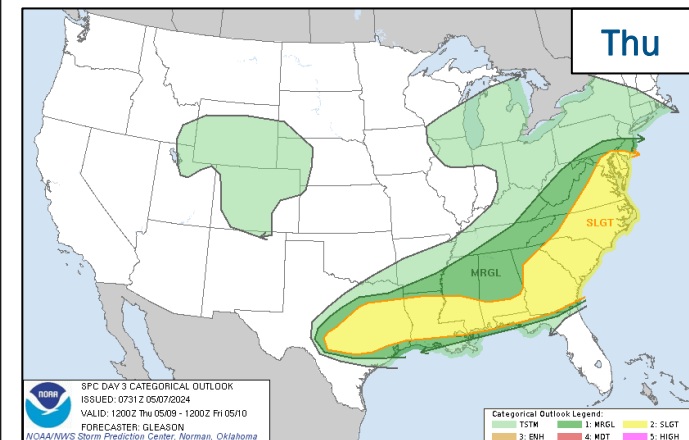
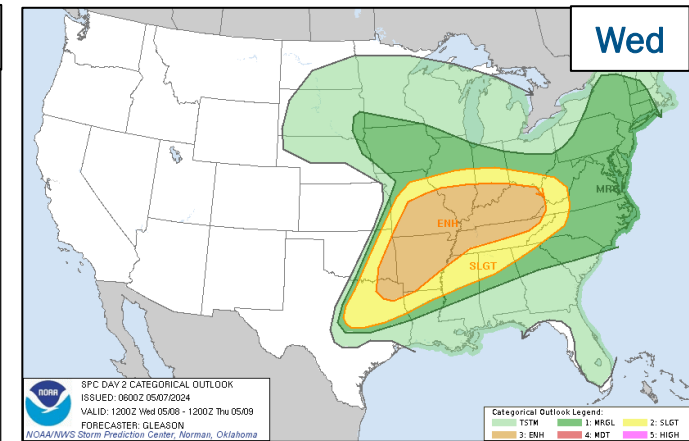
