<u>Situation:</u> FEMA, HHS, and federal partners continue working with state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to execute a Whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Among the 17 states not presently experiencing a decrease in confirmed cases, 7 have no stay-at-home order in place, 1 has local or limited stay-at-home order, and 9 have statewide stay-at-home orders in place. 

- Over 5K reported COVID-19 cases at 115 meat processing facilities nationwide Transportation
- U.S. Coast Guard is monitoring 84 cargo vessels with crewmembers that embarked at a coronavirus port of interest within 14 days of the vessels' scheduled arrival at a U.S. port; 24 will arrive in the next 24 hours















Severe Weather Outlook





