<u>Situation:</u> FEMA, HHS, and federal partners continue working with state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to execute a Whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Among the 17 states not presently experiencing a decrease in confirmed cases, 7 have no stay-at-home order in place, 1 has local or limited stay-at-home order, and 9 have statewide stay-at-home orders in place. Nationwide testing: 9,538,721 (+237,695) cumulative as of May 14










Severe Weather Outlook