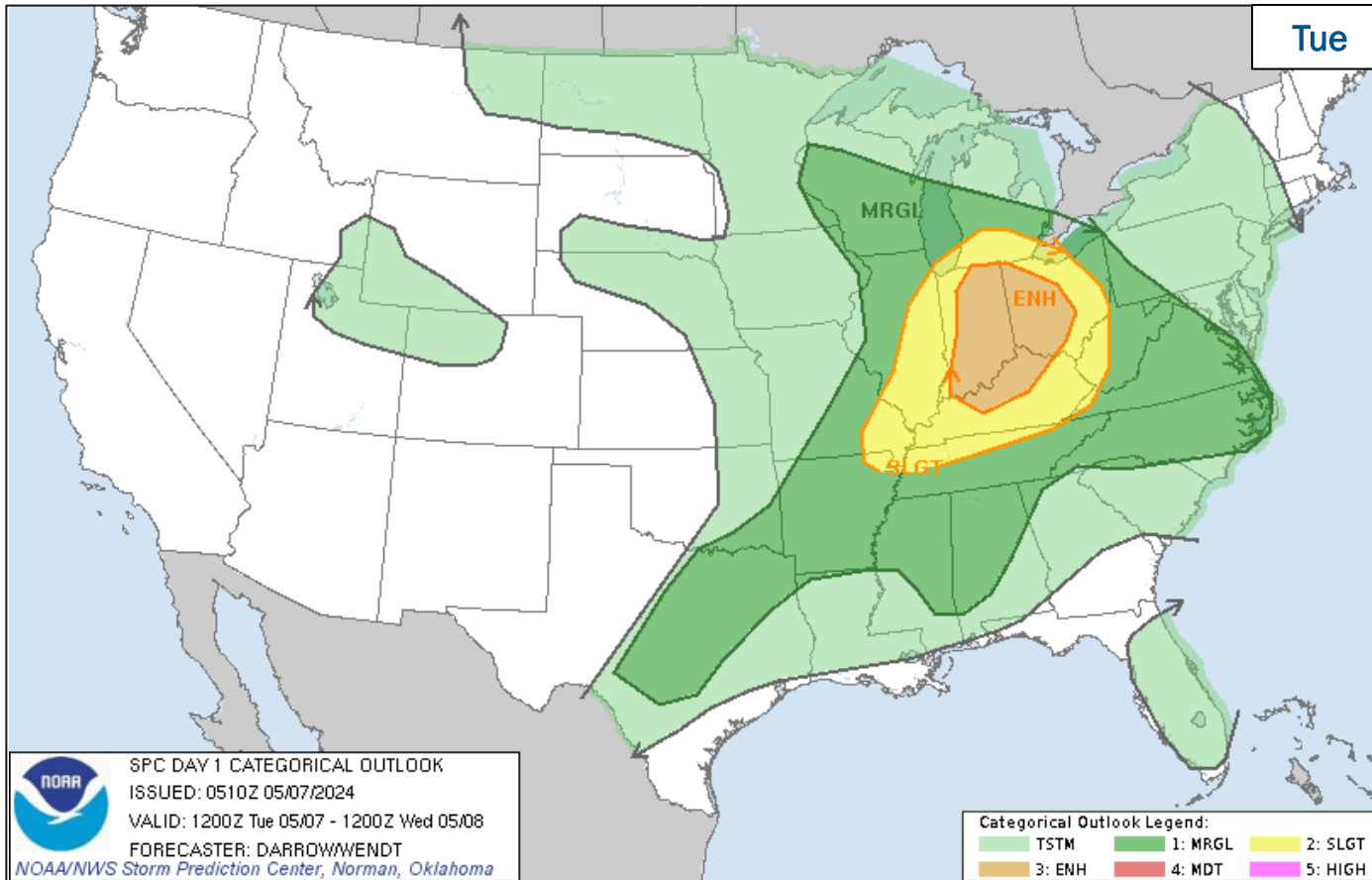
National Weather Forecast

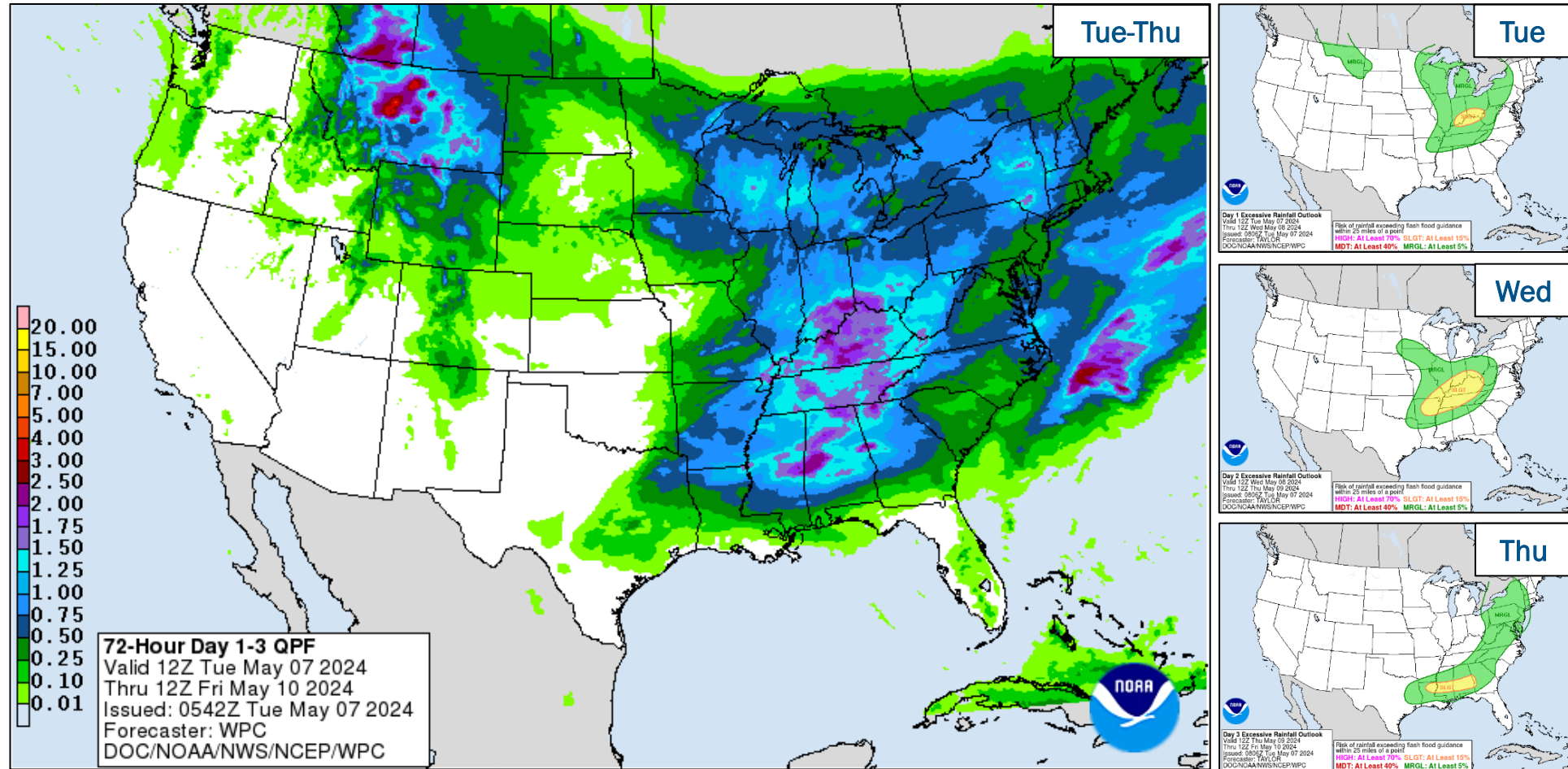
