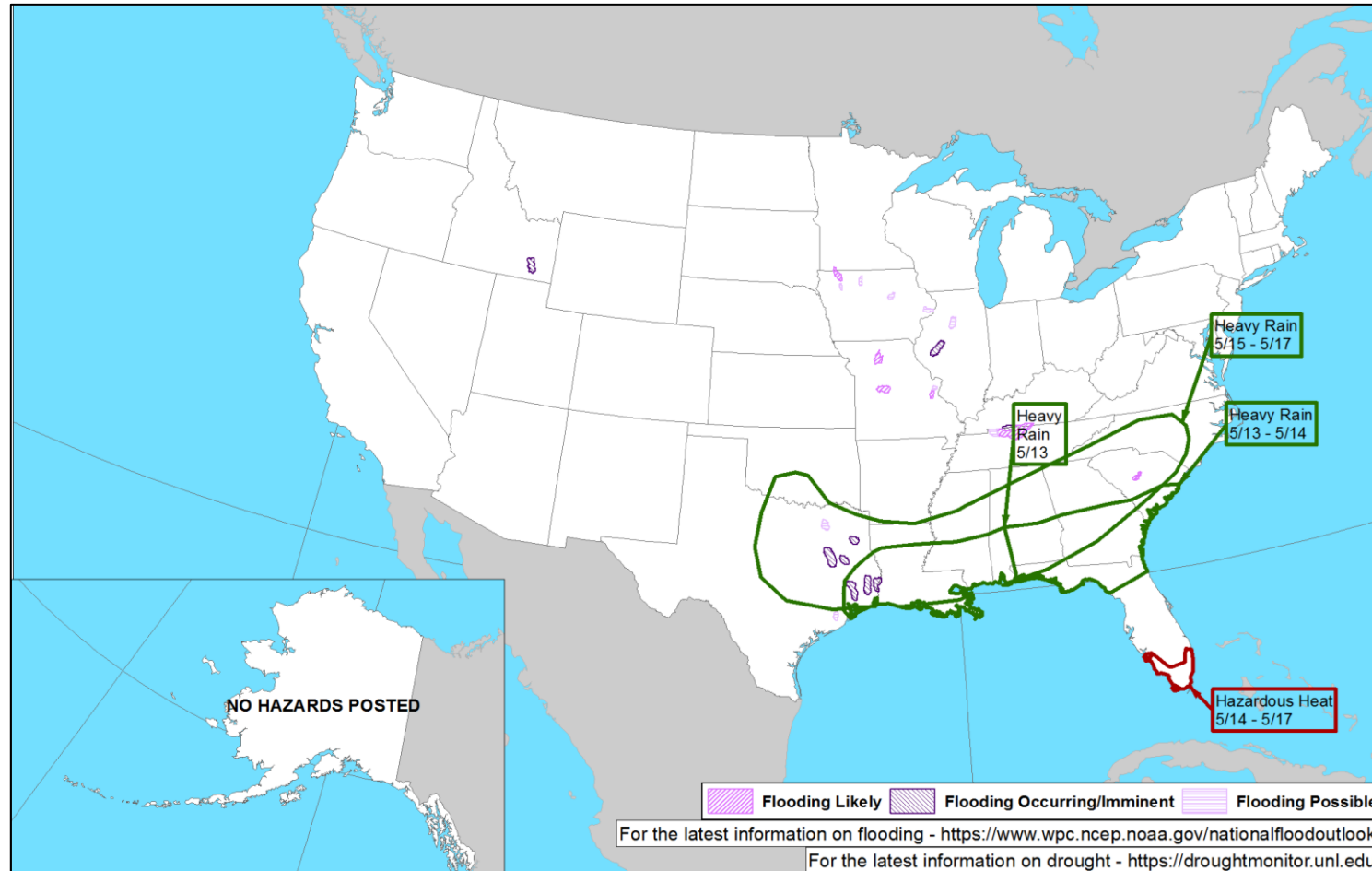
Severe Weather Outlook

Hazards Outlook – May 13-17

