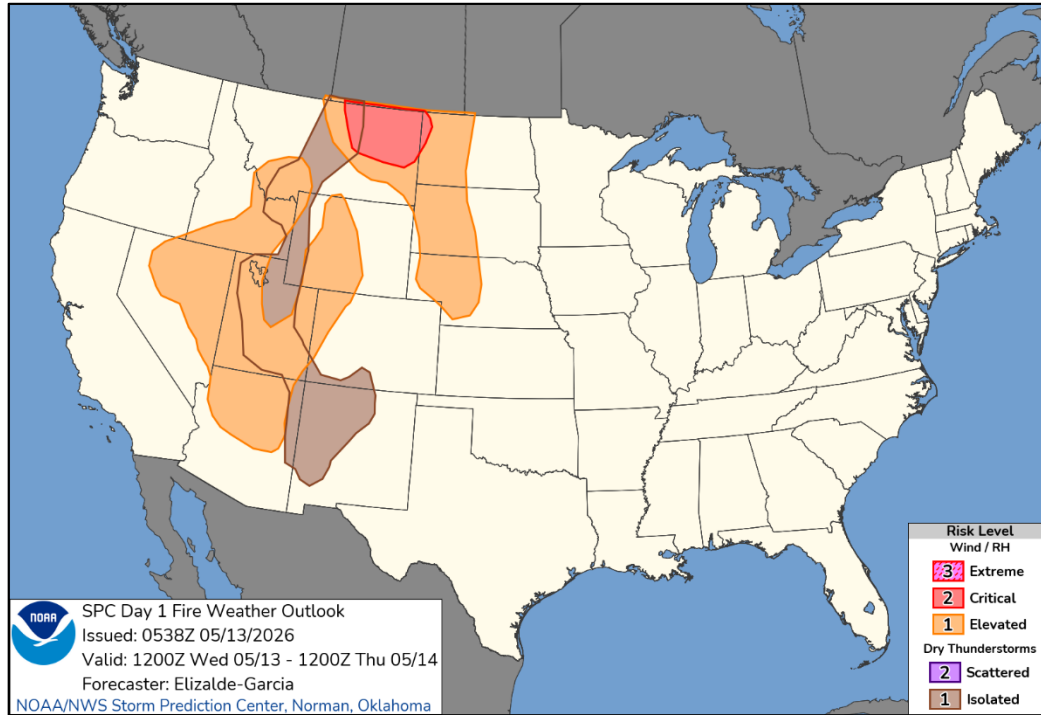
National Weather Forecast



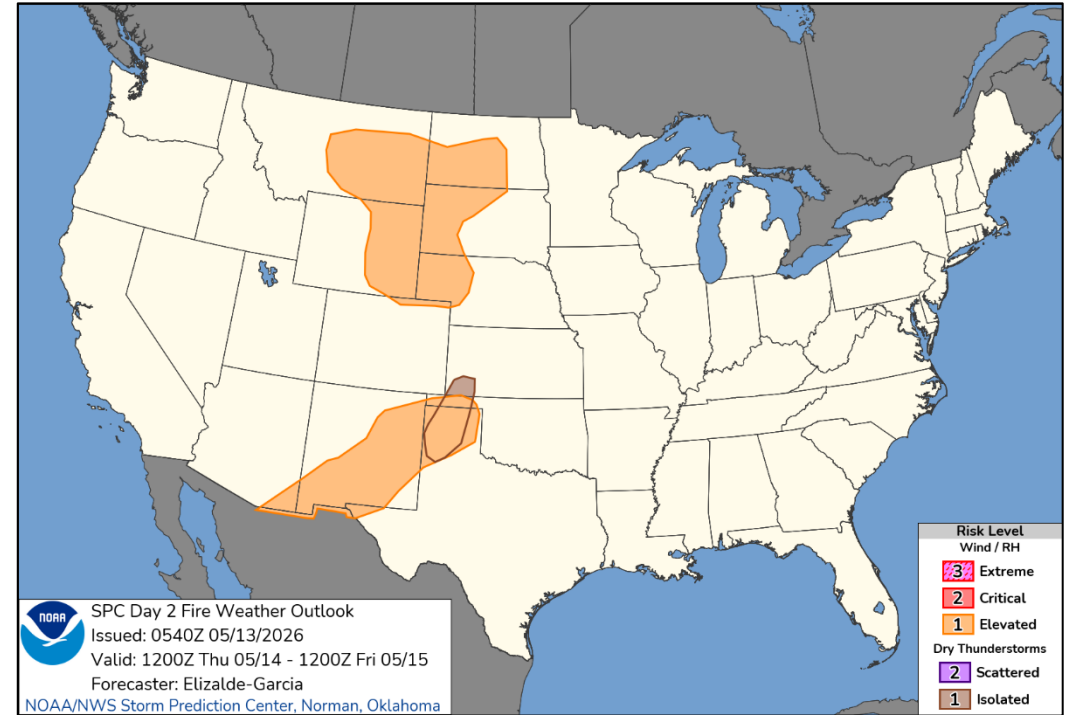

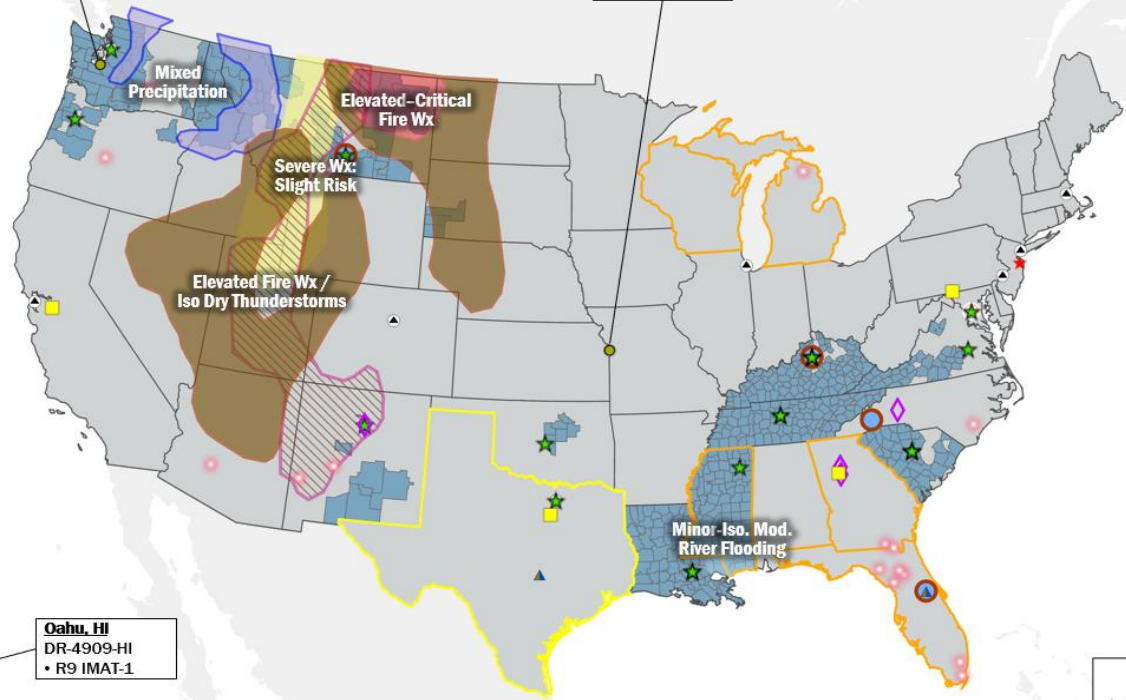