Severe Weather Outlook



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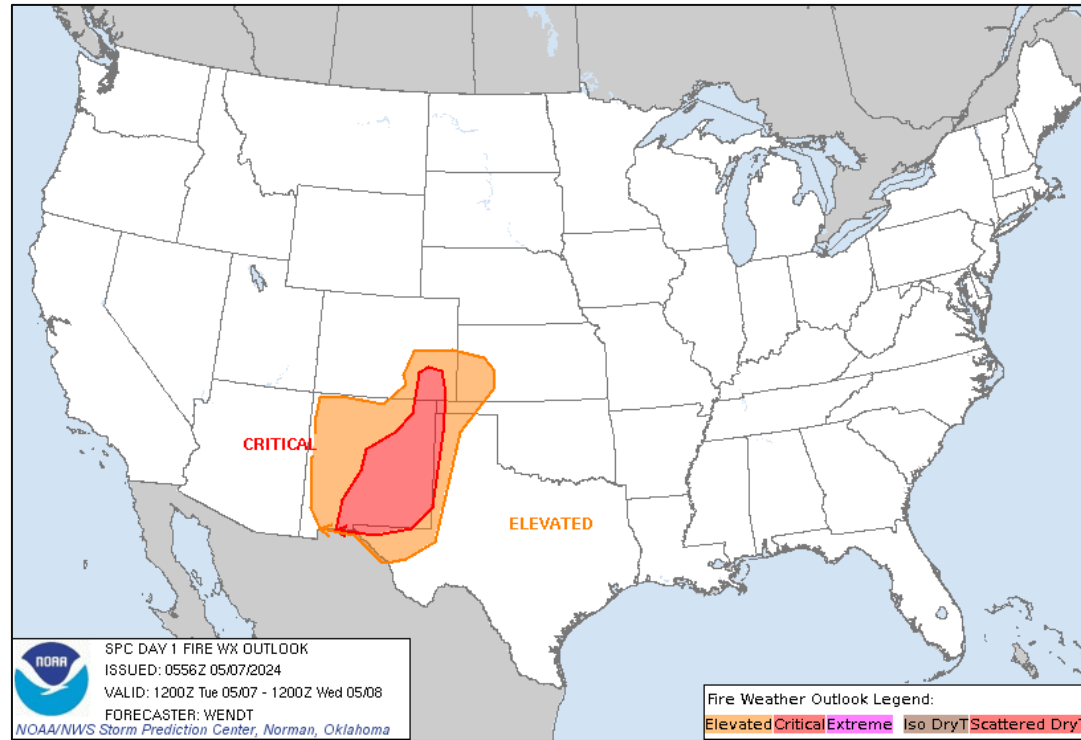