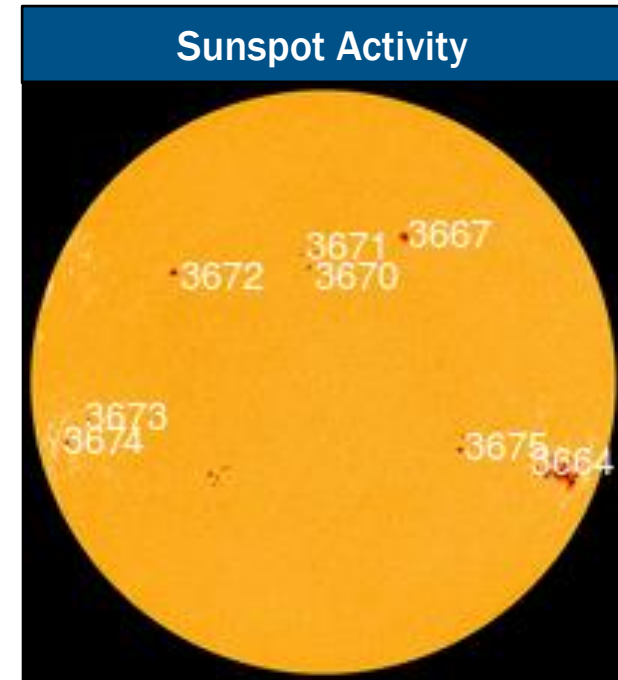
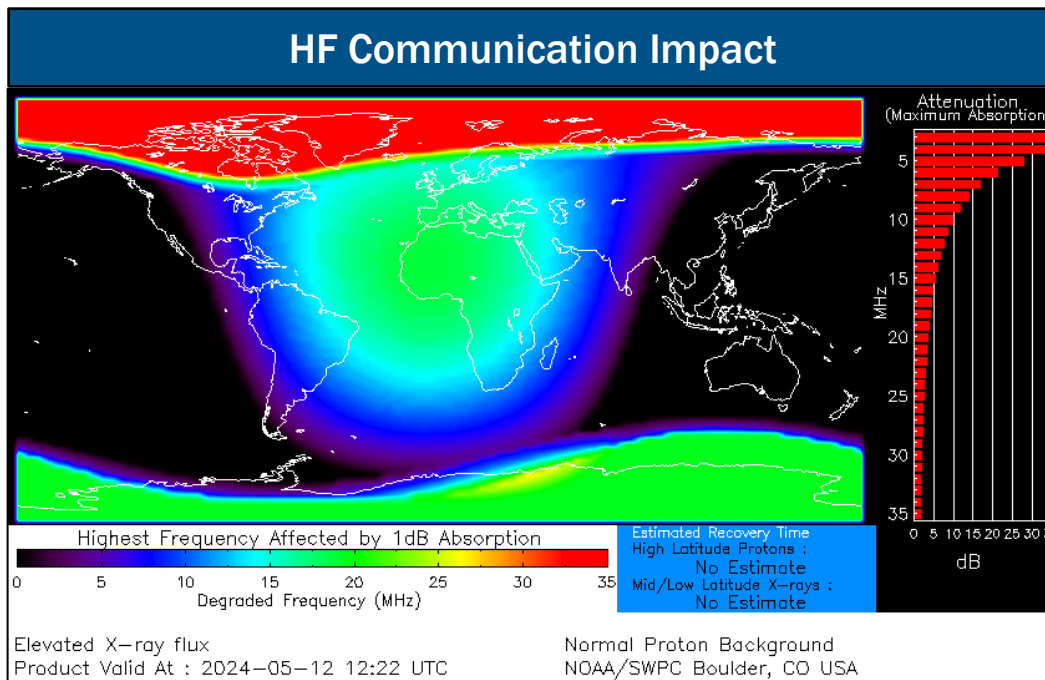

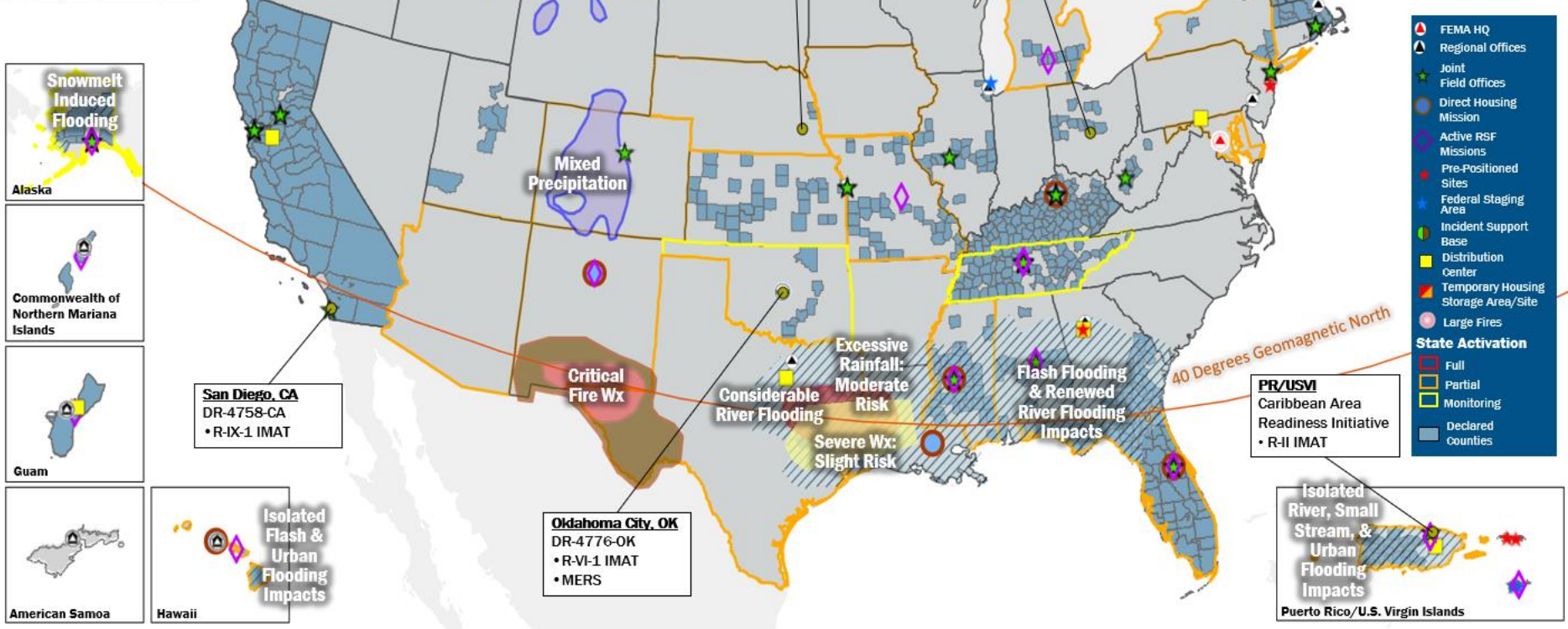