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



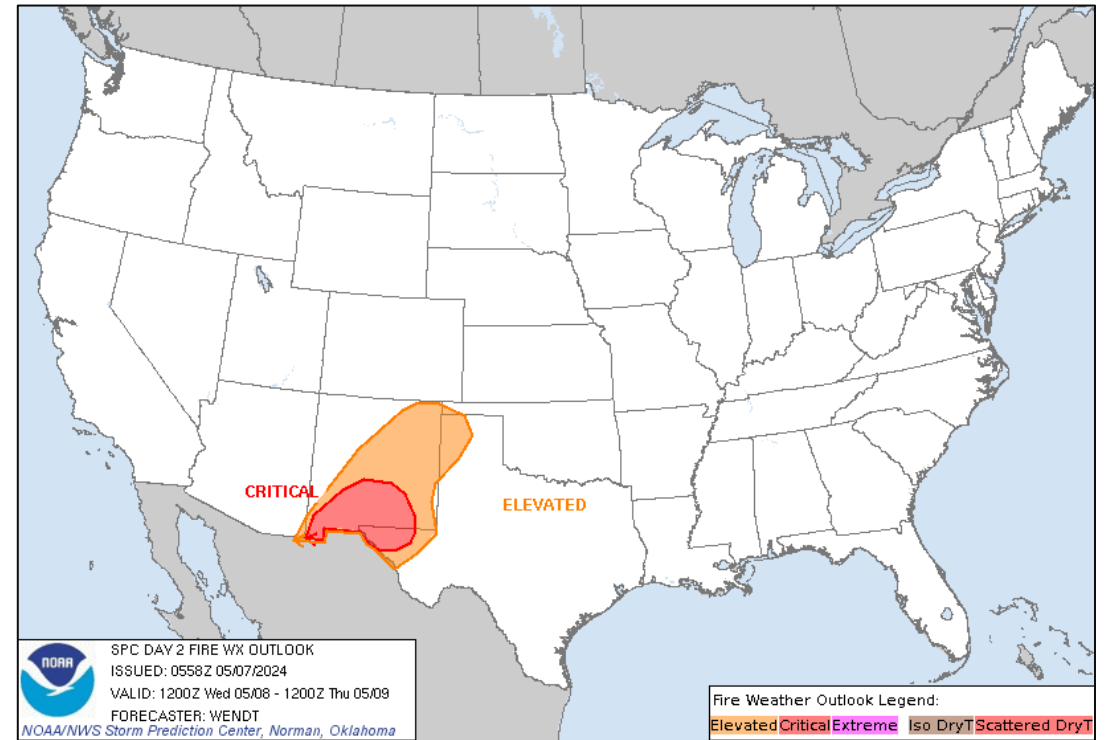

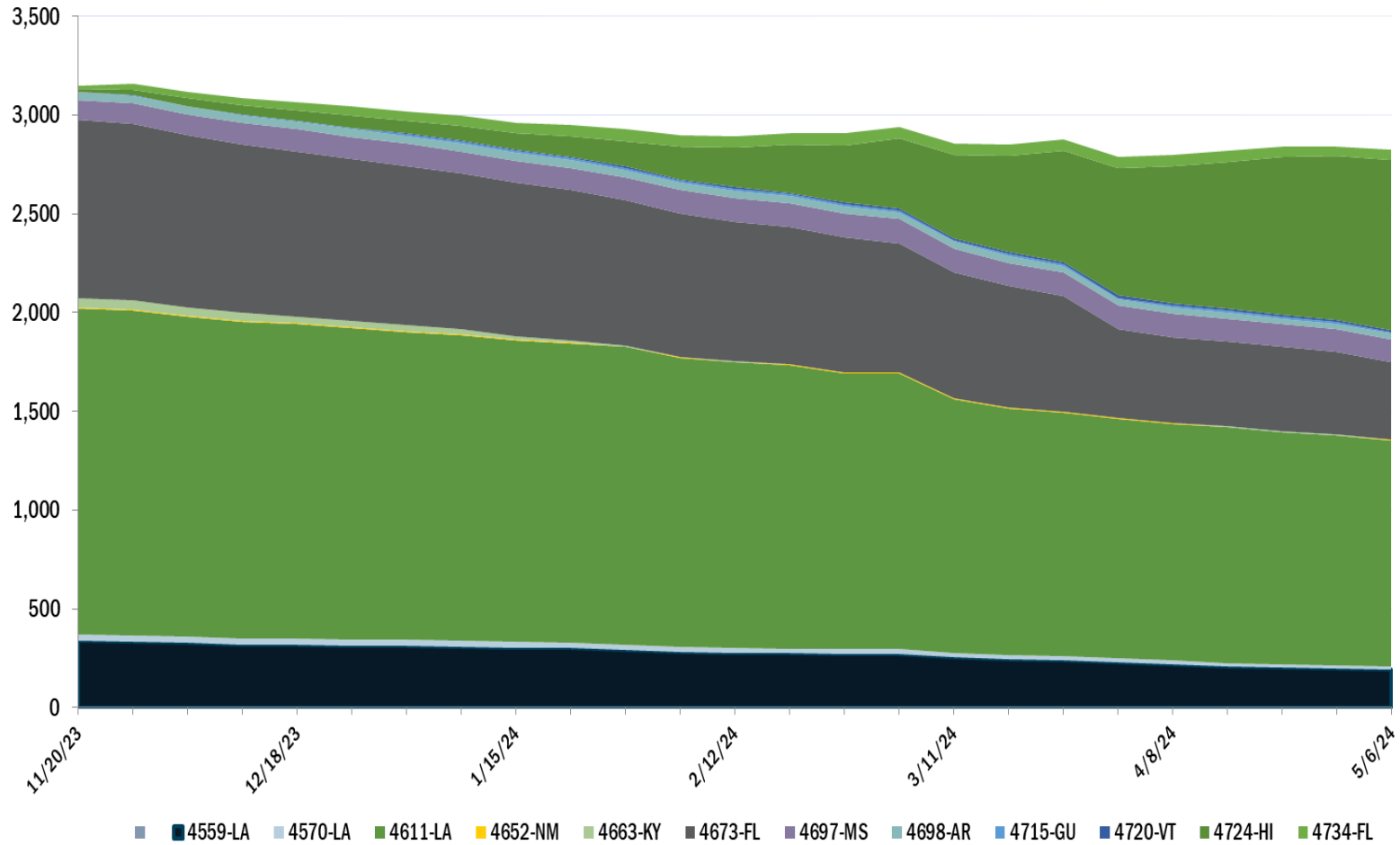

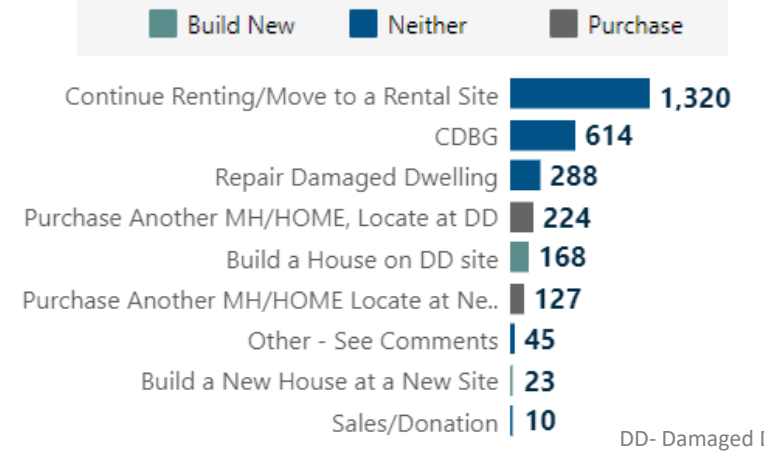
